**THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY**  
**JULY 1**  
**2021 - 2B Jose Altuve** hits his fifth career grand slam, a go-ahead shot in the 5th inning, in the Astros 7-2 win at Cleveland... the Astros trailed, 2-1, prior to the Altuve slam...Altuve now has seven career grand slams, which ties the franchise record.

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Astros will play another rubber game tonight as they conclude their three-game series with the visiting Twins at Daikin Park... **RHP Tatsuya Imai** (5-3), who's won three straight decisions, will get the start for the Astros tonight opposite **RHP Taj Bradley** (6-3) and the Twins.

**ABOUT IMAI:** **RHP Tatsuya Imai** joined the Astros this offseason as an international signing out of Japan...he's made 11 MLB starts this year, in which the Astros have gone 7-4, around a month-long IL stint (April 13-May 10)...he's flashed brilliance at times, including his 10-strikeout performance his last time out at DET (6IP), and his 6.0 innings of no-hit ball on May 25 at TEX...Imai has won his last three straight decisions over his last four starts.

**TOMORROW'S SUPPLY DRIVE:** The Astros Foundation will hold a supply drive tomorrow to collect items needed for victims of last week's earthquakes in Venezuela...the drive-thru supply drive will take place outside Union Station at Daikin Park tomorrow from 7 a.m.-6 p.m...Astros executives, players, coaches, families, Orbit and the Coca-Cola Shooting Stars will support the drive.

**THE SLOW TURNAROUND:** After a slow start to the season, the Astros are 23-14 since May 21, which is the best record in the AL in that span...on that date, the Astros were 20-31, 11 games under, which is their low water mark for the season.

**RECENT 'STROS:** The Astros have won six of eight, seven of 10, and are 10-4 in their last 14 games... the Astros 16-11 record in June tied as the best in the AL, along with their rival Rangers.

**SERIES-LY SPEAKING:** The Astros have won five consecutive series dating back to June 12...the last time the Astros won five straight series was from June 20-July 6 of last season (went 12-3 in that stretch)...they are looking for their first six-series winning streak since June 14-July 4, 2024.

**WINNING THE CLOSE CALLS:** The Astros are 9-5 in one-run games and 19-10 in two-run games... each of the Astros last seven wins and 12 of their last 13 victories have come by two-or-fewer runs.

**LAST NIGHT'S W:** The Astros rallied from an early 3-0 deficit with a six-run 4th inning in their 6-4 win over the Twins...**LF Jordan Alvarez** (3x4, HR, 4RBI) had the big blow, a go-ahead grand slam in the big 4th...**RHP Mike Burrows** (4ER/5IP) picked up the win and **LHP Josh Hader** (0ER/1IP) the save, as he stayed perfect in save chances on the season.

**ANOTHER ALVAREZ??:** Astros top prospect **OF Kevin Alvarez** has been selected to play in the 2026 All-Star Futures Game, which will be played on July 12 in Philadelphia...Alvarez, 18, who currently ranks as the 70th overall prospect in baseball per MLB.com, has played this season at Class A Fayetteville, hitting .266 (59x222) with 16 doubles, six homers and 30 RBI in 55 games.

**TODAY'S ROSTER MOVE:** The Astros have nullified the optional assignment for **RHP Kai-Wei Teng** and have placed him on the Major League 15-day Injured List with a right knee sprain...his IL placement is effective Sunday, June 28.

**JUNE BUGS:** The Astros went 16-11 in June thanks to strong June performances by:

- DH Jordan Alvarez:** .344 BA, 6 HR, 21 RBI, 1.036 OPS
- 3B Isaac Paredes:** .277 BA, 5 HR, 21 RBI, .877 OPS

- RHP AJ Blubaugh:** 2-0, 1.59 ERA, 3ER/17IP
- LHP Josh Hader:** 2-0, 8 saves, 0.69 ERA, 1ER/13IP

**ALL-STAR UPDATE:** **DH Jordan Alvarez** has been named a finalists on the 2026 KONAMI eBaseball MLB All-Star Ballot with second-phase fan voting available now through tomorrow at 11 a.m. CT...Alvarez has been an All-Star three times in his career.

**SALAMI SEASON:** **DH Jordan Alvarez** hit the seventh grand slam of his career last night, which ties the club record also reached by **2B Jose Altuve**, **3B Alex Bregman** and **LF Carlos Lee**...last night's slam was Alvarez's third of the season, which also ties the franchise record for grand slams in a single year, also reached by Bregman (2023), Altuve (2021) and **OF George Springer** (2016).

**TAP FOR SUCCESS:** Astros hitters have won an MLB-best 63 ABS challenges and lead the Majors in challenge success rate (61%)...**3B Isaac Paredes** (9-for-9) has the most successful challenges in the Majors without losing one...**2B Jose Altuve** has been successful on 15-of-21 challenges (71%), ranking second in the Majors in challenges won.

**WHAT A RELIEF:** **LHP Josh Hader** is 2-0 with eight saves (in eight chances) and a 0.69 ERA (1ER/13IP) in 13 appearances this season...he has 21 strikeouts in his 13.0 innings with a .049 (2x41) opponent average and a 0.54 WHIP...Hader has not allowed a hit in six consecutive appearances (6IP since June 21).

**WORKHORSE:** **RHP Bryan Abreu**, now in his eighth MLB season, has made 348 career appearances as an Astro, which ties him for fifth in club history.

- RHP Ronel Blanco** (rt. elbow surgery) will start tonight for Double A Corpus Christi at NW Arkansas in what is his third minor league rehab start.
- RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** (rt. shoulder inflammation) will make his second rehab start for Triple A Sugar Land tonight in their game at OKC.
- RHP Hayden Wesneski** (rt. elbow surgery) began his minor league rehab assignment yesterday for the FCL Astros, tossing 3.0 scoreless innings on 25 pitches.
- IF Braden Shewmake** (rt. adductor strain) will have his rehab assignment transferred to Triple A today.
- OF LaMonte Wade Jr.** (rt. hamstring strain) began a rehab assignment at Triple A last night, going 1x3 with a walk in a start at first base.

**LAST START, JUNE 25 at DET:** Allowed 2 hits and 1 walk with 10 strikeouts in 6.0 innings...earned his 5th win of the season as the Astros defeated the Tigers, 2-1...has recorded double-digit strikeouts in consecutive starts for the 1st time in his career, the last Astros pitcher to do so was **LHP Framber Valdez** on June 5 and 12 of 2025 (11 K at PIT, 12 K vs. CWS, respectively).

**ABOUT IMAI (pronounced ee-MY):** Rookie starter joined the Astros this offseason as an international signing out of Japan...has made 11 Major League starts this season around a month-long IL stint (April 13-May 10) due to right arm fatigue...the Astros are 7-4 in his 11 starts.

**HARD TO HIT:** Has proven to be tough to hit at the Major League level, as he's held opponents to a .215 (37x172) average with 58 strikeouts in 47.0 innings...is averaging 11.11 strikeouts per 9.0, which leads the Astros and ranks 7th in the AL (min. 40 IP)...has held right-handed hitters to a .176 average (12x68) and a .571 OPS.

**IMAI'S ARSENAL:** Has thrown 44.8% sliders in his MLB career, while throwing four-seamers (42.85) and sinkers (7%) as his fastballs...among fastballs, has heavily featured his four-seamer over his last 7 starts, throwing the pitch 277 times compared to just 11 sinkers...has also worked in select split fingers (3.6%), changeups (1.4%) and curveballs (0.7%)...has raised eyebrows by featuring his unique wrong-way slider, which was well known during his time pitching in the NPB...Imai's slider is averaging 4.4 inches of arm-side run...for context, the average MLB slider breaks 4 inches to the glove side.

**NO FREE PASSES:** On June 19 vs. CLE, he struck out a career-high 11 hitters, a season high for any Astro, and did not surrender a walk...marked the first time an Astros pitcher struck out 11+ batters without surrendering a walk since **LHP Yusei Kikuchi** struck out 12 batters without a walk on Aug. 31, 2024 vs. KC.

**KEEP IT 100:** Tossed a career-high 110 pitches on May 31 vs. MIL, which ties as the 3rd most pitches thrown by any MLB starter in a game this season...are the most pitches thrown by an Astro since **LHP Framber Valdez** threw 114 pitches on Aug. 25, 2023 at DET.

**A NO-HITTER!** On May 25 at TEX, Imai tossed the first 6.0 innings of the 18th no-hitter in Astros franchise history, the 5th combined no-hitter...navigated 6.0 scoreless, hitless innings despite walking 4 batters, including the first 2 batters of the game and 3 total walks in the 1st inning...retired 15 of the next 16 batters he faced to finish the outing, striking out 2...was relieved in the no-hitter by **LHP Steven Okert** (1 IP) and **RHP Alimber Santa** (2 IP), with Santa making his MLB debut in the outing...marked the Astros first combined no-hitter since **RHP Cristian Javier**, **RHP Bryan Abreu**, **RHP Rafael Montero** and **RHP Ryan Pressly** combined to no-hit the Phillies in Game 4 of the 2022 World Series at Citizens Bank Park.

**NO HITTER HISTORY:** Imai became the 4th Japanese-born pitcher in MLB history to start a no-hitter, joining **RHP Hideo Nomo** (1996, 2001), **RHP Hisashi Iwakuma** (2015) and **LHP Shota Imanaga** (2024)...both of Nomo's no-hitters and Iwakuma's no-hitter were complete-game efforts...the Astros no-hitter ended a 630-day drought between the last no-hitter thrown in the Majors when the Cubs tossed a combined no-hitter vs. the Pirates on Sept. 4, 2024...coincidentally, that no-hitter was started by Imanaga, who was relieved by **RHP Porter Hodge** and Imai's current Astros teammate, **RHP Nate Pearson**...was the longest no-hitter drought in the Majors since a span of 841 days between the 2004-06 seasons.

**2025 RECAP:** Went 10-5 with a 1.92 ERA (35ER/163.2IP) in 24 games with Seibu in the NPB in 2025...recorded 178 strikeouts and a 0.89 WHIP...in the NPB, he ranked T-1st in WHIP, 2nd in strikeouts, 6th in ERA and 10th in starts (24)...was selected as an All-Star for the 2nd consecutive season...struck out a club record 17 hitters on June 17, 2025 vs. the Yokohama DeNa Baystars...also tossed 8.0 innings of a combined no-hitter on April 18, 2025 vs. the Fukuoka Softbank Hawks.

**JAPANESE CAREER:** Prior to signing with the Astros, Imai starred in the Nippon Professional Baseball Organization (NPB) for the last 8 seasons (2018-25)...he went 58-45 overall with a 3.15 ERA (337ER/963.2IP) and 907 strikeouts in 159 career games in the NPB...was a 3-time All-Star in the NPB (2021, 2024 and 2025).

**JAPAN CONNECTION:** Became the 33rd Japanese-born pitcher to make a start in the Majors...is the fourth Japanese-born player to play for the Astros, joining **IF Kazuo Matsui** (2008-10), **OF Norichika Aoki** (2017) and **LHP Yusei Kikuchi** (2024)...Imai knows Matsui well, having played for him from 2023-24, while he was managing in the NPB with the Seibu Lions.
