RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals embark on their season-ending six-game road trip, beginning with the opener of a three-game series vs. the San Francisco Giants tonight at Oracle Park ... The Cardinals finish their season with a three-game weekend series with the division-rival Chicago Cubs at Wrigley Field. **20 SEASONS AT BUSCH III:** St. Louis was 3-3 on its recent homestand against the Red Legs (1-2) and Brew Crew (2-1), recording a winning season at home (44-37, .543) for the 18th time in 20 seasons ... Since 2006, their all-time .576 win pct (899-663) at Busch III ranks 3rd at home to the Dodgers (.622, 974-593) & Yankees (.614, 960-604) and as the 11th-best in the first 20 years of any home venue in MLB history. - *Elias*

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis enters tonight in 4th place in the NL Central and 4.0 games back of the third and final Wild Card spot ... The Cardinals postseason elimination number stands at three vs. the Reds (80-76) and two vs. the Mets (80-76) due to tiebreakers ... St. Louis needs to win all six remaining games to finish with a winning record (82+ wins) ... The last time the Cardinals experienced two losing seasons over a three-year span was 1997 (73-89) and 1999 (75-86).

SO YOU'RE TELLING ME THERE'S A CHANCE: Among MLB seasons consisting of 150+ games, the three-lowest win totals of postseason teams include the 1973 Mets (82-79, .509), 2005 Padres (82-80, .506), and 2006 World Series Champion Cardinals (83-78, .516).

GAMES THAT MATTER: Since 2011 Opening Day, the Cardinals have played 2,298 out of a possible 2,320 regular season games (99.1%) during which they still maintained playoff aspirations and had not yet been eliminated.

THE CITY BY THE BAY: The Cardinals lead San Francisco by a slim 366-363 margin in the all-time series since the Giants moved from New York in 1958 ... The Cardinals have won the season series over the Giants nine times in the last 11 seasons since 2013.

WILD, WILD WEST: Since 2019, the Cardinals are 65-33 in home games vs. the National League West, but just 37-55 on the road. THE LATE SHOW:
St. Louis is 153-158 all-time in night games played in the Pacific Time Zone since divisional play began in 1994 (0-1 at Arizona, 1-1 at San Diego, 1-1 at Los Angeles Dodgers, 0-3 at Seattle this season).

LAND OF THE GIANTS: According to *Baseball Reference*, RHP **Chris Roycroft**, LHP **Lee Guetterman** (1993), and RHP **Mike Naymick** (1944) are listed as the tallest pitchers in franchise history at 6 feet, 8 inches tall ... In addition, the Cardinals currently have 6-ft, 6-inch OF **Jordan Walker** on the team... Former Giants RHP **Sean Hjelle** (*pronounced "JELL-ee"*) stands as the tallest Major Leaguer in 2025, listed as 6-foot-11 ... Former Cardinals pitchers **Adam Wainwright** and **Andrew Miller** were both 6-foot-7.

THE SAN FRANCISCO TREAT: The Cardinals rank first in batting average (.264), on-base percentage (.327), slugging (.411), and OPS (.738) among all-time annual visitors to Oracle Park since it opened in 2000 ... St. Louis also is the stadium leader in triples (25) among the non-NL West teams ... **Dexter Fowler** (3) and **Kolten Wong** (3) share the Cardinals lead with three triples here, while current Cardinals with three-baggers include **Nolan Arenado** (1) and **Lars Nootbaar** (1).

MICHAEL MCGREEVY'S HIGHS

NL Rookie Rankings: Wins (7, T-7th),

TONIGHT'S STARTER:

- Making his 15th start (16th appearance) of the season (18th career start./20th app) in tonight's game.
- Enters on a 11.0-inning scoreless streak, 6th-longest active in the N.L., and his 2nd-longest of the season (Aug. 2-13, 12.0 IP).
- Tied for the Major League lead in winning percentage Post All-Star Break over the past two seasons (9-2, .818) with Matt Festa (NYM, TEX, CLE).
- His 6 Post All-Star Break wins in 2025 are T-3rd in the National League and the most by a Cardinals pitcher since Adam Wainwright had 10 in 2021.
- Ranks T-3rd among National League rookies with six wins trailing Cade Horton (CHI, 11) and Lake Bachar (MIA, 8).
- Is 5-0 career in 8 Road starts with a 2.57 ERA; the Cardinals have gone 7-1 in those games and have provided Michael with 6+ runs of support in his first five (four total in last two).
- Tonight's start extends his career-high of 12 consecutive starts uninterrupted by option/injury/doubleheader/etc. (July 21-present).
- Since McGreevy's MLB debut (July 31, 2024), sports the 2nd-lowest BB/9 IP (1.40) of pitchers with 100.0 or more innings behind Janson Junk (MIA, 1.28)
- The Cardinals are 10-5 in his 15 appearances this season and 14-5 in his career.
- Sports a 2.50 ERA (36.0 IP) in six road starts, but 4.50 ERA (60.0 IP) in 11 home games (9 starts) at Busch Stadium.
- Was 8-3 with a 3.72 ERA in 15 starts at Memphis this season. Ranked 3rd among International League in winning percentage (.727, 8-3), 5th in wins (8) wins and 8th in ERA (3.72) and WHIP (1.24) at time of last recall.

LAST TIME OUT (Tuesday, Sept. 16 vs. Cincinnati): W, 3-0: 7.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 3 BB, 6 K, 0 HR - 91 pitches

• Pitched his longest scoreless start of the season with three hits over 7.0 innings. Walked a season-high three batters.

2025:

- Made six straight appearances of 6.0 innings or more (8/2-30); longest streak by a Cardinals pitcher this season.
- Was 4-0 in August, most wins by a Cardinals pitcher in the month of August since Adam Wainwright (5-1) in 2021.
- Struck out a career-high seven batters in a 7-6 win over Pittsburgh (8/25).
- Held the Reds scoreless over a season-high 7.0 innings with just three hits in a 3-0 win on Sept. 16.
- Was the first Cardinals pitcher with 9 or fewer walks and 80.0+ IP in their first 14 career games and only the 2nd in MLB history with Elmer Steele (1907-08) of the Boston Red Sox.
- Had three consecutive Quality Starts (8/8-19), the longest streak of his career,.
- Pitched a season-high 7.0 innings at COL (7/21), the first team he started against a team for the second time in his career.
- Was recalled twice from Memphis (AAA) and optioned back the following day on May 4-5 and June 8-9. Appointed as the 27th player for the June 19 doubleheader. Recalled on June 24 and most recently on July 21.
- Sustained most of his damage from the 5-9 batters in the Dodgers lineup on June 8; as they were 7-for-14 while the Top 5 batters were a
 combined 1-for-12 which included Shohei Ohtani (1-3, 2B), Mookie Betts (0-3, K), Freddie Freeman (0-3, K) & Teoscar Hernandez (0-3).
- Made his 2025 debut against the New York Mets in Game 2 of a doubleheader on May 4. Earned the win and held the Mets scoreless to one hit over 5.2 innings with a walk and five strikeouts. Held Francisco Lindor (0-2, K), Juan Soto (0-2), Pete Alonso (0-2, K) and Mark Vientos (1-3, K) to 1-for-9 with 3 strikeouts.

CAREER:

- From the start of 2022 until July 2025, led all of Minor League Baseball in wins (39), starts (97), innings pitched (522.1), and complete games (4), and ranked T-1st for first in double plays induced (55), 11th in ERA (4.00), and 3rd in SO/BB ratio (3.59) among qualifiers.
- Made his Major League debut against the Texas Rangers on July 31, 2024, firing 7.0 innings allowing one run on five hits with three strikeouts.
- Scouted the Rangers while watching the game on TV from the hotel bar/restaurant across the street the night before he started.
- Posted a 1.96 ERA in 2024, the best four game start by a Cardinal since **René Arocha** in 1993 (1.52 ERA, 23.2 IP, 4 ER).
- Is the only pitcher in Cards history to earn a win as a starting pitcher (July 31 2024 vs. Texas) and then as a relief pitcher in his second appearance (Sept. 18, 2024 vs. Pittsburgh) in his first two career MLB appearances.
- Originally selected by St. Louis in the 1st round (18th overall) of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of California-Santa Barbara.
- Entered the 2025 season as the No. 10 prospect in the Cardinals organization by *Baseball America*.

McGREEVY vs. SAN FRANCISCO:

- Making his 3rd career start vs. the Giants and 2nd this season. All three appearances vs. SF have come in September.
- Is 1-1 with a 5.25 ERA in his two starts vs. the Giants.
- Was hit for six runs on nine hits over a season-low 4.0 innings at Busch Stadium on Sept. 5.
- Last faced the Giants at Oracle Park in the final regular season game of the 2024 season pitching a career-high 8.0 innings allowing one run in a 6-1 Cardinals win.
- Has made seven career starts vs. N.L. West opponents (3-3, 5.59 ERA), his most starts against any opposing division (N.L. Central 2nd with 4 starts).

GIANTS BATTERS VS MICHAEL MCGREEVY (CAREER)
