<u>BIRDLAND BITES</u>: Baltimore continues a seven-game road trip in Cleveland (4 to play) this week after a series loss over the weekend at Tampa Bay (1-2)...The O's snapped a four-game losing streak yesterday after the club won six of the previous seven from July 4-11.

- Backson Holliday led off Sunday's game with his second career leadoff home run (also 5/31 vs. CWS)...The Orioles have hit five leadoff homers this season and 18 since the beginning of 2024, tied with the Angels for the second most in the majors behind the Dodgers (20)...Cedric Mullins (2x) and Colton Cowser (1x) have the others for the O's this season.
- **Q**<sub>A</sub> **Ryan O'Hearn** snapped a season-long 18-game homerless streak yesterday.
- 6) Félix Bautista earned the save yesterday, but allowed a run and stranded the bases loaded...He's the first Orioles pitcher to secure a save of 1.0 inning or less while surrendering at least one hit and walking at least three batters.
- Ramón Laureano was ejected in the third inning by home plate umpire James Hoye... Laureano is the only Orioles player to be ejected this season (also 5/14 [G1] vs. MIN) and both have been by Hoye...Tony Mansolino was also kicked out by Hoye, his first career ejection in the majors.

<u>OPENING STATEMENTS</u>: Baltimore starting pitchers have allowed two runs or less in seven of the last 10 games since July 6, including one or no runs in five of those games...For the season, Orioles starters have a 5.16 ERA (282 ER/492.1 IP), the second highest in the majors ahead of the Rockies (6.11).

<u>RUN AND GUNN</u>: Gunnar Henderson is batting .315/.384/.500 (46-for-146) with 11 doubles, two triples, four home runs, 21 runs scored, and 19 RBI in 41 games since June 1...His .884 OPS in that period is the second highest among qualified shortstops behind CIN's Elly De La Cruz (.963)...During that time, he ranks among AL leaders in batting average  $(4^{th})$  and on-base percentage  $(10^{th})$ .

(b) In his first 50 games through May, Henderson hit .254/.315/.433 (51-for-201) with 20 extra-base hits (11 2B, 2 3B, 7 HR).

<u>THE WEST WING</u>: Jordan Westburg is slashing .372/.400/.605 (16-for-43) with one double, three homers, 11 runs scored, and seven RBI in 11 games this month after leaving with left hand discomfort on June 27...Westburg has recorded back-to-back multi-hit games (5 total H) for the first time this season and has five 2+ hit efforts in July after having seven in his first 26 games of the year.

 $\theta_{\rm A}$  He's batting .326 (14-for-43) with a .721 slugging percentage on breaking pitches this season after he hit .260 (34-for-131) with a .427 slugging last season.

<u>UNSUNG HERO</u>: In 42 games since May 14, Ramón Laureano is slashing .311/.376/.503 (47-for-151) with 11 doubles, six home runs, 28 RBI, and 14 walks...His .311 batting average during that period ranks seventh in the AL (min. 150 PA).

 $\theta_{\!\scriptscriptstyle A}$  Laureano's nine doubles since June 23 are tied for second in MLB lead with three others, behind MIA's Agustín Ramírez (10).

MOUNTAIN TIME: Félix Bautista has made 17 appearances since May 31, going 1-0 with a 1.06 ERA (2 ER/17.0 IP), an .073 (4-for-55) opponent average, a 0.88 WHIP, and a 44.0 percent strikeout rate (29 K/66 BF).

 $\theta$  $^{>}$  He has converted each of his last 12 save opportunities since May 26, the third-longest active run behind PIT's David Bednar and CHC's Daniel Palencia (both 13 G).

MILESTONE WATCH: Cedric Mullins is one home run shy of 100 for his career...With his next long ball, he would become the third player in team history (since 1954) to hit 100+ home runs and steal 100+ bases (currently at 138 SB), joining Brady Anderson (209 HR, 307 SB) and Paul Blair (126 HR, 167 SB).

<u>FIREMEN</u>: Baltimore relievers own an MLB-best 20.4 percent inherited scored rate (29 IRS/142 IR), ahead of Los Angeles-NL (24.2%)...**Keegan Akin** (4.2%, 1 IRS/24 IR) and **Seranthony Domínguez** (5.0%, 1 IRS/20 IR) have the two best inherited runners scored percentage in the majors.

- 8 Both Akin's and Domínguez's marks would set the single season franchise record (since 1954), currently held by Mark Thurmond (10.5%, 1988)...Since 1974, only five relievers have finished a full season with an inherited scored rate below 5.0 percent during the year (excluding 2020, 1981, 1995, & 1994): SF's Josh Osich in 2016 (4.7%), HOU's Wilton Lopez in 2010 (3.0%), and AZ's Jorge De La Rosa in 2017 (3.0%).
- $O_{3}$  As a club, the 20.4 percent mark would be the lowest in franchise history, ahead of 2014 (24.8%).

<u>TALES FROM THE ROAD</u>: Baltimore is 14-10 in its last 24 road games since May 24 (G2) after opening the season 8-19 away from Camden Yards...The club's .583 road winning percentage in that time trails the Brewers (.727), Marlins (.667), and Astros (14-8).

- $\vartheta_{\rm A}$  The Birds are averaging 3.65 runs per games on the road, the fourth-lowest mark in the
- majors ahead of the Pirates (2.84 R/G), Rockies (2.94 R/G), and White Sox (3.44 R/G).

  The Orioles' -63 run differential on the road is the third lowest in MLB this season ahead of the Rockies (-109) and Pirates (-67).

**DON'T LET YOUR GUARD DOWN**: The Orioles have won four of the last five games against the Guardians, their best five-game stretch against Cleveland since July 22, 2016-June 20, 2017 (also 4-1)...Entering this season, the O's have won or split three straight road series in Cleveland, their longest such run since doing so in five consecutive series at Cleveland Stadium from September 15, 1981-August 2, 1983.

Observation Cowser, Jackson Holliday, and Ryan O'Hearn have all hit in five straight games against Cleveland.

# THIS DATE IN O'S HISTORY

July 21, 1996 - Seven and a half years after being traded away, the Orioles re-acquire future Hall of Famer Eddie Murray from Cleveland in exchange for pitcher Kent Mercker.

July 21, 2000 - The Orioles beat the Blue Jays, 9-5, in Toronto, ending a 20-game losing streak in Canada. Baltimore had lost 14 straight games in Toronto and six in Montreal.

July 21, 2019 - Former Orioles Mike Mussina, Harold Baines, and Lee Smith are among six inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown, NY, before an estimated crowd of 55,000 - second only to the 82,000 on hand for Cal Ripken, Jr.'s induction in 2007.

QUICK HITS: Set to make his 19th career MLB start...Is the third-ever Japanese Player for the Orioles, joining right-handed relievers **Shintaro Fujinami** (2023) and **Koji Uehara** (2009-11)...In his March 30 debut at Toronto, at 35 years, 170 days old, became the oldest Japanese player to make his MLB debut since NYM's Ken Takahashi (40-016) on May 2, 2009 at Philadelphia.

<u>LAST TIME OUT</u>: Earned the victory on July 10 (G2) vs. New York-NL after tossing 6.0 innings, permitting three runs on four hits and a career-high-tying three walks (1 IBB) with two strikeouts...Threw 99 pitches, 60 strikes.

- Completed 6.0 innings for the first time since June 3 at Seattle (7.0 IP), snapping a streak of five straight starts in which he threw 5.0 innings or fewer.
- Did not allow a long ball after permitting a total of seven homers over his previous four starts.

<u>CLEVELAND ROCKS</u>: Sugano earned the win in his first career start vs. the Guardians on April 17 at Camden Yards...He tossed 7.0 innings of two-run ball, scattering five hits with zero walks and three strikeouts.

Both runs allowed came via back-to-back homers by Daniel Schneemann and Austin Hedges to open the third inning.

SPLITTING HAIRS: Sugano has limited opponents to a .204 (23-for-113) average on his splitter, the fifth-lowest average by any starter in MLB (min. 100 AB ending in pitch) behind LAD's Yoshinobu Yamamoto (.131), TOR's Kevin Gausman (.170), CHC's Shota Imanaga (.177), and TEX's Nathan Eovaldi (.179).

Os In 15 starts since April 17, he has limited the opposition to a .179 (17-for-95) clip

with 27 strikeouts off his splitter...In his first three starts, opponents hit .333 (6for-18) with two strikeouts on the offering.

**GRINDING IT OUT:** Despite a winning effort in his last outing, Sugano owns a 7.94 ERA (25 ER/28.1 IP) over his last six starts since June 8, with opponents slashing .349/.404/.556 (44-for-126)...In his previous seven outings from April 28-June 3, he went 3-2 with a 2.72 ERA (13 ER/43.0 IP), with opponents hitting .224/.256/.385 (36-

  (a) His 7.94 ERA since June 8 is fourth highest in MLB (min. 25.0 IP), ahead of PIT's Andrew Heaney (9.40 ERA), STL's Erick Fedde (8.64 ERA), and MIN's Chris Paddack
- On July 10 vs. New York-NL, Sugano held right-handed hitters to an 0-for-9 clip...In his previous five starts from June 8-July 2, righties went 22-for-58 (.379) with four doubles, three home runs, and 12 RBI.

IN CONTROL: Sugano owns a 5.2 percent walk rate, the sixth-lowest mark among all AL starters behind DET's Tarik Skubal (3.3%), TB's Zack Littell (3.5%), TEX's Nathan Eovaldi (4.0%), SEA's Bryan Woo (4.6%), and MIN's Joe Ryan (4.8%).

Prior to issuing a then career-high three walks on June 20 at New York-AL, he had allowed two walks or fewer in each of his first 14 starts, the second-longest career-opening run by an Oriole starter in team history behind Josh Towers (23 GS 2001 02) GS. 2001-02).

HOMER UNHAPPY: Sugano has permitted 19 home runs, tied for eighth most among all MLB starters and tied for fifth in the AL behind TB's Zack Littell (24 HR) and MIN's

Bailey Ober/TB's Ryan Pepiot/ATH's JP Sears (all 21 HR).

Only three other Oriole starters have allowed 19+ home runs through their first 18 career starts: David Hernández (25 HR, 2009), Rocky Coppinger (22 HR, 1996), and **David Hess** (20 HR, 2018).

SUCCESS WITHOUT THE STRIKEOUT: His 14.0 percent strikeout rate is the lowest

mong all qualified MLB pitchers.
Since 2010, the only Orioles to record a lower strikeout rates than Sugano's 14.0 percent clip are Brad Bergesen (10.9%) and Jeremy Guthrie (13.6%), both in 2010.

TORTOISE AND THE HARE: From innings one through three, Sugano owns a 6.00 ERA (36 ER/54.0 IP) and an .839 OPS...From the fourth inning on, however, those figures drop to 2.58 (13 ER/45.1 IP) and .689, respectively.  $\theta$  He has allowed an MLB-high 15 home runs from innings 1-3, including an MLB-

high seven long balls in the third frame.
