MAY THE FOURTH BE WITH YOU: SF will try and level this four-game series after falling in a one-run game here in last night's series opener.

- ▶ SF is 1-3 through the first four games of its longest road trip of the season after going 1-2 in Boston and 0-1 so far here in South Philly...the Giants wrap up their 10-game trip with three games in Denver Tuesday-Thursday.
- ▶ The Giants had an off-day in Boston on Monday before the series began Tuesday night...the Giants are in the midst of 16 consecutive scheduled games before their next off day on May 16...the 16 consecutive days without a day off is the Giants longest span of the season.

ROSTER MOVES: **C Blake Sabol** (#21) was recalled from Triple-A Sacramento...**C Patrick Bailey** was placed on the 7-day Concussion IL.

MAYBE WE NEED NEW KYBER CRYSTALS?: Over their last eight games the Giants offense is slashing .206/.270/.308 and have scored a total of 19 runs...they are averaging 2.4 runs/game in that span but have gone 3-5 as a team in the win-loss column.

- ▶ They haven't scored more than three runs in any of those eight games, which matches the longest stretch of games the 2023 Giants scored three or fewer runs in a game (the final eight games of the season where SF's offense actually scored no more than two runs in eight straight games).
- ▶ The last time the Giants had a stretch longer than eight games of scoring three runs or fewer was 2018 when they went 11 straight games from September 4-16.
- ▶ SF scored twice in the second inning yesterday but that has been a rarity for most of the season...entering play today, the Giants rank 28th in 1st inning OPS (.575) 29th in and 1st inning runs (nine)...they also rank 28th in 2nd inning OPS (.587) and 18th in 2nd inning runs (13) (SIS).

MY YOUNG PADAWAN: RHP Keaton Winn takes the ball tonight for his seventh start of the campaign and is facing the Phillies for the first time in his career...Winn enters today's start having pitched 6.0 innings and allowing one run in each of his last three outings (all Giants wins).

- ▶ Over his last four starts, Winn boasts a 1.96 ERA (5er, 23.0ip) with 21 strikeouts to six walks.
- ▶ The 26-year-old has not thrown more than 89 pitches in an outing so far this season (his first outing on April 1 at the Dodgers and April 12 at Tampa Bay).
- ▶ Winn has thrown 214 splitters this season, tied with Colorado's Cal Quantrill for most in the Majors...opponents are hitting .176 off the pitch
- ▶ The only member of the Phillies lineup Winn has faced before is IF Whit Merrifield when he was a member of the Blue Jays last season.

IMPERIAL GROUND CREW: Tonight's game features two of the Majors best groundball pitchers thus far in 2024...SF's starter **Keaton Winn** enters today with a 60.7% groundball rate, third-best in the Major Leagues.

- ▶ Just ahead of him is tonight's Phillies starter and reigning NL Pitcher of the Month LHP Ranger Suárez, who has a 62.2% groundball rate (second-best in MLB).

THE MICHAELORIAN: **OF Michael Conforto** owns a career .883 OPS with 20 doubles, 23 homers and 73 RBI against the Phillies (102 games), most of that coming in his time with the New York Mets.

- ▶ Conforto's 73 career RBI vs. the Phillies are third-most among active players behind Freddie Freeman (130) and Marcell Ozuna (77).
- ▶ In this ballpark, Conforto has a .281/.353/.552 slash line (.906 OPS) with 12 doubles and 15 homers...his 15 homers here are the most he's hit at any stadium outside of Citi Field (66), his home ballpark with the Mets from 2015-2021.

MEESA SO HAPPY TO SEE YOU!: Over their last two games the Giants bullpen has combined for 8.0 scoreless innings, allowed just three hits struck out 11 and not walked a batter.

- ▶ The Giants 'pen has one stretch of three consecutive games not allowing a run this year (April 5-7 vs. San Diego when they totalled 7.0 scoreless innings with four hits allowed, one walk and nine strikeouts).

THEIR MIDICHLORIAN COUNTS ARE OFF THE CHARTS: Giants starters have a 1.92 ERA (11er, 51.2ip) over their last 11 games...they've struck out 48, walked 21 and allowed one homer in those 51.2 innings.

- ▶ Despite the solid effort from the starts, SF is 5-6 in those 11 games as a team.
- ▶ Dating back to April 18, Giants starters have allowed just one homer in 67.1 innings pitched...that homer was on April 22 vs. the Mets (Pete Alonso off today's Giants starter **Keaton Winn**).
- ▶ Overall, Giants starters have given up the fourth-fewest homers this year trailing only the Nationals and Mets (both with 11) and Red Sox (12).

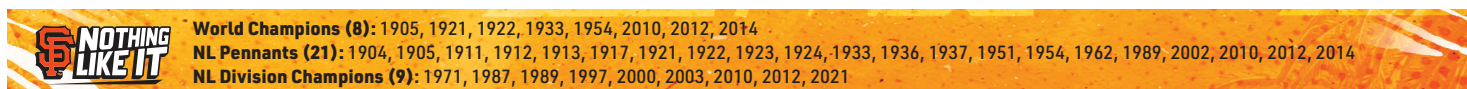
THE FORCE HAS NOT BEEN WITH US: Entering play today the Giants have a .367 SLG, 20th in the Majors...their expected slugging percentage based on batted ball data is .389...the -.019 difference is sixth-highest in the Majors...only the Cardinals (-.047), Royals (-.036), White Sox (-.031), Pirates (-.026) and Marlins (-.024) have a bigger difference.

FEAR IS A PATH TO THE DARK SIDE: The Giants were 2-for-11 with RISP last night and have scored 88 runs with RISP this season, tied for fifth-fewest in the Majors ahead of only the Blue Jays (80), Mariners (75), White Sox (65) and A's (57).

IT'S IOWA: The rookie made his first career Opening Day roster and is slated to face the Phillies for the first time in his young career... Winn was selected by the Giants in the fifth round (136th overall) of the 2018 draft out of Iowa Western Community College and made his debut last season.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his third consecutive win on Sunday against the Pirates...threw 6.0 innings and held opponents to just one run for a third straight start...Winn allowed just three hits in the outing - matching his fewest in a starting role - and struck out five...batters were just 1-for-10 off his splitter with three strikeouts in the start.

TRENDING UP: Over his last four starts, Winn is 3-1 with a 1.96 ERA (5er, 23.0ip) and 0.96 WHIP...he's holding opponents to a .203 average and .580 OPS in that span...the stretch comes after starting the season 0-2 with a 5.73 (7er, 11.0ip) and seven strikeouts in two starts prior.

FAST AND FURIOUS: Batters are just 3-for-26 (.115) with 10 strikeouts off his four-seam fastball this season...Winn's .115 opposing average with the four-seamer is fourth-lowest in MLB among starters who've thrown at least 100 four-seamers...more specifically over his last four starts dating to April 12 in Tampa, Winn has held opponents hitless in 18 at-bats ending with the pitch while striking out eight batters in 19 plate appearances.

BANANA SPLIT: Winn's trademark is his splitter, which he's been using 42.3% of the time this season...12 of his 28 strikeouts this season have come off the pitch and he's limiting opponents to a .176 (9x51) clip with just three extra-base hits (.294 SLG)...Winn's 42.3% splitter usage this season is the highest of any starting pitcher in MLB.

KEEP THEM GROUNDED: Winn has excelled at inducing ground balls early in his career...his 60.7% ground ball rate this season is third-best in MLB, trailing only ATL's Max Fried (67.4%) and today's rival, PHI's Ranger Suárez (62.2%) .

SLIIIIIDE TO THE LEFT: Lefties are just 6-for-54 off him this season with 16 strikeouts and a .390 OPS...Winn's .111 opposing average vs. lefties is best in the NL and ranks second in MLB (min. 55 BF) behind Toronto's José Berrios (.088).

GOT 'EM: Has been very successful at retiring batters when he gets ahead of the count in his young career...in 117 career plate appearances ending with Winn ahead in the count, opponents are hitting .167 with a .391 OPS.

WINNING WAYS: Has made 11 career Major League starts and has thrown at least 4.0 innings and allowed six hits or fewer in each of those outings...the 11 starts are the second-longest such streak by any Giants player to begin their MLB career in the modern era (since 1901)...only **Albert Suárez** had a longer streak (12).

2023 SEASON: After starting the year in Triple-A Sacramento, Winn made his Major League debut on June 13 at St. Louis in relief, firing 4.0 innings and picking up the save...he joined SF's rotation two weeks later and made five starts for the Giants, going 1-3 with a 6.04 ERA as a starter...overall, the right-hander posted a 1-3-1 record with a 4.68 ERA and 1.04 WHIP across nine MLB appearances.

SAVING THE DAY: After collecting the save in his Major League debut on June 13, 2023 at St. Louis, Winn became the third MLB pitcher since 1969 (when saves became an official stat) to pitch at least 4.0 innings and earn the save in his debut (*Elias*)...the other pitchers to achieve the feat were St. Louis' Zack Thompson (June 3, 2022) and Boston's Bob Stanley (April 16, 1977).

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Cutter, Sinker

Last Game: 5/2 at BOS; S, 1.0ip, k (14 pitches)

- ▶ Is 2-0 with a 1.64 ERA and 6-for-6 in save opportunities over his last 11 outings.
- ▶ Has struck out 15 batters over 11.2 innings of work (11.6 SO/9.0).
- ▶ 12 of his 15 strikeouts this year have come with his slider.
- ▶ Righties are just 2-for-19 (.105) off him, while lefties are 7-for-25.
- ▶ Earned his first career All-Star selection last season and wrapped up the 2023 season with 39 saves, tied for the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind CLE's Emmanuel Clase (44).

#64 SEAN HJELLE ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

Last Game: 5/3 at PHI; 2.0ip, 4k (28 pitches)

- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on April 19...missed SF's first 21 games with a right elbow strain he suffered early in spring.
- ▶ Three of his four outings with SF have been scoreless.
- ▶ Made 15 appearances for SF last year, posting a 6.52 ERA...had a really nice end to the '23 season with SF, working 7.0 scoreless innings with six strikeouts over the season's final 10 days.
- ▶ The 6'11" right-hander is tied for the tallest pitcher in MLB history with RHP Jon Rauch.

#77 LUKE JACKSON ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 5/3 at PHI; 1.0ip, h (16 pitches)

- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on April 22...he suffered a low back strain on Opening Day against the Padres back on March 28.
- ▶ Has made four appearances since being reinstated (4.1ip, 5h, 0r, bb, 2k).
- ▶ Batters are 7-for-18 (.389) with two walks and two strikeouts vs. Jackson in his five appearances at the MLB level this year.
- ▶ Appeared in 33 games for SF in 2023 and posted a 2.97 ERA with 43 strikeouts over 33.1 innings of work (11.61 SO/9).

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

Last Game: 5/2 at BOS; 1.0ip, k (15 pitches)

- ▶ Was used as an opener on May 1 at BOS...was his first start since June 2, 2022 with Double-A Reading.
- ▶ Has held opponents scoreless in nine of his last 10 outings, while striking out 14 batters and posting a 0.60 WHIP.
- ▶ LHBs are 2-for-18 off him and RHBs are 4-for-31.
- ▶ The southpaw made his debut on Opening Day.
- ▶ Is ranked the Giants No. 27 prospect according to *MLB.com*.
- ▶ Made 48 appearances in Triple-A last year and converted 14-of-17 save opportunities while striking out 73 batters (12.63 K/9ip).

#73 RANDY RODRÍGUEZ ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Changeup

Last Game: 4/30 vs. TAC (w/AAA); 1.0ip, 2k (10 pitches)

- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento Thursday and is on a Major League roster for the first time...is seeking his MLB debut.
- ▶ Is SF's 28th-best prospect according to *MLB.com*.
- ▶ In 10 appearances at Triple-A (all in relief), Rodríguez had a 1.69 ERA (2er, 10.2ip) with 10 strikeouts and four walks...batters were hitting .184 off him to start the year.
- ▶ Had a 4.37 ERA in 45 appearances last year between Double-A Richmond (2.97 ERA in 16 games) and Triple-A Sacramento (5.73 ERA in 27 appearances).
- ▶ Has allowed only 13 homers in 261.2 career minor league innings.
- ▶ Originally signed by SF as a non-drafted free agent on July 2, 2017 out of the Dominican Republic



#33 TAYLOR ROGERS ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Cutter
