ST. LOUIS CARDINALS (82-58) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (51-87)

SEPTEMBER 11, 2022 at PNC PARK, PITTSBURGH, PA -- GAME #139/HOME #71

LHP JOSÉ QUINTANA (5-6, 3.41 ERA) vs. RHP MITCH KELLER (5-10, 4.22 ERA)

THE PIRATES:...are 2-6 heading into the finale of their nine-game, 10-day homestand against the Blue Jays (0-3), Mets (1-2) and Cardinals (1-1).

THE LINE ON KELLER: Mitch Keller gets the start this afternoon in the finale of this three-game series and nine-game homestand for the Pirates.

- Keller has allowed three earned runs or fewer in 14 of his last 17 starts since returning to the starting rotation on May 31 against the Dodgers, posting a 3.45 ERA (91.1ip/35er) during that time. Since May 31, Keller's 3.45 ERA ranks 15th among all National League pitchers with at least 90.0 innings pitched.
- This season, Keller has thrown the most sinkers (483) in MLB without allowing a homer on the pitch.
- He has induced 19 grounded into double plays, tied for the fourth-most in the National League along with former teammate José Quintana.

ABOUT TODAY'S STARTER: Mitch Keller tossed 6.0 scoreless frames while winning an 8-2 decision in his last start Tuesday night against the Mets...He has worked 6.0 innings in two straight and 11 times in 24 starts this year after tossing at least 6.0 innings once in 23 starting assignments last season.

SHORT HOPS: Last night Oneil Cruz homered for the 14th time since being promoted from Triple-A on June 20, which ranks first among all National League rookies and second among rookies in MLB behind Seattle's Julio Rodriguez (15)...Cruz' 13 home runs as a shortstop since being promoted on June 20 are also tied for the second-most in all of MLB at that position, trailing only Milwaukee's Willy Adames (14).

CRUZ CONTROL: Oneil Cruz enters today with a seven-game hitting streak, going 14-for-30 (.467) with two doubles, two triples, three home runs and eight RBI...This month Cruz ranks first among National League rookies in OPS (1.282), slugging (.853) and total bases (29), second in batting (.412) and third in OBP (.429).

WE REMEMBER: Today the Pirates will honor the brave First Responders in our community...The celebration will include pregame recognition of our local heroes and a special ticket package featuring an exclusive Pirates First Responders Day cap.

HITTIN' THE ROAD: Following today's game the Pirates will depart for a three-city, 10-game road trip...The first stop will take the team to Cincinnati, which will include a split doubleheader on Tuesday...Tuesday's doubleheader will be the sixth of the season and third against the Reds...The Pirates will then travel to New York to face the Mets in a four-game series beginning Thursday night...Following a day off on Monday, the trip will conclude with a two-game series against the Yankees, which will be the fourth series ever for the Pirates in the Bronx and first since 2014.

YOUNG BUCS: Pirates rookies have totaled 47 home runs this season, the second-most in all of baseball behind Kansas City (63)...the 47 home runs by rookies this season are already the most in a single season by Pirates rookies...

- **Jack Suwinski** leads all Pirates rookies with 15 home runs followed by **Oneil Cruz** with 14 and **Diego Castillo** with ten...This is the first time in franchise history that the Pirates have had three different rookies with 10+ home runs in a single season (source: Elias Sports Bureau).
- Pittsburgh's rookies have also played in a total of 428 games this season, the third-most in all of Major League Baseball behind Kansas City (604) and Arizona (562).

SEPTEMBER SURGE: Cal Mitchell doubled twice last night and has now hit safely in six of his first seven games since being promoted back to the big leagues on September 1, going 9-for-22 (.368) with a 1.000 OPS in seven games...Mitchell's .455 batting average this month is the third-highest in all of MLB among rookies, trailing only Atlanta's Michael Harris II (.419) and teammate Oneil Cruz (.412).

JACK'S JACKS: Jack Suwinski homered in his first at-bat Saturday as part of his fourth three-hit game of the season (all four have come at PNC Park)...Suwinski has hit a team-leading 12 home runs this season at PNC Park (last year Bryan Reynolds led all players at PNC Park with 12 homers)...Prior to last year, the last player to hit more home runs at PNC Park in a single season was Josh Bell, who connected for 17 in 2019.

MITCH KELLER: The 26-year-old righthander will make his 25th start (27th appearance) today...He scattered five hits in 6.0 scoreless innings and won an 8-2 decision against New York's Taijuan Walker in his last start Tuesday night against the Mets...Has gone 3-4 with a 2.83 ERA (54.0ip/17er) over his last 10 outings since July 11...Has allowed three or fewer earned runs in 14 of his last 17 starting assignments since returning to the rotation on 5/31.

VS. ST. LOUIS: 2-1 with a 4.11 ERA (30.2ip/14er) in six career starts...Is 0-1 in two starts this season; suffered a 6-2 loss on 4/9 at Busch Stadium (4.0ip/4er) and was in line for the win (5.1ip/2r) but had a no-decision in a 7-5 loss at Busch on 6/13...Went 1-0 in two starts in 2021; pitched 5.0 scoreless innings in a combined 4-0 shutout at Busch Stadium on 8/20 and gave up seven runs in 5.1ip on 8/26 at PNC Park (no-decision).
