The Brewers have gone 9-1 over their last 10 games.

Home Brewed

The Brewers play the first game of a season-long 10-game homestand this evening.....the team is 18-10 (.643) at American Family Field in 2025

Climbing the Charts

The Brewers (34-29) look to climb to a season-high 6 games over .500.

Patrick Star

Chad Patrick currently ranks 11th in the National League in ERA (2.97) and first among qualified NL rookies.

1-2 Punch

Jackson Chourio (10 HR/12 SB) and Christian Yelich (13 HR/10 SB) are currently joined by the Cubs' duo of Pete Crow-Armstrong (16 HR/21 SB) and Kyle Tucker (12 HR/16 SB) as the only sets of Major League teammates with 10+ HR and 10+ SB this season.

Born Again Christian

Christian Yelich enters the day on an 11-game hitting streak in which he is batting .429 (21-for-49) with 6 HR and 15 RBL in this stretch he has a .472 OBP/.816 SLG/1.288 OPS.

We Sal-ute You!

In his last 17 games, **Sal Frelick** is batting .348 [23-for-66] with 2 HR and 11 RBI.....during this stretch, he has a .377 OBP/.485 SLG/.862 OPS.

The Durbinator

Caleb Durbin has hit .311 (14-for-45) with 7 RBI in his last 12 games with a .373 OBP/.467 SLG/.839 OPS....his 21 RBI overall this season trails only the Marlins' Liam Hicks (22) among National League rookies

It's Trevor Time

Trevor Megill has posted a 0.69 ERA over his last 14 appearances, allowing just 1 ER in 13.0 innings pitched.....he has converted each of his last 11 save opportunities and 12 of 13 chances overall this season with his only blown save coming on 4/12 at Arizona.

U Da Man!

Abner Uribe is unscored upon in 26 of his 30 appearances this season, including 18 of his last 19 outings and 5 in a row....he currently ranks among National League relief leaders in ERA (6th, 1.53) and strikeouts (T6th, 39).

A Large Inheritance

Grant Anderson has stranded each of his last 10 inherited runners.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is game 1 of a 10-game homestand against San Diego (3g), Atlanta (3g) and St. Louis (4g)....is the team's longest homestand of the season....the Brewers are coming off a 5-1 road trip to Philadelphia (3-0) and Cincinnati (2-1)....after an off day on June 16, the team takes a 6-game trip to Chicago-NL (3g) and Minnesota (3g).

LAST TEN: 9-1

IT WON'T BE THE SAME: This season marks just the second without Bob Uecker on the radio for the Milwaukee Brewers (also 1970).....the 2003 Hall of Famer passed away at the age of 90 on January 16.

IN THE STANDINGS (80 days): The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each spot in the NL Central standings: FIRST: 10*, SECOND: 19, THIRD: 37, FOURTH: 11, FIFTH: 3.....the Brewers are currently in third place, trailing the first-place Cubs by 5.5 games and second-place Cardinals by half a game (*9 days tied for first from 3/18-3/26 before playing a game).

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The team is 11-8-1 in series play. Game 1: 11-9, Game 2: 10-10, Game 3: 11-9, Game 4: 2-1 Sweep Wins [2]: vs. BOS (3g, 5/26-5/28) and at PHI (3g, 5/30-6/1)

Sweep Losses [1]: at NYY (3g, 3/27-3/30)

AT HOME: The team is 18-10 at home, going 7-2-0 in series play.....the Brewers are 6-1 in their last 7 home games, including 3 straight wins.

ON THE ROAD: The team is 16-19 on the road, going 4-6-1 in series play.....the Brewers are 6-1 in their last 7 raod games

MANAGER: Pat Murphy is in his second season as Brewers manager.....he was voted 2024 NL Manager of the Year after going 93-69 and winning the NL Central division championship.....he is the first manager in franchise history (in either league) to earn the honor.....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.

<u>COACHES</u>: Returning from 2024 is associate manager **Rickie Weeks** (2nd season), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (3rd season/2nd in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (7th season), assistant pitching & strategy coach **Jim Henderson** (4th season/2nd in current role), bullpen coach **Charlie Greene** (2nd season), hitting coach Connor Dawson (4th season), assistant coach Daniel de Mondesert (2nd season). infield coach Matt Erickson (2nd season) and third base coach Jason Lane (10th season/5th in current role).....first base coach Julio Borbón, lead hitting coach Al LeBoeuf and hitting coach Eric Theisen are all in their first seasons on the staff.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The team has made eight replay challenges this season, aging 5-3....their last challenge (won) came on 5/28 vs. Boston as an out call at second base involving Sal Frelick was overturned.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have made the postseason six times in the last seven seasons (2018-24) and won the NL Central in four of the last seven, three of four, and two in a row....Milwaukee is one of five teams to make the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons, joined by the Astros (7), Braves (7), Dodgers (7) and Yankees (6).....the team was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in eight straight seasons (2017-24), missing by a single game in both 2017 and 2022.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons (2017-24)....this does not include 2020.....the Brewers have 700 wins since 2017 (6th in MLB/3rd in National League).

PATRICK AT A GLANCE: Chad Patrick, 26, will be making his 14th appearance and 13th start.....Patrick last pitched last Saturday in a start at Philadelphia and earned a 17-7 win (6ip, 5h, 2r, 2er, 0bb, 6k, 1hr, 94 pitches).....the team is 6-6 in his starts.....he has 4 quality starts.....opponents are batting .246 (59-for-240, 5hr).....he was on the Opening Day roster and made his Major League debut on 3/29 at Yankee Stadium, pitching in relief.....Patrick was acquired from Oakland on 11/15/23 for INF Abraham Toro.

PATRICK STAR: The Hebron, Indiana native was supported by 300+ guests for his first Major League start on 4/1 vs. Kansas City, including his parents, coaches, family friends and high school friends.....many of them returned to see his first Major League win on 4/6 vs. Cincinnati.

LAST SEASON: Patrick went 14-1 with a 2.90 ERA in 26 games/24 starts last season at Triple-A Nashville to earn International League Pitcher of the Year honors.....the 2024 International League All-Star led the league in wins, ERA, strikeouts (145) and WHIP (1.09) while ranking second in opponent batting average (.215).....he was added to the 40-man roster on Nov. 19.

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER: Patrick has gone 23-14 with a 4.06 ERA in 68 games/60 starts while pitching in the Arizona (2021-23), Oakland (2023) and Milwaukee (2024) organizations.....he has produced 334 strikeouts in 312.1 innings pitched.....Patrick was selected by Arizona in the fourth round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft.....he was traded by Arizona to Oakland on 7/31/23 in exchange for INF Jace Peterson, who is now a consultant to the Brewers' performance psychology department.

AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 2-2 with a 2.37 ERA in 7 starts (38ip, 10er).

ON THE ROAD: Is 1-2 with a 3.86 ERA in 6 games/5 starts (25.2ip, 11er).

vs. PADRES: This will be his first career appearance against the San Diego, California Padres.
