**THE TWINS:** Have gone 2-6 through eight games on their nine-game, 10-day roadtrip, going 2-1 in Houston, 0-3 at New York-AL and 0-2 at Pittsburgh...today, Minnesota will complete the trip with the three-game series finale at PNC Park against the Pirates...after today's game, the Twins will travel home for a nine-game, 10-day homestand with three against the Rockies (Monday-Wednesday), four against the A's (Thursday-Sunday) and three against the Rays (June 18-20).  
 ☞ The Twins have lost five consecutive games, seeking their first win since last Sunday at Houston...their season-long for a losing streak is seven, done from May 14-20.

**SIMEON COOKS, BUT BATS STAY QUIET:** The Twins were shut out by the Pirates yesterday afternoon at PNC Park, losing by a score of 4-0...marked the fifth shutout for the Twins offense this season and second consecutive...Simeon Woods Richardson (2-1) made the start and was issued the loss, allowing just one run (Rowdy Tellez homer) on six hits in 6.1 innings pitched, with no walks and six strikeouts...the offense recorded just six hits (all singles) and walked just once.

**GETTING OFFENSIVE:** The Twins enter today with a 22-inning scoreless streak on offense...since their three-run fifth inning on Thursday at Yankee Stadium, they went four scoreless to finish that game, followed by back-to-back shutouts to start the Pittsburgh series...they had a 28-inning scoreless streak earlier this season from May 15-17, the fourth-longest scoring drought in club history (since 1961)...the club record is 34, from September of 2014-April of 2015.

**TWINS AND BUGS:** The Twins are 25-19 all-time against the Pirates, going 2-4 at Three Rivers Stadium (1998-2000), 8-4 at the Metrodome (1997-2009), 8-6 at PNC Park (2006-24) and 7-5 at Target Field (2015-23)...the Twins have won nine of their last 15 games vs. Pittsburgh, dating back to April of 2018...Twins' last win in this ballpark came on August 5, 2020.

**NATIONAL NEWS:** The Twins are 4-6 in Interleague Play this season...they played a two-game series in Milwaukee from April 2-3 (1-1), a three-game series at Target Field against Los Angeles (1-2), a three-game series at Washington (2-1) and have gone 0-2 at Pittsburgh this weekend...after this series, their next IL opponent will be the Rockies at Target Field from Monday-Wednesday...Minnesota is looking to avoid losing three straight to an NL opponent since getting swept in three games by the Braves from June 26-28, 2023.

**THE LAST DANCE:** The Twins are looking to avoid being swept for the sixth time this season...their previous five sweeps were April 4-6 vs. Cleveland (2 games), April 15-17 at Baltimore (3 games), May 14-16 vs. New York-AL (3 games), May 17-19 vs. Cleveland (3 games) and June 4-6 at New York-AL (3 game).

☞ The Twins have never been swept in three games by the Pirates...the only time they have ever been swept by them was in two games from July 28-29, 2015 at Target Field.

☞ The last time the Twins were swept in Interleague Play was by the Brewers in two games from August 22-23, 2023 at American Family Field...the last time they were swept in IL Play in three games was by the Braves at Truist Park from June 26-28, 2023.

**TWINS MiLB WEEKLYS:** Triple-A St. Paul outfielder Matt Wallner and Low-A Fort Myers right-handed pitcher Jose Olivares have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

☞ Wallner, 26, played in six games for the Saints, hitting .364 (8-for-22) with one double, four home runs, eight RBI, three walks, seven runs scored, a .462 on-base percentage, a .955 slugging percentage and a 1.416 OPS.

☞ Olivares, 21, made the start on Tuesday at Tampa, pitching 5.0 shutout innings, with four hits allowed, no walks and a season-high six strikeouts...the Altigracia de Orituco, Venezuela native was signed by the Twins as an international free agent in January of 2021.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Last started on June 4 at New York-AL, taking his fourth loss of the season in a 5-1 Minnesota's defeat opposite Luis Gil...allowed three runs on three hits (1 HR) in 5.0 innings, with four walks and two strikeouts -- his four walks allowed set a new single-game career high, surpassing his prior high of three...allowed a second-inning home run to Gleyber Torres and a two-RBI double to Aaron Judge in the third inning; went on to have scoreless fourth and fifth innings...generated seven whiffs on 35 swings (5%)...has now lost back-to-back starts for the first time this season.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Made the start on May 29, taking his third loss of the season against Kansas City Royals in a 6-1 defeat opposite Seth Lugo...allowed six runs on nine hits (3 HR) in 5.0 innings, with no walks and four strikeouts...nine hits and three home runs both tied season highs set March 31 in Kansas City...induced 15 whiffs on 49 swings (30.6%)...had a scoreless first inning for the fifth time in nine career starts vs. Kansas City...in the third inning, allowed four runs on four hits, including a Nelson Velázquez two-run home run...Salvador Perez and Velázquez added solo home runs in the fifth...has allowed 10 home runs in his career vs. Kansas City, second most against any opponent (DET - 12).

**VS. PITTSBURGH:** Making his first career start against Pittsburgh Pirates today.  
 ☞ Has made five career starts against the National League Central, going 1-0, 4.07 ERA (24.1 IP, 11 ER), 10 walks, 21 strikeouts a 1.27 WHIP and a .231 (21-for-91) opponent batting average...has made two starts vs. Cincinnati, two vs. Milwaukee and one vs. St. Louis.  
 ☞ Lone Interleague start this season came on April 8 vs. Los Angeles-NL...took a no-decision, allowing three hits, one run, two walks and seven strikeouts in a 4-2 Twins loss.  
 ☞ Making his 13th career Interleague start...in the previous 12 he is 3-1, 3.39 (63.2 IP, 24 ER), 19 walks, 58 strikeouts a 1.08 WHIP and a .215 (50-for-233) opponent batting average.  
 ☞ Has faced four active Pirates hitters: Yasmani Grandal, Edward Olivares, Michael A. Taylor and Rowdy Tellez.

**BACK ON THE ROAD:** Making his eighth road start of the season today...in previous seven, has gone 3-3 with a 5.50 ERA (36.0 IP, 22 ER), nine walks, 31 strikeouts, a 1.17 WHIP and a .241 (33-for-137) opponent batting average...in five home starts, he is 2-1, 4.15 ERA (26.0 IP, 12 ER), seven walks, 29 strikeouts, a 1.08 WHIP and a .219 (21-for-96) opponent batting average.  
 ☞ Has gone 9-11 with a 4.04 ERA (180.1 IP, 81 ER) in 35 career road starts compared to a 9-5 with a 3.67 ERA (174.1 IP, 71 ER) in 34 career home starts.  
 ☞ Since making his debut in 2021, Ober is tied for second among Twins pitchers with teammate Pablo López and Griffin Jax with nine road wins.

**REVERSE SPLITS:** On June 4, Yankees left-handed hitters went 0-for-6 with two walks against Ober, while righties went 3-for-12 with two walks and two strikeouts.  
 ☞ Lefties have a 26.7 percent whiff rate and 85.3 mph average exit velocity vs. Ober, while righties a 24.7 percent whiff rate and 90.3 mph average exit velocity.  
 ☞ Through 12 games this season, lefties have hit .194 (20-for-103) with a .620 OPS and 24.2 percent strikeout rate, while righties have .262 (34-for-130) with a .832 OPS and 26.9 percent strikeout rate.  
 ☞ Over his career, lefties are batting .242 (151-for-624) with 34 doubles, three triples and 18 home runs and a .692 OPS...right-handed hitters are batting .235 (168-for-715) with 30 doubles, five triples and, 39 home runs with a .723 OPS.

**THE ARSENAL:** Has used a five-pitch mix thus far in 2024, per Baseball Savant...uses 4-seamer and cutter against both left- and right-handed hitters...predominantly throws changeup and curveball to lefties, slider to righties. Here's his pitch usage through 12 starts:

 ☞ In his last start, Yankees hitters went 0-for-5 with two strikeouts against the slider.

**DAYTIME:** In five day games this season, he is 3-1, 4.56 ERA (25.2 IP, 13 ER), two walks, 23 strikeouts and a .216 (21-for-97) opponent batting average...this compares to 2-3, 5.20 ERA (36.1 IP, 21 ER), 14 walks, 37 strikeouts and a .243 (33-for-136) opponent batting average in six night game starts.

 ☞ Was Triple-A St. Paul's Opening Day starter and pitched in four games for Saints to begin the season, posting a 2.55 ERA (17.2 IP, 5 ER) with six walks and 22 strikeouts.  
 ☞ Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week on April 23 after throwing 5.0 scoreless innings.  
 ☞ Recalled by Twins on April 23 and made season debut that day against Washington, allowing one run on three hits in 5.2 innings, earning the win.  
 ☞ Posted a 1.82 ERA (24.2 IP, 5 ER) with four walks and 24 strikeouts over his next four starts with the Twins.  
 ☞ Pitched 7.0 shutout innings twice: May 5 at Cleveland and July 1 at Baltimore.  
 ☞ Allowed three earned runs-or-fewer in 15 of first 16 starts with Twins from April 23-July 23.  
 ☞ Posted career-best four-start stretch (July 18-August 4) without issuing a walk.  
 ☞ To limit innings, returned to Triple-A from August 28-September 15 and started once in that span.  
 ☞ Set career highs in wins (8), innings pitched (144.1), starts (26) and strikeouts (146).  
 ☞ Ranked fourth on Twins staff in starts, innings and strikeouts.  
 ☞ Left off AL Wild Card Series roster vs. Toronto but added to ALDS roster vs. Houston.
