#### STAY INFORMED

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**RAY REPORT**—The Rays begin a six-game homestand against the Angels (three to play) and Tigers (three to play) tonight at Tropicana Field...despite a four-game losing streak, have still won nine of 15, 16 of 23, 22 of 30, and 29 of their last 41 games...have owned the AL's best record for each of the last 20 days (May 9–pres.), including eight consecutive days leading the majors (May 18–25), their first time holding MLB's best winning pct. since June 30, 2023 (57-28)...have the second-easiest remaining schedule in MLB (.477 opp. winning pct.) behind only the Guardians (.475)...hold the best home record in the majors at 19-5 (.792), with 19 of their next 28 games (May 29–June 28) coming at Tropicana Field...have an 86.8 pct. chance to make the postseason, per FanGraphs, fourth highest in the majors to the Dodgers (99.6%), Yankees (99.0%), and Braves (97.3%) and an MLB-leading 57.3 pct. increase from their Opening Day odds (29.5%)...have spent 26 days leading the AL East, 25 in second, six in third, four in fourth, and three in fifth.

\* The Rays dropped the series finale, 11-2, in Baltimore on Wednesday...marked their first time being swept in 2026 and extended their losing streak to a season-worst four games...prior to the game, the Rays were one of five teams in the majors that had not been swept (also: ATL, CLE, LAD, SD).

\* Their losing streak is the longest since they dropped six straight between Sept. 25, 2025–March 28, 2026...all four losses have come vs. AL East opponents on the heels of a 14-2 start against the division...their 14-6 (.700) intradivision record is still the second best in the AL, trailing only the White Sox (8-3/.727).

\* **Hunter Feduccia** tallied a career-high three hits in the loss, his second multi-hit effort in his last four games (May 20–pres.). **Jonathan Aranda** notched his third straight multi-hit game (see more in "Go Jonny Go" note below).

\* The Rays staff was tagged for a season-high-tying 16 hits (also: April 7 vs. CHC)...they have yielded double-digit hits in six of their last 10 games (May 16–pres.) compared to six of their previous 40 (March 30–May 15).

\* The club's 26 runs allowed over the series was its most since June 27-29, 2025 at BAL (30), with 10 of the 26 being unearned runs...it tied June 7-9, 1999 for second-most unearned runs allowed in a series in team history (most: 11 UER, May 7-9, 1999 at CLE)...it was the most in the majors since the Blue Jays permitted 10 in a three-game set against the Rockies from Sept. 1-3, 2023 at Coors Field.

**RECENT TRANSACTIONS**—Today, the Rays selected **RHP Andrew Wantz** from Triple-A Durham, reinstated **INF Ben Williamson** (low back strain) from the 10-day IL, optioned **INF Carson Williams** to Durham, and designated **RHP Jon Heasley** for assignment.

\* Wantz, 30, last appeared in a major league game on June 30, 2024 vs. DET with the Angels...he made 91 career appearances (four starts) in four seasons with the Angels (2021-24) before signing with the Rays as a minor league free agent on Jan. 2, 2025...he has a 7.04 ERA (23 OIP, 18 ER) in 18 games with the Bulls in 2025...across stints with Class-A Bowling Green and Durham in 2025, he spun a 0.69 ERA (13 OIP, 1 ER) with a .167 (7-for-42) opp. average.

\* Williamson was placed on the 10-day IL with a low back strain on May 20...in 12 games during May prior to his injury, he was slashing .313/.421/.344 (10-for-32) with 1 2B, 4 RBI, and 6 R.

**35 CANDLES**—Today is **Steven Matz's** 35th birthday...upon appearing in his next game, he will be the fifth player to don a Rays uniform this season at age 35 or older (**Aaron Brooks**, **Craig Kimbrel**, **Nick Martinez**, and **Cole Sulser**).

**HOME SWEET HOME**—The Rays have a major league-best 19-5 (.792) record at home, their second-best winning pct. before the calendar flips to June in team history (2023, .813/26-6)...they have won five straight series at Tropicana Field (April 24–pres.), their longest home streak since they won six straight from May 9–June 8, 2025...the club has won seven of eight series openers in its return to Tropicana Field, including each of its last five...since April 22, the Rays are 15-1 at home, tied for the best 16-game stretch at home in franchise history (3x, last: May 14-31, 2021)...with a win tonight, the Rays would:

\* Tally their 20th home win of the campaign, marking just the third time in franchise history they have won 20 home games before June, joining 2023 (26-6) and 2008 (23-10).

\* Improve their home record since April 22 to 16-1, tying May 13-31, 2021 for the best 17-game span at home in team history.

\* Earn their sixth straight series-opening win at home, tied for the third-longest streak in team history (3x, last: May 23-June 20, 2025).

\* Tie the 2021 and 2019 clubs for second most wins in team history before the end of May, trailing only 2023 (40W).

**GO JONNY GO**—**Jonathan Aranda** tallied his third consecutive multi-hit game on Wednesday at BAL, one game shy of his career best (4G, 2x, May 2-5, 2026 & May 26-29, 2025)...his nine multi-hit efforts in May are tied for the most in the AL with **CWS Sam Antonacci**, **CLE Chase DeLauter**, **DET Riley Greene**, **ATH Nick Kurtz**, and **SEA Josh Naylor**...he went 7-or-10 (.700) last series in Baltimore, tied for the eighth-best average during a single series in franchise history (min. 10AB) and the best since **Yandy Diaz** batted .727 from Sept. 1-3, 2025 vs. SEA...under the same criteria, it was tied for the fourth-best average in a road series in team history and the best since **Manuel Margot** hit .714 (10-for-14) at Boston between Aug. 10-13, 2020.

\* He has a six-game hitting streak (May 20–pres.), tied for the sixth-longest active streak in MLB and tied for the fourth-longest streak of his career (4x, last: May 25-30, 2025)...with a hit tonight, he would extend his streak to seven games, tying his third-longest streak (July 5-11, 2025) of his career.

\* In May, he is hitting .375 (30-for-80) with 5 2B, 2 HR, 16 RBI, a .454 OBP, a .513 SLG, and a .966 OPS...he paces the majors in average and on-base pct. in May and ranks highly in hits (15th) and OPS (6th)...min. 90 PA, his .375 average is the 10th best during a calendar month in franchise history and would be the best since **Yandy Diaz** (.400) in September/October 2025...it would mark Aranda's highest average in any calendar month of his career, surpassing May 2025 (.341).

\* Throughout his career, Aranda has slashed .329/.408/.464 (68-for-207) with 10 2B, 6 HR, 37 RBI, and an .872 OPS in May...his .329 career May average is the third best in franchise history (min. 100AB) behind **David DeJesus** (.346) and **Akinori Iwamura** (.338), while his .408 on-base pct. is the second best under the same criteria to **Tommy Pham** (.412).

**ROTATIONAL DOMINATION**—Rays starting pitchers have yielded three runs or fewer in 28 of their last 30 outings (April 22–pres.) and 44 of 53 starts this season...their 3.00 ERA (263.2IP, 88ER) is second in the majors (NYY, 2.98) while their .282 opp. on-base pct. is the third best...their ERA is on pace to be the second best in club history through May, trailing only the 2019 rotation (2.35)...they have permitted 26 long balls, tied for MLB's third fewest (also: LAA & PIT) behind the Brewers (23) and Yankees (25).

\* At Tropicana Field, Rays starting pitchers hold a 2.94 ERA (116.1IP, 38ER) and a .222 (96-for-432) opp. average...they have allowed three runs or fewer in 19 of the 24 contests, going 18-1 when doing so...they have allowed one or zero runs in 13 of their last 16 home games since April 22.

\* The rotation has an average exit velocity of 87.8 mph against them, best in the majors, while they have the second-lowest hard-hit rate at 35.7 pct. behind the Brewers (34.9%).

**STRAIGHT OUTTA ANAHEIM**—The Rays and Angels are set to begin the first of two series in 2026 tonight, with the teams meeting in Anaheim between June 12-14...since 2017, the Rays are 36-18 against the Angels and are unbeaten in seven of their eight home series against them (4-1-3).

\* In six career games against the Angels, **Junior Camerino** has hit .333 (7-for-21) with 1 2B, 3 HR, 5 RBI, an .810 slugging pct., and a 1.157 OPS...in his last game against the club on Aug. 6, 2025 at LAA, he launched a pair of home runs, with the latter marking his 30th home run of the campaign and making him the youngest Ray with a 30-home run season.

\* In 37 career games opposite the Angels, **Yandy Diaz** has slashed .286/.371/.367 (42-for-147) with 6 2B, 2 HR, 15 RBI, and 20 BB...14 of the 37 games have been multi-hit efforts.

\* The Rays three probable starting pitchers for this series (**RHP Nick Martinez**, **RHP Drew Rasmussen**, **LHP Shane McClanahan**) have a combined 2.24 ERA (164.2IP, 41ER) in 30 starts this season...in their careers against the Angels, the trio holds a 2.37 ERA (95.OIP, 25ER) with 85 strikeouts to 23 walks.

**SCORING CHANGE**—On May 26 at BAL, **3B Blaze Alexander** reached in the 2nd inning on what was originally ruled a fielder's choice and error by **2B Richie Palacios**...this has been changed to a base hit, and as a result, one of the three runs allowed by **RHP Griffin Jax** that inning is now earned...the following statistics were affected:

\* Alexander (+H), Jax (+H, +ER), and Palacios (-E).

**TODAY IN RAYS HISTORY**—On May 29, 2017, the Rays won at Texas, 10-8, and **Erasmus Ramirez** became the first pitcher to record a save and go on to start his team's next game since fellow Nicaraguan **MTL Dennis Martinez** surrounding the 1993 All-Star break, according to Elias...he became the first pitcher to do that on consecutive days since **CLE Steve Farr** from June 9-10, 1984 vs. SEA.

**TONIGHT'S START**—Nick Martinez will make his 11th start with the Rays and fifth at home...marks his 291st career appearance (140th start) and 15th opposite the Angels (10th start)...has recorded 999.2 IP in his career, 0.1 shy of 1,000.0 IP...is in the midst of his ninth major league season and first with the Rays...signed as a free agent on Feb. 10, 2026.

- ✦ Ranks third among MLB qualifiers with a 1.51 ERA (53.2IP, 9ER), behind only PHI **Cristopher Sánchez** (1.47) and NYY **Cam Schlichter** (1.50).
- ✦ With a quality start tonight, Martinez would be one of 10 AL pitchers with seven quality starts or more this season, joining KC **Michael Wacha** (9QS), CWS **Davis Martin** (8QS), NYY **Cam Schlichter** (8QS), TOR **Kevin Gausman** (7QS), SEA **Emerson Hancock** (7QS), KC **Seth Lugo** (7QS), MIN **Joe Ryan** (7QS), DET **Framber Valdez** (7QS), and SEA **Bryan Woo** (7QS).
- ✦ Has recorded 5.0 IP or more with 1 ER of fewer in a career-high six straight starts...his previous career-best streak was five games from Sept. 4-27, 2024 with the Reds...the last Ray with a longer streak was Taj **Bradley** from June 24–July 25, 2024 (6G), while Shane **McClanahan** owns the franchise record with a seven-start streak from June 9–July 13, 2022.

**LAST TIME OUT**—Tossed 6.0 innings of one-run ball, allowing a season-high nine hits and one walk against one strikeout in a 4-2 win on May 22 at NYY...his lone blemish was a solo homer by **Austin Wells** to lead off the 5th inning...has allowed two runs or fewer in each of his first 10 starts this season, tied with Hoyt **Wilhelm** (1959) for the longest season-opening streak by an MLB starter age 35 or older in the live-ball era (since 1920)...his 10-start streak is tied for the longest in the majors this year with MIL **Kyle Harrison** and is the longest by a traditional starter in Rays history to begin a season...is also the longest such streak by an AL pitcher age 35 or older at any point in a season since TEX **Jacob deGrom** posted 14 straight from April 18–July 1, 2025.

- ✦ Had his 39.2 inning streak without allowing a home run snapped after Wells' homer, marking the first homer allowed by Martinez since April 11 vs. NYY (also to Wells)...on the season, his 0.60 home runs per 9.0 IP ranks sixth among qualified AL pitchers.
- ✦ Martinez is 4-0 with a 0.96 ERA (37.2IP, 4ER), 5 BB, 22 SO, a 1.04 WHIP, and a .241 (34-for-141) opp. AVG over his last six starts, making him one of six MLB pitchers with a sub-1.00 ERA in that span (min. 30.0IP).

**ANGEL NUMBERS**—The veteran right-hander is 3-3 with a 2.88 ERA (65.2IP, 21ER) and 43 strikeouts in 14 career appearances (nine starts) opposite the Angels...as a starter, he is 1-3 with a 3.31 ERA (54.1IP, 20ER) and has limited hitters to a .219 average (44-for-201).

- ✦ Martinez is 11-17 with a 3.44 ERA (245.2IP, 94ER) and 156 strikeouts in 56 career appearances (36 starts) vs. AL West opponents...is 8-15 with a 3.81 ERA (200.2IP, 85ER) with 121 strikeouts across those 36 starts...his 11 wins against the the AL West are his most against any division in his career...marks his first start against an AL West opponent this season.
- ✦ Last took the mound against the Angels on Aug. 20, 2025 (w/CIN) at Angel Stadium, tossing 6.0 innings of one-run ball, allowing two hits and one walk against seven strikeouts in a no-decision...marked his 11th quality start of the year.

**HOME COOKIN'**—In four starts at home this season, Martinez is 2-0 with a 1.14 ERA (23.2IP, 3ER) and 18 strikeouts, limiting opposing hitters to a .225 average (20-for-96)...his ERA at home this year ranks third lowest among AL starters (min. 20.0IP), trailing KC **Cole Ragans** (0.60), and HOU **Spencer Arrighetti** (0.89)...is one of four AL starters to have allowed three runs or fewer at home this season (min. 20.0IP).

**DEEP IN THE RED**—Martinez ranks highly in multiple MLB pitching rankings, according to Baseball Savant...his Pitching Run Value (12), Fastball Run Value (10), and Offspeed Run Value (7) are all in the 97th percentile or higher, an improvement from his -2 Pitching Run Value, 0 Fastball Run Value, and -2 Offspeed Run Value in 2025.

- ✦ Since the start of 2023, Martinez's 32.2 pct. hard-hit rate is third lowest in the majors (min. 1,000BF) behind NYY **Ryan Yarbrough** (29.7 pct.) and TOR **Tyler Rogers** (29.2 pct.).
- ✦ Opposing hitters have an average exit velocity of 86.8 mph since the beginning of 2023, ranking fourth lowest in the majors during that span (min. 1,000BF) behind LAA **Kyle Hendricks** (85.8), SD **Michael King** (86.5), and NYY **Max Fried** (86.7).

**LIVING IN THE ZONE**—Since the start of 2024, Martinez has issued only 72 walks, the recording the fifth-lowest walks per 9.0 innings (1.76) in the majors during that stretch (min. 250.0IP)...the veteran right-hander trails only SEA **Bryan Woo** (1.53), DET **Tarik Skubal** (1.55), SEA **George Kirby** (1.59), and CHC **Shota Imanaga** (1.67) during that span...min. 30.0 IP this season, his 5.0 pct. walk rate ranks fifth behind DET **Tarik Skubal** (3.6), TOR **Kevin Gausman** (4.3), TB **Drew Rasmussen** (4.6), and NYY **Cam Schlichter** (4.7).
