The Brewers are a Major League-best 39-18 (.684) since April 26.

#### Climbing the Charts

The Brewers (52-31) are looking to climb to a season-high 22 games over .500 with a win tonight.

#### You Go First

The Brewers last night improved to 20-16 in games in which the opponent scores first....Milwaukee is the only team in the majors this season with a winning record in such games....the team has won 4 consecutive games in which the opponent scored first.

#### Well Red

The Brewers are 50-19 (.725) in their last 69 games against the Reds with a current 6-game winning streak.

#### For Starters

In the last 18 games, Brewers starters have a 2.10 ERA (102.2ip, 24er) while producing 123 strikeouts against just 23 walks along with a 0.81 WHIP and opponents batting .169 (60-for-355).

#### Action Jackson

In his last 27 games, Jackson Chourio is batting .319 (37-for-116) with 10 HR and 25 RBI....during this stretch, he has a .375 OBP/.638 SLG/1.013 OPS.

#### Greetings and Salutations

Sal Frelick is on a 6-game hitting streak, batting .500 (9-for-18, 2rbi) with a .550 OBP/.667 SLG/1.217 OPS, and is batting .400 (16-for-40, 6rbi) in his last 16 games while producing a .455 OBP/.525 SLG/.980 OPS.

#### It's Trevor Time

Trevor Megill is unscored upon in his last 9 games (9ip, 3h, 2bb, 14k) and has a 1.33 ERA over his last 27 outings (27ip, 14h, 5r, 4er, 5bb, 38k).

**IN THE TRAINER'S ROOM:** RHP Coleman Crow (right forearm), LHP Brian Fitzpatrick (left elbow), LHP DL Hall (left pectoral), RHP Logan Henderson (back), OF Brandon Lockridge (right knee), RHP Quinn Priester (right thoracic outlet), RHP Carlos Rodriguez (right shoulder), LHP Rob Zastryzny (left trapezius) and LHP Angel Zerpa (left forearm) are on the IL....Fitzpatrick, Priester and Zerpa are on the 60-day IL.

**MANAGER:** Pat Murphy (407g, 242-165, .595) is in his third season as Brewers manager....he was voted NL Manager of the Year in 2024 and 2025....he is one of four managers ever to win Manager of the Year in consecutive seasons, joining the Braves' Bobby Cox (2004-05), Rays' Kevin Cash (2020-21) and Guardians' Stephen Vogt (2024-25)....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell....he signed a multi-year contract extension on 2/20/26.

**COACHES:** Returning from the 2025 staff is offense & strategy coordinator Jason Lane (11th season/1st in current role), pitching coordinator Jim Henderson (5th season/1st in current role), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (4th season/3rd in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (8th season), bullpen coach Charlie Greene (3rd season), lead hitting coach Eric Theisen (2nd season/1st in current role) and third base coach Matt Erickson (3rd season/1st in current role)....assistant pitching coach Juan Sandoval, hitting coach Guillermo Martinez, hitting coach Daniel Vogelbach and first base coach Spencer Allen are all in their first seasons on the coaching staff.

**IN THE STANDINGS (97 days):** The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each spot in the NL Central standings: **FIRST:** 59, **SECOND:** 10, **THIRD:** 8, **FOURTH:** 13, **FIFTH:** 7....the Brewers are currently in first place, leading the second-place Cubs by 5.5 games....the team has held first place for the last 43 days.

#### AT HOME:

The Brewers are 28-17 at home, going 9-4-1 in series play....the team has a pair of season-high 5-game winning streaks coming from 4/30-5/12 and 5/25-6/2.

#### ON THE ROAD:

The Brewers are 24-14 on the road, going 8-4-1 in series play....the team is 16-6 in its last 22 road games, including a current 4-game winning streak....had a season-high 5-game winning streak from 5/31-6/8.

#### LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE:

The Brewers have made 23 replay challenges this season, going 16-7....their last challenge (lost) came on 6/19 at Atlanta as an out call at home plate involving Jackson Chourio was confirmed.

#### BREWING SUCCESS:

The Brewers have qualified for the postseason seven times in the last eight seasons and three seasons in a row....the team was just two games away from making the postseason in nine straight seasons (2017-25), missing out in both 2017 and 2022 by a single game....Milwaukee has won the NL Central in four of the last five seasons and three seasons in a row.

#### BREWING CONSISTENCY:

The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last eight full seasons (2017-25)....this does not include the shortened 2020 season....the Brewers have 815 wins since 2017, which ranks fourth in the majors behind the Dodgers (909), Astros (849) and Yankees (836).

**SUMMARY:** Have gone 242-221-1 all time, including 5-0 this season....went 8-5 last season and are 50-19 (.725) over the last 69 games with 6 consecutive wins.

**at MIL:** Are 120-107 all time, going 110-100 at American Family Field and 10-7 at County Stadium....are 2-0 this season....went 4-3 last season.

**at CIN:** Are 122-114-1 all time, going 102-94 at GABP and 20-20-1 at Cinergy Field....are 3-0 this season....went 4-2 last season and are 47-18 (.723) since the 2018 season.

**DROHAN AT A GLANCE:** Shane Drohan, 27, will make his 17th appearance and seventh start of the season.....Drohan last pitched last Wednesday at Cincinnati and had no decision in the Brewers' 6-5 win (4.1ip, 5h, Or, 3bb, 5k, 98 pitches).....he is 1-2 with a 4.28 ERA as a starter (27.1ip, 13er) and 2-0 with a 1.82 ERA as a reliever (24.2ip, 5er).....the team is 3-3 in his starts.....he has 1 quality start.....opponents are batting .237 (47-for-198, 4hr).....he made his Major League debut in a start on 4/8 at Boston and took a 5-0 loss (2.2ip, 3h, 3r, 3er, 4bb, 2k, 63 pitches).....he is also 1-1 with a 3.29 ERA in 3 games/ 2 starts this season at Triple-A Nashville (13.2ip, 14h, 6r, 5er, 7bb, 17k, 2hr).....Drohan was acquired from Boston with LHP Kyle Harrison and INF David Hamilton on February 9 for INF Caleb Durbin, INF Andruw Monasterio, INF/C Anthony Seigler and a 2026 Competitive Balance Round B selection.....name is pronounced "DROH-ehn."

**LAST SEASON:** Drohan went 5-1 with a 2.27 ERA in 12 games/11 starts at Triple-A Worcester.....he held International League opponents to a .185 AVG with 67 strikeouts in 47.2 innings while posting a 1.01 WHIP.....he was on Worcester's injured list from 5/13-8/25 with left forearm inflammation.

**MINOR LEAGUE CAREER:** Is 32-22 with a 4.25 ERA in 107 games/91 starts (425.1ip, 387h, 226r, 201er, 212bb, 489k, 51hr) while pitching in the Boston (2021-25), Chicago-AL (2024) and Milwaukee (2026) organizations.....he was originally selected by Philadelphia in the 23rd round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft but did not sign.....he was then selected by Boston in the fifth round of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft.....Drohan went from Boston to Chicago-AL in the 2023 Rule 5 Draft and returned to the Red Sox in June 2024.....he underwent left shoulder surgery 2/22/24, performed by Dr. Nikhil Verma, and missed most of the 2024 season.

**AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD:** Is 1-1 with a 3.00 ERA in 11 games/3 starts (33ip, 11er).....**ON THE ROAD:** Is 2-1 with a 3.32 ERA in 5 games/3 starts (19ip, 7er).

**vs. REDS:** His only appearance against Cincinnati came in his last outing.

**ODDS & ENDS:** Drohan graduated from Cardinal Newman (FL) High School, where he played three years of football (quarterback) in addition to baseball.....he went on to attend Florida State University.....his father, Bill, pitched in the Royals organization from 1987-90 at the Rookie and Class-A levels.....Drohan enjoys watching football and basketball and playing video games.....he is a fan of the Miami Dolphins and Miami Heat.
