IT'S BAXTER'S BIRTHDAY!: Today features D-backs' mascot Baxter's birthday! Before the game, Baxter and mascots from around the Valley take on kids from Cactus Youth Baseball League in a special birthday wiffle ball game in the outfield...during the game, they will celebrate in the Sandlot, with coloring stations and activations by the Phoenix Zoo and Southern AZ Reptile Rescue.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 10-1 last night vs. Cardinals and have won 3 straight games for the first time since June 19-21.

- Sixth time scoring 3+ runs in the first inning...was the fifth game all-time vs. Cardinals where the D-backs scored 3+ first-inning runs (last: May 22, 2016).
- 9 runs scored in the first 4.0 innings were their second most in a game this season (behind 10 on May 17 vs. Rockies).
- Ryne Nelson** earned his sixth win after tossing his third quality start in his last 4 starts, allowing 1 run over 6.0 innings on 4 hits and 1 walk with 4 strikeouts.
- Corbin Carroll** had his third multi-triple game (also: April 27 vs. Braves and June 10 vs. Mariners).
- Eugenio Suárez** had his fifth multi-homer game and second in his last 4 games (also: July 12 @ Angels).
- Geraldo Perdomo** had his third career game (second in 2025) with 3+ hits and 3+ RBI and has consecutive games of 2+ hits with 2+ RBI.
- Blaze Alexander** has hit safely in 4 straight games, including 2 multi-hit efforts, and has recorded a RBI in 3 straight games.

FRANCHISE FEAT: Last night was the first game in franchise history where a D-backs player hit 2+ home runs and another D-backs player hit 2+ triples [source: Elias Sports Bureau].

GENO IS A MON-STAR: Since June 1, **Eugenio Suárez's** 18 homers are the most in the Majors, ahead of Cal Raleigh/SEA (16), Juan Soto/NYM (15), Aaron Judge/NYY (14) and Jo Adell/LAA (14).

- His 5 multi-homer games are tied for second in the Majors with Aaron Judge/NYY, Pete Crow-Armstrong/CHC and Kyle Stowers/MIA, behind Cal Raleigh/SEA (8).
- Suárez (33 HR) is 1 of 2 D-backs all-time to hit 30+ homers within the team's first 100 games of a season (also: Luis Gonzalez, 40 in 2001).
- Since the 2024 All-Star break, Suárez's 53 homers are tied for third in the Majors, behind Aaron Judge/NYY (59) and Shohei Ohtani/LAD (58).

CORBIN BARRELS: Per @OptaSTATS, **Corbin Carroll** is the only player in MLB history to have a season with 4+ multi-homer games and a season with 3+ multi-triple games.

- Carroll is the first MLB player to have 3+ multi-triple games in a season since Jose Reyes/NYM in 2011 (3).

STARTING PITCHING TREND: Since July 7 (9 G), D-backs' starting pitchers combined 3.29 ERA (19 ER in 52.0 IP) is fourth lowest in the NL, behind the Brewers (2.09), Cubs (2.22) and Phillies (3.28).

VS. OPPOSING STARTERS: Opposing starting pitchers have lasted fewer than 6.0 innings vs. D-backs in 6 straight games, tied for the second longest active MLB streak with the Braves and Guardians, behind the Angels (7).

- In those 6 games vs. starters, the D-backs are hitting .355 (44-for-124)/.1023 OPS with 11 doubles, 3 triples, 5 homers and 12 walks.
- Since July 1, the D-backs' offense vs. starting pitchers ranks among the NL in runs (1st, 48), times on base (1st, 119), walks (1st, 38), pitches seen (1st, 1,311), doubles (T-1st, 19 with Braves), triples (T-1st, with Rockies), OBP (2nd, .342), homers (T-2nd, 13), SLG (3rd, .467) and OPS (3rd, .809).

SLUGGING LEADOFF: Among MLB players in the leadoff spot [min. 150 PA], **Corbin Carroll** ranks in triples (1st, 9), SLG (2nd, .608, behind Byron Buxton-MIN/.636), homers (2nd, 20, behind Shohei Ohtani-LAD/33) and OPS (5th, .938).

- Since 2023, Carroll has 8 leadoff triples...dating back to 2017, no player has more than 6 leadoff triples:

NEW HOMER HIGH: The D-backs' 143 homers within their first 100 games of a season are a franchise high, ahead of 2019 (142 HR).

50-50 SHOT: With a victory, the D-backs will reach the 100-game mark with a 50-50 record for the fourth time in franchise history (also: 2019, 2012, 2008).

RECENT 'PEN: D-backs relievers, in their last 12 games since July 4, are fourth in the NL with a 2.43 ERA (10 ER in 37.0 IP) and are scoreless in 8 of the 12 games.

- The D-backs bullpen's 2.93 ERA is currently their lowest of any month, ahead of April (4.26), June (4.99) and May (5.87)...their last month finishing with a sub-3.00 ERA was Sept. 2023 (2.16).
