# CAREER

Tall right-hander from the University of Oklahoma developed into a reliable member of Washington's starting rotation and a leader in the clubhouse.

- After making 33 starts in 2024 and 2025, he joined **Max Scherzer** (2015-16) as the only two pitchers in Nationals history to start at least 33 games in back-to-back seasons.
- Had the "Best Control" in Washington's system, per *Baseball America*, entering the 2023 season.

## LAST START

Irvin tossed 6.0 innings and allowed four earned runs on six hits with four strikeouts against the Miami Marlins at loanDepot park on Aug. 22...He took the loss in the 4-2 defeat.

## vs. COLORADO

Irvin is set to make his fifth career start against the Colorado Rockies...He is 1-0 with a 3.70 ERA (10 ER/24.1 IP) and 31 strikeouts...Irvin has two career games of 10 or more strikeouts and five games in his career with nine or more strikeouts...One of each of them is against the Rockies, both at Coors Field: June 23, 2024: 6.0 IP, 3 H, 1 ER, 10 SO and April 20, 2025: 6.1 IP, 3 H, 2 ER, 9 SO).

- Irvin is one of only three active pitchers, with Zac Gallen (2) and Blake Snell (3), to have multiple games of at least 6.0 IP and three hits or less at Coors Field...There have only been 17 visiting pitchers to have two or more such games at Coors Field since it opened in 1995.

## HARD TO HIT

Over his last six starts, opposing batters are hitting .218 (24-for-110) with a .299 on-base percentage in 30.2 IP.

## CURVIN' IRVIN

Opponents are batting .116 (8-for-69) against Irvin's curveball...He has given up just two extra-base hits on his curveball this season.

## REHAB APPEARANCES

Irvin allowed just two hits (2-for-38) with 12 strikeouts and one walk in 11.1 innings across three rehab outings with the FCL Nationals and Double-A Harrisburg Senators...In two outings with Harrisburg, he allowed one hit in 8.1 innings with nine strikeouts and one walk.

## 2025

Was tied for second in Major League Baseball with 33 starts and ninth in the National League with 180.0 innings pitched.

- Matched a career high with 8.0 shutout innings against San Francisco on May 24...The game was completed in 1 hour, 52 minutes, tied for third fastest game in Nationals history (2005-pres.)...Irvin has pitched in two of the top six fastest games in Nationals history.
