TODAY'S GAME: The Giants look to get back in the win column in tonight's series opener vs. the A's.

- ▶ SF took the first two games of its four-game series vs. the Dodgers by a combined score of 15-5 to open the week before dropping the final two games by a combined score of 9-2...the series split snapped a streak of five-straight series losses at LAD.
- ▶ The Giants are 8-6 (.571) in series openers this season.
- ▶ Plenty of Giants are familiar with Sutter Health Park, with 18 of the 26 players on the active roster playing for the Sacramento River Cats (SF's Triple-A affiliate) at one point in their careers (including rehab assignments).
- ▶ The A's have allowed 115 runs at home this season, sixth-most in MLB...SF has scored 147 runs this season, fewest in MLB.

ROSTER MOVES: SF announced the following roster moves today:

- ▶ **C Daniel Susac** (#6) returned from his rehab assignment and was reinstated from the 10-day Injured List.
- ▶ **IF Christian Koss** was optioned to Triple-A Sacramento.

TODAY'S STARTER: RHP Tyler Mahle will make his ninth start of the season...last Sunday at Oracle Park, Mahle allowed four runs on five hits (two homers) and two walks with eight strikeouts vs. the Pirates in SF's extra innings win.

- ▶ This will be Mahle's third career start vs. the A's...despite an 0-2 record, Mahle has a 1.50 ERA (2er, 12.0ip), 14 strikeouts and a 0.83 WHIP in those outings.
- ▶ The veteran is five strikeouts shy of 800 for his career.
- ▶ Mahle is 0-2 with an 8.16 ERA (13er, 14.1ip) and a .964 opposing OPS in three road starts.
- ▶ The righty's two-most used pitches, four-seamer (47.6% usage rate) and splitter (25.0% usage rate), have combined for a -6 run value per *Baseball Savant*...the A's have an .846 OPS vs. four-seamers (fourth-best in MLB) and a .532 OPS vs. splitters (18th in MLB).

SAC-TOWN: The Giants went 5-1 vs. the A's last season, including a 2-1 series victory here at Sutter Health Park in early July...since the start of the 2022 season, SF is 12-6 vs. the A's, outscoring them 73-51 (+22) over that span.

- ▶ A's starter Aaron Civale's most-used pitch is his cutter (33.1% usage rate)...the Giants' .694 OPS vs. cutters is 25th in MLB.
- ▶ Civale has a 48.1% hard-hit rate in 2026, which is the eighth-highest in MLB (min. 40.0ip).

INTERLEAGUE STRUGGLES: SF is just 1-8 (.111) in interleague games in 2026, which is the lowest winning percentage in interleague games this season.

- ▶ To date, SF has faced the Yankees (0-3), Orioles (1-2) and Rays (0-3) from the AL.

RAFI! IF/DH Rafael Devers is slashing .385/.448/.731 over his last seven games and is batting .354 (17x48) with three homers, eight RBI and a 1.057 OPS over his last 14 games.

- ▶ He has hit safely in 13 of those 14 games dating to Game 2 of a doubleheader on April 30.

RUNNIN' WILD: OF Jung Hoo Lee hit his first career inside-the-park home run last night...it was the first ever inside-the-park homer by a Giant at Dodger Stadium.

- ▶ It was the 20th inside-the-park homer hit by a Giant on the road in the SF-era (since 1958) and it was the first inside-the-park homer by a Giants player vs. the Dodgers since September 22, 1981 (**Larry Herndon**).
- ▶ With an exit velocity of 73.2 mph, it was the lowest EV on a homer in MLB under the *Statcast* era, surpassing a 74.5 mph inside-the-park homer by NYM's Ruben Tejada in 2015.
- ▶ Lee is slashing .309/.346/.455 with 15 runs, seven doubles, a triple, three homers and 11 RBI over his last 31 games.

LOOK AT LUIS: IF Luis Arraez leads the Giants with 49 hits in 2026...Arraez has already led three different franchises in hits in a single season (Minnesota, Miami and San Diego).

- ▶ Arraez's 49 hits through his first 41 games this season are the most by a Giant in their first 41 games of a season since **Thairo Estrada** had 52 in 41 games to start the 2023 season.
- ▶ His 49 hits in his first 41 games with the Giants are the most in a player's first 41 games with SF since former A's/Giants infielder **Marco Scutaro** had 54 hits in his first 41 games after being acquired by SF at the 2012 trade deadline.

WELCOME TO SF: Is in the midst of his 10th season in the Majors and his first in a Giants uniform...the 31-year-old inked a one-year deal with SF on January 5.

LAST TIME OUT: Took a no-decision last Sunday in SF's extra-innings, 7-6 walk-off victory over the Pirates...struck out a season-high eight batters over 5.2 innings of work and gave up four runs on five hits with two walks...batters were 0-for-7 with three strikeouts off his cutter and are hitless in their last 10 at-bats ending with the pitch...they were 5-for-11 off his cutter in three starts prior.

VS. ATHLETICS: Will face the A's for just the third time in his career...suffered the loss in each of his two starts despite being dominant on the mound, sporting a 1.50 ERA (2er, 12.0ip) in the two starts with a .182 BAA & 14 strikeouts (10.5K/9ip)...last faced them on May 1, 2025 with the Rangers, tossing 6.0 innings with one run on five hits, one walk and six strikeouts.

HOT AND COLD: Has alternated good and bad starts this season and hasn't found much consistency yet early in the year...in odd-numbered starts (#1, #3, #5 and #7) this season, he's combined to post a 0.82 ERA (2er, 22.0ip) with 21 strikeouts and a .185 opposing average against...in the other four outings (#2, #4, #6), he's gone 0-3 with a 10.07 ERA (22er, 19.2ip), a 1.98 WHIP, .342 BAA and eight homers.

PUT IT IN REVERSE: Has been putting some significant reverse splits this season, with right-handers slashing .316/.409/.566 off him while lefties are just .214/.280/.345.

STAY GROUNDED: The 31-year-old is averaging a 47.5% ground ball rate this year, his highest since 2019 (47.8%) and a significant increase from last year's 38.6% mark...in 10 MLB seasons, Mahle has a 42% career ground ball rate.

HOMEBOY: Has been pitching much better at home this season...in five starts at Oracle Park, the righty has a 3.62 ERA (11er, 27.1ip), .233 BAA and .695 opponents' OPS...in three starts away from home, he is 0-2 with a 8.16 ERA (13er, 14.1ip), .316 opposing average and .964 OPS...last season, Mahle had a 0.84 ERA in 10 starts at home and 4.36 ERA in six road starts.

FIRST IMPRESSIONS: Opponents are 7-for-12 (.583) with a triple and a home run against Mahle on the first pitch of an at-bat.

WORKING THE COUNT: When Mahle gets ahead of the count 0-1, opponents are hitting just .188 with a .517 OPS...after he falls behind 1-0, however, opponents are hitting .294 with a .957 OPS.

NOT SO FAST: Over his last three starts, opponents are 5-for-33 (.152) with 11 strikeouts in at-bats ending with his four-seamer...overall, Mahle is throwing his four-seam fastball 47.6% of the time this year, averaging 92.4 mph (up 0.4mph from last season) with batters hitting .271 off the pitch...last year, he held batters to a .209 (27x147) clip with the pitch with 10 total XBH.

BANANA SPLIT: Batters are hitting .276 (16x58) with 15 strikeouts off his secondary pitch, his split finger, which Mahle throws 25% of the time...last year, Mahle's splitter was his most valuable pitch, accumulating a +5 run value...he used the pitch 27.7% of the time last year, with opponents hitting just .196 off his split-finger with 25 strikeouts (24.0% whiff rate).

TREVOR McDONALD RHP #72

2026 RECORD: 1-0, 2.92 ERA

- ▶ Is facing the A's for the first time in his career tomorrow for his third start of the season with SF.
- ▶ Limited the Dodgers to three runs on nine hits in 5.1 innings on Monday in Los Angeles in SF's 9-3 win...he struck out four, walked two and surrendered one homer.
- ▶ In his brief MLB career (six games, four starts) since 2024, McDonald has allowed seven earned runs in 30.1 innings (2.08 ERA), struck out 27 and walked only five.

#43 TRISTAN BECK ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball, Sweeper
Last Game: 5/13 at LAD; 2.0ip, 2h (36 pitches)

- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento on Monday...made 13 appearances with the River Cats out of the 'pen and had a 5.40 ERA (10er, 16.2ip) with 18 strikeouts and seven walks.
- ▶ Appeared in 31 games for SF last season, working in a bulk innings role... recorded at least four outs in 18 of the 31 games.
- ▶ Batters were 9x64 (.141) with 18 strikeouts off his sweeper in '25.
- ▶ Left-handed batters hit .202 (20x99) with 18 strikeouts off him.

#47 RYAN BORUCKI ▶ LHP *(bohr-RUCK-ee)*

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Split Finger, Sweeper
Last Game: 5/14 at LAD; 1.1ip (13 pitches)

- ▶ Threw 2.0 hitless, scoreless innings with a strikeout to get his first win as a Giant on Sunday vs. Pittsburgh...has tossed 3.1-hitless innings over his last two outings (5/10 and 5/14).
- ▶ Has allowed runs in seven of his 16 appearances (4.70 ERA)... however, he's 1-0 with a 2.70 ERA (3er, 10.0ip) in his last 10 games.
- ▶ Lefties are 5-for-32 (.156) with four walks and eight strikeouts vs. him...has held lefties to a .181 clip (72-for-401) in his MLB career.
- ▶ Righties, however, are 12-for-27 with five XBH (two HRs) this year.
- ▶ Signed a Major League contract with the Giants on March 21 after opting out of his minor league deal with the White Sox on March 20...was in camp with Chicago-AL as an NRI and went 2-0 with eight strikeouts and a 0.67 WHIP over 6.0 shutout innings.

#34 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP *(BROO-baker)*

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Cutter, Changeup
Last Game: 5/14 at LAD; 1.0ip, bb, k (13 pitches)

- ▶ In his last six outings, he has a 5.40 ERA (5er, 8.1ip) and .313 BAA (10x32)...in nine games prior, he had a 2.38 ERA (3er, 11.1ip) and .250 BAA (10x40).
- ▶ Has thrown 10.1 scoreless innings in eight appearances on the road... has a 7.71 ERA (8er, 9.1ip) in seven games at Oracle Park.
- ▶ Issued at least one walk in nine of 15 contests (5.49 BB/9.0ip).
- ▶ Right-handers are 13-for-44 (.295) with four XBHs off him while lefties are 7-for-28 (.250).

#93 MATT GAGE ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Splitter
Last Game: 5/14 at LAD; 0.1ip, 2h, r, er, bb, k (21 pitches)

- ▶ Has surrendered four runs (three ER) in 18.1ip this year (1.47 ERA).
- ▶ His 1.47 ERA is tied for the 10th-lowest among NL relievers.
- ▶ Lefties are just 2-for-23 (.087) against him this season, and 19-for-106 in his career (.179).
- ▶ His 25.5% hard hit rate ranks in the top 4% of MLB.
- ▶ Has issued 11 BBs in 18.1ip...his 14.7 walk rate is in the bottom 10%.
- ▶ He's the first wearer of #93 in SF Giants history...#93 is the highest player-worn uniform number in SF-era history, passing No. 87 (worn by RHP Dan Otero in 2012).
- ▶ Originally was a 10th-round pick of the Giants in 2014 before his career journey brought him back to SF last season.

#31 SAM HENTGES ▶ LHP *(HENT-chiss)*

Pitch Arsenal: Curveball, 4-Seam FB, Slider, Sinker
Last Game: 5/12 at LAD; 1.0ip, h, 2bb, 2k (32 pitches)

- ▶ Has made two appearances with SF, logging 1.1-scoreless innings with three walks and two strikeouts.
- ▶ This is his first MLB action since July 10, 2024.
- ▶ Missed the entire 2025 season while recovering from left shoulder surgery, performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache in Los Angeles on September 18, 2024...also developed some right knee soreness uring his rehab and underwent arthroscopic surgery in August 2025.
- ▶ Returned from rehab and reinstated from the 15-day IL Sunday.
- ▶ In 10 rehab games between Single-A San Jose and Triple-A Sacramento, the lefty had a 1.93 ERA (2er, 9.1ip) with six walks and eight strikeouts.
- ▶ Signed one-year deal with SF on December 3, 2025.

#45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(kill-EE-en)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball
Last Game: 5/12 at LAD; SV, 1.1ip, k (17 pitches)

- ▶ Earned second career save on Tuesday night.
- ▶ His 1.40 ERA (3er, 19.1ip) is 7th-lowest among NL relievers.
- ▶ Owns a 24.1% strikeout rate and .138 BAA (9x65) this season.
- ▶ Has a 5.59 BB/9ip...his 15.2% BB rate ranks in the bottom 8% of MLB.
- ▶ Left-handed batters are 5-for-39 (.128) with no XBH against him while right-handers are 4-for-26 (.154) with two homers.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite this past offseason...dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of 2025 with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.

#63 JOEL PEGUERO ▶ RHP *(jo-EL peh-GAIR-oh)*

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Changeup
Last Game: 5/13 at LAD; 1.1ip, bb (12 pitches)

- ▶ Activated May 5 after 10 rehab games with Triple-A Sacramento... missed SF's first 35 games while recovering from a left hamstring strain that also held him out of most of Spring Training.
- ▶ Has tossed 5.1 innings since returning from the IL, allowing two runs (one earned) on two hits in five games so far.
- ▶ Batters are 1-for-12 with a single off his sinker thus far, which he's thrown 51.5% of the time...he threw it 34.3% of the time in his stint w/SF last season.
- ▶ Made his MLB debut in 2025 with SF after signing with the org. prior to the season on an MiLB contract...posted a 3-1 record with a 2.42 ERA (6er, 22.1ip), 17 strikeouts and a 1.03 WHIP over 17 games.
- ▶ His sinker averaged 99.8 mph and his four-seamer 99.9 mph last season...his slider averaged 91.6 mph and accounted for 12 of his 15 strikeouts.

#67 KEATON WINN ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, 2-Seam FB, Splitter, Slider
Last Game: 5/11 at LAD; H; 1.0ip, h, k (14 pitches)

- ▶ Leads the team with nine holds, which is tied for the third-most in the Majors.
- ▶ 15 of his 19 appearances this year have been scoreless (2.45 ERA).
- ▶ Opponents are just 9-for-61 (.148) off him this year.
- ▶ Batters are just 5-for-36 (.139) with 13 K's off his splitter.
- ▶ His 84.8 mph average exit velocity ranks in the top 5% of the league while his 25.5% hard-hit rate ranks in the top 4%.
- ▶ His 1.67 xERA is third-best in the Majors behind Mason Miller (0.80) and Dylan Lee (1.49).
