TODAY'S GAME: The Giants will try and level this three-game series with the Reds after falling to Cincinnati last night 4-2 in the first game of this nine-game homestand.

- ▶ SF is 3-8 in its last 11 games dating to April 30...the only teams with fewer wins since April 30 are the Blue Jays (2-6), Cardinals (2-8) and Reds (1-8).
- ▶ The Giants are in a stretch of 16 consecutive games without a day off that started on April 30 at Boston...the Giants next off day comes on Thursday after their three-game series with the Dodgers (Monday-Wednesday).
- ▶ The Reds are sending another lefty to the hill to start this afternoon's game...after yesterday's defeat the Giants are 3-7 versus left-handed starting pitchers this year.

ROSTER MOVES: The Giants reinstated **C Patrick Bailey** (#14) from the 7-day concussion Injured List and recalled **IF/OF Brett Wisely** (#0) from Triple-A Sacramento.

- ▶ In corresponding moves, the Giants placed **OF Austin Slater** on the 7-day concussion IL and optioned **C Jakson Reetz** to Triple-A Sacramento.

QUÉ PASA...?: The Giants are slashing .227/.293/.343 over their last 15 games dating to April 24...they are averaging 2.87 runs/game in that span, scoring 43 runs in 15 games.

- ▶ SF's 2.87 runs/game is second-worst in the Majors in that span ahead of only the Pirates (2.27 runs/game)...the Reds are just above the Giants with the third-fewest runs/game in that span (3.00).
- ▶ Below is a breakdown of both teams offense in that stretch.

TAKE FEAR FROM BATS: SF was held to two runs again yesterday...it marked the club's 23rd time in 40 games (57.5%) this season being held to three runs or fewer.

- ▶ The Giants are 6-17 in those 23 games when scoring three or fewer runs.
- ▶ Only the Cardinals and White Sox have more games this year where they've been limited to three runs or fewer (24 each).
- ▶ Overall, the Giants have scored 148 runs through their first 40 games this year, their fewest through the first 40 games since scoring 139 runs in their first 40 games in 2017.

MIKE'S BACK ON?: **OF Michael Conforto** is 7-for-his-last-14 over his last four games with a pair of homers, three RBI, three runs scored and three walks.

- ▶ In nine games so far this month, Conforto is slashing .313/.405/.594 with four extra-base hits, four runs scored, four RBI and five walks.

FREEMASONRY: **RHP Mason Black** will make his Oracle Park debut this afternoon after making his Major League debut last time out in Philadelphia on Monday.

- ▶ Black allowed five runs on eight hits in 4.1 innings but pitched better than his line would indicate...he'd allowed one run through his first 4.0 innings before the Phillies scored four times in the 5th inning (three on a three-run homer by Bryce Harper).
- ▶ Black threw 84 pitches in the game after never throwing more than 71 in his six MiLB starts this year.
- ▶ The 24-year-old was 2-1 with a 1.01 ERA in six Triple-A starts for the River Cats before his promotion last week.

WELCOME BACK PAT: **C Patrick Bailey** returns to the active roster for the first time since taking a foul ball off the mask last Friday in Philly that caused him to leave the game with blurry vision and eventually land on the concussion IL the next day.

- ▶ SF went 2-5 in the seven games Bailey missed in full while recovering from the concussion...in Bailey's 24 starts this year the Giants are 12-12.
- ▶ Giants pitchers have a 3.41 ERA this year when throwing to Bailey and a 6.31 ERA when throwing to any other Giants catcher this season.

PATIENTLY WADE-ING: **IF/OF LaMonte Wade Jr.** has reached base in 11 consecutive games entering play today and has a .500 OBP with five RBI in that span...he's slashing .341/.474/.432 with five doubles, one homer and 12 RBI in 38 games so far this season.

- ▶ Wade's .474 on-base percentage and 20.2% walk rate are both tops in MLB (min. 100 PA), while his .341 average is sixth-best.

CONGRATS, MARIA! Prior to today's game Giants Senior Director of Broadcast Communications & Media Operations **Maria Jacinto** will be honored as this year's Alexis T. Busch Award winner.

- ▶ The award honors the legacy of the first bat girl in MLB history...it is presented annually to a woman in the Giants organization who embodies Alexis' bold spirit, her love for the Giants and the game of baseball and her commitment to encouraging girls and women of all ages to pursue their dreams in sports...Alexis' life was cut tragically short in a sailing accident in April 2012. She was 26.
- ▶ Jacinto, who has spent the last 35 years in the Giants organization, will accept the award on the field today at 3:40 p.m. prior to the game...for more on Jacinto's career, [click here](#).

WITH THE GIANTS: Black will be making his Oracle Park debut after having his contract selected from Triple-A Sacramento on Monday...he has spent parts of four seasons in the system after being taken in the third round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Lehigh University (Bethlehem, PA)...Black became the seventh Giant, and sixth pitcher, to make his Major League debut this season.

VS. CINCINNATI: This will be Black's first career game against the Reds.

LAST TIME OUT: Black made his MLB debut on Monday against his childhood favorite team, the Philadelphia Phillies...the Scranton, PA native had many friends, family and college teammates/coaches in attendance, allowing five runs on eight hits while striking out four across 4.1 innings...Black spun 3.0 shutout innings before a run in the 4th and four in the 5th spoiled the debut.

OPPORTUNITY CALLS: Black looked to be a favorite to win a rotation spot out of Spring Training prior to the signing of **LHP Blake Snell**...Black forced his way into the big leagues with a strong start in Triple-A, going 2-1 with a 1.01 ERA (3er, 26.2ip), 29 strikeouts, a 0.90 WHIP and a .178 opposing batting average (16x90) over six starts...he is 12-14 with a 3.22 ERA in the Minors with 320 strikeouts, a 1.16 WHIP and a .219 opposing batting average over 262.1 career innings (59 starts).

LAST SEASON: He ascended to Triple-A for the first time in his three-year professional career in 2023...he put forth a strong 3.86 ERA (26er, 60.2ip) in 13 starts in the hitter-friendly Pacific Coast League...Black posted a 1.19 ERA (4er, 30.1ip) with 42 strikeouts and seven walks over his final seven starts with Richmond...overall, he averaged 11.3 strikeouts per 9.0 innings for the season, striking out 155 batters in 123.2 innings.

THE FUTURE IS NOW: With the prospect graduation of both **LHP Kyle Harrison** and **RHP Keaton Winn**, Black is currently SF's third-ranked pitching prospect, No. 7 overall, according to *MLB.com*.

REVERSE SPLITS: In Triple-A, lefties had a .152/.300/.303 slash line against Black, while righties had a .193/.220/.246 mark...historically, however, lefties have a .183/.297/.312 slash line against Black with 156 strikeouts and 27 extra-base hits while righties have slashed .245/.304/.386 with 164 strikeouts and 41 extra-base hits.

THE RIGHT MAN: The Reds pose a favorable matchup for Black...Cincinnati's .210 batting average against right-handed pitchers ranks 30th in MLB, its .645 OPS is fourth-lowest in MLB and its 27.6% strikeout rate against righties is the second-highest in the Majors.

AWARDS: Black has had a well-decorated Minor League career...he has won six awards, including a PCL Pitcher of the Week this season when he struck out seven over 5.0 hitless/shutout innings vs. El Paso on April 12.

WHAT'S IN A NAME?: Black told reporters this spring that he and his brother Dixon's names are inspired by the Mason-Dixon line, which is a line that separates Pennsylvania, Maryland, Delaware and West Virginia...per *The Athletic's Andrew Baggarly*, Mason and Dixon have matching tattoos of the geographical location (39° 43' 18" N.) to honor their namesake... Dixon is an infielder at Wofford University.

Last Game: 5/8 at COL; 1.0ip, h, 2r, 2er, hr, 2bb (20 pitches)

- ▶ Has worked in just three of SF's last 11 games.
- ▶ Is 2-0 with a 3.95 ERA and 6-for-6 in save chances in 14 games.
- ▶ Has struck out 17 batters over 13.2 innings of work (11.2 SO/9.0).
- ▶ 13 of his 17 strikeouts this year have come with his slider.
- ▶ Righties are just 3-for-24 (.125) off him, while lefties are 7-for-26.
- ▶ Has gone 6-for-6 in save chances this year and owns a 1.50 ERA (1er, 6.0ip) with four hits allowed, one walk and eight strikeouts.
- ▶ In eight non-save situations in '24, Doval has a 5.87 ERA (5er, 7.2ip) with six hits allowed (two homers), nine walks and nine strikeouts.

#64 SEAN HJELLE ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

Last Game: 5/8 at COL; 0.2ip, 2h, r, er (8 pitches)

- ▶ Worked 4.0 scoreless innings and struck out 10 over two appearances in SF's last weekend in Philadelphia...the last time a Giants reliever had 10+ strikeouts in any series (since 1969) was **RHP Tom Griffin** from Aug. 14-17, 1980 vs. ATL.
- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on April 19...missed SF's first 21 games with a right elbow strain he suffered early in spring.
- ▶ Four of his six outings with SF have been scoreless.
- ▶ The 6'11" right-hander is tied for the tallest pitcher in MLB history with RHP Jon Rauch.

#77 LUKE JACKSON ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 5/9 at COL; 1.0ip, k (13 pitches)

- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on April 22...he suffered a low back strain on Opening Day against the Padres back on March 28.
- ▶ Has made seven appearances since being reinstated (7.1ip, 7h, 0r, 2bb, 5k).
