AROUND THE HORN

MEXICAN BASEBALL HALL OF FAME: On Tuesday, the Mexican Baseball Hall of Fame (Salon de Fama del Beisbol Mexicano) announced its Mexican Baseball Immortals of Class 2026, featuring the D-backs' own **Erubiel Durazo** and **Rodrigo Lopez** in the "Mexicans in Major Leagues" category... **Durazo**, who was a member of the D-backs' 2001 World Championship team, played 4 seasons (1999-2002) with Arizona and has served as D-backs Special Advisor on Mexico to the President, CEO & General Partner since 2016... **Lopez** pitched for the D-backs in 2010, where he led the team in innings (200.0) and starts (33), and has served as an analyst for D-backs Spanish Radio broadcasts since 2014 as well as general manager of Mexico's 2023 and 2026 World Baseball Classic teams.

HERE'S THE STORY: D-backs' starters have recorded 8 quality starts in their last 11 outings and allowed 1 or fewer runs in 7 of those.

- Since May 5, the D-backs' 2.32 ERA ranks fourth in the Majors, behind the Brewers (9 G, 1.75), Braves (10 G, 2.02) and Rays (10 G, 2.16).
 - In the span, the D-backs rank among MLB leaders in quality starts (1st, 8), innings (1st, 73.2), innings/G (1st, 6.2), OBP (1st, 244), WHIP (1st, 0.91), strikeouts (T-3rd, 61), opponent AVG (3rd, .187) and OPS (4th, .573).
- D-backs' pitchers have starts of 6.0+ innings in 9 of their last 11 games.
- The D-backs look to take 11 of the last 13 series vs. Rockies since 2023 in today's rubber match.
- The D-backs are 16-5 (.762) when leading after 5.0 innings, including 7-4 (.636) on the road.

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 4-2 @ Rockies yesterday.

- **Eduardo Rodriguez**, after a 31-pitch first inning and trailing 2-0, settled in to finish with 5.1 innings and exit the game in the sixth down 3-2 (L, 3 R, 9 H, 0 BB, 6K).
- **Ketel Marte** (2-for-4, 2B, BB) and **Corbin Carroll** (1-for-3, 2B, RBI, 2 BB) each reached base 3 times.
- **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** (2-for-4, 2B) and **Jose Fernandez** (2-for-4) had 2 hits apiece.
- **Taylor Clarke** (0.2 IP), **Jonathan Loaisiga** (1.0 IP) and **Kevin Ginkel** (1.0 IP) had scoreless outings.

DIVISION SHOWDOWNS: The D-backs face 13 straight NL West matchups (1-1, May 15-17 @ Rockies, May 18-20 vs. Giants, May 21-24 vs. Rockies, May 25-27 @ Giants) and 17 of their next 20 (also: June 1-4 vs. Dodgers).

BULLPEN SPOTLIGHT: In their last 14 games since May 1, the D-backs lead MLB in ERA (2.10, 9 R-8 ER in 34.1 IP), opponent AVG (.183; 22-for-120), WHIP (0.93), runs (9), hits (22) and walks (10), and are tied for the fewest homers (0).

CLARKE CLUTCH: **Taylor Clarke** has allowed 1 earned run in his last 19 games, going 1-1 with a 0.46 ERA (2 R-1 ER in 19.2 IP), 0.56 WHIP, 2 walks and 9 strikeouts.

¡BRAVO MORILLO! **Juan Morillo** has allowed 1 run over his last 11 games, going 1-0 with 1 save, a 0.84 ERA (1 ER in 10.2 IP), 0.56 WHIP, 1 walk and 14 strikeouts.

LEAN ON LOAISIGA: **Jonathan Loaisiga** has allowed 1 run in his last 9 games, going 0-0 with a 1.23 ERA (1 ER in 7.1 IP), 0.82 WHIP, 2 walks and 4 strikeouts.

A ROX LEGEND: **Nolan Arenado**, who was drafted by Colorado in the second round of the 2009 Draft, played 12 professional seasons with the organization, including 5 in the Minors (2009-2013) and 8 in the Majors (2013-20), where he was a 5-time NL All-Star, 4-time Silver Slugger, 8-time Gold Glove and 4-time Platinum Glove.

ROLLIN' NOLAN: **Nolan Arenado** has reached base safely in 19 of his last 21 starts, hitting .354 (23-for-65)/1.060 OPS with 6 doubles, 3 homers, 9 RBI and 14 walks, including 10 games reaching 2+ times.

- Since April 21, ranks among MLB third basemen [min. 80 PA] in OBP (1st, .470), AVG (2nd, .348), OPS (2nd, 1.046), SLG (2nd, .576), runs (2nd, 17), times on base (3rd, 39) and hits (T-5th, 23).

ROAD SNAKES: **Ildemaro Vargas** has reached base in 16 of his 19 road games, hitting .358 (29-for-81)/.875 OPS with 5 doubles, 2 homers, 11 RBI and 3 walks.

- **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** has reached base in 8 of his last 9 road games, hitting .324 (11-for-34)/.780 OPS with 3 doubles, 4 RBI and 3 walks, including 4 multi-hit efforts.
- **Corbin Carroll** has reached base in 7 straight road games and in 9 of his last 10, hitting .314 (11-for-35)/.969 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 homer, 2 RBI and 9 walks.

VS. ROCKIES: The D-backs face the Rockies for the Rocky Mountain Showdown as part of MLB's second annual "Rivalry Weekend" presented by Booking.com.

- The D-backs have taken 4 of their last 6 road series @ Rockies since 2023 and are 11-10.

- **Ketel Marte** has reached base 2+ times in 11 of his last 12 starts, hitting .440 (22-for-50)/1.277 OPS with 10 doubles, 2 homers, 14 RBI and 7 walks.
- **Corbin Carroll** has a 9-game hitting streak (.333, 12-for-336/1.109 OPS, 3 2B, 3 HR, 7 RBI, 7 BB) and hit safely in 20 of his last 21 games (.306, 26-for-85/1.034 OPS, 5 2B, 2 3B, 6 HR, 12 RBI, 14 BB).
- **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** has a 9-game hitting streak, batting .333 (12-for-36)/.949 OPS with 3 doubles, 2 homers, 11 RBI and 2 walks...reached base in 13 straight games (.327/.942 OPS, 17-for-52, 3 2B, 3B, 2 HR, 14 RBI, 7 BB).
- **Gabriel Moreno** has 2+ hits in 6 straight games, batting .577 (15-for-26)/1.400 OPS with 6 doubles, 5 RBI and 1 walk.

ON DECK VS. GIANTS: The D-backs have won or split 7 of the last 9 series (won 5, split 2).

- The D-backs took the season series last year at 7-6.
- The D-backs went 4-3 @ Chase Field last season and have won 5 of the last 8 at home.

NEXT STARTER: RHP ZAC GALLEN (1-4, 5.02)

- Had a quality start in his last outing vs. Giants on Sept. 15, 2025 (W, 1 ER in 6.0 IP, 2 H, BB, 6 K).
- In his last 3 home starts vs. Giants, is 3-0 with a 1.42 ERA (3 ER in 19.0 IP), 3 walks and 27 strikeouts.
- The D-backs are 6-0 in his last 6 home bids vs. Giants...Gallen has 5 straight wins in his last 5 decisions at home vs. Giants.
