THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
JUNE 21

1973 - In a 12-2 win over the Padres, **1B Lee May** becomes the second player in club history to hit three HR in a game...**2B Tommy Helms** adds a grand slam...**RHP Ken Forsch** goes the distance for the win...a young **LF Dave Winfield** hits his first Major League homer for the Padres.

TODAY'S GAME: The Astros, who have won three of their last four series, will play the rubber game of their three-game set with the Guardians today in a Father's Day matinee at Daikin Park...**RHP Kai-Wei Teng** (3-6), who tossed 2.2 scoreless innings against the Guardians back in April, will get the start for the Astros today opposite **RHP Slade Cecconi** (3-5) and the Guardians.

MY WAY OR THE KAI-WEI: **RHP Kai-Wei Teng** has split his season between the bullpen (13g) and rotation (8 starts), posting a 4.31 ERA (26ER/54.1IP) and a .232 opponent average with 58 strikeouts in 54.1 innings pitched...Teng is new to the Astros, as he was acquired from the Giants this offseason in exchange for minor leaguer **C Jancel Villarreal**...a native of Taiwan, Teng is the second Taiwanese-born player to appear with the Astros in their history, joining **RHP Chia Jen-Lo**, who made 19 relief appearances with the Astros in 2013.

A MONTH OF WINNING: Over the last month, dating back to May 21, the Astros have gone 16-11 (.593), which ties as the fifth-best record in the Majors and is the second-best record in the AL.

FATHER'S DAY PROMOTIONS: In honor of Father's Day today, there will be special ceremonial first pitches from fathers of Astros players...there will also be a Human Blue Ribbon on the field for Father's Day and Prostate Cancer Awareness.

VS. THE GUARDIANS: The Astros and Guardians have played each other in the regular season 102 times in their franchise histories, with the two teams splitting those matchups with 51 wins apiece...those games have also been evenly split in Houston (26-26) and Cleveland (25-25), which includes a 23-23 record at Daikin Park.

RACKING UP K'S: The Astros have struck out 62 batters through 45.0 innings in five games this homestand, which are their most strikeouts in any five-game span this season...in 2026, Astros pitchers rank fifth in the AL in strikeouts (671), while their opponent today, the Guardians, rank first with 707.

PEN PALS: Since May 15, the Astros bullpen has a 2.78 ERA (36ER/116.2IP) with 112 strikeouts, a 1.02 WHIP and a .190 opponent average...among AL teams since May 15, the Astros bullpen ranks first in ERA, first in WHIP, and first in opponent batting average...the Astros are also 19-14 since May 15.

MAKING THE PLAYS: The Astros have committed the fewest errors (29) and own the best fielding percentage (.989) in the AL...**1B Christian Walker** has led the way, as he has not committed an error in 77 games and 536 total chances.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Astros had their mini three-game winning streak snapped last night with an 8-1 loss to the Guardians...the Astros offense was limited to just five hits on the night, including a 2x4 performance by **2B Jose Altuve**.

LAST NIGHT'S TRADE: Announced last night, the Astros acquired minor leaguer **1B Cameron Sisneros** from the Cubs in exchange for **RHP Jayden Murray**...Sisneros, 25, has split the 2026 season with Double A Knoxville and High A South Bend in the Cubs organization, batting a combined .265 (44x166) with eight doubles, six home runs, 37 RBI and an .840 OPS (.419 OBP/.422 SLG).

ALL-STAR VOTING UPDATE: On Monday, MLB announced the first balloting update for the 2026 MLB All-Star Game, which revealed **DH Yordan Alvarez** as the AL's top vote-getter among all position players...other Astros among the AL's top 10 at their respective positions: **2B Jose Altuve** (4th), **SS Jeremy Peña** (5th), **1B Christian Walker** (9th), **3B Isaac Paredes** (9th), and **C Yainer Diaz** (9th).

THE LINEUP: The Astros have used 77 different lineups in their 78 games, repeating a lineup just once on the season...**DH Yordan Alvarez** has the most starts at any spot in the lineup among Astros, hitting second 66 times.

ON THE LEADERBOARD: **DH Yordan Alvarez** leads the Majors in OPS (1.54), SLG (.630), and total bases (177), and ranks tied for first in extra-base hits (39)...in the AL, he ranks first in hits (90), tied for first in homers (24), second in batting average (.320), second in RBI (55), second in OBP (.424), fourth in walks (47) and tied for fifth in runs (52).

STREAK SNAPPED: **DH Yordan Alvarez** had his 25-game on-base streak snapped last night by going 0x3...in the streak, which ran from May 22-June 19, Alvarez hit .366 (34x93) with nine homers, 24 RBI, 16 walks, a .459 OBP and a 1.158 OPS...this ranks as the fifth-longest streak of his career and his longest since the 2024 season.

WALKER, TEXAS HAMMER: **1B Christian Walker** ranks tied fourth in the AL in RBI (52), behind only **1B Nick Kurtz** (58), **DH Yordan Alvarez** (55) and **C Dillon Dingler** (53)...he also ranks tied for sixth in the AL in total bases (139), and tied for seventh in extra-base hits (33) and in homers (18).

BACK WITH A VENGEANCE: Since **SS Jeremy Peña** returned to the lineup on May 18, the Astros have gone 17-13, while Peña has hit .295 (33x112) with four doubles, six homers, 18 RBI and an .851 OPS in 30 games...prior to that date, Peña played in only 10 of the Astros first 48 games of the season, with the Astros going 19-29 in those contests.

TAPPING FOR SUCCESS: Astros batters have won a Major League-leading 49 ABS challenges on the season and rank tied for first in the Majors in ABS challenge success rate (57%)...**3B Isaac Paredes** (7-for-7) is perfect in successful challenges, while **2B Jose Altuve** has been successful on 12-of-17 challenges (71%).

MY BOY BLU: **RHP AJ Blubaugh** struck out the side in a perfect 1.0 inning of relief last night, giving him five consecutive scoreless appearances (9IP), in which he's struck out 11 batters with a .103 (3x29) opponent batting average...Blubaugh has been on a strong run since April 11, going 2-0 with a 2.29 ERA (10ER/39.1IP) in his last 25 appearances.

LAST START, JUNE 15 vs. DET: Allowed 5 runs on 6 hits with 2 walks and 9 strikeouts in 3.1 innings...set a single game career-high in strikeouts with 9, previous career-high was 8 strikeouts, which he recorded on Sept. 1, 2025 at COL and Sept. 7, 2025 at at STL

PRONUNCIATION: Full name is pronounced "kiy-way dung"

KAI-WEI PATROL: The 27-year-old righty has made 7 consecutive turns in the Astros rotation, dating back to his start on May 10 at CIN...as a starter this season, he's recorded a 5.77 ERA (22ER/34.1IP) with 38 strikeouts, 19 walks and a .276 opponent batting average...in a 4-start stretch from May 10-29, he recorded a 2.84 ERA (6ER/19IP) with 21 strikeouts, a .188 opponent batting average (12x64) and a 1.26 WHIP...that 4-start stretch included a career-high 6.0 innings in a scoreless outing on May 23 at CHC.

CAREER MARKS: Has already set a single game career-high in starts with 8, surpassing 7 starts last season with the Giants...has already set his single-season career highs in appearances (21) and strikeouts (58), surpassing totals of 8 appearances and 39 strikeouts last season with the Giants.

NO. 100: Recorded his 100th career strikeout on June 15 vs. DET on strikeout in the second inning against **OF James Outman**...is also closing in on 100 career innings, as he enters today's start with 95 career innings.

SWINGMAN: An offseason acquisition, Teng made his 1st career Opening Day roster and began the season working out of the Astros' bullpen...made his first 11 apps. of the season out of the bullpen, posting a 2.16 ERA (4ER/16.2IP) over that span, before making his 1st start of the season on April 28 at BAL...returned to the bullpen for 2 appearances on May 2 at BOS and May 4 vs. LAD before his current stretch of 7 consecutive starts...has made 33 total MLB appearances (2024-26), with 15 of them as a starter...has posted huge strikeout numbers as a starter in his MLB career, recording 73 strikeouts through 59.0 innings in those outings (11.14 SO/9IP).

HARD TO HIT: Has limited opponents to a .232 opponent average (47x203) this season, including a .190 (19x100) average to right-handed hitters...also owns a 0.98 WHIP vs. right-handed hitters this season.

TENG FROM TAIWAN: The Taiwanese righty was acquired from San Francisco on Jan. 29, 2026, in exchange for catching prospect **Jancel Villarroel**...has appeared in parts of 3 seasons with the Giants (2024-25) and Astros (2026), making 30 career Major League appearances (12 starts)...he became the 2nd Taiwanese-born player to appear with the Astros in franchise history, joining **RHP Chia-Jen Lo**, who made 19 relief appearances with the Astros in 2013.

LAST APPEARANCE (6/20 vs. CLE): Tossed 1.0 scoreless inning last night vs. CLE.

TURNING THE PAGE: Has gone 2-1 with 4 saves and a 2.81 ERA (5ER/16IP) in his last 18 appearances, dating back to May 3...within these appearances, he logged 9 consecutive scoreless outings (8.2 IP) from May 3-28...his 9-game scoreless streak is the 2nd-longest by an Astro this season, behind LHP Steven Okert (active 11-game streak).

ALL-TIME ASTRO RANKINGS: Has made 346 career appearances, recently passing RHP Ryan Pressly (342g) for 6th in franchise history in relief appearances...now directly trails LHP Joe Sambito (348g) for 5th on that all-time list...also ranks 4th all-time among Astros relievers in strikeouts (481) and 10th in innings pitched (355.0).

CAREER: In 346 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.92 ERA (115ER/355IP) with 481 strikeouts, a 1.22 WHIP, a 12.19 K/9 and a 0.79 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 2nd in appearances among active AL relievers.

AGAINST THE GUARDIANS: In 12 career appearances vs. CLE, he's recorded a 0.71 ERA (1ER/12.2IP) with 18 strikeouts and a .163 opponent batting average.
