TONIGHT'S GAME: Is Game 2 (1-0) of a 3-game series vs **Fredy Quevedo's Cubs** and the seventh game (3-3) of a 9-game homestand that includes a pair of series losses vs **Bal** (1-2) and **Phi** (1-2).

REDS SELECT SS JUSTIN LEBRON: The Reds earlier today selected **SS Justin Lebron** with their first pick (18th overall) in the 2026 MLB Draft.

- The Reds will complete the first day of the draft by selecting 58th (second round), 70th (Competitive Balance Round B), 94th (third round), and 122nd (fourth round).

ALL-STARS: **RHP Chase Burns** and **INF Sal Stewart** have been named to the 2026 National League All-Star team.

- It's the first career All-Star selection for both players.
- 2026 marks the third straight year in which Cin has multiple All-Stars.
- Burns** and **Stewart** are the third set of teammates in Reds history to each earn an All-Star selection at age 23 or younger in the same season (also **Johnny Bench & Wayne Simpson** in 1970, and **Frank Robinson & Vada Pinson** in 1959).

★ CHASE BURNS ★

- Is the third Reds pitcher in club history with 11 or more wins and 118 or more strikeouts before the All-Star break, joining **Edinson Volquez** (12w, 126k in 2008) and **Jim Maloney** (13w, 121k in 1963).
- Along with **AZ's Eduardo Rodriguez**, leads the majors with 15 starts of 2 runs or fewer.
- Is 10-0 with a 2.58 ERA over his last 14 starts...is the first Reds pitcher since 1985 to win 10 or more consecutive decisions during a single season.
- The Reds are 14-4 this season when he pitches, including team victories in each of his last 6 apps and in 10 of his last 11.
- He ranks among Major League starting pitcher leaders in wins (11, T1st), ERA (2.54, 8th), runs allowed per game (1.61, 2nd), opponents' batting avg (.206, 6th), and strikeouts (118, 14th).
- Owns a 31.7% miss rate (819 swings/260 misses), 7th-best in MLB.
- His 4.3 WAR leads the Reds and ranks fifth among all Major League pitchers.
- Will be 23 years, 179 days old on the day of the All-Star Game (7/14), the youngest Reds All-Star pitcher since **Mike LaCoss** in 1979 (23 years, 48 days).

★ SAL STEWART ★

- Finished second in the player balloting for NL third basemen (228 votes; **Max Muncy** 555 votes).
- Was National League Rookie of the Month for April.
- Is the seventh rookie in Reds history to make the All-Star team, the first since **Scott Williamson** in 1999, and the first position player since **Chris Sabo** in 1988.
- Leads the Reds with 19 HR, 65 RBI, 91 H, 45 walks, and 40 XBH.
- His 19 HR before the All-Star break are more than any other Reds rookie in franchise history (first ASG was in 1933).
- Ranks among all Major League leaders with 65 RBI.
- Joined **Jim Greengrass** (1953) and **Tony Cuccinello** (1930) as just the third Reds rookie since 1920 to have multiple months with at least 20 RBI (26 in April, 22 in June).
- Became the sixth Reds batter since 1900 with at least 20 HR through his first 100 Major League games, joining **Adam Dunn** (27), **Hank Sauer** (26), **Aristides Aquino** (25), **Frank Robinson** (25), and **Bernie Carbo** (20).
- Leads all NL Rookies in HR, RBI, 2B (21), BB, XBH, and TB (169).
- Is the eighth Red to ever earn an All-Star nod at age 22 or younger, the first since teammate **Elly De La Cruz** in 2024.

SERIES NOTES: The Reds and **Cubs** are meeting for the second time this season...**Chc** swept the 4-game series at **Wrigley Field** from 5/4-5/7...that series featured 3 straight walkoff wins by the **Cubs** (5/4-5/6)...it was the first time **Chc** swept Cin in a 4-game series since 8/23-8/26, 2018 (also at **Wrigley Field**)...it was **Chc's** first sweep of Cin of any length since 2022. .

- Last year, Cin went 8-5 vs **Chc** for its third straight season series victory.
- The Reds are 197-194 vs **Chc** since 2003 and 94-112 since 2014...are 103-87 (.542) all time at **Great American Ball Park** and 469-505 (.482) all-time at **Wrigley Field**.

ELLY MAKING HISTORY: **SS Elly De La Cruz** (494 career games) is the second player in Major League history to produce at least 75 HR and 150 SB within his first 500 career games, joining Reds Hall of Famer **Eric Davis**, who had 107 HR and 190 SB through his first 500 career games.

- Elly** enters tonight's game with 199 career extra-base hits.

BRING 'EM ON: The Reds own a 29-33 record (.468) this season against opponents entering play with a .500-or-better winning percentage, but are 22-35 (.386) vs teams currently at or above .500.

- Have dropped 30 of their last 44 games vs teams entering play with a .500-or-better winning percentage.
- Are 21-15 (.5683) vs teams currently under .500.
- Have the second-toughest remaining schedule in the majors based on opponents' winning percentage (.530; **NYM** .537).

STRUGGLING AGAINST PEERS: The Reds are 6-20 (.231) vs their NL Central counterparts and 23-37 (.383) against all National League opponents.

- Conversely, Cin owns the majors' seventh-best record vs American League teams (20-13, .606).

TOUGH SLEDDING: The Reds have dropped 8 of their last 12 games and 11 of their last 17 games.

- Went 20-11 (.645) to begin the year...entered May a season-high 9 games over .500 and in first place in the NL Central (+1.0)...ended the month 2 games over .500 and in fifth place (-6.0).
- Beginning 5/1, have gone 23-39 (.371).
- Beginning 6/1, have gone 13-22 (.371).

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the 3-2 win on Sun, 7/5 vs Bal (6.0ip, 6h, 1r/1er, 2bb, 4k, 97TP).

- His 2nd-inning strikeout of Jeremiah Jackson marked the 500th of his Major League career.
- Extended his scoreless innings streak to 14.0 before allowing an RBI-single to Coby Mayo in the 6th inning...was the second-longest streak of his career (15ip, 2025).
- Threw 28 of his 97 pitches in the 6th inning.
- Held batters to 1-for-14 when ahead in the count.
- Threw first-pitch-strikes to 19 of his 26 batters.
- Marked his third quality start of the season, his first since 5/31 vs Atl.

JUNE 29 at MIL: Did not factor in the decision in the 5-3 loss on Mon, 6/29 at Mil (5.0ip, 1h, 0r, 4bb, 4k, 1hb, 96TP).

- Was in line for his third win but fell victim to a Chase Petty blown save.
- Allowed 6 base runners (4 walks, 1hb).
- Was just the third time in his career that he allowed fewer than 2 hits over at least 5.0 innings pitched (4/13/24 at CWS & 4/29/24 at SD).

JUNE 23 vs MIL (Injured): Did not factor in the decision in the 2-0 loss vs Mil on Tue, 6/23 (4.0ip, 2h, 0r, 1bb, 6k, 75TP).

- Left the game after the 4th inning with a left wrist contusion suffered when Jackson Chourio led off the inning with a 107.6 mph single back to the mound...managed to pitch out of a 1-out bases loaded jam that inning before exiting.
- Allowed just 3 of his 15 batters to reach...faced the minimum through the first 3 innings.

JUNE 17 vs NYM: Suffered the 9-1 loss on Wed, 6/17 vs NYM (4.2ip, 11h, 7r/7er, 2bb, 2k, 90TP) .

- The 11 hits were 1 shy of his career high.
- Threw 33 of his 90 pitches in the 3rd inning.
- His 94.7mph max velocity was his lowest since 7/18/25 at NYM (94.4mph).
- For the second time in 3 starts, allowed a season-high 21 balls in play.

HOMERLESS INNINGS STREAK

Has not allowed a home run in 25.0 consecutive innings (since 6/12 vs AZ), the longest single-season streak of his career.

500 STRIKEOUTS

Struck out Bal's Jeremiah Jackson in the 2nd inning on 7/5 for his 500th Major League strikeout...became the third-fastest Reds pitcher by appearances (87) to reach that milestone since 1893 (when the mound moved to its current distance), behind Hunter Greene (74g) and Luis Castillo (79g).
