RAY REPORT—The Rays commence the final series of a nine-game, 10-day homestand against the Mets (3-0), White Sox (2-1) and Yankees (3 to play) tonight at Tropicana Field... despite a 4-1 loss in Wednesday evening's series finale against the White Sox, the Rays have still won five of their last six games after a 2-8 stretch from April 21-May 5 dropped them to a season-high four games below .500...the Rays, who are 6.0 games back in the AL East standings, are at the .500 mark for the seventh time this season.

★ The Rays have won back-to-back series over the Mets and White Sox on the heels of an 0-4-1 stretch in series play...they are seeking a third consecutive series victory for the second time this season, joining April 5-14 (at COL, at LAA, vs. SF).

★ The Rays are also seeking their fourth consecutive series-opening win after beginning the season 1-8 in series openers.

★ According to Elias, the Rays have had the second-easiest strength of schedule in the majors to this point, with a combined opponent winning pct. of .434...only the Phillies (.426) have had an easier slate...at .538, the Rays have the hardest remaining schedule by opponent winning pct., ahead of the Marlins (.524).

★ Beginning with tonight's contest, Tampa Bay will play 13 consecutive games against AL East opponents (vs. NYY, at BOS, at TOR, vs. BOS) ahead of a May 23 off day...only seven of the club's first 38 games came against division rivals.

★ After debuting their City Connect jerseys on May 3 vs. NYM, the Rays rattled off five consecutive victories while wearing the threads...tonight, they will don their throwback Devil Rays uniforms, which they are 2-0 in this season and 13-3 in overall since their 2023 debut.

★ **RHP Taj Bradley** will make his season debut tonight after being reinstated from the 15-day IL (right pectoral strain) on Wednesday...the right-hander recorded the highest strikeout rate by a rookie in franchise history last season at 28.4 pct. (min. 300BF).

HEATING UP—Since beginning the current homestand on May 3, the Rays offense has improved in several key categories...the date coincides with the additions of **OF Jonny DeLuca** (reinstated from 10-day IL) and **C Alex Jackson** (selected from Triple-A Durham) as well as the debut of the club's City Connect jerseys:

RELIEF RENAISSANCE—Over six games on the current homestand, the Rays bullpen has produced a 1.35 ERA (26.2IP, 4ER), holding opponents scoreless in 17.2 of 21.2 IP... since April 16, the group leads the AL in opp. average (.192) while ranking highly in opp. SLG (3rd, .311), opp. OBP (4th, .289), WHIP (4th, 1.11), opp. OPS (4th, .600) and ERA (5th, 3.06)...they entered that stretch with a majors-worst 6.92 ERA (67.2IP, 52ER).

★ Rays relievers have allowed only 20.8 pct. of their inherited runners to score, the sixth-lowest mark in the majors...**RHP Phil Maton** (0-for-6) and **LHP Garrett Cleavinger** (0-for-3) have stranded all of their inherited runners.

★ Cleavinger has not allowed a hit in his last seven outings, the longest streak by a Rays reliever since **Kevin Kelly** (7G) from June 21-July 15 (G2)...he has faced 24 batters since last permitting a hit (LAA **Zach Neto** 1B, April 16)...the southpaw has not allowed an earned run in his last 11 appearances dating back to April 6, yielding only three hits in that span (3-for-30/100).

★ Maton has pitched to a 1.17 ERA (7.2IP, 1ER) since being tagged for a career-high-tying five runs on April 15 vs. LAA, turning in an 0.52 WHIP in that timeframe.

★ **RHP Jason Adam** owns a 0.71 ERA (12.2IP, 1ER) in his last 12 appearances...**RHP Shawn Armstrong** has recorded a 0.96 ERA (9.1IP, 1ER) in his previous eight games.

ON THE OFFENSIVE—Despite being held to one run on Wednesday vs. CWS, the Rays offense is averaging 5.7 runs per contest over their last six games...this comes on the heels of plating six total runs over their previous four games (1.5 R/G)...on the season, the Rays rank among AL leaders in stolen bases (1st, 45), infield hits (2nd, 50), singles (3rd, 224), sacrifice hits (3rd, 5) and batting average (5th, .244)...however, their 86 extra-base hits are tied with the Mariners for the fewest in the AL and their 31 HR rank 13th, ahead of only the Blue Jays (30) and White Sox (26)...it marks their fewest homers through the first 38 games of a season since 2014 (31).

★ **Isaac Paredes** owns a 19-game home on-base streak dating back to March 30...he is slashing .333/.457/.621 (22-for-66) with 4 2B, 5 HR and 11 RBI during the run, drawing more walks (12) than total strikeouts (9).

★ On the season, Paredes has recorded 25.8 pct. (8/31) of the Rays total home runs...only **ATL Marcell Ozuna** (33.3%) and **DET Riley Greene** (28.1%) have been responsible for a larger portion of their team's homers.

GONE FISHING—Rays hitters own the AL's highest chase rate, swinging at 30.9 pct. of pitches outside of the strike zone...it trails only the Marlins (33.9%) and Rockies (32.2%) in all of MLB...however, the club also owns the most hits and highest batting average (80-for-411/.195) on pitches out of the zone, well above the major league average of .157.

IT JUST FEELS RIGHT—Rays right fielders are slashing a combined .343/.405/.469, leading the majors in average while ranking second in on-base pct. behind Yankees right fielders (.444) and sixth in OPS (.874)...five different Rays have started in right field, tied with second base and designated hitter for the club's most at any position.

★ **Richie Palacios** is batting .365 (19-for-52) when playing right field compared to .143 (4-for-28) at all other positions...**Amed Rosario** has hit .344 (22-for-64) in right and .241 (14-for-58) elsewhere.

YANKEE DOODLE—The Rays and Yankees continue a 13-game season series tonight at Tropicana Field, beginning the second of four individual series in 2024...it marks the first of two series between the teams in St. Pete—New York will return to Tampa Bay from July 9-11 as the clubs wrap up the season series with seven games in a span of 13 days from July 9-22...the Rays dropped two of three games at Yankee Stadium from April 19-21 despite the pitching staff posting a 1.73 ERA (26.0IP, 5ER) in the series...the Rays are 9-7 against the Yankees since the beginning of last season, going 4-2 at home.

★ The Rays have won three of the last four season series since 2020, posting the best record vs. New York by any AL team over that span (36-28/.563)...they went 38-57 (.400) from 2015-19.

★ Limiting big innings has been crucial for Rays pitchers in recent meetings with the Yankees...in four of their last five losses to New York dating back to May 12, 2023, the Rays have allowed 4+ runs in at least one frame.

★ **Yandy Diaz** has reached base safely in 24 of his last 25 games against the Yankees, batting .302 (29-for-96) with an .870 OPS...**Isaac Paredes** is hitting .340 (16-for-47) with 3 2B, 1 HR and 7 RBI in his last 14 games vs. New York.

★ The Yankees have hosted Spring Training in Tampa Bay since 1996...their spring ballpark, Tampa's George M. Steinbrenner Field, is also home to their Class-A affiliate, the Tampa Tarpons...previously, New York had three stints hosting Spring Training in St. Petersburg: 1925-42, 1946-50 and 1952-61.

★ Manager **Kevin Cash** received a World Series ring from the Yankees in 2009 after appearing in 10 games in May while **Jorge Posada** was on the injured list.

★ Hitting coach **Chad Mottola** was selected fifth overall by the Reds in the 1992 First-Year Player Draft, one spot before the Yankees drafted **Derek Jeter**.

★ **OF Richie Palacios** is a Brooklyn native who grew up rooting for the Yankees.

★ **C Ben Rortvedt** appeared in 32 games for the Yankees last season and spent Spring Training with them before being traded to the Rays on March 27.

★ **RHP Zack Littell** began the 2017 season in the Yankees minor league system before being dealt to the Twins at the trade deadline.

★ Bally Sports Sun announcer **Dewayne Staats** was the Yankees lead play-by-play announcer from 1990-94.

★ Triple-A Durham manager **Morgan Ensberg** concluded his MLB career with the Yankees in 2008.

★ Yankees **RHP Luke Weaver** pitched at Florida State University from 2012-14...he resides in Tallahassee during the offseason.

★ Yankees **LHP Caleb Ferguson** served as an opener for **RHP Ryan Pepiot** three times last season while both pitchers were with the Dodgers.

TONIGHT'S START—Bradley is set to make his season debut tonight vs. the Yankees...he was sidelined after suffering a right pectoral strain while warming up in the bullpen prior to his scheduled Spring Training start on March 12 at Baltimore...in his lone Grapefruit League start on March 6 at New York-AL, he threw 3.0 scoreless innings, conceding two hits with no walks and one strikeout.

ON THE MEND—In two rehab starts for Triple-A Durham, he went 1-0 with a 0.82 ERA (11.0IP, 1ER) and 15 strikeouts against three walks.

- On April 28 vs. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, tossed 5.0 scoreless innings, allowing no hits and one walk while fanning seven.
- On May 3 at Gwinnett, threw 6.0 innings of one-run ball, scattering two hits and two walks with eight strikeouts.

NEW YORK, NEW YORK—Bradley will be making his first career start against the Yankees...made eight appearances (6GS) against the AL East last season, going 3-2 with a 5.56 ERA (34.0IP, 21ER) and 40 strikeouts against seven walks.

LEARNING CURVE—He went 5-3 with a 3.86 ERA (49.0IP, 21ER) in his first 10 MLB starts, allowing 5 HR while limiting opponents to a .235 AVG (44-for-187)...in his final 13 appearances (11GS), he went 0-5 with a 7.11 ERA (55.2IP, 44ER) while opponents hit .271 (62-for-229) with 18 HR.

STRIKEOUT SAVANT—Bradley recorded 128 strikeouts in 21 starts last season, the most in Rays history through a rookie pitcher's first 21 career starts...he posted a 28.4 pct. strikeout rate, the highest mark by a rookie in Rays history (min. 300BF), surpassing **Shane McClellan's** 27.3 pct. strikeout rate in 2021.

- In his June 15 start at Oakland, he recorded each of his first nine outs via the strikeout, becoming the first MLB rookie to accomplish the feat since **ATL Spencer Strider** on July 7, 2022 vs. STL...his 11 SO on the day were tied with six other pitchers for the second most by a Rays rookie, trailing only **Dan Wheeler** (12SO) on Sept. 12, 1999 vs. OAK.

OLD SOUL—Bradley was the youngest pitcher in the majors last season to make 20+ starts...he became the third pitcher (4th instance) in Rays history to make 20+ starts in an age 22 or younger season, joining **Scott Kazmir** (32GS, 2005; 24GS, 2006) and **Joe Kennedy** (20GS, 2001).

BIT BY THE LONG BALL—From his April 12 debut through June 15, his 0.84 HR/9.0 IP was 12th lowest in the AL (min. 40.0IP)...from that point on, his 2.77 HR/9.0 IP was second highest in the majors (min. 50.0IP) behind **MIIN Joe Ryan** (2.79).

- Of the 23 long balls Bradley conceded, 18 were solo shots...he allowed six homers on the first pitch of an at-bat, his most in any count.
- He allowed 1+ HR in seven straight starts from June 21-July 29, the longest streak by a Rays pitcher since **Jake Odorizzi** (15GS) from May 1-July 23, 2017.
- He allowed six home runs with two strikes, tied with **Zach Eflin** for the most by a Rays pitcher last season.

PITCH MIX—Last season, Bradley's primary offering was his four-seam fastball, which he utilized 44.9 pct. of the time...his most effective pitch was his curveball, an offering he threw 16.7 pct. of the time, limiting opponent to a .169 (11-for-65) AVG on the pitch.
