RAY REPORT—The Rays continue a nine-game, 10-day homestand against the Mets (3-0), White Sox (1-0, 2 to play) and Yankees (3 to play) tonight at Tropicana Field...they have won a season-high four straight games, their longest winning streak since a four-game run from Sept. 8-11, 2022...their last winning streak of 5+ games was a seven-game stretch from June 3 (G2)-June 9, 2023.

Last night's 8-2 win matched Tampa Bay's largest of the season, joining March 29 vs. TOR (8-2)...following Tommy Pham's 3rd-inning homer, Rays pitching combined to hold the White Sox to a 1-for-21 (.048) clip with 7 SO over the remainder of the contest

combined to hold the White Sox to a 1-for-21 (.048) clip with 7 SO over the remainder of the contest. The Rays have won five straight games at Tropicana Field for the first time since May 28–June 9, 2023 (5G)...their last home winning streak of 6+ games was their franchise-best 14-game run to open the 2023 campaign from March 30–April 24. Last night, all nine Tampa Bay starters reached base safely, the fourth time they have accomplished the feat this season (last: April 26 at CWS). The Rays recorded a season-high three extra-base hits in the 5th inning (2 2B, HR), their most in any frame since Sept. 29, 2023 at TOR (3).

<u>DeLUCA'S DOMINANCE</u>—In four games since making his Tampa Bay debut on May 3, Jonny DeLuca is 5-for-15 (.333) with a walk-off 3B, 1 HR, 10 RBI and 2 SB...his 4 RBI in last

His 10 RBI are the most through a player's first four games with the Rays in club history and are the most through a Rays hitter's first four games of a season, surpassing Evan Longoria (8) in 2009...the record through a player's first five games with the Rays is held by Rey Ordóñez (8) in 2003...Dave Martinez's 9 RBI in 1999 are the most through a Tampa Bay hitter's first five games of a season.

Prior to DeLuca, Wilson Ramos (8G, 2017) was the fastest Ray to reach 10 RBI with the franchise. Deluca is the first Pay with 3+ PBI in back-to-back games since

the franchise...DeLuca is the first Ray with 3+ RBI in back-to-back games since **Josh Lowe** from Aug. 18-19 (G1), 2023.

Despite playing in only four contests, his three games with 3+ RBI are tied for fifth most in the AL, one shy of co-leaders HOU Yordan Alvarez, CLE Josh Naylor, KC Salvador Perez and NYY Juan Soto (4G each).

RUNNING WILD-Tampa Bay has swiped 12 bases over its last three games...it marks

the third time in club history the Rays have stolen 12+ bases in a three-game period (last: 12SB from May 25-27, 2023)...the Rays 12 multi-steal games lead the AL and are fourth most in the majors behind Washington (15G) and Cincinnati/Milwaukee (13G).

The Rays have five players with 5+ steals: José Caballero (14SB), Randy Arozarena (6SB), Jose Siri (6SB), Richie Palacios (5SB) and Amed Rosario (5SB)...they are one of three teams in the majors to have 5+ players with 5+ steals, joining Cincinnati (6) and Washington (5) (6) and Washington (5).

Caballero has 14 SB in 32 games to open the season, the third most by any Ray through 32 games in franchise history...Carl Crawford stole 21 bases from April 7–May 9, 2009 and swiped 17 bags from March 30–May 13, 2004.

run of the year behind a season-opening nine-game run...entering play today, the five-game stretch is the longest active streak in the majors.

ON THE OFFENSIVE—During the Rays current four-game winning streak, they are slashing .313/.415/.478 (42-for-134) with 9 2B, 2 3B and 3 HR...they have plated 28 runs during this stretch (7.0 R/G) after tallying six runs in their previous four games from April 28-May 1 (1.5 R/G).

Following an 0-for-15 stretch from April 28–May 1, **Yandy Díaz** has hit safely in each of his last four games, including three multi-hit efforts, going 7-for-18 (.389) with 12B and 5 RBI.

Harold Ramírez tallied a career-high-tying four hits last night (also Aug. 19, 2023 at LAA)...his three runs scored also matched a career high (7x, last: Aug. 14, 2023 at SF)...he has a team-leading four games with 3+ hits, tied for fourth most in the AL behind CLE Steven Kwan (7G), HOU Jose Altuve (6G) and HOU Yordan Alvarez (5G).

Richie Palacios has a seven-game on-base streak, batting .375 (9-for-24) with 12B, 1 HR, 7 BB and 4 SB...he is two games shy of matching his career-long nine-game on-base streak from Sept. 24, 2023–March 29, 2024.

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE—Tampa Bay has drawn 4+ walks in five straight games, its longest such streak since June 20-26, 2021 (6G)...they have 28 BB overall during this stretch, their most in a five-game period since Aug. 4-9, 2022.

RELIEF RENAISSANCE—The Rays bullpen has pitched to a 0.89 ERA (20.1IP, 2ER) while limiting opponents to a .129 (9-for-70) average over the last four games...since April 16, the Rays 'pen ranks among MLB in opp. average (3rd, .183), hits/9.0IP (3rd, 6.04), opp. OBP (4th, .282), WHIP (5th, 1.08), opp. OPS (5th, .584), ERA (6th, 3.08) and opp. SLG (6th, .302).

RHP Kevin Kelly has recorded six scoreless appearances (8.0IP) since being recalled from Triple-A Durham on April 22...Kelly has retired 22 of 24 BF since plunking DET Mark Canha on April 22.

LHP Garrett Cleavinger has not allowed an ER in his last 11 outings, yielding only three hits in that span (3-for-30/100), he has struck out 1+ batter in a career-best

three hits in that span (3-for-30/100)...he has struck out 1+ batter in a career-best 10 consecutive appearances.

RHP Jason Adam owns a 0.71 ERA (12.2IP, 1ER) in his last 12 appearances...RHP Phil Maton has turned in a 1.35 ERA (6.2IP, 1ER) in his previous eight outings.

TROP TALK—Isaac Paredes has reached base safely in 17 straight home games, the third-longest active streak in the AL behind LAA Mike Trout (21G) and LAA Luis Rengifo (19G)...the last Ray with a longer streak was Yandy Díaz (21G) from May 2–June 25, 2023.

Paredes has drawn at least one walk in four straight games, tied with three others, including teammate **José Caballero**, for the longest active streak in the majors... his five multi-walk games are tied for fourth most in the AL behind BOS **Rafael Devers**, SEA **Jorge Polanco** and NYY **Juan Soto** (6G each).

SOUTH SIDERS IN ST. PETE—The Rays and White Sox continue a six-game season series tonight at Tropicana Field...Chicago swept a three-game set at Guaranteed Rate Field from April 26-28, earning its first sweep over Tampa Bay since Aug. 3-5, 2018.

The Rays are 8-3 vs. the White Sox at Tropicana Field since July 21, 2019, outsoring

Chicago, 63-38 (+25), during that time...prior to the 11-game stretch, the White Sox won five straight games in St. Pete from Aug. 3, 2018–July 20, 2019.

TONIGHT'S START—Eflin makes his eighth start of the season, including his fourth at home...marks his first outing at Tropicana Field since April 15 vs. LAA...has turned in a 5.40 ERA (11.2IP, 7ER) in his last two starts after recording back-to-back scoreless starts from April 15-20 (12.1IP)... is on a three-decision losing streak, his longest since May 1-28, 2022 (3)... is seeking his first win since April 2 vs. TEX...the Rays have lost four of his last five starts.

LAST TIME OUT—Eflin took his second consecutive loss on May 1 at MIL despite falling one out shy of his fourth quality start (L, 5.2IP, 6H, 3ER, 6SO, HR)...went six-up, six-down on 24 pitches in the first two frames... yielded 3 hits in the 4th, including a two-run William Contreras double...did not allow another hit until Willy Adames took him deep with one out in the 6th.

SOX SNAPSHOT—In four career appearances (3GS) opposite Chicago, Eflin is 1-1 with a 3.50 ERA (18.0IP, 7ER) and 15 strikeouts against four walks...in two starts in 2023, he went 1-0 with a 2.70 ERA (10.0IP, 3ER)...in his lone start this season, he yielded a season-high-tying nine hits on April 26 in Chicago (L, 6.0IP, 9H, 5R, 4ER, 2BB, 4SO, HR)...in that contest, he held the Sox to two runs through five innings, but permitted a three-run HR to Martín Maldonado with one out in the 6th.

In two home outings (1GS) against the White Sox, Eflin is 1-0 with a 1.29 ERA (7.0IP, 1ER) and 0.43 WHIP, retiring 21 of his 24 BF.

In 11 career appearances (10GS) against the AL Central, he is 6-3 with a 3.59 ERA (57.2IP, 23ER)...was 6-0 with a 1.58 ERA (45.2IP, 8ER) in his first eight games vs. the division, but is 0-3 with an 11.25 ERA (12.0IP, 15ER) in three starts since.

DOME SWEET DOME—After allowing a season-high 6 ER on Opening Day vs. TOR, Eflin has gone 1-0 with a 0.71 ERA (12.21P, 1ER) in his last two home starts...since joining the Rays ahead of last season, he is 12-5 with a 3.32 ERA (122.01P, 45ER) across 21 home starts, with the Rays going 15-6 in those games...in his first 11 outings in St. Pete, the Rays went 10-1 while Eflin posted a 2.10 ERA (68.2IP, 16ER)...in his previous 10 Tropicana Field starts dating back to July 26, 2023, the Rays are 5-5, with Eflin turning in a 4.89 ERA (53.1IP, 29ER).

HUNG OUT TO DRY—The Rays have lost five of Eflin's seven starts, supplying him with a major league-low 1.98 runs of support per 9.0 IP... he has received two runs of support or fewer in six of his seven starts, including five outings with one or zero runs...excluding his April 2 start vs. TEX, he has a combined 1.04 run support average in his other six outings...
overall, the Rays are averaging 2.57 total runs per game in his starts.

In the two Eflin starts the Rays have won (April 2 vs. TEX & April 20 at NYY), he has pitched to a combined 0.73 ERA (12.1IP, 1ER).

IT'S A MARATHON—In innings 1-5, Eflin has posted a 2.31 ERA (35.0IP, 9ER) and held opponents to a .208 (27-for-130) average and .539 OPS...from the 6th inning on, he owns a 15.00 ERA (6.0IP, 10ER), .486 (17-for-35) opp. average and 1.457 opp. OPS...he has allowed nine of his 20 total runs in the 6th frame, tied with LAA José Suarez for the most by any pitcher in the 6th inning this season 6th inning this season.

When his pitch count resides between 1-60, opponents are 22-for-113 (195) against him...once he surpasses the 60-pitch mark, opposing hitters have gone 22-for-52 (.423), the highest such average in the majors (min. 40AB), ahead of TEX Martín Pérez (.380).

OUALITY CONTROL—Eflin paces the majors in walk rate (2.3%) and walks per 9.0 IP (0.88) and ranks fourth in SO/BB ratio (9.00) behind PIT Jared Jones (10.40), SEA George Kirby (10.25) and DET Jack Flaherty (9.33)... he walked only two of his first 130 BF (1.5%) in 2024 before walking consecutive batters on April 26 at CWS...since issuing the back-to-back walks, he has strung together a 39 BF streak without a free pass.

He has produced the lowest walk rate in the majors since 2020 at 3.9

pct. (min. 1,500BF), ahead of **Zack Greinke** (4.4%).
Eftlin's 68.8 pct. strike rate since the beginning of last season ranks fourth in the majors (min. 150.0IP) behind only Kirby (70.9%), MIN **Joe Ryan** (68.9%) and MIA **Sandy Alcantara** (68.9%)...his 7.93 SO/BB ratio ranks second behind Kirby (9.26) under the same parameters.
