



# Los Angeles Angels (28-42) at San Francisco Giants (34-37)

**TODAY'S GAME:** SF is looking to avoid the sweep this afternoon and even out the homestand with a win against the Angels... the Giants are 2-3 on the homestand after winning the series against Houston (2-1) and dropping the first two against LAA.

- ▶ SF fell to 6-11 in Interleague games this season with yesterday's defeat...the club's .353 winning percentage in those games ranks 27th of 30 teams, ahead only of the Mets (3-9, .250), White Sox (6-15, .286) and Marlins (6-14, .300).
- ▶ The Giants are 15-12 (.556) in their last 27 games dating to May 15...the .556 winning % in that time is fifth-best in the NL behind Philadelphia (17-10, .630), St. Louis (16-11, .593), Milwaukee (16-12, .571) and Cincinnati (16-12, .571).
- ▶ SF has been swept just once at home this season, dropping all three games against NYY at home on May 31-June 2.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The Giants have made the following roster moves prior to today's game:

- ▶ **LHP Kyle Harrison** placed on the 15-day Injured List (retroactive to June 13) with a right ankle sprain.
- ▶ **RHP Spencer Bivens** (#76) selected from Triple-A Sacramento.
- ▶ **RHP Nick Avila** released.

**THEY DON'T MAKE 'EM LIKE THEY USED TO:** The Giants are 26-18 all-time in the regular season vs. the Angels, outscoring them 218-175 (+43)...at Oracle Park, SF is 11-7 vs. LAA, outscoring them 79-70.

- ▶ However, the Giants have dropped each of their past four games against the Angels...it marks their first four-game losing streak to the Halos since also dropping four straight from June 21, 2006-June 17, 2009.

**WHEN I WAS YOUR AGE...: OF Heliot Ramos'** two-run shot in the 1st inning yesterday marked his second time homering in back-to-back games this month (also: June 2-3)...the 24-year-old now has six home runs in June, tying CIN's Jeimer Candelario and CWS' Paul Dejong for second-most in MLB this month, trailing only BAL's Anthony Santander (eight).

- ▶ Ramos' 17 RBI this month are second-most in the MLB behind NYY's Aaron Judge (18).

**DON'T SPEND IT ALL IN ONE PLACE:** Ramos' power surge isn't new to this month...he's reached base safely in 30 of his 34 games since being recalled on May 8, logging 30 RBI in that stretch.

- ▶ His 30 RBI since May 8 are fourth-most in the Majors and the most in the National League in that span.
- ▶ Ramos became the first Giant to have 30 RBI in the first 34 games of their season with SF since **Marlon Bryd** (August 21-September 28, 2015).
- ▶ In the 33 games Ramos has started, the Giants are averaging 4.97 runs per game and hitting .254, compared to 3.6 runs per games and a .237 average when he doesn't (SIS).
- ▶ Defensively, he has +7 DRS in the outfield in 289.2 innings...the +7 DRS are tied for fifth-best among MLB outfielders.

**ASK YOUR MOTHER:** The Giants went 1-for-13 with runners in scoring position yesterday and are just 11-for-66 (.167) in those situations over their last eight games.

- ▶ SF's .297 OBP with RISP this season is fourth-lowest in MLB, while its .234 average ranks as the seventh-lowest.

**I'M JUST RESTING MY EYES:** The Giants are 19-12 (.613) in day games in 2024, including an 11-5 mark in day games here at Oracle Park.

- ▶ SF's .613 winning percentage in day games is sixth-best in the Majors and second-best in the NL behind the Brewers (21-11, .656).
- ▶ The Giants own a .734 OPS in those 31 day games, 69 points higher than their OPS in night games this season (.665).
- ▶ The Giants are 7-3 in their last 10 day games here at Oracle Park dating to April 28.

**THAT'S HOW THEY GET 'YA:** Ramos slugged the Giants' 24th homer at home this season...SF's 24 homers at home are still fewest in the Majors...the team with the next fewest is Toronto (26).

- ▶ Furthermore, the Giants have a -8 home run differential in their home ballpark this year having allowed 32 homers while hitting only 24 themselves.
- ▶ Overall, the Giants and their opponents have combined to hit 56 homers at Oracle Park this season, the fewest of any park in the Majors...St. Louis' Busch Stadium has the next fewest at 58 combined homers.

**WHAT'S THE DAMAGE?:** After allowing three more stolen bases yesterday, the Giants have now surrendered 73 steals to opponents this season...the 73 stolen bases allowed are tied with the Mets for most in the Majors.

- ▶ SF's 73 stolen bases allowed are their most in the first 71 games of the season since 1985, when the Giants gave up 74 bases through their first 71 games of the year.
- ▶ The 73 steals in that span rank as the fifth-most in SF era.
- ▶ The Giants themselves have just 23 stolen bases this season, fewest in the Majors by a wide margin...the next closest team, the Braves, have swiped 31 bags this year.

**READY TO ROCK AND ROLL?:** After today, the Giants travel to Chicago to face the Cubs for a three-game set at Wrigley Field before heading to Birmingham, AL to play the Cardinals on Thursday...the jewel event will take place at historic Rickwood Field, the oldest professional baseball stadium in the US...first pitch is scheduled for 6:15 p.m CT (4:15 p.m. PT).

### #76 SPENCER BIVENS ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Two-Seam FB, Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Sweeper

**Last Game:** 6/11 at RNO (w/AAA): 1.0ip, 2h, 2r, 2er, bb, k (28p)

- ▶ Selected from Triple-A Sacramento today...is on a Major League roster for the first time in his career.
- ▶ Was 4-0 with a 2.81 ERA in 21 relief outings for the River Cats...struck out 36 in 41.2 innings with opponents hitting .220 off him.
- ▶ Named the Pacific Coast League's Pitcher of the Month for May after going 2-0 with three saves, a 0.49 ERA (1er, 18.1ip), 17 strikeouts, an 0.98 WHIP and a .153 batting average against.
- ▶ Signed by SF as a minor league free agent on May 13, 2022 after beginning the year in Indy ball with Gastonia.
- ▶ Began his professional career pitching for the Savigny-sur-Orge Lions in French Division One in 2019 before coming back stateside to pitch for Steel City in Indy Ball in Washington, PA in 2020 during the pandemic.
- ▶ In 81 career minor league games since joining SF's organization he's posted a 3.54 ERA in 178.0 innings with 176 strikeouts.

### #75 CAMILO DOVAL ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, Cutter, Sinker

**Last Game:** 6/12 vs. HOU, SV, 1.0ip, k (9 pitches)

- ▶ Converted his 12th save of the season on Wednesday...is 12-for-14 in save opportunities this season.
- ▶ Issued 19 walks in 27.1ip...his 15.2% walk rate is in the bottom 4% of the league.
- ▶ Righties are just 8-for-53 (.151) with three extra-base hits off him, while lefties are 15-for-53 (.283) with six extra-base hits.
- ▶ Has struck out 35 batters over 27.1 innings of work (11.52 SO/9.0).
- ▶ 20 of his 35 strikeouts this year have come with his slider.
- ▶ Opponents are hitting .368 (7-for-19) off his sinker this year.

### #64 SEAN HJELLE ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Sinker, Cutter, Changeup, Knuckle Curve

**Last Game:** 6/15 vs. LAA; 1.0ip, bb, k (14 pitches)

- ▶ Over his last eight outings, he's thrown 11.1 innings and allowed just one run (solo HR) on two hits with seven strikeouts (0.79 ERA).
- ▶ SF has won 11 of the last 16 games he's appeared in.
- ▶ Has recorded at least five outs in 10 of his 21 games w/SF.
- ▶ Since April 30, Hjelle has a 1.73 ERA (5er, 26.0ip) with 26 strikeouts.
- ▶ Has a 65.5% ground ball rate this year.
- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on April 19...missed SF's first 21 games with a right elbow strain he suffered early in spring.
- ▶ At 6'11, he is tied for tallest pitcher in MLB history with Jon Rauch.

### #77 LUKE JACKSON ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Four-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball

**Last Game:** 6/15 vs. LAA; 1.0ip, hb (7 pitches)

- ▶ Hasn't allowed a run in seven of his last eight outings (8.2ip) and hasn't given up a hit in five of those games.
- ▶ Allowed all four of his inherited runners to score so far in 2024.
- ▶ Lefties are 11-for-32 (.344) off him with six RBI...righties are just 9x47 (.191).
- ▶ Has a 9.64 ERA on the road (9.1ip) and a 1.54 ERA at home (11.2ip).

### #68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

**Last Game:** 6/14 vs. LAA; 1.0ip (16 pitches)

- ▶ Will open today's game with **LHP Kyle Harrison** going on the IL...it's the fifth time he'll be used as an opener this year.
- ▶ In his previous four outings as an opener he's allowed one run on two hits in 4.2 innings in those four starts (1.93 ERA).
- ▶ Over his last 13 games dating to May 15 he's allowed four runs (two earned) in 11.1 innings (1.59 ERA) with 14 strikeouts.
- ▶ LHBs are 6-for-40 (.150) off him and RHBs are 16-for-71 (.225) with five home runs (one inside the park) and 11 RBI.
- ▶ Opponents are 8-for-48 (.167) off his changeup with 13 strikeouts.
- ▶ Has allowed 15 walks in 31.2 innings.

### #73 RANDY RODRÍGUEZ ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Four-Seam FB, Slider, Changeup

**Last Game:** 6/14 vs. LAA; 2.2ip, 3h, 4er, 4er, hr, bb, k (44 pitches)

- ▶ Gave up a career-high four earned runs Friday.
- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento on May 2 and made his MLB debut on May 4 at Philadelphia.
- ▶ Held hitters scoreless in nine of his last 12 appearances (since May 17)...allowed eight runs and struck out 15 in that stretch (15.2ip).
- ▶ Has thrown 4+ outs in eight of his 15 MLB outings...had only pitched more than 1.0ip in two of his 10 Triple-A appearances this season.
- ▶ Four of his 11 inherited runners w/SF have scored.
- ▶ Is SF's 27th-best prospect according to *MLB.com*.
- ▶ In 10 appearances at Triple-A (all in relief), Rodriguez had a 1.69 ERA (2er, 10.2ip) with 10 strikeouts and four walks...batters were hitting .184 off him to start the year.

### 33 TAYLOR ROGERS ▶ LHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, Sinker

**Last Game:** 6/14 vs. LAA; 1.0ip, h, bb (23 pitches)

- ▶ Has not allowed an earned run in his last 11 appearances (12.0ip) and has a 1.06 ERA (2er, 17.0ip) in his last 17 games dating back to May 3...has struck out 23 batters during that stretch (12.18 K/9.0).
- ▶ LH batters are 13x43 (.302) off him overall but are 55-for-their-last-22 (.227) dating to May 11...righties are 10x60 (.167) overall vs. Rogers in 2024.
- ▶ Stranded 16 of his 21 inherited runners so far in 2024.

### #71 TYLER ROGERS ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Sinker, Slider

**Last Game:** 6/12 vs. HOU; 1.0ip, h, k (10 pitches)

- ▶ Has not allowed a run in his last eight outings (8.0ip) dating to May 26...has allowed just two hits in that span.
- ▶ Is three appearances away from 300 in his MLB career...his 35 appearances this year are tied for second-most in MLB.
- ▶ Has allowed just one walk (and it was intentional) in 33.0 innings pitched...his 0.8 BB% is the lowest in MLB (min. 100 batters faced).
- ▶ Opposing batters have gone 30-for-125 (.240) off him and are hitting .216 (11-for-51) off his slider...all three homers he's allowed this year have come off the slider.
- ▶ Since his MLB debut on August 27, 2019, no pitcher in the Majors has appeared in more games than Tyler (297g).

### #74 RYAN WALKER ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Sinker, Slider

**Last Game:** 6/15 vs. LAA; L, 1.0ip, h, r, bb, k (32 pitches)

- ▶ His 36 outings are most in MLB.
- ▶ 29 of Walker's 36 appearances have been scoreless.
- ▶ Has struck out 46 batters over 36.1ip (11.39 K/9.0), compared to just seven walks allowed...his 31.9% strikeout rate ranks in the top 7% of MLB.
