TODAY'S GAME: SF is looking to avoid the sweep this afternoon and even out the homestand with a win against the Angels. the Giants are 2-3 on the homestand after winning the series against Houston (2-1) and dropping the first two against LAA.

- SF fell to 6-11 in Interleague games this season with yesterday's defeat...the club's .353 winning percentage in those games ranks 27 th of 30 teams, ahead only of the Mets (3-9, .250), White Sox (6-15, .286) and Marlins (6-14, .300)
- The Giants are 15-12 (.556) in their last 27 games dating to May 15...the . 556 winning \% in that time is fifth-best in the NL behind Philadelphia (17-10, .630), St. Louis (16-11, .593), Milwaukee (16-12, 571 ) and Cincinnati (16-12, 571 ).
- SF has been swept just once at home this season, dropping all three games against NYY at home on May 31-June 2.
ROSTER MOVES: The Giants have made the following roster moves prior to today's game:
- LHP Kyle Harrison placed on the 15-day Injured List (retroactive to June 13) with a right ankle sprain.
- RHP Spencer Bivens (\#76) selected from Triple-A Sacramento.

THEY DON'T MAKE 'EM LIKE THEY USED TO: The Giants are 26-18 all-time in the regular season vs. the Angels, outscoring them 218-175 (+43) ...at Oracle Park, SF is 11-7 vs. LAA, outscoring them 79-70.

- However, the Giants have dropped each of their past four games against the Angels...it marks their first four-game losing streak to the Halos since also dropping four straight from June 21, 2006-June 17, 2009.

WHEN I WAS YOUR AGE...: OF Heliot Ramos' two-run shot in the 1st inning yesterday marked his second time homering in back-to-back games this month (also: June 2-3)...the 24-year-old now has six home runs in June, tying CIN's Jeimer Candelario and CWS' Paul Dejong for second-most in MLB this month, trailing only BAL's Anthony Santander (eight)

- Ramos' 17 RBI this month are second-most in the MLB behind NYY's Aaron Judge (18).

DON'T SPEND IT ALL IN ONE PLACE: Ramos' power surge isn't new to this month...he's reached base safely in 30 of his 34 games since being recalled on May 8, logging 30 RBI in that stretch

- His 30 RBI since May 8 are fourth-most in the Majors and the most in the National League in that span.
- Ramos became the first Giant to have 30 RBI in the first 34 games of their season with SF since Marlon Bryd (August 21-September 28, 2015)
- In the 33 games Ramos has started, the Giants are averaging 4.97 runs per game and hitting .254, compared to 3.6 runs per games and a 237 average when he doesn't (SIS).
- Defensively, he has + 7 DRS in the outfield in 289.2 innings. the +7 DRS are tied for fifth-best among MLB outfielders.
ASK YOUR MOTHER: The Giants went 1-for-13 with runners in scoring position yesterday and are just 11-for-66 (.167) in those situations over their last eight games.
- SF's . 297 OBP with RISP this season is fourth-lowest in MLB, while its . 234 average ranks as the seventh-lowest.


I'M JUST RESTING MY EYES: The Giants are 19-12 (.613) in day games in 2024, including an 11-5 mark in day games here at Oracle Park.

- SF's 613 winning percentage in day games is sixth-best in the Majors and second-best in the NL behind the Brewers (21-11, .656)
- The Giants own a . 734 OPS in those 31 day games, 69 points higher than their OPS in night games this season (.665).
- The Giants are 7-3 in their last 10 day games here at Oracle Park dating to April 28.
THAT'S HOW THEY GET 'YA: Ramos slugged the Giants' 24th homer at home this season...SF's 24 homers at home are still fewest in the Majors...the team with the next fewest is Toronto (26).
- Furthermore, the Giants have a -8 home run differential in their home ballpark this year having allowed 32 homers while hitting only 24 themselves.
- Overall, the Giants and their opponents have combined to hit 56 homers at Oracle Park this season, the fewest of any park in the Majors...St. Louis' Busch Stadium has the next fewest at 58 combined homers.
WHAT'S THE DAMAGE?: After allowing three more stolen bases yesterday, the Giants have now surrendered 73 steals to opponents this season...the 73 stolen bases allowed are tied with the Mets for most in the Majors.
- SF's 73 stolen bases allowed are their most in the first 71 games of the season since 1985, when the Giants gave up 74 bases through their first 71 games of the year.
- The 73 steals in that span rank as the fifth-most in SF era.
- The Giants themselves have just 23 stolen bases this season, fewest in the Majors by a wide margin...the next closest team, the Braves, have swiped 31 bags this year.

READY TO ROCK AND ROLL?: After today, the Giants travel to Chicago to face the Cubs for a three-game set at Wrigley Field before heading to Birmingham, AL to play the Cardinals on Thursday...the jewel event will take place at historic Rickwood Field, the oldest professional baseball stadium in the US. first pitch is scheduled for 6:15 p.m CT (4:15 p.m. PT).
