# Minnesota Twins (54-41) at San Francisco Giants (46-50)

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Giants wrap the unofficial first half today with the finale of this three-game series against the Twins to head into the All-Star break.

- ▶ The two teams have been historically evenly matched since first facing each other in the regular season in 2003, with SF going 12-11 in the 23 overall games.
- ▶ The Giants are trying to win their third Interleague series of the year, having lost six of their eight Interleague series thus far in 2024...the only series vs. American League teams SF has won were at Texas (June 7-9) and vs. Houston (June 10-12).
- ▶ SF has won eight of its last 13 games here at Oracle Park dating to June 16 while averaging 5.7 runs/game.

**PURPLE RAIN:** SF has done well against the Twins in recent years, particularly here at home...the Giants have won seven of their last 10 games against Minnesota at Oracle Park dating to June 22, 2011, outscoring them by 21 runs (47-26) in that stretch.

**WORTH NOTING:** When it's all said and done today, the Giants will have played 97 games before the All-Star break, their most in an unofficial first half since playing 98 before the break in 2018.

- ▶ The most games SF has played before the break was 99 games in 1973.

**LET'S FINISH STRONG:** The Giants recorded eight more hits yesterday but are still hitting .220 this month (11 games), lowest in the National League and tied for third-lowest in the Majors with the White Sox (.220) and ahead of the Yankees (.217) and Angels (.216).

- ▶ SF has averaged 4.0 runs/game so far this month, 20th of 30 MLB teams.
- ▶ Yesterday the Giants struck out 10 more times, giving them six games already this month where they've struck out 10 or more times...their 26.7% strikeout rate this month is fifth-highest in MLB.

**GOIN' STREAKING:** **OF Heliot Ramos** extended his on-base streak to 13 games with his 1-for-4 day yesterday...he's slashing .377/.414/.660 with three doubles, four homers, 10 runs scored and 11 RBI during the streak.

- ▶ Ramos leads the team in homers (14) and RBI (46)...his 2.4 fWAR is tied with **IF Matt Chapman** for second-most among position players on the team...**C Patrick Bailey** (2.6 fWAR) is first...**RHP Logan Webb** leads all Giants with 3.0 fWAR.
- ▶ He's also riding a nine-game hitting streak into today's game that dates to July 4...the streak is the longest of his brief MLB career thus far.

**STARGAZING:** Ramos, who was born in Humacao, PR but raised in Maunabo, PR, is the first Giants homegrown outfielder to be selected to an All-Star Game since **OF Chili Davis** in 1986.

- ▶ Since being called up on May 8, the 24-year-old leads the National League in RBI (46) and ranks among the top in home runs (14, 4th), batting average (.303, 4th), SLG% (.532, 6th), and OPS (.903, 6th).
- ▶ He has started 58 of SF's 59 games since being recalled and has started in 57 consecutive games entering play today.

**SHAKE & BLAKE:** **LHP Blake Snell** aims to build off his last outing in his final first half start today against the Twins.

- ▶ Snell turned in his most effective outing as a Giant on Tuesday, spinning 5.0 scoreless innings against the Blue Jays with three walks and three strikeouts...he threw 73 pitches in the outing, his first off the IL (left groin strain).
- ▶ According to *Sports Info Solutions*, the Blue Jays had only four hard-hit balls off Snell Tuesday and all four were outs.
- ▶ Today's outing marks Snell's eighth for SF after signing late in Spring Training...he's missed a total of 59 games this year with two IL stints and one trip to the Paternity List.

**FUTURES:** Giants prospect **IF Bryce Eldridge** (#2 on MLB's Top-30 Giants prospects and #70 in MLB.com's Top-100 prospects) went 1-for-2 with an opposite field single for the National League in yesterday's Futures Game in Arlington, TX.

**TEXAS PICK 'EM:** The 2024 MLB draft kicks off tonight beginning at 7 p.m. ET on ESPN with the first 74 picks of the draft (the first two rounds, compensatory rounds, competitive balance rounds and prospect promotion incentive selections).

- ▶ The Giants will pick 13th in the first round tonight and then not pick again until Round 4 on Monday after losing their second and third round picks for the free agent signings of **IF Matt Chapman** and **LHP Blake Snell** this past offseason.
- ▶ The last time SF picked 13th in the 1st round was 2020 when they selected **C Patrick Bailey** out of NC State.
- ▶ Rounds 3-10 of the draft take place on Monday and the draft concludes on Tuesday with rounds 11-20...Day 2 and 3 of the draft will begin at 2 p.m. ET each day and can be watched on MLB.com.

**REST UP, WE GO ON FRIDAY:** The Giants return to play Friday with a seven-game road trip straight out of the break...they'll visit Colorado for three Friday-Sunday before heading to LA to play the Dodgers in a four-game set from July 22-25.

- ▶ Those four games are the final four regular season matchups between the Giants and Dodgers this season.

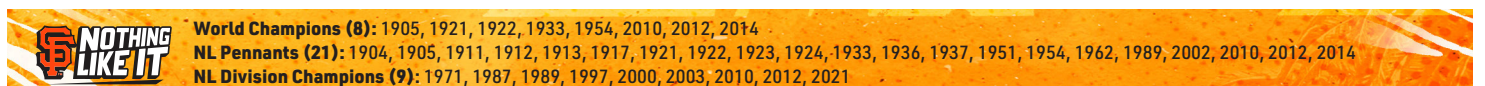
**RAY'S UP:** **LHP Robbie Ray** is slated to make another rehab start at Single-A San Jose this afternoon...he's expected to be in the 65-75 pitch range.

- ▶ For Ray, it'll be his ninth rehab game (eighth start)...he's appeared in four games in the ACL, two in Triple-A and this will mark his third at Single-A San Jose.
- ▶ In other rehab news, **RHP Alex Cobb** is slated to make his next rehab appearance tomorrow.

**CITY BY THE BLAKE:** The reigning NL Cy Young will make his second start back from the Injured List, and eighth start overall after joining SF late in the spring on a two-year, \$62 million contract (includes an opt out after the 2024 season).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Made his first start back from a left groin strain that held him out of MLB action since June 2...pitched a season-high 5.0 innings (73 pitches) with three strikeouts while allowing no runs on one hit and three walks in the first game of this home-stand (July 9) vs. Toronto.

**REHAB UPDATE:** Through the three tuneup starts, Snell posted a 4.66 ERA (5er, 9.2ip), a 1.24 WHIP and 15 strikeouts...in the three rehab starts, opponents went 1-for-10 (.100) with seven strikeouts against his curveball, and 2-for-13 (.154) with a home run and five strikeouts against his fastball.

**VS. MINNESOTA:** The Twins have been a thorn in Snell's side throughout his career...he is 2-2 with a 5.97 ERA (19er, 28.2ip), 33 strikeouts, .313 opposing batting average and 1.50 WHIP in six starts...the 5.97 ERA is his highest against teams he has at least six career starts...he hasn't faced the Twins since July 29, 2022 with San Diego at Petco Park...in that outing, Snell struck out seven and allowed one run on four hits over 6.0 innings in a 10-1 Padres win.

**YOU AGAIN:** Snell has done well against the Twins veteran hitters between the regular and Postseason...IF Carlos Correa is 3-for-14 (.214) with a double and three strikeouts in his career vs. Snell...IF Carlos Santana is 2-for-15 (.133) and OF Byron Buxton is 1-for-7 (.143), yet each has a home run.

**DOWN AND OUT:** Snell has thrice been on an inactive list for SF...he missed 31 games during this most recent trip to the IL (left groin strain), and paired with his trip to the Paternity List (May 23-May 26) and his first time on the IL with a left adductor strain (April 23-May 22), has missed a total of 59 games for SF.

**CURVE IT:** Opponents are hitting .103 (3x29) against Snell's curveball with 14 strikeouts this season...in his last start, Toronto was 0-for-5 against his curveball...Minnesota has a .241/.299/.393 slash line against curveballs this season with their .692 OPS ranking sixth-best in MLB...of Snell's 234 strikeouts last season, 109 came on his curveball...opponents hit .079 on the pitch with a .140 slugging percentage...his curveball had a run value of 22 last season after posting a run value of three in 2022...the 22 run value was the second-best rated curveball behind Atlanta RHP Charlie Morton's 25, and rated as the sixth-best pitch overall.

**WALK IT BACK:** This season, Snell has walked 17 batters in 28.2 innings (12.4% walk rate)...the Twins do not walk a lot, with their 7.7% walk rate ranking 21st in MLB while their 31.9% O-Swing rate (percent of swings at pitches outside the strike zone) is 14th in MLB...the lefty became the first pitcher since ERA was established in both leagues in 1913 to finish as baseball's leader in walks (99) and ERA (2.25), doing so last season.

**FAST TIMES:** Snell's four-seam fastball, which he's used 47.6% of the time this year w/SF, has a .375 opposing batting average (18x48) and a .667 slugging percentage...Minnesota is toward the top of MLB against left-handed four-seam fastballs, with a .281/.353/.498 slash line and a .851 OPS (sixth-best in MLB).
