CHICAGO CUBS (66-86) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (56-96) SEPTEMBER 25, 2022 at PNC PARK, PITTSBURGH, PA -- GAME #153/HOME #75 RHP ADRIAN SAMPSON (2-5, 3.35 ERA) vs. RHP LUIS ORTIZ (0-0, 0.84 ERA)

THE PIRATES:...snapped their eight-game losing streak with last night's 6-0 win...Are 1-2 after the first three games of their four-game series against the Cubs...Went 4-6 on their recently completed road trip to Cincinnati (4-0) and New York against the Mets (0-4) and Yankees (0-2).

ABOUT TODAY'S STARTER: Luis Ortiz gets the start this afternoon in the finale of this four-game series with the Cubs...Ortiz opened his career with 9.2 consecutive scoreless innings prior to allowing his first runs in the fifth inning of his last start Tuesday at Yankee Stadium...Since 2000, Ortiz' 9.2 consecutive scoreless innings are the fourth-most by a Pirates starter to begin a career (only including starts; relief appearances omitted), and the most since Roansy Contreras had 12.0 consecutive scoreless innings to begin his career as a starter from September 29, 2021-May 29, 2022.

ORTIZ' SEASON IN REVIEW: Luis Ortiz finished the 2022 season with the second-most strikeouts (138) among all Pirates minor leaguers, trailing only Jared Jones, who spent the entire season with High-A Greensboro while pacing the South Atlantic League with 142 punchouts...Ortiz spent a majority of the 2022 season with Altoona, where he was named the team's pitcher-of-the-year and finished with the fourth-most strikeouts (126) in a single-season in Curve history.

THE YOUNG ARMS RACE: Righthander Luis Ortiz makes the start today at the age of 23 years and 241 days...Coming into today, the average age of Pittsburgh's current starting rotation is 24 years and 4 days...Mitch Keller is the oldest of the group at 26 years and 174 days, followed by Bryse Wilson (24 years and 279 days), Johan Oviedo (24 years, 207 days) and Roansy Contreras (22 years, 322 days).

HERE'S THE PITCH: Last night the Bucs recorded their sixth shutout of the season and second of this month after blanking the Reds on one hit in game two of the September 13 doubleheader at Cincinnati...José Quintana started two of the six shutouts while Zach Thompson, Roansy Contreras, Luis Ortiz and Johan Oviedo started the others.

START ME UP: Pittsburgh's starting rotation has posted a 3.37 ERA (125.2ip/47er) in the team's last 26 games dating back to August 28...The only two starting rotations in the National League to record a lower ERA in that time are the Dodgers (3.17) and Cubs (3.36).

HELLO NEWMAN: Kevin Newman enters today with an eight-game hitting streak, tied for the second-longest active streak in the National League along with San Diego's Jose Azocar...Francisco Lindor of the Mets owns the longest active hit streak in the National League at 10 games...The longest hitting streak by a Pirate this season belongs to Ke'Bryan Hayes (nine games) from July 10-22.

GOOD THINGS COME IN THREES: Last night Jack Suwinski hit the third pinch-hit home run for the Pirates this season and the fifth three-run home this month...Pittsburgh's five three-run homers this month are tied for the second-most in the NL along with the Rockies and Mets...The Dodgers lead the way with eight this month.

ROOKIE BALL: Jack Suwinski has gone deep in two straight and four times in his last 15 games...Suwinski enters today ranked second among all National League rookies in home runs behind Michael Harris II of the Braves, who hit his 19th yesterday...Suwinski's 18 home runs are also the most by a Pirates rookie since Josh Bell hit 26 in 2017.

THE BEAR FACTS: The Pirates are 9-9 heading into their final game against the Cubs this season...A win this afternoon would give the Bucs their first winning season against Chicago since going 14-5 during the 2014 campaign.

ON DECK: Pittsburgh's homestand continues tomorrow with the beginning of a three-game series against the Reds...The Pirates swept the Reds in a four-game series when the teams met earlier this month at Great American Ball Park...A win tomorrow would give Pittsburgh its longest winning streak against the Reds in a single season since taking six straight games from March 31 to May 27, 2019.

REYNOLDS ON A ROLL: Bryan Reynolds has recorded a 1.095 OPS over his last 13 games since September 12...That's the eighth-highest OPS in MLB in that time (Aaron Judge leads the way with a 1.461 OPS in that time).

LUIS ORTIZ: The 23-year-old righthander will be making his third big league start today after being promoted from Triple-A Indianapolis on September 18...Had a no-decision (5.0ip/3r/2er) in his last start; a 9-8 walkoff loss Tuesday night at Yankee Stadium...Allowed one hit in 5.2 scoreless innings in his Major League debut on 9/13 in game two of a doubleheader at Cincinnati in a 1-0 Pirates win...Is currently rated by MLB Pipeline as Pittsburgh's 30th-best prospect...Began the season with Double-A Altoona, where he struck out 126 batters, the fourth-most in a single season in Curve history behind Ian Snell (142 in 2004), Justin Wilson (134 in 2010) and Rudy Owens (132 in 2010).
