**BIRDLAND BITES:** The Orioles beat the Reds, 9-5, to even the series yesterday...Baltimore will play its fifth rubber game of the year already (1-3) with all five series of three games needing one to begin the season...The club wraps up its longest homestand of the year (10 days) today, having gone 4-3 against Toronto (1-1), Cleveland (2-1), and Cincinnati (1-1)...Following an off day tomorrow, the Birds travel to the nation's capital to play the Nationals from Tuesday-Thursday before heading to Detroit for a three-game set next weekend.

- ⚾ The O's hit five home runs for the second time this season (6, 3/27 at TOR)...The Angels (6, 4/10 at TB), Cubs (4/18 vs. AZ), and Yankees (9, 3/29 vs. MIL) are the only other teams with 5+ homer games in 2025.
- ⚾ Yesterday, the Orioles hit back-to-back home runs to lead off the game, had two sets of back-to-back homers off two different pitchers, and a player with multiple home runs off the bench...According to *Stats Perform*, no other team in MLB history has accomplished all three single-game feats over an entire season, let alone in one game.
- ⚾ Baltimore hit back-to-back home runs to start a game for the 11<sup>th</sup> time in franchise history and for the first time since **Cedric Mullins** and **Trey Mancini** did so on June 7, 2022 vs. Chicago-NL.
- ⚾ Baltimore hit two pairs of back-to-back home runs for the seventh time in team history (since 1954) and the first since **Adley Rutschman** and **Ryan Mountcastle** in the third inning, and **Anthony Santander** and **Austin Hays** in the fourth inning on June 27, 2022 at Seattle...The other instances were on August 10, 2017 at Oakland, August 25, 2014 vs. Tampa Bay, May 27, 2008 vs. New York-AL, August 28, 2007 vs. Tampa Bay, and May 17, 1967 at Boston.
- ⚾ **Cedric Mullins** hit his team-leading sixth home run of the year and second leadoff homer of the year (also 4/3 vs. BOS)...His 18 career leadoff home runs rank second in Orioles history behind **Brady Anderson** (44).
- ⚾ **Ramón Laureano** entered in the third inning as a defensive replacement for **Heston Kjerstad** and tallied his fifth career multi-homer game and first since June 30, 2022 at Seattle...He's the fifth player in Orioles history to hit two home runs off the bench and the first since **Trey Mancini** on June 7, 2017 vs. Pittsburgh.
- ⚾ **Félix Bautista** secured his 50<sup>th</sup> career save in his 127<sup>th</sup> game, second fastest Oriole to 50 saves by an Oriole behind **Gregg Olson** (101 G).

**ROSTER MOVES:** The Orioles today recalled right-handed pitcher **Cody Poteet** from Triple-A Norfolk...Poteet will be making his O's debut after he was acquired from the Cubs in exchange for cash considerations on March 29 and optioned to the Tides...To make room on the active roster, right-hander **Brandon Young** was optioned to Triple-A.

**CED AND DONE:** **Cedric Mullins** has homered in at least two straight games for the 12<sup>th</sup> time in his career and for the first time since June 26-27, 2024...He's gone deep in three straight games once, from September 5-7, 2021.

- ⚾ He ranks among AL leaders in on-base percentage (2<sup>nd</sup>, .443), walks (T-2<sup>nd</sup>, 15), OPS (3<sup>rd</sup>, 1.104), RBI (T-3<sup>rd</sup>, 19), slugging percentage (4<sup>th</sup>, .661), runs (T-5<sup>th</sup>, 15), and extra-base hits (T-5<sup>th</sup>, 11).
- ⚾ He is one of four MLB players leading their team in hits (18), homers (6), RBI (19), and walks (15), along with CHC's Kyle Tucker, NYY's Aaron Judge, and SD's Fernando Tatis Jr.

**THE MAGIC NUMBER:** The O's are 9-2 when scoring four or more runs this year and winless (0-9) when scoring three or fewer.

- ⚾ Since 2024, Baltimore is 89-21 (.809) when scoring four or more runs, the fourth-best winning percentage in MLB during that time behind San Diego (89-15, .856), Cleveland (85-15, .850), and Houston (81-19, .810)...During that same period, the Birds are 11-61 (.153) when scoring three runs or fewer, the fourth-worst mark in the majors ahead of the White Sox (12-108, .100), Diamondbacks (9-51, .150), and Rockies (14-79, .151).
- ⚾ The O's have lost 19 straight games when scoring three runs or fewer dating to September 7, 2024, with their last such victory coming on September 6, 2024 vs. Tampa Bay (2-0).

**LONG BALL LIVING:** The Birds have hit 18 homers during the seven games on this homestand, tallying multi-homer performances in six of the contests...This follows a 10-game stretch from March 30-April 9 in which they hit an MLB-low two homers...Baltimore's 30 home runs on the season are third in the AL and tied for fifth in MLB with the Diamondbacks, behind the Dodgers (36), Yankees (35), Cubs (34), and Angels (32).

- ⚾ The O's have hit at least two home runs in six of 10 home games this season, including four straight since Thursday...The club has 13 total homers in the last four games, the most in a four-game home stretch since August 23-30, 2017 (also 13).
- ⚾ Baltimore has homered in seven straight games in a single season for the first time since doing so in 16 straight from August 4-21, 2024...The team set a club record by going deep in 22 consecutive games from June 1-23, 2024.
- ⚾ The O's have received 14 long balls from their 6-9 hole hitters, the most in MLB...The club led MLB with 87 such homers in 2024.

**'PEN PALS:** The O's bullpen has posted a 2.97 ERA (25 ER/75.2 IP) this season, second in the AL and fifth in MLB behind the Padres (1.65), Giants (1.78), Mets (2.02), and Astros (2.87)...Orioles relievers have allowed 0.48 home runs per 9.0 innings, second lowest in MLB behind the Mets (0.45).

- ⚾ **Seranthony Domínguez** has thrown 8.1 scoreless innings across nine appearances to open the season, allowing two hits and six walks with 10 strikeouts.
- ⚾ **Yennier Cano** has yet to allow a run across 8.1 innings, scattering five hits and one walk while fanning eight.
- ⚾ **Bryan Baker** has allowed one run with three walks and 11 strikeouts in 10 outings.

**ADVANCED TALK:** O's batters have produced a collective 46.1 percent hard-hit rate, ranking fourth in the majors behind the Yankees (47.0%), Red Sox (46.7%), and Mets (46.3%).

- ⚾ **Gunnar Henderson** has recorded a 67.6 percent hard-hit rate, second best among batters (min. 25 batted balls) behind ATL's Drake Baldwin (71.4%)...**Ryan O'Hearn** (55.8%), **Ryan Mountcastle** (55.3%), and **Heston Kjerstad** (51.4%) are all above 50 percent.

THIS DATE IN O'S HISTORY

April 20, 1992 - Detroit's Mickey Tettleton becomes the first player in Oriole Park history to homer onto Eutaw Street in the fourth inning, landing the third consecutive Tigers home run off Ben McDonald on the iconic pavement. The O's rally to win, 12-4, with 12 unanswered runs.

**QUICK HITS:** Morton is set to make his fourth start of the season this afternoon and the 23<sup>rd</sup> of his career against Cincinnati...At 41 years, 142 days old in his home debut, became the oldest Orioles pitcher to record 10 strikeouts in a game in franchise history (since 1954), per [@SlangOnSports](#)...Made four Grapefruit League starts, recording a 3.38 ERA (3 ER/8.0 IP) on nine hits and one walk with six strikeouts... Signed a one-year contract with the Orioles on January 3, 2025...Made 30 starts with the Braves in 2024, going 8-10 with a 4.19 ERA (77 ER/165.1 IP) on 154 hits (23 HR), 85 total runs, 65 walks, and 18 hit batters with 167 strikeouts...Was on Atlanta's NLWC roster, but did not appear in a game.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Was dealt his fourth consecutive loss on April 15 vs. Cleveland after allowing five runs on seven hits (1 HR) and three walks with two strikeouts in 5.0+ innings...Did not record an out before being removed in the sixth inning with a runner on, who came around to score...The last O's starter with an ERA of 8.84 or higher through his first four starts of the year was John Means in 2020 (10.13)...Has received losing decisions in each of his first four starts of the season for the second time in his career (2010, five straight losses)...Is one of three MLB starters to lose their first four starts so far this year (PHI's Aaron Nola & TB's Zack Littell)...Threw 88 pitches, 50 strikes.

**PAINT THE TOWN RED:** Has made 22 career starts opposite Cincinnati, going 8-9 with a 4.01 ERA (57 ER/128.0 IP) on 119 hits (8 HR), 46 walks, and 11 hit batters with 87 strikeouts...Was dealt the loss in his last outing against the Reds on September 9, 2024 at Truist Park with Atlanta after allowing one run on six hits, two walks, and one hit batter with seven strikeouts in 6.2 innings.  
🕒 Tossed back-to-back complete games against the club on April 15 and May 18, 2011 at Great American Ballpark with Pittsburgh, going 2-0 with one total run surrendered across the two starts...Allowed a two-out, solo home run to Jay Bruce in the bottom of the ninth inning to snap the 8.2-inning shutout on April 15, 2011.

**LIKE FINE WINE:** In his Orioles debut, at 41 years, 136 days old, Morton became the oldest pitcher in franchise history to start a game for the Orioles, surpassing Orlando Peña (39y, 177d) on May 13, 1973 (G1) at New York-AL...The oldest pitcher to ever appear in a game in club history is Jesse Orosco (42y, 160d) on September 28, 1999 at New York-AL.

**BEHIND THE CURVE:** Opponents are slashing .435/.464/.870 (10-for-23) with two doubles, one triple, and two home runs off Morton's curveball this season...Through his first five starts in 2024, he held opponents to a .208/.300/.245 (11-for-53) line and two extra-base hits (2-2B) with his curveball.  
🕒 In 2024, Morton limited opponents to a .200 (55-for-275) average on the offering while producing a 34.2 percent whiff rate...Of his 167 strikeouts last season, 102 came on the curveball (61.1%).

**WALK THIS WAY:** Has issued at least one walk in 17 straight starts dating back to July 20, 2024 (G1)...The 17-game stretch is the fifth-longest active streak among MLB starters and the longest stretch of Morton's career since a 58-gamer from June 28, 2022 to June 2, 2024 (148 total BB)...Has walked multiple batters in 12 of the 17 outings (38 total BB).

**FOUR-GET ABOUT IT:** Has allowed four or more runs in a career-high six consecutive starts (26 total R) dating back to September 20, 2024...It is the longest active stretch in the majors and the first such streak since Cole Irvin's six-gamer from June 13 to July 11, 2024 with Baltimore (31 total R)...The last Orioles pitcher to allow 18+ runs through his first four starts of the year was Ty Blach in 2019 (21 R, 8/12 [G2]-9/3 [G1]).

**MODEL OF CONSISTENCY:** Made 30+ starts in each of his last six full seasons (excluding 2020) since 2018...He joins Toronto's José Berríos, Texas' Patrick Corbin, and Philadelphia's Aaron Nola as the only pitchers in MLB to accomplish the feat during that stretch...Morton had not reached the 30-start mark in each of his first 12 seasons from 2008-19.

**UPS AND DOWNS:** His 3.97 run support average in 2024 was the sixth lowest in MLB (min. 120.0 IP) behind Pittsburgh's Luis Ortiz (3.32), Pittsburgh's Jared Jones (3.48), Washington's Patrick Corbin (3.50), Cincinnati's Hunter Greene (3.89), and St. Louis' Andre Pallante (3.93).  
🕒 Since 2023, Morton is 19-5 with a 3.33 ERA (69 ER/186.1 IP) when receiving three runs or more of support, compared to 3-21 with a 5.15 ERA (92 ER/160.2 IP) when receiving two runs or fewer.
