NEW YORK YANKEES NOTES

- The Yankees dropped their series opener vs. the Blue Jays...have lost back-to-back games after winning their previous three games.
 - Are still 6-3 in their last nine games (since 9/10), 14-7 in their last 21 games (since 8/28) and 16-10 in their last 26 games (since 8/23).
- RHP Clarke Schmidt (5.0IP, 4H, 4ER, 2BB, 1K, 2HR) started and took the loss...allowed more than 3ER for just the second time in his last 21 starts (since 5/19), the third time in his last 24 starts (since 5/3) and just the fourth time in his last 26 starts (since 4/23).
- **2B Gleyber Torres** (2-for-4, 1 double, 1RBI) drove in the Yankees' only run of the game with a game-tying RBI double in the first inning...is batting .315/.406/.562 (51-for-162) with 27R, 13 doubles, 9HR, 22RBI, 23BB, 2HP and 5SB in 43 games (since 8/1)...has hit safely in 30 of those games and has reached base safely in 36 of those contests.
 - Has recorded multiple hits in two of his last three games (since 9/16) and four of his last seven games (since 9/12-G2).
 - Has reached base multiple times in 12 of his last 19 games (since 8/28) and 14 of his last 23 games (since 8/24).
 - Since 7/6, is batting .308/.376/.525 (74-for-240) with 37R, 14 doubles, 1 triple, 12HR, 30RBI, 26BB, 2HP, 3SF and 6SB in 62 games.
- **1B DJ LeMahieu** (1-for-3, 1BB) reached base twice...has hit safely in each of his last six games (since 9/12-G1), batting .360/.407/.480 (9-for-25) with 4R. 3 doubles, 5RBI and 2BB.
 - Has reached base in 16 of his last 17 games (since 8/30), 34 of his last 37 games (since 8/1), 51 of his last 56 games (since 7/4) and 58 of his last 65 games (since 6/23).
 - Is a career .332/.387/.524 (90-for-271) batter with 42R, 20 doubles, 1 triple, 10HR, 31RBI, 23BB and 4SB in 70 games vs. the Blue Jays...in 67 games vs. Toronto as a Yankee, has hit .336/.392/.531 (88-for-262) with 42R, 19 doubles, 1 triple, 10HR, 31RBI, 23BB and 4SB...owns the highest BA among players with at least 100PA against the Blue Jays as a Yankee (next: Oscar Gamble, .331, 48-for-145).
- **RF Aaron Judge** (2-for-4, 1R) has reached base in 27-of-63 plate appearances over his last 14 games (since 9/5), posting a .429 OBP in that span (11H, 16BB).
 - Has reached base safely in 79 of his 97 games this season...has hit safely in 57 of those games...has reached base safely in 56 of his last 68 games (since 5/12).
 - Has reached base multiple times in 49 of his 97 games this year, including 37 of his last 68 games (since 5/12).
- LHP Nick Ramirez (1.1IP, 2H, 1K) and RHP Greg Weissert (1.2IP, 1H, 1BB) were both scoreless in relief.
- RHP Zach McAllister (1.0IP, 3H, 3R/2ER, 1HR) allowed 3R/2ER in the ninth inning.

TORONTO BLUE JAYS NOTES

- The Blue Jays defeated the Yankees in the first game of a three-game set...are 1-0 on their six-game road trip.
 - Improve to 23-11 over their last 34 road games (since 6/20).
 - Have won 12 of their last 18 games (since 8/29), 16 of their last 27 games (since 8/19) and 30 of their last 52 games (since 7/23).
 - Improve to 4-4 vs. the Yankees this season.
 - Are 51-79 all-time at the current Yankee Stadium.
- LHP Yusei Kikuchi (5.0IP, 4H, 1ER, 1BB, 7K) earned his 10th win of the season after allowing just 1ER over 5.0IP...marks his first career season with double-digit wins...has also recorded 30-or-more starts in his second career season (also 32GS in 2019 with Seattle).
 - Tossed at least 5.0IP with 1R-or-fewer allowed for the 14th time this season...entered tonight tied for the second-most such starts in the Majors this season (tied for the most in the AL).
 - Has recorded 7K-or-more in four of his last seven starts (since 8/15).
 - In 12 career appearances (10 starts) vs. the Yankees, is 4-3 with a 3.57 ERA (53.0IP, 21ER) and 49K.
 - Was removed from tonight's game with a left upper trap muscle cramp.

- RF George Springer (2-for-4, 2R, 1HR, 1RBI, 1BB) hit his 20th home run of the season with a leadoff HR in the first inning.
 - His home run marked his fifth leadoff home run of the season and the 57th of his career...his 57 such home runs are the second-most all-time, trailing only Rickey Henderson's 81 career leadoff home runs.
 - Has reached 20 home runs for the eighth time in his career (also 2014, 2016-19, 2021-22).
 - Is one of seven players to hit 20-or-more home runs in at least eight seasons since 2014...joins Manny Machado, Nolan Arenado, Paul Goldschmidt, J.D. Martinez, Anthony Rizzo and Giancarlo Stanton (all with eight).
 - 12 of his 20 home runs this season have either given his team the lead (11) or tied the game (one).
 - Turned 34 years old today, marked the first time in his career he has recorded a home run on his birthday...became the 16th Blue Jay (17th time) to homer on his birthday and the first since Randal Grichuk on 8/13/19 vs. Texas.
 - Is batting .417/.462/.625 (10-for-24) with 5R, 2 doubles, 1HR, 2RBI and 2BB over his last six games at Yankee Stadium (since 8/18/22).
- SS Bo Bichette (2-for-4, 2R, 1HR, 2RBI, 1BB) hit his 19th home run of the season with a two-run shot in the fifth inning.
 - Is hitting .328/.360/.513 (87-for-265) with 36R, 15 doubles, 2 triples, 10HR, 35RBI, 11BB, 2HP and 2SB in 61 road games this season.
 - In eight games vs. the Yankees this season, is batting .333 (11-for-33) with 6R, 2 doubles, 2HR, 5RBI and 3BB...has also hit safely in 11 of his last 12 games against the Yankees (since 8/21/22), batting .360/.396/.540 (18-for-50) with 7R, 3 doubles, 2HR, 6RBI and 3BB in that span.
- C Alejandro Kirk (1-for-4, 1R, 1HR, 2RBI) hit his seventh home run of the season with a two-run shot in the ninth inning.
 - Marked his first home run since 7/29 vs. Los Angeles-AL...snapped a 34-game homerless streak, the longest of his career.
- 1B Cavan Biggio (2-for-5, 1RBI) hit a go-ahead RBI single in the fourth inning.
 - Has recorded multiple hits in consecutive games for the third time this season (also 6/11-13 and 6/21-25).
 - Has reached base in six of his last 11PA over his last three games (since 9/16: 5H, 1BB).
- RHP Jordan Hicks (1.0IP, 1K) tossed a scoreless eighth inning.
 - Nine of his last 10 outings have been scoreless (since 8/27).
 - Since being acquired by the Blue Jays at the trade deadline (since 8/1), has gone 2-2 with four saves, a 2.37 ERA (19.0IP, 5ER) and 16K in 21 appearances.
- RHP Yimi García (1.0IP, 1H, 1K) tossed a scoreless inning of relief.
 - Stranded an inherited runner after entering the game in the sixth inning...has stranded 28 of his 35 inherited runners this season...entered tonight with the fifth-best inherited runners scored percentage in the AL (ninth-best in the Majors).
