TODAY'S GAME: The Giants continue their homestand with the first of three games against NL West foe Arizona...SF began this six-game homestand by dropping a series to the Marlins over the weekend, going 1-2, before a day off yesterday.

- ▶ The Giants have lost 12 of their last 19 games dating to August 11 and are two games under .500 for the first time since August 3 when they were 55-57 after a loss at the Reds.
- ▶ SF is 6.5 back of the Braves (74-63) for the final NLWC spot with 24 games left...the Mets (74-64), Cubs (71-67) and Cardinals (69-69) all sit between the Giants and the Braves as well...per *FanGraphs*, SF's playoff chances are now 0.3%.
- ▶ The Giants will wear their City Connect uniforms tonight... they are 4-4 in the Creamsicle uniforms in 2024 but 30-14 in them since they were introduced in 2021.

ROSTER MOVES: **IF Marco Luciano** (#37) and **OF Luis Matos** (#29) were recalled from Triple-A Sacramento... **C Blake Sabol** and **IF Casey Schmitt** were optioned to Triple-A Sacramento.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY, REV. GREASON! Today at historic Rickwood Field the town of Birmingham, the baseball community and military representatives will come together to celebrate the 100th birthday of **Reverend Bill Greason**...the celebration at the ballpark is hosted by Bethel Baptist church and the Heart & Armor Foundation.

- ▶ Reverend Greason fought at the battle of Iwo Jima and pitched for the Birmingham Black Barons with his teammate, roommate and lifelong friend **Willie Mays**...he has served his community in Birmingham, AL for over 50 years as pastor at Bethel Baptist church where he still preaches each Sunday.

IT AIN'T EASY: The Giants have the toughest remaining schedule in MLB in terms of their opponents' combined win%...SF's remaining opponents have a .556 win%...each of the Giants final 24 games are against teams currently .500 or better and 21 of the 24 are against teams in playoff position.

PARSELTONGUE: SF is 22-8 versus the Diamondbacks at Oracle Park since the start of the 2021, having not lost a series in that time (SF is 7-0-2 in the nine series).

- ▶ Four of those eight losses, however, have come since the start of last season...the Giants are 7-4 versus Arizona since the beginning of 2023 and have a negative run differential in that time, being outscored 50-45.

MORE FROM THE FARM: Over the weekend, Single-A San Jose clinched a second half division title in the California League...it's the fifth year in a row that the club has made the Postseason...their Postseason begins next week.

- ▶ San Jose is the third Giants affiliate to play in the Postseason this year...both the DSL Giants ACL Giants also took part in their respective league's playoffs.
- ▶ San Jose **RHP Josh Bostick** was named CAL Pitcher of the Week for last week's action...Bostick struck out seven while allowing one unearned run on three hits and a walk over 5.0 innings on August 29...he was SF's 8th round pick in the 2023 draft.

HARRY AT HOME: 23-year-old **LHP Kyle Harrison** makes his 24th start of the season with his outing today.

- ▶ Harrison was cruising along in his outing at Milwaukee last Wednesday, throwing 4.0 scoreless...he ran into trouble in the 5th and allowed five runs on three consecutive two-out hits to end his day.
- ▶ He's 4-1 with a 3.43 ERA (23er, 60.1ip) in 11 home starts this year that includes at 2.15 ERA (7er, 29.1ip) in his last five starts here dating to June 10...SF as a team is 8-3 in his 11 outings at Oracle this year.

'ZILLA: **LHP Blake Snell** was named the NL's Pitcher of the Month earlier today...he's the first Giants pitcher to win the award since **RHP Kevin Gausman** in May of 2021.

- ▶ It's Snell's fifth career monthly award and the 18th time a Giant has won the honor.
- ▶ He went 2-0 with a 1.64 ERA in six August starts, a month that also included his first career complete game and no-hitter on August 2 at Cincinnati...Snell struck out 53 batters in August in just 38.1 innings and gave up just 16 hits.

VERYYYYY BRYYYYCE...: Giants prospect **IF Bryce Eldridge** was named the Northwest League Player of the Week yesterday after a huge week at High-A Eugene.

- ▶ Eldridge, the Giants #1 prospect according to *MLB.com* and the 53rd-best prospect in the minors overall, was 11-for-20 (.550) with four doubles, five homers, eight RBI, four walks and 10 runs scored in six games last week.
- ▶ **Today, Eldridge was officially promoted to Double-A Richmond**, his third team this year after starting the year in Single-A San Jose...his 48-game stint in the NWL saw him slash .335/.442/.618 for a 1.060 OPS in 48 games with 11 doubles, 12 homers, 41 RBI and 35 runs scored...he is set to be in the lineup tonight for the Squirrels at first base.
- ▶ Eldridge has a .798 SLG and a 1.277 OPS since August 1, both tops among all qualified players in the full season minor leagues in that time...Eldridge's 10 homers in that span are second-most while his .383 batting average is ninth best.
- ▶ Across two levels this year, the 19-year-old Eldridge has hit .296 with 25 doubles, 22 homers, 86 RBI and a .923 OPS in 99 games...Eldridge won't turn 20 until October 20.

2024 RECORD: 7-6, 4.22 ERA

TONIGHT'S START: Harrison is scheduled to make his 24th start of the season tonight...Harrison is 7-6 with a 4.22 ERA (57er, 121.2ip) in his 23 starts this season...the Giants have posted an 14-9 record in his starts this season...after a stretch of winning eight straight Harrison starts from April 15-May 24, the Giants are just 5-7 in his last 12 outings.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered the loss on August 28th at Milwaukee...cruised through 4.2-scoreless innings with seven strikeouts and then with two outs in the 5th inning things started to unravel, as he allowed five runs on three hits (one homer) and two walks.

INNINGSFEST: Harrison has received extra rest between starts with the clubs extra days off recently...he has worked a career-high 121.2 innings w/SF so far in 2024...last season, Harrison tossed 102.1 innings between Triple-A Sacramento and the Giants...his previous career-high in innings pitched came in 2022 when he worked a combined 113.0 innings between High-A Eugene and Double-A Richmond.

VS. ARIZONA: Is slated to face the Diamondbacks for the third time in his career...is 0-1 with a 5.40 ERA (6er, 10.0ip) and 10 strikeouts...the last time he faced Arizona here at Oracle Park was April 20, 2024 when he tossed 4.0 innings and allowed three runs on six hits with five strikeouts.

THE FASTBALL: Harrison has relied heavily on his four-seam fastball this season, throwing it 58.0% of the time...in his last start against the Brewers 6 of the 7 strikeouts recorded by Harrison came by the fastball...he has thrown 1,163 four-seam fastballs this season...he's holding opponents to a .244 average with 77 strikeouts against his fastball...in his last two start opponents are hitting .174 (4-for-23) with nine strikeouts...overall this year, his fastball has a +10 run value.

CHANGE IT UP: He's thrown his changeup a lot more this season throwing it 19.7% of the time, compared to 11.1% of the time last season...opposing hitters are hitting .279 with a .432 SLG%, both these numbers are the highest among Harrison's repertoire...he also only has a 22% whiff percentage on the changeup with a K% of 11% which are both the lowest out of his pitches...a big reason for why opposing hitters are hitting his changeup so well is due to location...out of the 395 changeups thrown that end AB's - a 100 of them have ended up in the middle third (horizontal)... when the changeup ends in this location opposing hitters are raking with a .302 AVG and .465 SLG (S/S).

FIRST PITCH: Opponents are hitting .327 (16-for-49) with six extra base hits off him on the first pitch of an at-bat.

NIGHT OWL: Harrison is 6-4 with a 3.71 ERA (37er, 89.2ip) and a .239 opponent batting average during night games this season (16 starts)...during day games (seven starts), he has a 5.63 ERA (20er, 32.0ip) and .302 opponent batting average.

HIT HARD: Harrison has a hard hit percentage of 44% which ranks him 9th worst in MLB...he is second on the team behind Logan Webb who has a hard rate percentage of 47% (SIS).

NO FREE PASSES: Has limited his walks thus far this season, allowing 41 free passes in 121.2 innings (3.03 BB/9)...however, he's allowed 19 walks over his last nine games (3.86 BB/9).

ABOUT KYLE: Entered the season as the No. 1 ranked player in the SF system and the top left-handed pitching prospect for the 2024 season, according to *MLB.com* and *Baseball America*...Harrison was selected in the third round of the 2020 draft out of local De La Salle High School in Concord, CA.
