RAY REPORT—The Rays open a seven-game, seven-day road trip against the Red Sox (4 to play) and Blue Jays (3 to play) tonight at Fenway Park...Tampa Bay is in the midst of a 13-game stretch featuring matchups exclusively vs. AL East opponents...after going 1-2 against the Yankees from May 10-12, the Rays return home for a three-game set with the Red Sox from May 20-22 to complete the 13-game stretch...Tampa Bay remains a season-high-tying 7.0 games back in the AL East standings and has been at or within one game of the .500 mark for eight consecutive days.

The Rays conceded a season-high-tying 5 HR in yesterday's 10-6 defeat vs. New York-AL (also April 13 vs. SF)...Tampa Bay is the only team in the majors to have allowed 5+ HR in multiple games.

Tampa Bay has hit 2 HR in back-to-back games for the second time this season (also March 31-April 1)...the last time the Rays hit multiple HR in three straight games was May 7-9, 2023 (3G).

The Rays have won five straight games at Fenway Park dating to June 3, 2023, outscoring Boston 28-12 (+16) during that stretch...it marks Tampa Bay's longest winning streak in Boston since a franchise-best eight-game winning streak from June 9, 2019–Aug. 13, 2020.

ON-BASE PAREDES—Isaac Paredes has reached base safely in 12 straight games dating to April 28, slashing .381/.481/.595 (16-for-42) with 3 2B, 2 HR, 6 RBI, 8 BB while producing a 7.7 pct. strikeout rate (4SO/52PA)...the 12-game run is tied with José Caballero for the second-longest streak by a Ray this season, trailing Amed Rosario (14G) from April 5-22.

Paredes has 10 multi-hit games since April 17, tied with PHI Alec Bohm for the

most in the majors during that period.

WALK IT OUT -Ben Rortvedt has drawn at least one walk in a career-best five straight games, the longest active streak in the majors...he is the first catcher in franchise history to draw a walk in five straight games...three other Tampa Bay catchers (4 instances) had turned the trick in four straight games, the most recent being **Derek Norris** from May

1-5, 2017...John Jaso (2x) and Dioner Navarro also put together four-game streaks.
 With a walk in his next appearance, Rortvedt can tie NYY Austin Wells (6G) for the most consecutive games with walk by a catcher this season.
 Tampa Bay has drawn an MLB-best 66 walks in 15 games (4.4BB/G) since April 26, outpacing Los Angeles-NL and Philadelphia (both 65BB).

YANDY DANDY—Yandy Díaz has hit safely in four straight and eight of his last nine games since May 3, including five multi-hit efforts, going 14-for-37 (.378) with 3 2B, 2 HR and 8 RBI...this, following an 0-for-15 skid from April 28-May 1...after going 37 straight games without a home run from March 29-May 10, he has homered in back-to-back contests for the fifth time in his career (last: May 4-5, 2023).

In 68 career games against Boston, Díaz is slashing .336/.423/.525 (82-for-244) with 18 2B, 2 3B, 8 HR, 34 RBI and 33 BB against 46 SO...min. 200 AB, his .336 career batting average vs. Boston leads all active players outpacing HOLL lose Altrure

batting average vs. Boston leads all active players, outpacing HOU Jose Altuve (.321) and TOR Bo Bichette (.315).

HOMER (UN)HAPPY—The Rays have allowed 54 HR, second most in the majors behind the White Sox (55HR)...Tampa Bay relievers have permitted an MLB-high 25 HR, accounting for 46.3 pct. of the team total...the 54 HR allowed are the most Tampa Bay has surrendered through 41 games since 2016 (57HR)...prior to allowing 5 HR yesterday, the Rays had yielded a total of 5 HR in their previous seven games.

Seventeen of Tampa Bay's 54 HR allowed (31.2%) have come with two outs, tied for fourth most in the majors behind Chicago-AL (23HR) and Baltimore/San Diego (both 19HR)...overall, opponents are hitting .257 against the Rays with two outs, the highest mark in the AL and third highest in MLB behind the Rockies (.274) and Giants (.265).

PECKING ORDER—Opposing nine-hole hitters are batting .293 against Tampa Bay, the PECKING ORDER—Opposing nine-hole hitters are batting .293 against Tampa Bay, the highest mark in the majors, with the next closest clubs being Houston (.275) and Detroit (.259)...when facing the bottom third of an opponent's lineup, Tampa Bay has allowed a .268 batting average, the highest mark in the AL and tied with Arizona for the third highest clip the majors behind Washington (.270) and Milwaukee (.269).

In comparison, 1-3 hitters are batting .253 against the Rays, the 14th-highest mark in MLB...4-6 hitters have posted a .221 clip, the fifth-lowest mark in the majors and third lowest in the AL behind New York-AL (.213) and Baltimore (.217).

EXTRA, EXTRA!—Tampa Bay has registered 28 extra-base hits over its last nine games since May 3 (17 2B, 2 3B, 9HR)...the Rays had 18 extra-base hits (10 2B, 8HR) in their previous nine games from April 22–May 1.

Of the 28 XBH, 18 have come from the 1-4 hitters (11 2B, 7 HR) while 10 have come from the 5-9 batters (6 2B, 2 3B, 2 HR)...despite the recent string of success, Tampa

Bay's 96 XBH overall are tied with Chicago-AL for second fewest in the AL, ahead of only Seattle (95XBH).

POWER OUTAGE—Rays batters have produced an average exit velocity of 87.6 mph, the lowest mark in the majors, with the next closest clubs being Toronto (87.9mph) and Cincinnati/Texas (both 88.0mph)...Tampa Bay's 34.9 pct. hard-hit rate and 6.0 pct. barrel rate are both third lowest in the majors.

PEN PALS—During Tampa Bay's nine-game homestand from May 3-12, the bullpen produced a 2.31 ERA, including a 1.36 ERA through eight games before conceding four runs in yesterday's loss.

n yesterday's loss. LHP Garrett Cleavinger has not allowed a hit in his last nine outings, the longest streak by a Rays reliever since Jason Adam (9G) from April 10–May 2, 2022 and tied for the second-longest streak in the majors this season behind WSH Kyle Finnegan (11G)...the single-season Tampa Bay record of 11 straight hitless relief appearances is held by Scott Aldred (April 8–May 1, 1999). RHP Phil Maton has pitched to a 1.04 ERA (8.2IP, 1ER) and 0.46 WHIP in his last 10 games since being tagged for a career-high-tying five runs on April 15 vs. LAA. RHP Jason Adam owns a 0.64 ERA (14.0IP, 1ER) in his last 14 appearances.

SHIPPING UP TO BOSTON-Tampa Bay and Boston open a four-game set tonight at Fenway Park...the two clubs will meet seven times in the next 10 days, with the Red Sox traveling to St. Petersburg from May 20-22...Tampa Bay went 11-2 vs. Boston last season, including a 5-1 mark at Fenway Park.

The Rays had 10+ hits in four of six games at Fenway last year while tallying a total of 16 doubles.

TONIGHT'S START-Eflin will take the mound for his ninth start of the season, including his fifth on the road...is seeking his first road victory since Sept. 26, 2023 at Fenway Park...has gone 1-2 with a 2.32 ERA (31.0IP, 8ER) over his last five starts...his 2.63 run support average is fourth lowest in the majors...he has received zero runs of support in three of his four road starts.

LAST TIME OUT—He turned in his fourth quality start in a 5-1 Rays win on May 7 vs. CWS, recording season highs in innings (7.0) and pitches thrown (94) en route to his first victory since April 2 (W, 7.0IP, 6H, ER, 3SO, HR)...allowed only one hit through the first four frames before working out of a two-out, bases-loaded jam in the 5th courtesy of a **Gavin Sheets** fly out...allowed three consecutive hits in the 7th, including a **Paul DeJong** HR, before retiring Sheets to conclude the outing.

FENWAY FILES-Effin is 1-0 with a 6.16 ERA (19.0IP, 13ER) in four career starts against the Red Sox...his teams have won all four of those starts, outscoring Boston, 36-24 (+12), while providing him with 8.53 runs of outscoring Boston, 36-24 (+12), While providing him with 8.53 runs of support per 9.0 IP, his highest mark against any opponent in his career (min. 2GS)...he has not recorded more than 5.0 IP in any of those starts... Eflin owns a 7.00 ERA (9.0IP, 7ER) in two career starts at Fenway Park... last season, he earned the win in his final start of the season on Sept. 26 in Boston (W, 5.0IP, 5H, 3ER, 4SO).

Effin is 9-7 with a 3.97 ERA (122.1IP, 54ER) in 23 career games (21GS) against AL East opponents...he is 5-2 with a 2.63 ERA (54.2IP, 16ER) in his last nine starts against division rivals dating to May 25, 2023, allowing three runs or fewer in eight of those games while tossing

Six quality starts.

Since the second half of last season, Eflin is 3-0 with a 1.50 ERA (24.0IP, 4ER), zero walks, 23 SO and a 0.50 WHIP in four road starts against AL Éast clubs.

ON THE ROAD-Eflin has seen mixed results away from Tropicana Field this season...on both April 8 at LAA and April 26 at CWS, he allowed exactly five runs on nine hits...he recorded a combined 2.31 ERA (11.2IP, 3ER) in his other two road starts (April 20 at NYY; May 1 at MIL)...overall, he is 0-3 with a 4.76 ERA (22.2IP, 12ER) in four road outings...this comes after he went 4-0 with a 1.48 ERA (30.1IP, 5ER) in his final five road starts of 2023.

JEKYLL AND HYDE—In Rays wins (3GS), Eflin has pitched to a 0.93 ERA (19.1IP, 2ER), holding opponents to a .189 (14-for-74) average while posting a 0.78 WHIP...in losses (5GS), he has turned in a 5.65 ERA (28.2IP, 18ER), .300 (36-for-120) opp. average and 1.36 WHIP.

IT'S A MARATHON—In innings 1-5, Eflin has posted a 2.03 ERA (40.0IP, 9ER) and held opponents to a .200 (30-for-150) average and .507 OPS...from the 6th inning on, he owns a 12.38 ERA (8.0IP, 11ER), .455 (20-for-44) opp. average and 1.364 opp. OPS...he has allowed nine of his 21 total runs in the 6th frame, tied with TEX Martín Pérez and LAA José Suarez for the most by any pitcher in the 6th inning.

When his pitch count resides between 1-60, opponents are 25-for-132 (.189) against him...once he surpasses the 60-pitch mark, opposing hitters have gone 25-for-62 (.403), the highest such average in the majors (min. 40AB), ahead of Pérez (.389).

Opponents are batting .186 (26-for-140) against him the first and second times through the order compared to .444 (24-for-54) thereafter.

QUALITY CONTROL—Eflin paces the majors in walk rate (2.0%) and walks per 9.0 IP (0.75) and ranks second in SO/BB ratio (9.75) behind DET Jack Flaherty (10.50)...he walked only two of his first 130 BF (1.5%) in 2024 before walking consecutive batters on April 26 at CWS...since issuing the back-to-back walks, he has strung together a 68 BF streak without a free pass.

He has produced the lowest walk rate in the majors since 2020 at 3.9

pct. (min. 1,500BF), ahead of **Zack Greinke** (4.4%). Eflin's 68.8 pct. strike rate since the beginning of last season ranks third in the majors (min. 200.0IP) behind SEA **George Kirby** (70.9%) and MIN **Joe Ryan** (69.0%)...his 8.04 SO/BB ratio ranks second behind Kirby (9.04) under the same parameters.

He has issued two or fewer walks in 42 consecutive starts, the longest active streak in the majors and longest overall since STL Miles Mikolas (43) from July 10, 2018–Sept. 1, 2019 (G1).
