NATIONALS NEWS	
MOVING ON The Washington Nationals square off against the New York Mets in the second game of this three-game weekend series on Saturday afternoon...Washington dropped the first game, 4-1, on Friday night. - Washington is in the midst of a stretch of 39 games in 41 days that started on July 24 and runs through Sept. 2. - The Nationals have won five of their last nine games since Aug. 5...Washington is outscoring its opponents, 53-41 during this stretch. - The Nationals are 13-5-1 in road series this season and 33-28 (.541) on the road overall this season.	
START ME UP Over the last three games, Washington's starters have combined to allow just six hits (.103 AVG, 6-for-58, 2B, HR) with 20 strikeouts and a 2.55 ERA (5 ER/17.2 IP). Brad Lord will attempt to continue this strong run with his third start of the season on Saturday afternoon...He last pitched on Aug. 9 vs. Cincinnati, striking out four batters in 2.2 innings of two-hit. one-run ball in his second start of the year...Lord's first start of 2026 came on July 1 at Boston...He threw 2.1 shutout innings with two hits, two walks and one strikeout.	
ALIEN ENCOUNTERS CJ Abrams - the National League Player of the Month in July - is at the top of the Major League and National League leaderboards in several offensive categories...See chart to the right for the list. - With 91 RBI this season, Abrams has matched Ian Desmond (91 in 2014) for the most RBI by a shortstop in a single season in Nationals history (2005-pres.)...With nine more RBI, he will become the 12th player in Nationals history to record 100 RBI in a season and first since Anthony Rendon (126) and Juan Soto (110) in 2019. - With six more stolen bases, Abrams will become the second player in Nationals history to record a 30 homer/30 stolen base season joining Alfonso Soriano (40 HR/41 SB) in 2006.	
CHAPPY AND ABI The combination of Andrés Chaparro and Abimelec Ortiz have put up impressive numbers over the last month: Andrés Chaparro ranks third in Major League Baseball in OPS (1.056) and is second in slugging percentage (.673) since the All-Star break...He's hitting .288 (15-for-52) with a .383 on-base percentage (5 BB), five doubles, five homers, 21 RBI and 12 runs scored in the 20 games since the break. Abimelec Ortiz is 7-for-20 (.350) with three homers, seven RBI, just two strikeouts and four runs scored in his last six games...He's hit safely in five of the six and has recorded at least one RBI in four of the six.	
HOT BATS Other Nationals hitters enjoying hot stretches at the plate: Harry Ford has scored at least one run in five straight games, the longest active streak in baseball and has at least one extra-base hit in four straight, the third-longest active streak. Daylen Life is 10-for-28 (.357) with a double, homer, nine RBI, one stolen base and four runs scored in his last seven games...He's hit safely in six of the seven. Keibert Ruiz has hit safely in six of his last eight games, going 10-for-27 (.370) with a double, three RBI, four walks, just three strikeouts and four runs scored. Jacob Young is 11-for-26 (.423) with two doubles, one triple, one homer, five RBI, two hit by pitch, two walks, just one strikeout and five runs scored in his last eight games...He's hit safely in seven of the eight.	
HOMER HAPPY Washington leads Major League Baseball with 177 home runs, seven ahead of the New York Yankees (170). - The Nationals have clubbed 140 home runs since May 6, the most in Major League Baseball and 18 more than the New York Mets (122)...Washington entered play on May 6 with 41 home runs, 12th-most in MLB. - Washington has seven players (Abrams, Crews, Garcia Jr., Lile, Mead, Wood, Young) with at least 10 home runs, the most by a Nationals team (2005-pres.) since the 2019 Nationals had 10 players with at least 10 homers.	
BORN TO RUN The Washington Nationals lead Major League Baseball with 135 stolen bases and 10.5 baserunning runs above average, according to FanGraphs... Nasim Nuñez leads MLB with 40 stolen bases. He is seven stolen bases shy of tying CJ Abrams' Nationals record (2005-pres.) of 47 stolen bases in 2023... He is one of four players in Nationals history (2005-pres.) to steal at least 40 bases joining Alfonso Soriano (2006, 41), Trea Turner (2017, 43 and 2017, 46) and CJ Abrams (2023, 47).	
NICE ABS The Nationals rank sixth in MLB with a 60.0% (39-for-65) in ABS challenge success rate since July 12. - Washington's hitters are 10-for-21 (47.6%), while the catchers are 29-for-44 (65.9%) over this stretch...The 27 successful challenges by the catchers third in Major League Baseball since July 12. Keibert Ruiz's 18 successful challenges are fourth among MLB catchers since July 12, while Harry Ford is 11-for-17 (64.7%) on challenges in 15 games since being recalled on July 17.	
FARM REPORT	
FORGOT ABOUT TREY? Rochester infielder/outfielder Trey Lipscomb has hit safely in 11 straight and in 32 of 36 games since July 1 (.359/.401/.572)...During the 11-game streak, he is 20-for-52 (.385) with threee doubles, four homers, 15 RBI and 15 runs scored...He's 7-for-13 (.538) with a double, homer, and four RBI over his last three games...Lipscomb ranks among Nationals minor leaguers in extra-base hits (T1st, 45), home runs (T2nd, 22), RBI (2nd, 71), hits (2nd, 112), slugging percentage (2nd, .532), batting average (2nd, .295), doubles (3rd, 22), and OPS (4th, .865).
