TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS: The Reds today placed **OF Jake Fraley** (right shoulder sprain) on a rehabilitation assignment at AAA-Louisville; transferred the rehabilitation assignment of **RHP Carson Spiers** (right shoulder impingement) from R-ACL Reds to Louisville.

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- Is Game 2 (0-1) of a 4-game series vs Adam Nichols' Marlins and the second game (0-1) of a 7-game homestand before the All-Star break that includes a weekend series vs the Rockies.
- Following Sun's "first-half" finale vs Col, the Reds will enjoy 4-day break before lifting the lid on the season's "second half" at NYM (7/18-7/20) and Wsh (7/21-7/23).
- The Reds are coming off a 2-4 road trip at Bos (1-2) and Phi (1-2).

ELLY DE LA ALL-STAR: On Sun, **SS Elly De La Cruz** was named to the National League All-Star team for the second consecutive season.

- He's the first Reds player to be selected as an All-Star in back-to-back years since Joey Votto (2017-18).
- Is the <u>sixth</u> primary shortstop in Reds history to make consecutive All-Star teams, joining **Barry Larkin** (1988-91, '93-'97, '99-2000), **David Concepcion** (1975-82), **Leo Cardenas** (1964-66), **Roy McMillan** (1955-57), and **Eddie Miller** (1943-44, '46-'47).
- Is the seventh Red to earn multiple All-Star selections within his first 3 career seasons, the first since Chris Sabo (1988, '90).
- Joins Johnny Bench (4, 1968-71), Frank Robinson (3, 1956-59), and Vada Pinson (2, 1959-60) as the only Reds players named to multiple All-Star teams before turning 24.

FRANCONA CLOSING IN ON 2000 WINS: Terry Francona enters tonight's game 4 wins away from reaching 2,000 as a Major League manager.

- He'd become the 13th manager to reach the 2,000-win milestone.
- Would be the second active manager in the majors with 2,000 wins (Tex' Bruce Bochy 2,215).
- Each big league skipper with 2,000 career wins, except for Bochy and Dusty Baker, are in the Hall of Fame.
- Baker (2,183) and Sparky Anderson (2,194 wins) are the only 2,000win skippers to manage the Reds.
- Leo Durocher is the only 2,000-win manager to play for Cin (1930-33).
- Would be the fourth manager to earn his 2,000th win for a team he once played for (1987), joining Bochy (SF), Bucky Harris (Det), and John McGraw (NYG).

SERIES NOTES: The Reds are 135-105 all-time vs the **Marlins**, including 42-28 here at **Great American Ball Park**.

- Cin went 1-2 at Mia from 4/21-4/23 when the roof was open for all 3 games at loanDepot park...it marked the Reds' first series loss to the Marlins since 8/7-8/9, 2023 at GABP (1-2).
- The Reds have gone 24-14 over the last 7 seasons (6-1 in 2019, 0-0 in 2020, 5-2 in 2021, 4-3 in 2022, 3-3 in 2023, 5-2 in 2024, 1-3 in 2025) following 4 straight season series losses to the Marlins.

HARD TO SWALLOW: The Reds have lost 18 games this season in which they held a lead, including each of their last 3 games.

- Have scored fewer than 2 runs in 22 games this season, including each of their last 3 games.
- Have been held to 1 hit in a game 3 times this season, including Sun at Phi (Zack Wheeler, 1-hit CG).
- Are 2-36 this year when trailing after 7 innings.
- Are 1-39 when trailing after 8 innings, their lone victory in that scenario coming on 6/29 vs SD (trailed 2-1 entering the 9th inning, won 3-2).


RUNS, RUNS: The Reds have scored 416 runs this season, 10th-most in the majors, but have plated just 122 of them with 2 outs (fourth-fewest).

LATE & CLOSE

Late and Close refers to game situations in the 7th inning or later with the batting team tied, ahead by 1, or the tying run on base, at bat or on deck... here's how Reds batters rank in those situations in 2025:

HOME BOY: Spencer Steer has an active 9-game hitting streak at GABP (17-for-33, .515/.514/.970, 4hr, 10rbi, 32tb, 18 times on base).

NO ROOM FOR THE BROOM: The Reds have not been swept in any of their first 29 series this season, including the recently-completed 3-game set at **Phi** (1-2).

- Marks their longest streak of consecutive series without being swept to open a season since 1989, when they went 30 straight series before getting broomed in a 3-game set from 7/17-7/19 vs Phi.
- The Reds are the only Major League team that have yet to be swept this season.

ELLECTRICITY: Over his last 42 games dating back to 5/19, **SS Elly De La Cruz** is slashing .311/.383/.573 (51-for-164, 10hr, 21xbh, 38r, 19bb, 29rbi).

- His 60 RBI in 2025 are most by a primary Reds shortstop (>50% of G at the position) before the All-Star break in club history (the first ASG was in 1933), surpassing the previous mark of 52 set by **Barry Larkin** 1999...are also the most ever by a Cin switch hitter prior to the ASB.
- Is batting .294/.375/.528 this season <u>vs RHP</u> (69-for-235, 13hr, 44rbi).
- Against left-handed pitchers in June, slashed .338/.442/.646 (3hr).
- Is 2 HR shy of joining Eric Davis (23hr/33sb, 1987) as the only players in Reds history with at least 20 HR and 20 SB before the All-Star break.
- Swiped his 20th base of 2025 in the 4th inning of the 1-0 win on 6/10 at Cle, making him the first player in Reds history with 20 or more steals in each of his first 3 seasons in the majors (courtesy Elias).

WREAKING HAVOC IN THE FIRST: The Reds have scored at least 1 run in the 1st inning 27 times this season, but haven't plated a run in the opening frame since 6/28 vs **SD**, a span of 8 straight games without a 1st inning run.

THE FUTURE IS HERE: C Alfredo Duno and INF Sal Stewart will represent the Reds organization in the 26th edition of the All-Star Futures Game on 7/12 at Truist Park in Atlanta, GA.

NO HOMERS AT HOME: The Reds haven't homered in any of their last 3 games at **Great American Ball Park**.

- Is their longest homerless streak at home this season.
- Is their longest homerless streak at **GABP** since going 4 straight homerless home games last season (4/25-5/5, 2024).
- Didn't homer in a club record 8 straight games at GABP from 8/21-9/5, 2016

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the 8-4 win on 7/2 at Bos (6.2ip, 9h, 4r/4er, 0bb, 2k, 89TP).

- Held Bos to 1 run through the first 5 innings before allowing a 2-out, 2-run HR to Wilyer Abreu in the 6th inning.
- Prior to Abreu's HR, had allowed just 2 runs over his previous 16.2 innings dating back to 6/21 at StL.
- Pitched at least 6.0 innings in consecutive starts for the first time since doing so in 6 straight outings from 4/28-5/26.
- Pitched into the 7th inning for the fifth time this season.

JUNE 27 (NO-HIT BID): Earned the 8-1 win on 6/27 vs SD... carried a no-hitter into the 9th inning before allowing a double to the inning's second batter, Elías Díaz (8.0+ip, 1h, 1r/1er, 2bb. 6k, 112TP).

- The 8-inning no-hit bid marked the longest of his career.
- Was the longest no-hit bid by a Reds pitcher since LHP Wade Miley's no-hitter on 5/7/21 at Cle and the longest by a Reds pitcher at Great American Ball Park since RHP Homer Bailey's no-hitter on 7/2/13 vs SF.
- Pitched into the 9th inning for the first time in his career, as a starter.
- Matched his career-high with 8.0 inning pitched (also: 9/27/24 at Chc).
- Was the sixth time he allowed exactly 1 hit in a start (last: 8/10/24 at Mil).
- Matched his career-high with 112 pitches (also: 5/28/15 for Tex vs Bos).
- After walking Jackson Merrill in the 1st inning, retired the next 22 consecutive batters until he walked Trenton Brooks in the 9th inning.
- Marked the first time in the expansion era (since 1961) that any Major League team had a pitcher throw 8 or more no-hit innings in the same game in which a teammate (Spencer Steer) hit 3 or more home runs (Elias).

JUNE 23 (RELIEF): In Mon's 6-1 win vs NYY made his second consecutive relief app (1.0ip, 1k, 12TP)...was his 139th career app out of the bullpen.

 Replaced reliever Scott Barlow in the top of the 7th...retired DJ LeMahieu (flyout), Jasson Domínguez (groundout), and Paul Goldschmidt (strikeout swinging) in order.

JUNE 21 (RELIEF): In Sat's 11-inning 6-5 loss at StL made his first relief app of the season, his first since 8/2/24 vs SF.

 Relieved starter Brent Suter in the 3rd inning and retired all 6 batters he faced (18TP).

LIMITING FREE PASSES: Has issued 33 walks through his first 33 starts as a member of the Reds, second-fewest by a Cin pitcher in that span since the mound moved to its current distance in 1893, per *Elias*, fewer than only Slim Sallee (25bb, 1919-20).

LIMITING HARD CONTACT: Among all pitchers with at least 90 innings, his hard-hit percentage of .364 ranks among the best in the majors...hard-hit percentage measures the percentage of pitches <u>put in play</u> at an exit velocity over 95 mph...league avg is .412.

1-2-3 BATTERS: Is holding batters at the top of the order (1, 2, 3) to a .208/.260/.396 slash line with just 8 walks (145 BF)...his 1-2-3 batters have reached safely just 40 times.

QUALIFIED: On November 19, 2024, Martinez accepted the club's qualifying offer to return for the 2025 season after opting out of his original 2-year contract he signed in 2023.
