The 2024 Baltimore Orioles Media Guide, as well as the latest game notes, rosters, press releases, and other team information, can be found at oriolespressbox.com.

BACK IN THE WIN COLUMN: The Orioles defeated the White Sox, 8-6, in the first game of the four-game set to snap their season-long three-game losing streak...Improved to 25-10 when homering and 20-3 when hitting multiple home runs...Are a perfect 25-0 when outhitting their opponent.

- 👉 **Grayson Rodriguez** earned the win after allowing two runs on three hits, one hit batter, and a career-high five walks with seven strikeouts in 5.0 innings.
- 👉 **Craig Kimbrel** needed just two pitches to convert his 10th save of the year, the fewest to record a save in his career and fewest by an O's pitcher since **Danny Coulombe** earned the save with just one pitch on August 25, 2023 vs. Colorado; Kimbrel's 427 career saves are sixth all-time and second among active pitchers (see box at right).
- 👉 **Cedric Mullins** swiped second and third in the third inning for his ninth and 10th stolen bases of the year; marked the seventh time in his career that he's stolen two bags in one inning (last: 6/17/22 vs. TB); his 103 career stolen bases are tied with **Corey Patterson** for eighth in O's history.
- 👉 **Ryan Mountcastle** went 4-for-5 with a double and two runs scored, tying his career high in hits for the seventh time (last: 8/3/23 at TOR).
- 👉 **Jorge Mateo** (3) and **Anthony Santander** (8) each homered in the win; Mateo's homer traveled 434 feet, the longest shot of his career and third-longest by an O's batter in 2024 (Cowser, 438 feet & O'Hearn, 435 feet).

THE ERAS TOUR: The O's have a 2.69 ERA (57 ER/191.0 IP) in their last 21 games since April 29, the second-best mark in MLB behind the Yankees (2.58)...During that time, the Birds have surrendered an MLB-low 135 hits while holding opponents to a .197 batting average (135-for-687).

TOP GUNN: **Gunnar Henderson** ranks second in MLB with 16 home runs and among the leaders in a variety of statistical categories (see box at right)...Homered in four straight games from May 17-20, the first Oriole to do since **DJ Stewart** from September 5-9, 2020; is one of four MLB players to homer in at least four straight games this year, along with Boston's Rafael Devers (6 G), Chicago-NL's Michael Busch (5 G), and Los Angeles-NL's Mookie Betts (4 G).

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles rank second in MLB with 71 home runs, the fourth-most homers through the first 48 games of a season in O's history behind 1987(77), 1996(76), and 2012(72).

👉 The Orioles have eight players with at least six homers, the most in MLB: **Gunnar Henderson** (16), **Adley Rutschman** (9), **Anthony Santander** (8), **Jordan Westburg** (7), and **Colton Cowser**, **Ryan Mountcastle**, **Cedric Mullins**, and **Ryan O'Hearn** (6); the Yankees rank second with six players.

LEADING ACTORS: Baltimore leads MLB with six leadoff homers this season...**Gunnar Henderson** has hit five of those, the most in MLB...**Jordan Westburg** has the other for the O's...Since the start of 2021, the Orioles have 23 leadoff blasts, ranked fourth in the AL and tied for eighth in MLB.

👉 Henderson's five leadoff home runs are tied for the fifth-most in a single season in O's history with **Cedric Mullins** (2022), **Seth Smith** (2017), **Adam Jones** (2016), and **Don Buford** (1971); he trails **Brady Anderson** (7 in 1999 & 2000), Mullins (8 in 2021), and Anderson (12 in 1996).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: The Orioles are on a seven-game road trip...Were swept in three games by the Cardinals...Began a four-game set against the White Sox last night.

AGAINST THE WHITE SOX: The Orioles and White Sox opened up a four-game set in Chicago last night, the first of two series between the teams this season...The O's will host the ChiSox in Baltimore for three games from September 2-4...Last year, the Orioles went 4-2 against the Sox, taking two of three in Chicago from April 14-16 and two of three in Baltimore from August 28-30...The Orioles also won the season series against the White Sox in 2022 (5-2) and are 10-4 against them since the start of 2022.

THE SKIPPER: Manager **Brandon Hyde** is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the O's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the BBWAA AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Oriole manager to win the award...He was also voted the *Sporting News* American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year...Hyde's 345 wins rank fifth all-time among Oriole managers, trailing **Hank Bauer** (407), **Paul Richards** (517), **Buck Showalter** (669), and Oriole Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer **Earl Weaver** (1,480).

SCORING CHANGE: In the top of the second inning on May 19 vs. Seattle, Luke Raley reached second base on what was originally scored a double and later came around to score...This has been changed to a fielding error by first baseman **Ryan Mountcastle**... As a result, the run that inning is now unearned.

ROSTER MOVES: The Orioles today recalled right-handed pitcher **Dillon Tate** and left-handed pitcher **Nick Vespi** from Triple-A Norfolk...In corresponding moves, right handed pitcher **Jonathan Heasley** was optioned to the Tides and right-handed pitcher **Dean Kremer** was placed on the 15-day Injured List (right triceps strain), retroactive to May 21.

TRADE WINDS: On Wednesday the Orioles acquired catcher **Blake Hunt** from the Seattle Mariners in exchange for right-handed pitcher **Mike Baumann** and minor league catcher **Michael Pérez**...Hunt was optioned to Triple-A Norfolk.

👉 Hunt, 25, slashed .293/.372/.533 (22-for-75) with four doubles, one triple, four home runs, 15 runs scored, 20 RBI, six walks, and four hit-by-pitches in 24 games with Triple-A Tacoma this season...He was ranked as the No. 23 Mariners prospect by *MLB Pipeline*.

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his 11th start of the season tonight against the White Sox...A three-time All-Star and 2021 NL Cy Young Award winner, Burnes was acquired by the Orioles from the Brewers in exchange for LHP DL Hall, INF Joey Ortiz, and a 2024 Competitive Balance Round A pick on February 1, 2024...Entering the 2024 season, he was ranked as the No. 29 overall player in MLB Network's Top 100 Right Now...He was originally selected by the Brewers in the fourth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Saint Mary's College(CA).

LAST TIME OUT: Secured the win in his last time out in May 19 vs. Seattle after allowing one unearned on six hits and one walk with a season-high-tying 11 strikeouts (3/28 vs. LAA), his first start of the season with zero earned runs... In the top of the second inning, Luke Raley reached second base on what was originally scored a double and later came around to score; this has been changed to a fielding error by 1B Ryan Mountcastle, meaning the run that inning is now unearned...Recorded his first five outs via strikeouts...Received more than two runs of run support for the first time since April 20 at Kansas City...Threw 94 pitches, 63 strikes.

WINDY CITY WARRIOR: Slated to make his third career start and fourth appearance against the White Sox tonight...Has pitched to a 1-0 record with a 4.70 ERA (8 ER/15.1 IP) and 16 strikeouts in his three prior games...Did not factor into the decision in his last start against the ChiSox on August 11, 2023; surrendered five runs on eight hits (1 HR)and three walks with five strikeouts across 5.2 innings.

AGAINST THE AL CENTRAL: Making his 21st career appearance (18th start) and third of the season against the AL Central...Owns a lifetime 9-1 record with a 2.87 ERA (35 ER/109.2 IP) against the division...Earned the win in his last time out against an AL Central opponent on April 20 at Kansas City; allowed three runs on four hits (1 HR) and one walk with four strikeouts in 5.2 innings.

EXTRA REST: When pitching on at least five days of rest this season, Burnes is 4-1 with a 2.22 ERA (12 ER/48.2 IP) in eight starts...Opponents are hitting .202 (36-for-178) on extra rest, compared to .244 (10-for-41) on four days rest.

EARLY STRUGGLES: Burnes has surrendered five of his 16 earned runs in the first inning this season with four of those coming via solo home runs...The four first-inning home runs allowed are tied for second in MLB with Atlanta's Chris Sale, Los Angeles-AL's Griffin Canning, and Minnesota's Pablo López, trailing only San Diego's Matt Waldron (5).

RING 'EM UP: Burnes is one of six pitchers with at least 200 strikeouts in each of the last three seasons (2021-23), along with Dylan Cease, Gerrit Cole, Kevin Gausman, Aaron Nola, and Spencer Strider...His 765 strikeouts from 2020-23 were the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind Gerrit Cole (816)...He is 70 strikeouts away from 1,000.

INNINGS EATER: The 622.1 innings consumed by Burnes since the start of 2021 rank third in MLB (Aron Nola – 644.1 and Zack Wheeler – 626.0)...Last season, he tossed 193.2 innings, which would have been the most by an Oriole since Chris Tillman threw 207.1 innings in 2014.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS: Burnes' 2023 campaign was highlighted by his third consecutive All-Star Game appearance...Burnes made his second straight Opening Day start for the Brewers...On July 25, he became the sixth pitcher in Brewers franchise history to notch 800 career strikeouts...He pitched to a 5-3 record with a 2.72 ERA (30 ER/99.1 IP) across his final 16 starts of the season.

POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE: Burnes' NL Wild Card Series start on October 3, 2023 against the Diamondbacks marked his eighth Postseason appearance (2 GS)...In those games, he has posted a 2.84 ERA (6 ER/19.0 IP) with 11 hits, six walks, and 22 strikeouts.
