THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
JULY 12
2016 - 2B Jose Altuve and RHP Will Harris represent the Astros in the All-Star Game, as the AL downs the NL by a score of 4-2 at Petco Park in San Diego...for Altuve, it marked his second All-Star start and fourth overall appearance...Harris, who was making his All-Star debut, pitched out of a huge jam in the 8th inning, striking out the Cardinals PH Aledmys Díaz with the bases loaded to preserve the 4-2 lead.

TODAY'S GAME: The Astros and Rangers will play their final game of the first half today in the rubber game of their big three-game series at Globe Life Field in Arlington, TX...both teams named today's starters postgame last night with the Astros tabbing **RHP Cristian Javier** (0-1) for the start opposite **LHP MacKenzie Gore** (5-8), who'll be working on three-days rest for the Rangers.

ABOUT JAVIER: **RHP Cristian Javier**, who missed nearly three months of the season with a right shoulder strain, is returning to the rotation today after making his last two appearances out of the 'pen...he broke camp in the rotation and made just three starts to open the season before being sidelined...the veteran Javier, who was limited to eight starts in 2025 while recovering from Tommy John surgery, is 35-23 in his career with a 3.81 ERA.

THE SILVER BOOT SERIES: The Astros are 6-3 vs. the Rangers thus far in the 2026 Silver Boot Series and can win the season series today with a win...since the start of the 2017 season, the Astros have won or split nine straight season series against the Rangers, going 99-54 vs. the Rangers in that span.

THE SLOW TURNAROUND: After a slow start to the season, the Astros are 27-19 since May 21, which is the best record in the AL in that span...on that date, the Astros were 20-31, 11 games under, which is their low water mark for the season.

ROAD WARRIORS: The Astros are 17-11 on their last four road trips combined and are 23-17 on the road since going 1-9 on their first road trip of the season...the Astros have won four of their last six road series dating back to May 22.

WINNING THE CLOSE CALLS: The Astros are 9-6 in one-run games and 21-11 in two-run games...nine of the Astros last 11 wins and 14 of their last 17 victories have come by two-or-fewer runs...last night's 9-3 win was the Astros first win by four-plus runs since June 19 vs. CLE, in a 9-3 win.

TODAY'S TELECASTS: Today's game will be televised by Space City Home Network with **Kevin Eschenfelder**, **Geoff Blum** and **Lauren Callender** on the call...**Shelby Coppedge** and **Brian Bogusevic** will host the pre- and postgame show on SCHN.

DRAFT DAY 2: The second and final day of the 2026 MLB Draft (rounds 5-20) will begin today at 10:30 a.m. CT...yesterday, the Astros made six selections in the first four rounds, selecting **OF Logan Hughes** out of Texas Tech with their first round pick at number 17 overall.

LAST NIGHT'S BIG WIN: The Astros posted their largest win in nearly a month with a 9-3 win over the Rangers in the penultimate game prior to the ASG break...**RHP Peter Lambert** (1ER/6IP) was great in his start, fanning seven en route to his 8th win...**DH Yordan Alvarez** (2x3) and **C Christian Vázquez** (1x3) both hit solo homers, but the big blast came from **RF LaMonte Wade Jr.** (1x4), who smashed the first grand slam of his eight-year career.

TODAY'S ROSTER MOVE: The Astros have traded **IF Braden Shewmake** to the Brewers in exchange for cash considerations...Shewmake was designated for assignment by the Astros on Friday.

ASTROS AYA ALL-STARs: The Astros Youth Academy has its baseball and softball teams playing in tournaments in Philadelphia this weekend, with the boys participating in the Commissioner's Cup and the girls participating in the Jennie Finch Classic...these events are a part of MLB's baseball and softball development events taking place as part of this year's All-Star Week activities.

ALL-STAR ALVAREZ: **DH Yordan Alvarez** has been voted by the fans as the starting DH for the AL All-Star team...this marks the fourth All-Star selection for Alvarez (2022-24, 2026) and the second time that he has been voted as a starter (also in 2024).

MVP-CALIBER: **DH Yordan Alvarez** is a strong MVP candidate, currently leading all of baseball in OPS (1.055), OBP (.422), SLG (.633), and total bases (219)...additionally, he ranks first in the AL in HR (31), first in RBI (70), first in XBH (48), tied for first in hits (109), second in batting average (.315), second in runs (65), and fourth in walks (61).

WHAT A HALF!: **DH Yordan Alvarez** has hit 31 homers this season, which are the most in a first half in franchise history, topping **OF Lance Berkman**, who hit 29 homers in the first half of the 2002 season...Alvarez is on pace to hit 51 homers on the season, which would represent a new franchise record, topping the 47 homers hit by **1B Jeff Bagwell** in 2000.

SECOND HOME: **DH Yordan Alvarez** is hitting .455 (10x22) with seven homers, 11 RBI and five walks in six games at Globe Life Field this season...in just 36 career games at Globe Life Field, Alvarez ranks tied for 11th all-time at the stadium in homers (19), just ahead of the Rangers **DH Joc Pederson** (16 HR in 96g) and **1B Jake Burger** (12 HR in 97g).

BEST IN TEXAS: **2B Jose Altuve** has 38 home runs and 101 RBI in his career vs. the Rangers, which are his most vs. any opponent...all-time in MLB history opposite the Rangers, Altuve ranks fifth in runs scored (145), seventh in homers (38), and eighth in hits (245)...all-time leaderboards vs. TEX below:

ON THE MEND: **RHP Hayden Wesneski** (right elbow surgery) made a rehab start at Triple A last night vs. Albuquerque, tossing 4.2 innings, allowing one run on five hits with seven strikeouts and no walks on 61 pitches...**LHP Bennett Sousa** (left elbow inflammation) also pitched at Triple A last night, tossing 1.0 scoreless inning on eight pitches.

TODAY'S FUTURES GAME: The Astros top two prospects, **OF Kevin Alvarez** and **IF Xavier Neyens**, will represent the club in the All-Star Futures Game, which will be played today in Philadelphia...both prospects, which play for Class A Fayetteville, are considered top 100 prospects per MiLB.com, with Alvarez ranking 69th and Neyens 87th overall.

LAST APPEARANCE, JULY 8 AT WSH: Worked a scoreless 1.0 inning while allowing 1 hit and 2 walks in Wednesday's series finale at WSH...tossed 30 pitches in the outing, 16 for strikes...has posted a 3.00 ERA (1ER/3IP) with 4 strikeouts through his 2 relief appearances this year (also, July 4 vs. TB).

LAST START, APRIL 8 AT COL: Was limited to just 1.0 inning, allowing 1 run on 3 hits with 1 strikeout...was removed from the game following his inning of work due to right shoulder tightness and would subsequently be placed on the IL with a right shoulder strain.

REPTIL IN THE ROTATION: Returns to the Astros rotation after a 2-appearance stint in the bullpen following his reinstatement from the IL...began the season as the Astros' No. 3 starter and made 3 turns in the rotation before being placed on the IL with his right shoulder strain...has worked predominantly as a starter since the 2022 season, making 74 of his 81 total appearances in that span as a starter...has gone 34-22 with a 3.90 ERA (207ER/477.1IP), a .208 opponent batting average, a 1.16 WHIP and 9.5 SO/9 in his 93 career regular-season starts.

WELCOME BACK: Was reinstated from the 60-day IL on July 3 after missing 76 games (April 9-July 1) due to a right shoulder strain...made 5 starts as part of his rehab assignment, dating back to June 3...made 4 starts with Triple A Sugar Land and 1 start with Double A Corpus Christi...posted a 4.08 ERA (8ER/17.2IP), .226 opponent batting average and 1.25 WHIP throughout his rehab assignment.

VS. TEX: Has made 16 career regular-season appearances (12 starts) vs. the Rangers, tied with the A's for his most appearances vs. an opponent...has gone 7-1 with a 3.66 ERA (31ER/76.1IP), a .199 opponent batting average, a 1.07 WHIP and 9.43 SO/9IP in his career vs. TEX...his .199 opponent batting average vs. TEX ranks 1st among MLB pitchers since his debut season of 2020 (min. 150 batters faced)...is set to make his 1st appearance at Globe Life Field since a start on July 3, 2023.

INVISBALL: Among AL pitchers since 2022 (min. 300 IP), he ranks 6th in H/9 (7.07) and 7th in opponent batting average (.213).

NO. 600: Recorded his 600th career strikeout on April 3 at ATH...became the 27th pitcher in Astros history to record 600 strikeouts with the club...became just the 10th player in Astros history (for a player who began his career with the club) to record 600 strikeouts within their first 126 career appearances...also became the 56th Dominican-born pitcher in MLB history to record 600 career strikeouts.

EL REPTIL: The Dominican pitcher is in his 7th MLB season with the Astros and has gone 35-23 with a 3.81 ERA (233ER/550.1IP) and 606 strikeouts in 129 appearances, including 93 starts...among Astros pitchers with at least 500 innings pitched with the club, his .206 career opponent batting average ranks 3rd, behind only **LHP Billy Wagner** (.186) and **RHP Justin Verlander** (.199)...was signed by the Astros as a non-drafted free agent from the Dominican Republic on March 19, 2015...signed a 5-year contract extension in Feb. 2023 that will keep him in Houston through the 2027 season.

2025 RECAP: Returned from Tommy John surgery in early August...went 2-4 with a 4.62 ERA (19ER/37IP)...also recorded 34 strikeouts, a .230 opponent average and a 1.27 WHIP in eight starts.

LAST APPEARANCE (7/7 at WSH): Allowed 1 hit and struck out 1 in 1.0 scoreless inning on Tuesday night at WSH.

TURNING THE PAGE: Has gone 2-1 with 4 saves and a 2.61 ERA (6ER/20.2IP) with 22 strikeouts, a 1.16 WHIP and a .203 opponent batting average in his last 22 apps., dating back to May 3...within these apps., he logged 9 consecutive scoreless outings (8.2 IP) from May 3-28...his 9-game scoreless streak is the 2nd-longest by an Astro this season, behind **LHP Steven Okert** (14-game streak).

VS. TEX: In 31 career regular-season appearances vs. the Rangers, he's posted a 3.90 ERA (14ER/32IP) and 10.30 SO/9IP...his 31 appearances vs. TEX since his 2019 debut season rank 2nd among all MLB pitchers, behind only former teammate **RHP Ryan Pressly** (39 apps.)...has posted a 1.28 ERA (2ER/14.1IP) in his 14 games vs. the Rangers since the beginning of the 2024 season...has held **IF Josh Jung** to 0x7 with 3 strikeouts and **IF Jake Burger** to 0x5 with 4 strikeouts in their career matchups.

ALL-TIME ASTRO RANKINGS: Has recorded 350 career relief appearances with the Astros...recorded his 349th career appearance on July 1 vs. MIN, surpassing **LHP Joe Sambito** for the 5th-most relief appearances in Astros history...now trails **RHP Brad Lidge** (377) for No. 4 on the list...also ranks 4th all-time among Astros relievers in strikeouts (486) and 10th in IP (359.2).

CAREER: In 350 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.90 ERA (116ER/359.2IP) with 486 strikeouts, a 1.22 WHIP, a 12.16 K/9 and a 0.80 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 2nd in appearances among active AL relievers.
