RAY REPORT—The Rays complete a seven-game, two-team homestand against the Giants (2-1) and Angels (1-2, 1 to play) this afternoon at Tropicana Field...they are 3-3 so far in a stretch of 13 consecutive games without an off day that concludes on April 24 vs. Detroit.

- ✦ Prior to last night's 5-4 defeat, the Rays were 3-0 in one-run games to open the 2024 campaign.
- ✦ Tampa Bay suffered its first loss in a game decided by two runs or fewer since Sept. 17, 2023 at Baltimore (5-4), snapping a club-record-tying streak of 10 consecutive wins in such games.
- ✦ Over the last three games, the Rays are batting .167 (5-for-30) with runners in scoring position...this comes on the heels of an 11-game stretch in which they hit .337 (28-for-83) with RISP from April 2-14.

WHAT'S AT STAKE—With a win today, the Rays would:

- ✦ Claim a 4-3 season series victory over the Angels and secure their eighth consecutive season series win over Los Angeles...after dropping the season series in 2014 (2-5) and tying in 2015 (3-3), the Rays have won each of the last seven season series (did not play in 2020), going 36-18 (.667) against Los Angeles during that timeframe.
- ✦ Avoid their first home series defeat against the Angels since dropping three of four contests from July 4-7, 2017.
- ✦ Salvage a series tie and remain undefeated in their last four series (3-0-0 in prev. 3).

RECENT TRANSACTIONS—Prior to today's game, Tampa Bay optioned RHP Kevin Kelly to Triple-A Durham and recalled LHP Jacob Lopez from Durham.

- ✦ In his first two starts this season for the Bulls, Lopez went 2-0 with a 2.70 ERA (10.0IP, 3ER) and nine strikeouts against one walk...in his last outing on April 12 at Lehigh Valley, he worked 0.2 innings, conceding six runs on five hits with one walk and zero strikeouts.

ALL ABOUT AMED—Amed Rosario has hit safely in each of his last nine games since April 5, batting .400 (16-for-40) with 2 2B, 2 HR and 8 RBI during the run...it marks his longest hitting streak since an 11-game stretch from July 11-24, 2022.

- ✦ The nine-game run is tied with Isaac Paredes for the longest by a Ray this season...Paredes hit safely in nine straight from March 30-April 9...it is also tied with BAL Cedric Mullins for the longest active streak in the AL.
- ✦ He is batting an MLB-best .545 (12-for-22) with two outs...Isaac Paredes is tied for second in the majors with a .500 (9-for-18) two-out average.

HITTING HAROLD—Following a 1-for-17 (.059) start through four games, Harold Ramirez has hit safely in 11 of his last 13 games...during that stretch, he is batting .315 (17-for-54) with 1 2B, 1 HR, 8 RBI and 10 R.

- ✦ In his last 16 games against the Angels since May 11, 2022, Ramirez is batting .300 (18-for-60) with 3 2B, 1 HR and 18 RBI.
- ✦ Ramirez has an 11.1 pct. strikeout rate (8SO/72PA) through 17 games, ranking in the top 94th percentile of all MLB hitters.

THAT'S MORE LIKE IT—Yandy Diaz went 2-for-5 with one double and one run scored last night, tallying his first multi-hit effort since April 5 at Colorado (2-for-5, 2B, RBI, BB, 2R)...his 10 straight games with one hit or fewer was his longest since a 12-game run from July 29-Aug 14, 2022.

- ✦ Despite batting .193 (11-for-57) over his last 14 games since April 2, he has struck out one time for fewer in each of those contests.
- ✦ His 14.0 pct. whiff rate this year ranks in the 93rd percentile of all MLB hitters.

HOMER (UN)HAPPY—Tampa Bay has allowed 29 home runs this season, tied with Toronto for the most in the majors...the 29 HR allowed are the most through 19 games in franchise history, ahead of the 2000, 2001, 2003 and 2007 Devil Rays...the club record for most homers allowed through 20 games is held by the 2000 Devil Rays (30HR).

SMALL BALL—The Rays have tallied an AL-best 19 infield hits, four most in the majors behind the Brewers (26), Pirates (25) and Phillies (22).

- ✦ Harold Ramirez's five infield hits pace all AL batters and are tied for third most in the majors behind PHI Trea Turner (7) and MIA Tim Anderson (6).
- ✦ Amed Rosario has four infield hits this season...his 85 infield hits since 2020 are second most in the majors behind Turner's 96.
- ✦ Tampa Bay's 144 infield hits last season were second most in the AL behind Cleveland (153) and fifth most in MLB behind Miami (172), Washington (151) and Chicago-NL (147).

UNDER THE MICROSCOPE—Tampa Bay relievers have posted an MLB-worst 6.23 ERA (78.0IP, 54ER), ahead of only Miami's 5.63 ERA (76.2IP, 48ER).

- ✦ The Tampa Bay bullpen has issued an MLB-high 50 walks ahead, of Chicago-NL (45BB), while their 14 HR allowed are second most in the majors behind Toronto (15HR).

IN A FUNK—In his last 14 games since April 1, Randy Arozarena is batting .127 (7-for-55) with 1 2B, 3 RBI and 5 BB against 15 SO...his .127 AVG during that stretch is the second lowest in the majors (min. 50AB) behind CIN Jonathan India (.118).

- ✦ He has not homered in 14 straight contests since going deep in back-to-back games from March 30-31 vs. Toronto...the 14-game homerless drought is his longest since a 15-game stretch from Aug. 2-19 (G1), 2023.
- ✦ He has gone 24 straight games without a multi-RBI game, his longest drought since a career-long streak of 42 games from Sept. 25, 2021-May 16, 2022.

COAST TO COAST—The Rays and Angels complete a seven-game season series today at Tropicana Field, as all seven matchups between the clubs have come over an 11-day period...the Rays took two of three games from the Angels in Los Angeles from April 8-10.

DOWN ON THE FARM—Biscuits SS Carson Williams went 3-for-5 with 1 2B and 1 RBI in Double-A Montgomery's 4-2 loss at Tennessee last night...his current seven-game hitting streak is the second longest in the Southern League...the 20-year-old is batting .483 (14-for-29) with 4 2B, 1 HR, 4 RBI, 9 R and 4 SB.

- ✦ Williams, rated the No. 19 overall prospect in the minors by MLB.com, sits fourth in all of MiLB with a .432 AVG while ranking among Southern League leaders in hits (1st, 16), XBH (1st, 7), total bases (1st, 25), runs (T1st, 11), OBP (2nd, .488), OPS (2nd, 1.164) and SLG (3rd, .676).

CONNECTIONS

- ✦ LHP Reid Detmers threw the 12th no-hitter in Angels history on May 10, 2022 vs. Tampa Bay.
- ✦ Last season, a three-game set between the Rays and Angels in Anaheim was impacted by Hurricane Hilary, resulting in the series concluding with a day-night doubleheader on Saturday, Aug. 19.
- ✦ After serving as Tampa Bay's manager from 2006-14, Joe Maddon was at the helm for Los Angeles (2020-22) following five seasons managing Chicago-NL (2015-19).
- ✦ Guy Gallagher, the Angels Director, Equipment and Clubhouse Operations, joined Los Angeles after spending the previous 23 seasons as the Rays Visiting Clubhouse Manager. He originally joined the Tampa Bay organization in 1996 as a minor league equipment and clubhouse manager.
- ✦ Angels LHP Matt Moore made 96 appearances (94GS) for the Rays between 2011-2016, going 39-28 with a 3.88 ERA (540.0IP, 233ER) and 494 strikeouts.

TODAY'S START—Pepiot will make his fourth start of the year and third at Tropicana Field in the finale of the Rays seven-game homestand...marks his third daytime start—he is 1-1 with a 3.27 ERA (11.0IP, 4ER) in his two previous daytime outings...his 30.8 pct. strikeout rate ranks sixth among AL starters...his enters today's contest 5.0 frames shy of reaching 100.0 IP for his career.

LAST TIME OUT—Took the loss in the Rays 11-2 defeat to the Giants on April 13 at Tropicana Field after allowing a pair of two-out homers (L, 5.0IP, 5H, 4ER, BB, 6SO, 2HR)...tagged for an RBI-double in the opening frame, but did not permit another hit until **Thairo Estrada's** solo home run in the 4th...had a chance to escape the 5th frame unscathed, but **LaMonte Wade Jr.** took him deep before he retired **Jorge Soler** to conclude the outing.

FIRST TIME—Pepiot will make his first start opposite the Angels this afternoon...he has yet to face any member of the Angels active 26-man roster in his MLB career...it will mark his second outing against an AL West opponent, joining his Rays debut on April 1 vs. Texas (5.2IP, 4H, 6ER, 4BB, 3SO, HR).

HUNG OUT TO DRY—The Rays have lost two of Pepiot's three starts while being outscored, 22-8 (-14)...they have provided him with only 2.16 runs of support per 9.0 IP, the lowest mark among Rays starters and 12th lowest among AL pitchers (min. 15.0IP)...in his career as a starter, Pepiot is 5-0 with a 2.34 ERA (42.1IP, 11ER) when receiving just two or more runs of support (8GS) and 0-3 with a 6.46 ERA (23.2IP, 17ER) with one or zero runs.

HEAT CHECK—Pepiot's four-seam fastball has been his most effective pitch...opponents are 3-for-32 (.094) against the pitch with 14 SO...conversely, opposing hitters have gone 9-for-27 (.333) in AB's ending with his slider or changeup...his 43.5 pct. whiff rate on the four-seamer is the highest mark on any MLB pitcher's fastball this season (min. 50 pitches swung at), ahead of CWS **Deivi Garcia's** four-seamer (43.1%).

MEET ME IN THE MIDDLE—He has been at his best in the middle frames of his outings, holding opponents to one run and a .107 (3-for-28) average in innings 2-4 while posting a 10.57 ERA (7.2IP, 9ER) and .281 (9-for-32) opp. average in all other frames...opposing hitters are 3-for-26 (.115) against him the second time through the lineup compared to a combined 9-for-34 (.265) the first and third times.

(DON'T) WALK THE WALK—Limiting walks has been key to Pepiot's success early in his career...when he issues one or zero walks (12G/6GS), he is 5-2 with a 2.21 ERA (61.0IP, 15ER)...in outings with multiple walks (8G/7GS), he is 1-1 with a 5.03 ERA (34.0IP, 19ER)...since his 6th-inning walk of **TEX Evan Carter** on April 1, he has issued only one free pass to his last 45 batters faced (2.2%), drawn by **SF LaMonte Wade Jr.** on April 13.

KING OF COORS—Pepiot struck out a career-high 11 batters without issuing a walk on April 7 at Colorado...he became the fifth pitcher (8th instance) in franchise history to strikeout out 11+ batters on the road without issuing a walk (last: **Blake Snell** on April 8, 2019 at CWS).

✦ He became the first visiting pitcher, and third overall, (**Jon Gray** & **Germán Márquez**) to throw 6.0+ innings, walk zero batters and record 10+ strikeouts at Coors Field.

2023 RECAP—Pitched to a 2-1 mark with a 2.14 ERA (42.0IP, 10ER) in eight appearances (3GS) with the Dodgers...after being named the organization's No. 5 prospect by *Baseball America* during the offseason, opened the year on the 15-day IL with a left oblique strain and was transferred to the 60-day IL on April...pitched behind an opener in his season debut on Aug. 19 vs. Miami (5.0IP, 3H, ER, BB, 5SO)...his 0.76 WHIP from the time of his debut through the end of the season led the NL (min. 40.0IP) while his 2.14 ERA ranked third behind SD **Blake Snell** (1.02) and NYM **Kodai Senga** (2.06). posted a 3.1 pct. walk rate compared to 16.9 pct. in 2022.

✦ Went 2-1 with a 2.00 ERA (18.0IP, 4ER) in his three starts...pitched behind an opener three times, producing a 1.59 ERA (17.0IP, 3ER)...all three of those games were started by **Caleb Ferguson**.
