TODAY'S GAME: With a series win secured after last night's win, the Giants can try to get greedy as they eye a sweep of the Dodgers this afternoon...SF has won five of its last six games, outscoring opponents 26-15 and out-hitting opponents 60-33 in that time.

- ▶ This series win against the Dodgers is the Giants' first since June 28-30, 2024 after losing each of their last five series against LAD dating to mid-2024...SF's shutout of the Dodgers last night was their first since they blanked LA 15-0 on June 17, 2023 in LA.
- ▶ The Giants are trying to sweep LA for the first time since June 16-18, 2023 when they did so down at Dodger Stadium in LA...the last time SF swept LA here at home was a three-game series June 10-12, 2022.
- ▶ Despite these two wins, SF is still 20-40 (.333) against the Dodgers since the start of 2022, their lowest winning percentage against any NL opponent in that time.

WEBB SLINGER: RHP Logan Webb makes his sixth start of the season this afternoon.

- ▶ SF's Opening Day starter is off to his roughest five-start stretch to start a season since joining the rotation in 2020, carrying a 5.10 ERA into today's game.
- ▶ Prior to this year, Webb's highest ERA through five starts to open a season was a 4.40 ERA in 2023...he logged a 3.06 ERA over his final 28 starts that year, led the Majors in innings (a career-best 216.0) and set a then career-highs in starts (33) and strikeouts (194).
- ▶ In four starts against LA last season Webb went 2-2 with a 5.79 ERA (15er, 23.1ip) and was actually better against the Dodgers in LA, going 1-1 with a 1.93 ERA (3er, 14.0ip) in two starts compared to 1-1 with a 11.57 ERA in two starts (12er, 9.1ip) at home.

PATRICK STAR: C Patrick Bailey provided all the offense in last night's 3-0 win with his three-run blast in the 7th inning.

- ▶ It was Bailey's second go-ahead homer in the 7th inning or later against LA after hitting a walk-off grand slam September 12, 2025 against the Dodgers...he's one of three Giants since 2010 with multiple go-ahead homers against LA in the 7th inning or later, joining **C Buster Posey** and **IF Juan Uribe**.
- ▶ Coincidentally enough the walk-off grand slam against LA last September was the last homer Bailey had hit prior to last night's blast.
- ▶ With last night's homer, exactly half of Bailey's 22 career homers since breaking into the leagues in 2023 have given SF a lead or tied the game (11)...of those 11, seven have come in the 7th inning or later...the seven go-ahead homers in the 7th inning or later are the most such homers by a Giant over that span.

GOING DEEP: RHP Tyler Mahle became the second Giant this season to reach 7.0 innings with his outing last night...overall, Giants starting pitchers are averaging 5.2 innings a start tied for the most of any group's starters with the Dodgers, Mariners, Tigers and Yankees.

- ▶ On the flip side, SF has six different position players who have played in 23 or more of the team's first 24 games...only the Braves (eight players), Angels (seven) and A's (seven) have had a larger group of players appear in 23 or more games so far this year.
- ▶ SF's position players have been going the distance as the Giants' 10 pinch-hit at-bats as a team are third-fewest in MLB ahead of only Minnesota (nine) and Arizona (six).
- ▶ In a semi-related note, the Giants have had the platoon advantage in only 48.9% of PAs this year, fifth-lowest in the league...league average is 57.2%.

PEN TO PAPER: The Giants' bullpen has allowed just two earned runs over their last eight games (0.66 ERA, 27.1ip, 29 strikeouts and 10 walks).

- ▶ Since April 7, the SF bullpen has a 1.74 ERA (8er, 41.1ip) over its last 13 games...opponents have hit .172 in that time with a .530 OPS...the 1.74 ERA in that span is best in the Majors, with the next closest team being the Reds (2.34).
- ▶ Overall, the Giants' bullpen has a 3.28 ERA (29er, 79.2ip) for the season, sixth-lowest in the Majors and fifth-lowest in the National League entering play today...in terms of hard-hit rate, the bullpen's 34.3% mark is fifth-lowest in MLB (S/S).

YOU & ME GOING FISHIN' IN THE DARK?: Following today's game the Giants welcome in the Miami Marlins Friday-Sunday to wrap this six-game homestand.

- ▶ SF was swept by the Marlins in a three-game series in SF last June 24-26 and has lost five straight at home to Miami dating to August 31, 2024...they're 1-5 over the last two seasons at home against Miami.

In his first start of the season, **Carl Hubbell** of the New York Giants pitched a three-hit shutout against the Boston Bees. For Hubbell, it was his 17th straight win dating back to July 17, 1935.

LOGAN WEBB RHP #62

GOLD GLOVE: 2025 | ALL-STAR: 2024, 2025

WEBBMASTER: Is in his eighth season in a Giants uniform and is in the third year of his five-year contract extension he signed in 2023...the 29-year-old is the longest-tenured Giant on the roster after making his MLB debut on August 17, 2019 at Arizona.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the win last Friday at Washington despite allowing four runs (three earned) on seven hits in 6.0 innings in the Giants' 10-5 victory...it was essentially the same start he turned in at Baltimore that resulted in a loss a week earlier (6.0ip, 5h, 4r, 3bb, 6k)...told reporters after the game "that at this point, I'm just kind of hurting the team, to be honest, I'm lucky we scored 10...I mean, it's first and third because I threw bad pitches. You can't make every play but it's on me to get more outs and not give up as many hits and runs and walks."

VS. LOS ANGELES-NL: Is set to face the Dodgers for a 21st time in his career and first time this season...in four starts last year against LA he was 2-2 with a 5.79 ERA (15er, 23.1ip)...oddly, Webb has reverse home/road splits against the Dodgers during the regular season in his career...in 10 starts at Dodger Stadium he's 4-2 with a 3.40 ERA (SF is 6-4 in those games)...in 10 starts here at Oracle he's 2-6 with a 5.60 ERA (33er, 53.0ip) and the team is 4-6 in those games...in his two starts against the Dodgers at home last year he allowed a total of 12 runs on 16 hits in 9.1 innings.

COMPARE AND CONTRAST: Looking at Webb's pitch mix through five starts compared to his 34 starts year a season ago, you see that his sinker usage is up almost 6% from last season while his sweeper usage is down roughly 5% from a season ago...Webb's whiff rate on his sweeper through five starts this year is 14.3%...a season ago it was 29.0%...batters are 4-for-16 (.250) off it in the early going this year, which is in line with what opposing hitters did against it last year (52-for-182, .286) but he's getting much less swing through on the offering in 2026 with his whiff % on the pitch down nearly 15%.

THROUGH FIVE: Webb's 5.10 ERA through his first five starts of the season is his highest through his first five starts to begin a year since he became a full-time member of the rotation in 2020...his previous high for an ERA through five starts was 4.40 through his first five in 2023...Webb went on to finish that season making a then career-high 33 starts, posting a 3.25 ERA (10th-best in MLB), striking out a then career-high 194 batters and working a career-best 216.0 innings (led MLB)...Webb logged a 3.06 ERA over his final 28 starts that year.

SEARCHING...: Most of Webb's plate discipline metrics are very comparable to last season except for a few...hitters have made more chase contact this year (65.8%) after a 52.8% chase contact rate in 2025...similarly, Webb's first pitch strike % is only 60.6% this year, down from 68.5% last year and a 66.1% career-rate...after getting to 0-1 this year, batters have a .605 OPS while it's a .741 OPS after it gets to 1-0...lastly, Webb is carrying a 52.2% hard-hit rate through five starts, 12% higher than his 40.2% hard-hit rate all of last season...his 52.2% hard-hit rate this year is in the bottom 8% of MLB.

HE POSTS: Since 2022, no pitcher in the Majors has thrown more innings than Webb's 850.0 innings...the next closest pitcher is Detroit's Framer Valdez, who has logged 797.2 innings...Webb's 88 quality starts since 2022 are also tops in the Majors ahead of Valdez' 87...lastly, his 137 starts in that span are most in MLB ahead of TOR's Dylan Cease (135).

DO IT FOR WEBBY: The Giants were only 18-16 in Webb's 34 starts last year, which was actually an improvement over them going 16-17 in his 33 starts in 2024...they are 2-3 in his five starts this year...since 2022, SF as a team is 69-68 in Webb's 136 starts yet his 3.28 ERA in that time is 10th-best in MLB among starters who have made at least 80 starts...his 2.96 FIP in that span is second in the NL behind LAD's Blake Snell (2.95) and is third in MLB also behind Detroit's Tarik Skubal (2.50).

ADRIAN HOUSER RHP #12

2026 RECORD: 0-2, 5.40 ERA

- ▶ Got a no decision with five runs (four earned) on seven hits and two walks across 5.2 innings at Washington on April 18...struck out only one batter in the game.
- ▶ This will be Houser's sixth career game (four start) vs. the Marlins...he is 3-0 with a 3.22 ERA (8er, 22.1ip), 31 strikeouts and a 0.94 WHIP in the five previous outings.
- ▶ Left-handed batters are slashing .352/.417/.611 vs. Houser this season with a 1.028 OPS...righties have a .211/.250/.237 slash line (.487 OPS).

#47 RYAN BORUCKI ▶ LHP

(bohr-RUCK-ee)

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Split Finger, Sweeper

Last Game: 4/21 vs. LAD; 1.0ip, h, k (10 pitches)

- ▶ Lefties are 2-for-17 (.117) with two walks and six strikeouts vs. him...has held lefties to a .179 clip (69-for-386) in his MLB career.
- ▶ Righties, however, are 8-for-15 with four XBH (two HRs) this year.
- ▶ Signed a Major League contract with the Giants on March 21 after opting out of his minor league deal with the White Sox on March 20...was in camp with Chicago-AL as an NRI and went 2-0 with eight strikeouts and a 0.67 WHIP over 6.0 shutout innings.

#34 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP

(BROO-baker)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Cutter, Changeup

Last Game: 4/19 at WSH; 1.0ip (12 pitches)

- ▶ Eight of his nine appearances this year have been scoreless.
- ▶ Has issued at least one walk in six of nine contests (6.35 BB/9.0ip).
- ▶ Right-handers are 9-for-27 (.333) with three XBHs off him while lefties are 1-for-13 (.077).
- ▶ Three of his nine appearances thus far have been 2.0 innings.
- ▶ Signed a minor league contract w/SF on Aug. 13, 2025 and made five appearances (one start) with SF, posting a 4.26 ERA (6er, 12.2ip) with 12 strikeouts and a 1.26 WHIP.

#93 MATT GAGE ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Splitter

Last Game: 4/21 vs. LAD; 0.2ip, bb (14 pitches)

- ▶ Lefties are just 1-for-12 (.083) against him this season, and 18-for-95 in his career (.189).
- ▶ Has appeared in 11 of SF's 24 games, tossing 10.0 innings and allowing two earned runs (1.80 ERA).
- ▶ Signed an MiLB deal with SF on July 2, 2025 after spending the first half of the year in the Tigers organization.
- ▶ He's the first wearer of #93 in SF Giants history...#93 is the highest player-worn uniform number in SF-era history, passing No. 87 (worn by **RHP Dan Otero** in 2012).
- ▶ Originally was a 10th-round pick of the Giants in 2014 before his career journey brought him back to SF last season.

#45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(kill-EE-en)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 4/22 vs. LAD; 1.0ip, h (13 pitches)

- ▶ Earned his first MLB win with 2.0 scoreless innings of relief last Saturday...stranded the free base runner in both the 11th & the 12th.
- ▶ Allowed one run on three hits in 11.0 innings with 14 strikeouts and six walks in 11 games.
- ▶ Has a 33.3% strikeout rate early on that is in the top 8% of MLB...his .168 xBA ranks in the top 6% of MLB.
- ▶ Batters are 0-for-13 with four Ks in ABs that end with his four-seamer...eight of his 14 strikeouts have come w/his knuckle curve.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite this past offseason...dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of 2025 with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.

#60 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4 Seam FB, Sinker, Changeup

Last Game: 4/21 vs. LAD; 1.0ip, h, bb, k (26 pitches)

- ▶ Has not allowed a run in his last five appearances dating back to April 8 vs. Philadelphia (5.0ip, 2h, 3bb, 9k).
- ▶ Has appeared in nine of SF's 24 games, allowing four runs in 8.0ip.
- ▶ Has not allowed a homer in his last 53.1 innings dating to August 14, 2024, the fourth-longest active homerless streak in MLB.
- ▶ Had a 1.02 ERA (2er, 17.2ip) in his final 21 outings last season (May 12-July 2) before hitting the injured list with a left elbow sprain on July 3...did not pitch for SF the rest of the year.

#46 BLADE TIDWELL ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Sweeper, Slider, Splitter

Last Game: 4/17 at WSH; 1.0ip, hbp (10 pitches)

- ▶ Has held opponents scoreless in five of his six outings (2er, 8.0ip) and posted a 0.75 WHIP and .192 BAA.
- ▶ Has only walked one batter in 8.0ip this season (3.6% walk rate).
- ▶ Recalled on April 2 with **RHP José Buttó** being placed on the IL...logged his first career save in his Giants debut that night pitching against the Mets, the team that drafted him.
- ▶ Pitched one game for Triple-A Sacramento on March 29, drawing the start vs. El Paso while spinning 2.2 hitless/shutout innings.
- ▶ Played for Giants **MGR Tony Vitello** while at the Tennessee...is from Loretto, TN, which has a population of about 1,700 people.
- ▶ Was selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2022 draft and joined SF at last year's deadline alongside **RHP José Buttó** and **OF Drew Gilbert** in exchange for RHP Tyler Rogers.

#74 RYAN WALKER ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Sinker, Slider

Last Game: 4/22 vs. LAD; SV, 1.0ip, bb (16 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in 11 of SF's first 24 games and converted three of his four save opportunities.
- ▶ Last season, his 87.0 mph avg. exit velo ranked in top 7% of MLB...this season it sits at 83.1 mph, which is seventh-best in the Majors.
- ▶ Batters are 3-for-18 in ABs that end with his slider and 6-for-23 in ones that end with his sinker...last season, batters hit .277 (41x148) off his sinker and .207 (18x87) off his slider.
- ▶ In his 44 career save opportunities, Walker owns a 5.74 ERA (27er, 42.1ip)...in his 160 games in a non-save situation, Walker owns a 2.31 ERA (44er, 171.1ip).

#67 KEATON WINN ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, 2-Seam FB, Splitter, Slider

Last Game: 4/21 vs. LAD; 0.1ip, k (5 pitches)

- ▶ Leads the team with four holds on the season.
- ▶ Nine of his 11 appearances this year have been scoreless...opponents are just 4-for-33 (.121) off him this year.
- ▶ Struck out 13 batters in 9.2 innings of work.
- ▶ Batters are just 1-for-19 with 11 K's off his splitter this season.
- ▶ Spent most of the first half of 2025 on the injured list dealing with right shoulder tendinitis.
- ▶ Appeared in seven games with SF last season exclusively out of the 'pen, posting a 4.50 ERA (5er, 10.0ip) with nine strikeouts...prior to 2025, he had started 17 of his 21 games at the big league level.
- ▶ Overall, was 1-1 with a 8.49 ERA (22er, 23.1ip) in 14 games (three starts) with Triple-A Sacramento in 2025.
