RAY MATTER—The Rays have lost back-to-back games and four of their last 5 games, returning to .500 for the 10th time in 38 games...they would need a win tonight to avoid falling under .500 for the first time since the end of play on May 2 (14-15)...the next loss will be their 20th of the season to match their total from the 60-game 2020 campaign...the Rays are 1-4 in their last 5 games, 6-7 in their last 13 games and 9-11 in their last 20 games...the Rays are in 4th place in the AL East, 3 GB of first-place Boston.

- + Tonight the Rays continue a 6-game homestand against the Yankees (0-2) and Mets (3)...the Rays are 7-12 at home this season after going 20-9 last season...they are 1-4-1 in home series after going 6-0-4 in 2020, and 0-4-1 in their last five home series...the Rays have had back-to-back losing homestands for the first time since they went 2-4 from July 21-26, 2017 and 2-7 from Aug 4-13, 2017.
- + The Rays have 13 players on the injured list, tying the single-game club record...this season the Rays have used 38 players (tied for 4th in majors), 22 pitchers (tied for 2nd) and 11 starting pitchers (2nd).
- + The Rays have nine comeback wins this season, overcoming a season-high 3-run deficit in 4 games...they have blown a lead in eight of their losses, tying their total from the shortened 2020 season.
- + The Rays have used 37 different batting orders in 38 games.

NO BROOMS ALLOWED—Tonight the Rays are attempting to avoid being swept for the second time this season, following April 5-7 at BOS (0-3)...the Rays were swept in a series of 3 games (or more) once last season: July 31-Aug 2 at BAL (0-3)...the Rays haven't been swept at Tropicana Field (regardless of series length) since April 19-21, 2019 vs. BOS (0-3).

- + In franchise history, the Rays have been swept by the Yankees in a series of 3 games (or more) 16 times—12 times as the Devil Rays and four as the Rays...the most recent was June 17-19, 2019 at NYY (0-3), and the last time at Tropicana Field was April 17-19, 2015 (0-3).

ICE COLED—Last night the Rays were shut out for the second time this season, both over a span of 17 games (April 25 vs. TOR)...two other times over that stretch the Rays have been shut out entering the 9th inning...these shutouts come on the heels of 69 straight games without one, which tied for the 3rd-longest streak in franchise history...the Rays have played four 1-0 games this season, most in the majors (Mariners/Nationals, 3), and have lost their last two after going 6-0 in 1-0 games in between.

- + Last night was the third time in club history the Rays lost a 1-0 game with the only run scoring on a sacrifice fly, following June 21, 2015 at CLE (David Murphy) and Sep 7, 2008 at TOR (Rod Barajas).
- + Last night was the 10th time the Rays and Yankees have played a 1-0 game, with the Rays falling to 5-5 in them...it was the first time the Rays lost a 1-0 game to the Yankees since July 10, 2011 at Yankee Stadium and the first time at home since July 7, 2006.

ABOUT THE OFFENSE—The Rays have scored 1 run on 7 hits this series, recording 1 run (or fewer) in back-to-back games for the second time this season (April 25-26 vs. TOR/OAK)...tonight they are attempting to avoid scoring 1 run (or fewer) in a third consecutive game for the first time since April 13-15, 2016 vs. CLE/CWS (3)...for the record, the franchise low for runs scored during a 3-game series is 2, 5x-last Aug 4-6, 2017 vs. MIL.

- + This season the Rays rank 9th in the AL in runs (154), 12th in avg. (.217), 11th in on-base pct. (.298) and 11th in homers (38)...the .217 avg. would be the lowest mark in franchise history (.238 in 2020).
- + The Rays have struck out a major-league-most 397 times, ahead of the Brewers (376)...the Rays are on pace for 1,692 SO, which would be a major league record ahead of the 2019 Tigers (1,595)...the Rays have a majors-most 26 games of reaching double-digit strikeouts.
- + The Rays have scored 1 run (or fewer) nine times this season, tied for most in the majors, compared to six times during the abbreviated 2020 season (tied for 3rd-fewest in the majors)...the Rays have scored 4 runs (or fewer) in 25 of 38 games (65.8 pct.), tied with the Athletics and Orioles for the most such games among ML clubs.
- + In the last 3 games the Rays have been held to 5 runs, all coming on homers (3-run, solo, solo)...the Rays have been held to 4 hits (or fewer) in three consecutive games, their longest streak since doing so in a club-record four straight games from Aug 11-14, 2017.
- + In the last 5 games, the Rays have combined for 9 runs on 24 hits, 4 HR and 8 BB and are batting .151 (24-for-159) over that stretch.
- + The Rays are batting .201 (124-for-616) at home, 29th in the majors ahead of Seattle (.184)...they have scored 2 runs (or fewer) in six of

their last 7 games at Tropicana Field and eight of their last 10.

- + In the last 8 games, opposing starters have a 1.28 ERA (49.1-IP, 7-ER) against the Rays...in the last 10 games, opposing starters have a 2.33 ERA (58-IP, 15-ER) and bullpeners have a 5.81 ERA (31-IP, 20-ER).

CHICKEN ON THE BONE—This season the Rays are batting .197 (62-for-314) with RISP, last in the majors—in 29th place is the Pirates at .205...prior to this season, the lowest avg. with RISP in major league history was .210 by the 1981 Mets, and the lowest in AL history was .217 by the 1988 Orioles...with RISP and 2 outs, the Rays are batting .149 (22-for-148), last in the majors (29th: Nationals, .152)...prior to this season, the lowest avg. with RISP and 2 out in major league history was .173 by the 2011 Giants.

- + The Rays are 0-for-9 with RISP so far this series including 6 SO.
- + This season the Rays are batting .135 (19-for-141) with RISP at Tropicana Field, compared to .249 (43-for-173) with RISP on the road...they have 5 hits in their last 74 AB with RISP at Tropicana Field.
- + The Rays have struck out 111 times with RISP, most in the AL (Red Sox, 97) and tied with the Dodgers for most in the majors...Willy Adames is tied for 3rd in the majors with 15 SO with RISP, while Randy Arozarena and Brandon Lowe are tied for 6th (14).

PITCHING PROPERLY—The Rays rank 10th in the majors and 4th in the AL with a 3.68 ERA (342-IP, 140-ER)...the Rays have pitched to a 2.67 ERA (97.2-IP, 29-ER) in their last 11 games and a 2.80 ERA (160.2-IP, 50-ER) in their last 18 games...last night was the seventh time this season they lost when allowing 3 runs (or fewer), tied with the Marlins and Padres for 2nd in the majors behind the Tigers (8)...all 7 losses have come since April 25.

- + The Rays have yielded 3 runs (or fewer) 22 times this season, tied for most in the AL and tied for 2nd in the majors behind the Padres (25)...this includes eight of the last 9 games and 15 of the last 18.
- + Rays pitching ranked as low as 28th in the majors with a 5.74 ERA through April 9...since April 10, the Rays have a 3.22 ERA (279.1-IP, 100-ER) in 31 games, which ranks 8th in the majors over that span.
- + The bullpen has a 2.47 ERA (87.1-IP, 24-ER) in the last 19 games, reducing its season ERA from 5.40 to 3.73...since April 10, the bullpen is 8th in the majors with a 3.06 ERA (144-IP, 49-ER) in 31 games.
- + The Rays have allowed 60 runs in the 7th inning or later, 7th-most in the majors...however, in the last 19 games the Rays have allowed 15 runs in the 7th inning or later, compared to 45 runs through the first 19 games...these 60 runs are two shy of matching their total from the abbreviated 2020 season...the Rays have yielded 4 HR in the 7th inning, 4 HR in the 8th, 3 HR in the 9th and 1 HR in extras.
- + The Rays are 10-11 in games decided by 2 runs (or fewer) this season after going a major-league-best 23-10 last season...similarly, they are 5-7 in 1-run games after going a majors-best 14-5 in 2020.

RAYS vs. YANKEES—Last night's loss ended a streak of six consecutive regular-season series wins over the Yankees...the Rays lost a series to them for the first time since July 15-18, 2019 at NYY (1-3) and for the first time at home since May 10-12, 2019 (1-2)...the Rays are 5-3 against the Yankees this season (2-3 at home, 3-0 on the road), most recently a 3-game sweep in the Bronx (April 16-18)...the Rays have outscored them, 37-24, and Rays pitching has held the Yankees to 3 runs (or fewer) in five consecutive games, one shy of tying the longest such streak in club history.

- + Since Sep 24, 2019, the Rays are 15-5 against them in the regular season with a +31 run differential (90-59)...tonight is the ninth of 19 meetings between the two clubs this season, which includes 16 in advance of the trade deadline...the Rays and Yankees end the regular season facing each other in a 3-game series in the Bronx.

UP NEXT: METS—Tomorrow the Rays begin a 3-game series with the Mets, the only series between the two clubs this season...the Rays went 2-1 against them last season, clinching the third AL East title in franchise history with a win on Sep 23 at Citi Field...the Rays are 13-14 (.481) all-time against the Mets (5-7 at home, 8-7 on the road) and haven't faced them at Tropicana Field since winning two of three from Aug 7-9, 2015.

KING OF THE HILL—Rich Hill enters tonight's start on a scoreless streak of 11 IP...with Albert Pujols designated for assignment by the Angels, Hill is the oldest active player in the majors, according to Stats LLC...at 41 years, 63 days as of today, he tops the list ahead of MIN Nelson Cruz (40.316), STL Adam Wainwright (39.256) and MIN J.A. Happ (38.206).

LAST START—On Fri at OAK, pitched six scoreless innings, his longest start without allowing a run since June 2, 2019 vs. PHI (7 IP, with LAD)... three of his five baserunners allowed reached in his first 2 IP, including a walk and single to lead off the 2nd inning, but he escaped the jam with a strikeout, popout and lineout...erased a leadoff hit by pitch in the 3rd with a groundball double play, then retired 10 of his last 11 BF before being replaced...his line: ND, 6 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 4 SO, 1 HBP, 79 pit., 55 str.

- + Received no run support as opposing starter **Sean Manaea** took a perfect game into the 7th inning and a no-hitter into the 8th.
- + Has allowed 2 runs in his last 3 starts spanning 15 IP.

ROLLIN' RICH—After pitching to a 8.82 ERA (16.1-IP, 16-ER) in his first 4 starts this season, has a 1.20 ERA (15-IP, 2-ER) in his last 3 starts, including an active 11 IP scoreless streak...since April 26, he ranks among AL leaders (min. 15 IP) in ERA (3rd), opp avg. (.104, 1st) and WHIP (0.67, 3rd).

vs. YANKEES—Is 2-2 with a 5.06 ERA (26.2-IP, 15-ER) in 12 career apps (4 starts) against the Yankees, including a win against them on April 9 at Tropicana Field when he allowed 4 runs in 6 IP...retired his first 8 BF, including 4 SO, before his only four baserunners allowed all reached and scored consecutively with 2 outs in the 3rd inning—including a 2-run homer by **Aaron Hicks**...following the homer, retired his final 10 BF.

- + Has allowed 7 runs in 18 IP in his last 3 starts against them after allowing 5 runs in 3 IP in his first start on July 21, 2009 with BAL.
- + Made 14 relief apps for the Yankees spanning 5.1 IP in 2014.

CRAZY CURVE—Hill has used his curveball on 41.2 pct. of his pitches this season, the highest rate in the majors (min. 300 pitches)...opponents are batting .170 (9-for-53) in at-bats ending with the curveball, the 10th-best rate in the AL (min. 20 AB)...his 22.9 pct. whiff rate on the curveball this season is his highest rate since 2017, when his whiff rate was 25.1 pct.

- + His hard-hit rate on the pitch this season is 34.1 pct. compared to 18.2 pct. last season, which was the 9th-best rate in the majors.

IN THE ZONE—Has thrown first-pitch strikes to 66.4 pct. (85 of 128) of batters faced this season, 10th in the AL and 7th among AL lefties (min. 30 IP), according to Stats LLC...has thrown strikes on 67 pct. of his pitches, tied for 10th in the AL, compared to 63 pct. of pitches in 2020 (with MIN).

- + Has entered 2-strike counts to 57.8 pct. (74 of 128) of batters faced, and opponents are batting .167 (11-for-66) in those situations.

MR. 1000—Became the 50th active pitcher to eclipse 1,000 career innings pitched with a 1-out flyout in the 2nd inning of his start on May 2 vs. HOU...among those pitchers, is tied for 5th in opp avg. (.223), 10th in opp SLG (.369), 11th in winning pct. (.602) and 12th in strikeout rate (25.3 pct.).

DOME SWEET DOME—Is 2-1 with a 3.40 ERA (39.2-IP, 15-ER) in 10 career apps (7 starts) at Tropicana Field, despite going 1-1 with a 4.66 ERA (19.1-IP, 10-ER) in 4 starts here this season...he entered the 2021 season with a 1-0 record and 2.21 ERA (20.1-IP, 5-ER) in 6 apps (3 starts) at the ballpark.

- + Since 2019, is 5-3 with a 3.46 ERA (78-IP, 30-ER), .215 opp avg. (61-for-284) and 79 SO in 16 starts when pitching at home.

SWEET SINCE '15—Over the last seven seasons (2015-21), is 44-23 with a 3.05 ERA (536.1-IP, 182-ER) and 616 SO in 102 apps (101 starts)...min. 500 IP, ranks among major league leaders over that stretch in ERA (7th), WHIP (1.07, 8th), opp avg. (.206, 3rd) and opp SLG (.343, 3rd)...in comparison, through his first 10 seasons, he was 24-22 with a 4.72 ERA (471-IP, 247-ER), 1.39 WHIP, .243 opp avg. (429-for-1,768) and .398 opp SLG.

SENIOR LIVING—With **Albert Pujols** designated for assignment, he is the oldest active player in the majors...at 41 years, 63 days, he tops the list ahead of MIN **Nelson Cruz** (40.316) and STL **Adam Wainwright** (39.256)...if he appears in a game for the Rays on May 24 or later, he would become the oldest player in franchise history...would pass **Wade Boggs**, who was 41 years, 73 days old when he played in his last game on Aug 27, 1999.

- + Since turning 38, he is 18-9 with a 3.48 ERA (261.1-IP, 101-ER).
