D-backs captured their second NL pennant and made their second trip to the World Series, first since winning it all in 2001, in their seventh Postseason berth ('99, '01, '02, '07, '11, '17, '23) last season.

- ◆ Lourdes Gurriel Jr. went 2-for-4 to mark his fifth consecutive multi-hit game.
- Slade Cecconi tossed 3.0 innings of 5-hit, 1-run ball with 2 strikeouts.

ACES MANAGER BLAKE LALLI DONATES KIDNEY TO HIS GIRLFRIEND: Triple-A Reno Manager, Blake Lalli, underwent successful kidney donation on March 5 to donor and girlfriend, Aleah Hartung...after receiving the news that Hartung needed another transplant, after 2 previous ones, Lalli went through testing and, in January, they received news that he was a perfect match.

- ♦ Today, Lalli wears No. 29 on his jersey in honor of the day he met his girlfriend and the day she received her first kidney transplant from her mom.
- Lalli and Hartung will be recognized and run the bases during the second inning at the Reno Aces' Home Run for Life game, presented by Donor Network West, on Friday, June 28, 2024, at Greater Nevada Field.

MARTE MAKING HIS CASE CLEAR: Ketel Marte leads all second basemen with a 3.9 bWAR, an .835 OPS, 33 extra-base hits, 12 defensive runs saved and 1.5 dWAR, is tied for first with 147 total bases, second with 15 homers and 43 RBI, tied for second with 16 doubles and third with 82 hits.

♦ Marte's 3.9 bWAR is third in the NL (8th in MLB), behind Shohei Ohtani/LAD (4.3) and Mookie Betts/LAD (3.9).

VS. TWINS: The D-backs welcome the Twins back to Chase Field for the first time since June 17-19, 2022.

- ♦ In their last series @ Chase Field, the D-backs took 2-of-3 from the Twins.
- ♦ The D-backs are 7-5 lifetime @ home vs. Twins.

THE NL CHAMPS: The 2023 National League Champion SIX STRAIGHT SERIES OPENERS: The D-backs have won their last 6 series-opening games (June 3-21) after going 3-15 in their previous 18 to start the season (March 28-May 30).

> BY SERIES: The D-backs have won 3 straight home series and 4 of their last 5 overall (last 3: vs. Angels, vs. White Sox, vs. Giants)...they have won or split 6 of their last 7 series overall since May 30.

> HOME SWEET HOME: Over 9 games in June, the D-backs are batting .301 (90-for-299) as a team at home with 6.56 runs per game, the second-best home average and runs per game this month in the Majors, behind the Twins (.332, 6.70), while their .884 OPS is third.

> ♦ The D-backs have recorded 9+ hits in 8 of their 9 home games in June, including their last 4 games.

> GURRIEL'S MULTI-HIT STREAK: Lourdes Gurriel Jr.'s 5 straight multi-hit games (since June 18) is the longest streak by a D-back since Ketel Marte in 2019 (8 games).

In 2018 with the Blue Jays, Gurriel boasted an 11-game multihit streak (July 11-29) to set a Toronto franchise record and tied "Shoeless" Joe Jackson (1912) and Sam Rice (1925) for the longest of its kind in AL history.

CARROLL'S HOME STREAK: Corbin Carroll has reached base safely in 10 straight home games (since May 25), tied for his second-longest single-season streak (also: April 3-May 1), behind his career-best 18-gamer (Aug. 22-Sept. 30, 2023).

♦ Over his last 10 home games, he has a .372 OBP (9 H, 6 BB, 1 HBP) with 3 doubles, 2 triples, 3 RBI and 2 stolen bases
