NATIONALS NEWS

BELTWAY SERIES

The Washington Nationals square off against the Baltimore Orioles in the second game of this three-game series at Camden Yards on Saturday night...Washington fell to Baltimore, 3-1 last night...Following this series, the Nationals will head to Boston for a three-game series starting Monday.

- Washington is 30-26 (.536) since April 25 and are 9-3-1 in their last 13 series since May 12.
- Tonight's matchup continues Washington's stretch of 13 games in 13 days that began on Friday in Tampa Bay... Washington's next off day is July 2.

ROTATION NOTES

Washington's starting rotation (regardless of opener) has pitched to a 2.48 ERA (8 ER/29.0 IP) over the last six games...Specifically:

- **Miles Mikolas** (3.1 IP, 5 H, 2 R, 0 ER, SO), **Zack Littell** (4.0 IP, 5 H, 2 ER, 5 SO), **Foster Griffin** (7.1 IP, 4 H, ER, 9 SO), **Andrew Alvarez** (4.0 IP, 4 H, ER, 6 SO & 4.1 IP, 6 H, 2 ER, 5 SO) and **Cade Cavalli** (6.0 IP, 5 H, 2 ER, 7 SO) have combined to record 33 strikeouts and four walk over the last six games.

HOMER HAPPY

Since May 6, the Nationals lead Major League Baseball with 72 home runs ahead of the White Sox (70), Phillies (68) and Athletics (68)...Washington ranks second in slugging (.453) and third in OPS (.780) over this stretch.

- The Nationals have hit 109 home runs this season, the fourth-most in team history (2005-pres.) through 83 games behind the 2017 Nationals (124 HR), 2019 Nationals (116 HR) and 2016 Nationals (114 HR).

CORNER BATS

Since May 22, Washington's corner infielders **Luis Garcia Jr.** (10 HR, 27 RBI), **Curtis Mead** (9 HR, 21 RBI) and **Jorbit Vivas** (2 HR, 5 RBI) lead Major League Baseball with 21 home runs and 53 RBI...These stats reflect when they are in the game at one of the corner positions (not PH or DH).

- **Luis Garcia Jr.** and **Curtis Mead's** (one as DH) 10 homers rank tied for third in Major League Baseball and tied for fourth in the National League over this span.
- In addition, **Luis Garcia Jr.** leads the National League and ranks tied for third in Major League Baseball with 27 RBI since May 22.
- **Jorbit Vivas** homered on back-to-back games from June 23-24 for the first time in his career...In his last four games, he is hitting .300 (3-for-10) with two homers, four RBI, a walk and three runs scored.

NAS (H)IM

Nasim Nuñez is 16-for-36 (.444) with a double, two triples, seven RBI, five walks, six stolen bases and seven runs scored over his last 12 games...He has hit safely in 10 of the 12 games and has produced six multi-hit efforts.

- He has reached base safely in 16 of 18 games, hitting .379 (22-for-58) with a .438 on-base percentage (6 BB) and a .483 slugging percentage (2 2B, 2 3B).
- His career-long 15-game on-base streak and nine game hitting streak were the longest such streaks by a Nationals player this season.
- On the season, he leads Major League Baseball with 31 stolen bases and trails only **Trea Turner** (35 in 2017) for the most stolen bases prior to the All-Star break in Nationals history (2005-pres.).

CREWSIN'

Dylan Crews is slugging .500 with a .795 OPS with four doubles, three homers, 11 RBI, two stolen bases and 13 runs scored in his last 15 games...He's hit safely in 12 of the 15 games.

- The 11 RBI are tied for first on the Nationals with **Curtis Mead** since June 10.

ROLLIN' RUIZ

Keibert Ruiz is hitting .337 (35-for-104) with 10 doubles, five home runs, 21 RBI, two stolen bases and 18 runs scored in 30 games since May 7... He's hit safely in 23 of the 30 games.

- He leads Major League catchers (min. 100 PA) with a .941 OPS and a .337 batting average and is second with a .577 slugging percentage in 30 games since May 7.
- He entered play on May 7 hitting .182/.203/.303 and is now up to .276/.302/.471 on the season.

SAVES ON SAVES

The Washington Nationals have had nine separate pitchers record at least one save this season, tied for the second-most in Major League Baseball with the Miami Marlins and Cincinnati Reds and behind the Minnesota Twins (11) and the second-most in Nationals history (2005-pres.) behind the 2017 Nationals (11).

- **Clayton Beeter** (6), **Gus Varland** (6), **Richard Lovelady** (4), **PJ Poulin** (2), **Orlando Ribalta** (2), **Andrew Alvarez** (1), **Brad Lord** (1), **Mitchell Parker** (1) and **Paxton Schultz** (1) have all recorded saves this year.

HOUSE ON FIRE

Rochester third baseman **Brady House** went 3-for-5 with a double, an RBI and a runs scored last night...He has hit safely in his last six games going 11-for-28 (.393) with three doubles, six RBI, two walks and three runs scored...Since May 22, he ranks in Washington's system in batting average (1st, .316), hits (1st, 36), total bases (5th, 53), RBI (7th, 18), OPS (10th, 807) and SLG (10th, .465).

- Recorded his first career hold on April 25 at Chicago (AL).
