TONIGHT'S GAME: The Giants' six-game road trip continues tonight with the middle game of this three-game series against the Guardians...SF enters tonight having lost four of their last five games, seven of their last nine and 12 of their last 16...they've been outscored 79-to-49 in their last 16 contests.

- ▶ At 51-74 (.408), the Giants are in 4th place in the NL West, just 1.5 games ahead of the last-place Rockies...the Giants' .408 winning percentage is the fourth-lowest in MLB, ahead of the Athletics (.389), Rockies (.397) and Angels (.397).
- ▶ SF enters tonight having dropped 11 of their last 13 road games and 18 of their last 23...the Giants are 22-41 (.349) on the road this season.

ROSTER MOVES: The Giants made the following roster moves prior to tonight's game here in Cleveland:

- ▶ **LHP Matt Wilkinson** (#71) selected to Major League roster.
- ▶ **LHP Philip Abner** claimed off waivers from Arizona and optioned to Triple-A Sacramento.
- ▶ **LHP Reiver Sanmartin** optioned to Triple-A Sacramento.
- ▶ **C Daniel Susac** and **OF Harrison Bader** transferred to the 60-day Injured List.

ALL ABOARD: LHP Matt "Tugboat" Wilkinson is scheduled to make his Major League debut tonight...the 6-foot-1, 250-pound Wilkinson was acquired by the Giants from the Guardians along with the 29th overall pick in this year's draft in exchange for C Patrick Bailey on May 9th...Wilkinson was a 10th-round draft pick by the Guardians in 2023.

- ▶ Wilkinson is 6-6 with a 3.40 ERA (34er, 90.0ip) in 20 starts across four minor league levels this season...he had a 1.59 ERA in six starts for Double-A Akron, a 0.00 ERA in one start for the ACL Giants, a 2.40 ERA in three starts for Double-A Richmond and a 5.15 ERA in 10 starts for Triple-A Sacramento.
- ▶ According to Matt, his dad's best friend (Phil McNeil) gave him the nickname "Tugboat" when he represented Team Canada in the Little League World Series...Wilkinson's own explanation: "I wasn't moving too fast around the bases growing up."
- ▶ In 10 starts for Triple-A Sacramento this season, Wilkinson averaged just 89.9 mph on his fastball, topping out at 92.2 mph from a low release point.

STRONG AND MIGHTY: Wilkinson will become the fifth Canadian-born Giants pitcher to start a game all-time, joining **Tip O'Neill** (1883), **Bill Magee** (1901-1902), **Bob Steele** (1918-1919), **Georges Maranda** (1960) and **Ken MacKenzie** (1964).

- ▶ Wilkinson will join O'Neil as the only Canadian-born Giants pitcher to make their MLB debut as a starting pitcher.

GOING...GOING...GONE!: IF/DH Bryce Eldridge has three home runs and five RBI in his last six games...Eldridge has 14 home runs this season, the most by a Giants player at age 21 or younger since **Orlando Cepeda** hit 25 homers in his rookie season of 1958.

SABR'S ALL-TIME INTEGRATION ERA TEAM: Last night, the Society for American Baseball Research (SABR) announced its All-Time Integration Era Teams (1947-1972)...players associated with the Giants' organization selected to the teams include: **Willie McCovey** (1B/1st Team), **Juan Marichal** (SP/1st Team), **Willie Mays** (OF/1st Team), **Gaylord Perry** (SP/2nd Team) and **Leo Durocher** (MGR/3rd Team)...the full story on the All-Time Integration Era Teams [is available here](#).

DOWN ON THE FARM: MLB Pipeline released its updated farm system rankings, with the Giants making the largest jump, climbing from No. 19 to No. 5...San Francisco's 14-spot rise is the organization's highest ranking since 2021, when they ranked No. 8 and is one spot shy of the biggest jump ever...according to MLB Pipeline, no organization has made as dramatic a move in so short a time as San Francisco improving from No. 28 in the 2025 preseason to No. 5 now.

- ▶ The Giants have five top 100 prospects per MLB.com: **SS/2B Josuar Gonzalez** (No. 17), **SS/3B Luis Hernández** (No. 27), **RHP Jackson Flora** (No. 31), **SS/2B Jhonny Level** (No. 47) and **RHP Ramon Marquez** (No. 100).
- ▶ SF added to its farm system talent by signing draft arms (**RHP Jackson Flora**, **LHP Carson Bolemon** and **RHP Kaden Waechter**) and dealing for **RHP Ramon Márquez**, **LHP Henry Lalane** and **RHP Miguel Mendez** at the deadline.

MLB DEBUT: 23-year-old **LHP Matt Wilkinson** is scheduled to make his Major League debut tonight in game two of this three-game series against the Guardians...a 10th round pick by Cleveland in 2023 out of Central Arizona JC, he was acquired by the Giants in early May alongside the 29th overall pick in this past draft (**LHP Carson Bol-emon**) in exchange for C Patrick Bailey.

HE'S A ROOKIE EH: Wilkinson is the fifth Canadian-born Giants pitcher to start a game all-time, joining **Tip O'Neill** (1883), **Bill Magee** (1901-1902), **Bob Steele** (1918-19), **Georges Maranda** (1960) and **Ken MacKenzie** (1964)...Wilkinson will join O'Neill as the only Canadian-born Giants pitcher to make their MLB debut as a starting pitcher.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the win on August 13 at Las Vegas, striking out one while allowing three runs on five hits and four walks over 5.0 innings for Triple-A Sacramento...in 10 Triple-A starts overall, Wilkinson is 3-4 with a 5.15 ERA (25er, 43.2ip), 43 strikeouts and a 1.21 WHIP in the hitter-friendly PCL.

IN DOUBLE-A EH: Pitched six games for Akron (Cleveland) and three games for Richmond (SF) before being promoted to Triple-A at the start of June...was 3-2 with a 1.87 ERA (9er, 43.1ip), 49 strikeouts and a 0.83 WHIP in nine combined Double-A starts.

LAST SEASON: Went 4-9 with a 4.24 (49er, 104.0ip), 117 strikeouts and a 1.38 WHIP in 25 starts for High-A Lake County...ranked inside the top-5 in the Cleveland organization in strikeouts (117, T-5th), and games started (25, T-3rd)...his 117 strikeouts ranked 11th-most in High-A, and fifth-most among High-A lefties.

FULL CIRCLE: He pitched for Team Canada in the World Baseball Classic earlier this season and was also part of the Canadian crew in the 2015 Little League World Series, with Giants broadcaster Dave Flemming serving as the play-by-play announcer for the tournament...you can click [here](#) to watch the video highlights with Flemming's commentary.

TO THE LEFT: The southpaw has dominated left-handed hitters this season...Wilkinson has held left-handed hitters to a .127 average (13x102) with three extra-base hits, 26 strikeouts and a .384 OPS...comparatively, righties are hitting .215 (46x214) with 23 extra-base hits, 70 strikeouts and a .695 OPS...eight of his nine homers allowed were by righties.

PUNCH OUT: He has 390 strikeouts in 313.2 MiLB innings (70 games, 69 starts)...his 11.4 K/9 since 2024 is sixth-best in the minor leagues over that span (min. 300 innings).

TUGBOAT: Nicknamed "Tugboat" by his father's best friend, Phil McNeil, who saw him running at a slow speed around the bases while Matt was playing in the 2015 Little League World Series.
