## SNAKEBITES

**THE NL CHAMPS:** Last season, the D-backs captured their second NL pennant and made their second trip to the World Series, first since winning it all in 2001, in their seventh Postseason berth ('99, '01, '02, '07, '11, '17, '23).

**LAST GAME:** The D-backs lost 6-2 vs. Reds.

◆ **Slade Cecconi** took the loss (6 ER in 5.2 IP).

◆ **Blaze Alexander** had a 2-run single in the third inning.

◆ **Kevin Newman** had a single, double and walk.

**A BRIGHT SPOT:** **Slade Cecconi** went 6 up 6 down to start last night's game to become the only Major League pitcher in the last 50 years to be perfect through 2.0 innings in 5 consecutive starts at any part of the season [source: Stats LLC].

**SNAKEBITES:** The D-backs are 6-3 in their last 9 games.

◆ The D-backs, in 1-run decisions, have won 5 of their last 6 such games and are an overall 7-5 in 1-run games and 10-10 in 1- or 2-run games.

**DAY GAMES:** The D-backs are 5-2 in their last 7 day games, 1-0 at home and 4-2 on the road.

◆ Overall, are 8-6 in day games, 3-2 at home and 5-4 on the road.

◆ **Joc Pederson** has reached base in 10 of 13 day games, hitting .333 (10-for-30)/1.178 OPS with 3 doubles, 3 homers, 4 RBI and 4 walks.

**PFAADT PFEELING IT:** **Brandon Pfaadt** has quality starts in 4 of his last 5 outings, missing another by 0.2 of an inning (3.56 ERA, .237 opponent average, 5 BB, 25 K).

**VS. REDS:** The D-backs, in their last 25 games vs. Reds, since 2021, are 15-10 overall, including 7-5 at home.

◆ The D-backs are 6-2 in their last 8 day games vs. Reds, since April 11, 2021 (3-0 at home, 3-2 on the road).

**AT HOME VS. NL CENTRAL:** The D-backs are 15-9 at home vs. NL Central since last season (11-5 in 2023).

**NEWMAN STREAKING:** **Kevin Newman** has a career-high-tying 4 straight multi-hit games May 11-present (also: May 23-28, 2023)...last season was the most recent occurrence with a trio of 4-game streaks: Christian Walker (June 16-19, 2023; May 2-6, 2023) and Ketel Marte (April 17-21, 2023)...the last 5-gamer was Pavin Smith from May 25-29, 2021...6 games has been done 4 times, 7 games once and the club-record 8 games once.

◆ In his last 9 games, since May 4, is hitting .467 (14-for-30)/1.200 OPS with 5 doubles, 1 triple, 2 RBI and 2 walks.

**JOC AT HOME:** **Joc Pederson**, among all players at home (min. 50 PA), is sixth with a .660 SLG and 10th with a 1.073 OPS.

◆ In his last 7 home games, is hitting .321 (9-for-28)/.964 OPS with 3 doubles, 2 homers and 3 RBI.

**bWAR(e) OF KETEL:** **Ketel Marte's** 2.7 bWAR is fourth among all players [pitcher or position], behind Mookie Betts/LAD (3.4), Bobby Witt Jr./KC (3.0) and Shohei Ohtani/LAD (2.8).

**MARTE STREAKING:** **Ketel Marte's** season-long 14-game hitting streak is the longest active streak in the Majors and tied for the fourth-longest overall hitting streak this season, behind Alec Bohm/PHI (18), Marcell Ozuna/ATL (16) and Ozzie Albies/ATL (15).

• His career best is 16 games (May 16-June 4, 2022; .390, 23-for-59, 7 2B, 1 HR, 9 RBI, 5 BB).

• His 10 career hit streaks of 10+ games are third in team history (Luis Gonzalez - 12; Paul Goldschmidt - 11).

◆ Has hit safely in 9 straight home games at a .395 clip (15-for-38)/1.162 OPS with 4 doubles, 3 homers, 5 RBI and 2 walks.

**MAY BLOOM:** **Kevin Newman**, in 11 games in May, is hitting .467 (14-for-30)/1.200 OPS with 5 doubles, 1 triple, 2 RBI and 2 walks.

◆ **Jake McCarthy**, in 11 games in May, has a .304 AVG (7-for-23)/.970 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 homer, 4 RBI and 6 walks.

◆ **Joc Pederson**, in 12 games in May, is hitting .308 (12-for-39)/.973 OPS with 3 doubles, 3 homers, 4 RBI and 2 walks.

**BULLPEN HANGING ZEROES:** **Ryan Thompson** has held opponents scoreless in his last 7 games (7.1 IP) and 15 of 17 games overall (2 ER in 17.0 IP).

◆ **Joe Mantiplay** has held opponents scoreless in 9 of his last 10 games (1 ER in 9.1 IP).

◆ **Justin Martinez** has held opponents scoreless in 5 outings in May (6.2 IP) and 9 of 10 overall this season.

**STARTERS STALLING OPPONENTS:** D-backs starting pitchers have allowed 3 or fewer runs in 7 of their last 8 starts, since May 7 (3.91 ERA, .250 opponent average, 16 walks and 27 strikeouts).

◆ When D-backs starting pitchers allow 3 or fewer runs, the team is 18-14.

**CALL TO THE 'PEN:** The D-backs bullpen in its last 8 games has a 3.46 ERA (11 R-10 ER in 26.0 IP), .258 opponent average (25-for-97), .731 opponent OPS, 11 walks and 23 strikeouts.

**ABOVE AVERAGE DEFENDERS:** The D-backs are the only team to feature multiple players in the Top 10 of MLB Outs Above Average leaders: **Christian Walker** (T-3rd, 7), **Ketel Marte** (T-5th, 6) and **Kevin Newman** (T-10th, 4).

**ON DECK - DETROIT TIGERS:** The D-backs are 23-17 all-time vs. Tigers, 11-9 at home.

◆ Eighth time facing the Tigers at Chase Field (2001, '02, '05, '08, '14, '17, '22).

◆ Last faced the Tigers last season in Detroit, sweeping a 3-game set from June 9-11 (outscored them 23-11).

**WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:** Ninth start of the season, fifth on the road.

- Has 4 quality starts in his last 5 bids.
- Has tossed 5.0+ innings in 9 consecutive starts dating back to Sept. 27, 2023.

**NL RANKINGS:** Ranks among NL starters in walks (T-2nd, 8), walks per 9.0 innings (4th, 1.53) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (6th, 5.25) and

**LAST START:** Took the loss on May 10 @ Orioles (3 ER in 6.0 IP, 5 H, 2 BB).

**VS. REDS:** Third career start vs. Reds.

- Won his lone home start on Aug. 25 @ Chase Field (2 ER in 5.1 IP, 3 H, 1 BB, 5 K).
- In 2 career starts, is 1-1 with a 3.97 ERA (5 ER in 11.1 IP, 11 K).

**VS. NL CENTRAL @ HOME:** In 4 career starts vs. NL Central opponents @ home, is 2-1 with a 3.80 ERA (11 R-10 ER in 23.2 IP) and 21 strikeouts.

- Has allowed 2 or fewer runs in 2 of those 4 games and walked 2 or fewer batters in all 4 contests, including 2 games with 1 walk and 1 game with 0.

**IT'S UNDER CONTROL:** His 88.2 pct. competitive pitch location (pct. of pitches within the center of the zone) ranks fourth in the NL [min. 6 starts], behind only Martín Pérez/PIT (89.1%), Jake Irvin/WSH (89.0%) and Trevor Rogers/MIA (88.4%).

- His 67.8 strike pct. ranks sixth in the NL [min. 6 starts], behind Jared Jones/PIT (71.9%), Chris Sale/ATL (70.5%), Yoshinobu Yamamoto/LAD (68.3%), Yu Darvish/SD (68.0%) and Sonny Gray/STL (67.9%).
- His 4.0 walk pct. is third in the NL (min: 25 innings)...boasts a 2.1 walk pct. with runners in scoring position, which ranks fourth in the NL [min. 6 starts], behind 3 others who have not allowed a walk with runners in scoring position.

**VS RIGHTIES:** Is holding right-handed hitters to a .198 average (19-for-96) with 3 walks and 26 strikeouts.

**NO-HIT FRAMES:** His 4.0 no-hit innings tossed on April 22 @ Cardinals were the second longest of his career, behind his 6.1 innings on Aug. 18, 2023 @ Padres.

**FIRST PITCH SUCCESS:** His first-pitch swing (34.0 to 44.2) and first-pitch strike (63.9 to 74.4) percentages are up from 2023.

**BATTED BALL STATS:** From 2023 to 2024, his groundball percentage is up to 42.5 from 32.6 while his fly ball percentage is down to 26.0 from 33.9.

**2023 RECAP:** Went 3-9 with a 5.72 ERA (61 ER in 96.0 IP) in 18 starts with Arizona.

- Entered the season rated as the D-backs' No. 4 prospect by The Athletic (No. 38 overall) and MLB Pipeline (No. 59 overall) and No. 5 by *Baseball America*.
- Made his Major League debut on May 3 @ Rangers (7 ER in 4.2 IP)... was the second D-backs starting pitcher to make their MLB debut @ Rangers and first @ Globe Life Field (last: Nelson Figueroa on June 3, 2000).
- Struck out Josh Jung in the second inning for his first career strike-out.
- Earned his first Major League win on August 25 vs. Reds (2 ER in 5.1 IP, 5 K).
- Recorded 3 career-high-tying 8-strikeout games on Aug. 13 vs. Padres and back-to-back on Sept. 22 @ Yankees and Sept. 27 @ White Sox.
- Owned a 12.2 inning scoreless streak from 8/13/23 vs. SD (2nd inning) - 8/25/23 vs. CIN (2nd inning).
- Appeared in 1 game in relief, the first of his career, on Sept. 10 vs. Cubs (4 ER in 6.0 IP).

**2023 POSTSEASON HIGHLIGHTS:** Appeared in 5 Postseason games, going 0-1 with a 3.27 ERA (8 ER in 22.0 IP) and 26 strikeouts.

- Made his Postseason debut in Game 1 of the NL Wild Card on Oct. 3 @ Brewers (3 ER in 2.2 IP).
- Was the second-youngest (24-353) pitcher to start a Postseason game in franchise history, behind Daniel Hudson (24-207 on Oct. 2, 2011 @ Brewers) [source: Elias Sports Bureau].
- Became the third D-backs rookie to start a Postseason game (also: Josh Collmenter/2011 vs. MIL and Micah Owings/2007 @ COL [source: Elias Sports Bureau]).
- Tossed 4.1 scoreless innings in his second career Postseason start and first @ Chase Field on Oct. 11 vs. Dodgers in NLDS Game 3.
- Became the youngest (24-361) D-backs' pitcher to start a home Postseason game in franchise history (previous: Josh Collmenter (25-239) vs. Brewers on Oct. 4, 2011 in NLDS Game 3) [source: Elias Sports Bureau].
- Tossed 5.2 scoreless innings in his first career start vs. Phillies @ Chase Field on Oct. 19 in Game 3 of the NLCS (2 H, 0 BB, 9 K).
- Became the first pitcher in MLB history to allow 0 runs and 0 walks in consecutive Postseason starts (source: @ESPNStatsInfo).
- Became the second pitcher in franchise history to strike out 9+ batters without a walk in a Postseason game (also: Curt Schilling, 2001 World Series Game 7) and the fourth Rookie pitcher in MLB Postseason history to record 8+ strikeouts without a walk.

**HOW IT STARTED:** Selected by the D-backs in the fifth round of the 2020 First-Year Player draft out of Bellarmine University.

- Named the D-backs' 2022 Minor League Pitcher of the Year after going 11-7 with a 3.83 ERA (71 ER in 167.0 IP), 218 strikeouts and 1.16 WHIP in 29 starts with Double-A Amarillo and Triple-A Reno...led all organization farmhands in wins, ERA and strikeouts.
- Attended Bellarmine University for 3 years (2018-2020)...was the second-highest draft pick in school history behind Todd Wellemeyer (4th round, 2000) and 9th all-time.
