## NATIONALS NEWS

**SWEET 16**  
The Washington Nationals finish out this stretch of 16 games in 16 days on Wednesday afternoon against the Cleveland Guardians... The Nationals are 10-5 (.667) during this stretch...Washington will finally enjoy a day off on Thursday before welcoming the San Diego Padres to Nationals Park this weekend.

- The Nationals beat the Guardians, 6-3, on Tuesday night behind another strong outing from **Cade Cavalli** (6.0 IP, 5 H, ER, 2 BB 7 SO) and a three-hit game by **James Wood** (3-for-4, HR, 2 RBI, 2 R, BB).
- Wood is 7-for-9 (.778) with two homers, three RBI, one walk and four runs scored over the last two games.
- With a win today, Washington would secure it's second sweep of the season (5/1-3 at MIL)...The Nationals last swept the Guardians Sept. 27-29, 2019 at Nationals Park and have never swept them in Cleveland.

**WINNING WAYS**  
The Nationals have won a season-high four games in a row, five of eight and are 18-11 (.621) since April 25...They have won seven of their 10 series over this stretch.

- In the 18 wins, the pitching staff has a 2.56 ERA, a .205 opponents' average and 9.2 strikeouts per 9.0.
- Washington's 29-27 (.518) record is the best mark through the Club's first 56 games since the 2018 Nationals started the season 33-23 (.589).
- The Nationals are two games over .500 this late in the season for the first time since June 30, 2021 (40-38).
- The Nationals have a 19-11 (.633) record on the road this season...Washington's 19 wins on the road are the second-most in Major League Baseball behind only the Braves (20) and ahead of the Dodgers (18).

**PITCHING IN**  
Over the last six games, the Nationals pitching rotation has pitched to an 1.00 ERA (4 ER/36.0 IP) with 39 strikeouts and just seven walks.

- As a whole, **Simon Mathews'** pitching staff has pitched to a 1.78 ERA (11 ER/55.2 IP) and a .194 opponents average with just one home run allowed during this stretch.

**VERY OFFENSIVE AS OF LATE**  
Since May 6, Washington's offense leads Major League Baseball in home runs (35), extra-base hits (88), doubles (48), slugging percentage (.497), OPS (.836) and runs scored (121).

- Of note, the 88 extra-base hits are 17 more than the next closest club (San Francisco, 71), the 35 home runs are seven more than the White Sox (28) and the 121 runs are 11 more than the Dodgers (110).
- The Nationals have recorded at least one extra-base hit in 26 straight games, tied for the third-longest active streak in baseball with the Chicago White Sox and behind San Francisco (30) and Pittsburgh (28).

**GET READY TO VOTE**  
With All-Star voting set to open next week, **CJ Abrams** and **James Wood** have placed themselves among the best players in Major League Baseball and the National League...See charts to the right for position specific rankings.

- Abrams' ranks among National League hitters in RBI (2nd, 46), OPS (6th, .923), wOBA (6th, .399), wRC+ (6th, 157), home runs (18th, 12), extra-base hits (8th, 25), slugging (9th, .542) and on-base percentage (10th, .381).
- Wood leads Major League Baseball with 49 runs scored and four leadoff home runs...He ranks in the National League in walks (1st, 46), on-base percentage (1st, .413), wRC+ (1st, 168), wOBA (1st, .414), OPS (11st, .964), extra-base hits (3rd, 29), home runs (12nd, 15), doubles (16th, 14) and RBI (17th, 37).

**GOOD WOOD**  
**James Wood** leads MLB with an average exit velo of 96.4 MPH ahead of **O'Neil Cruz** (96.1)...His 34 barrels (at least 98 MPH exit velo/26 degree launch) are the most in MLB ahead of **Aaron Judge** (29) and **Kyle Schwarber** (29).

- Wood is one of five players in Major League Baseball with more than one batted ball greater than 116.0 MPH this season with **Junior Caminero** (3), **Yordan Alvarez** (2), **O'Neil Cruz** (2) and **Ketel Marte** (2).

**THIS AND THAT**  
Some notable notes about other Nationals players:

- Daylen Lile** leads National League outfielder and is tied for second in the National League with 15 doubles...He's reached base safely in 12 straight games, the longest on-base streak by a Nationals player this season.
- Nasim Nuñez** leads Major League Baseball with 22 stolen bases, ahead of **Jose Ramirez** (20).
- Dylan Crews** has reached safely in all eight games since being recalled on May 19.
- The Nationals have had eight players record at least one save this season, tied for third-most in a season in Nationals history (2005-pres.) with the 2009 Nationals...The 2017 Nationals hold the record with 11 players recording at least one save that season.

**A NOTE FROM THE LAND DOWN UNDER**  
On the significance of **Curtis Mead** (Washington) and **Travis Bazzana** (Cleveland) squaring off this week, per *Elias*:

- Last time two Australian-born players faced off on opposing teams was Sept. 6, 2017: **Peter Moylan** (KC) vs. **Warwick Saupold** (DET)
- The last time two Australian-born players both started on opposing teams was June 27, 2011: **Luke Hughes** (MIN) vs. **Trent Oeltjen** (LAD).

**STREA-KING**  
Rochester shortstop **Seaver King** has reached base safely in all 41 games this season, the longest active streak in Minor League Baseball and the longest streak in MiLB overall this season...He is 9-for-23 (.391) with two doubles, one triple, a homer, nine RBI, two walks and two runs scored in six games since joining Rochester last week.
