



## Houston Astros (30-37) at San Francisco Giants (33-34) RHP Ronel Blanco (5-2, 2.78) vs. RHP Jordan Hicks (4-2, 2.82)

**TODAY'S GAME:** SF aims to secure its second consecutive series win after claiming the first game of this three-game series last night, 4-3.

- ▶ Despite a recent season-high six-game losing streak from May 29-June 4, the Giants have still won 14 of their last 23 games dating to May 15 (a .609 winning percentage).
- ▶ The .609 win % in that time is fifth-best in the Majors behind the Yankees (19-6, .760), Guardians (15-6, .714), Phillies (15-7, .682) and Orioles (17-8, .680).
- ▶ Since that aforementioned six-game slide, the Giants have won four of their last five games with the only loss coming to the Rangers on Sunday in Arlington.

**I PUT ON FOR MY CITY:** SF is wearing its City Connect uniforms for the third time this season, having gone 1-1 in the Creamsicle jerseys this year.

- ▶ Overall, SF is 27-11 in these uniforms since they made their debut in 2021 with a +46 run differential.

**MORE OF THIS, PLZ:** LHP Kyle Harrison worked 6.1 innings in last night's SF win...he's the first Giants starter other than RHP Logan Webb to record an out in the 7th inning since he himself did so over a month ago on May 7 at Colorado when he twirled 7.0 shutout innings.

- ▶ Overall it was just the third time this year a Giants starter other than Webb has recorded an out in the 7th inning... besides Harrison's two instances, tonight's starter RHP Jordan Hicks has the other one (7.0ip in the home opener on April 5 vs. San Diego).
- ▶ Giants starters have thrown the third-fewest innings in the Majors this year (325.0) behind only Milwaukee (312.2) and Miami (318.1).

**TEXAS TWO-STEP:** After taking two-of-three from the Rangers over the weekend in Arlington, the Giants are looking to secure this series against Houston here in SF.

- ▶ Dating back to August 11, 2020, the Giants have won six of their last nine games against Houston, despite a -1 run differential (40-41).
- ▶ Since Oracle Park opened in 2000, the Giants are 33-19 (.635) against the Astros here...that's SF's third-best winning % against an opponent at home since 2000 (min. 50g).

**MR. BRIGHTSIDE: OF Heliot Ramos** has been a bright spot for SF since his call-up on May 8, reaching base safely in 27-of-his-30 games since the call-up with a .318/.405/.527 slash line, five doubles, six homers and 23 RBI.

- ▶ In nine games this month he's 14-for-35 (.400) with five extra-base hits (one double, four homers), 10 RBI, six runs scored and six walks.
- ▶ In the 29 games Ramos has started, the Giants are averaging 5.14 runs per game and hitting .255, compared to 3.6 runs per games and a .237 average when he doesn't (SIS).
- ▶ The Giants are 17-12 in Ramos' 29 starts this year.
- ▶ Defensively, Ramos has been worth +7 DRS in the outfield in 253.2 innings...the +7 DRS is tied for sixth-best among all MLB outfielders.

**KICKS WITH HICKS:** RHP Jordan Hicks makes his 14th start of the season with his outing tonight against the Astros...the Houston-born Hicks enters tonight's contest with the eighth-best ERA in the NL at 2.82.

- ▶ He also enters this outing with a 53.6 groundball percentage, fifth-best in the Majors behind PHI's Cristopher Sánchez (62.7%), ATL's Max Fried (61.4%), teammate Logan Webb (56.6%) and BOS' Tanner Houck (54.5%).
- ▶ Hicks' pitch count got the best of him last Wednesday in Arizona as he threw 92 pitches in 3.2 innings while allowing two runs in SF's 9-3 win...he struck out seven and walked four in what was his shortest start of the year.
- ▶ In seven starts here at Oracle he's logged a 2.52 ERA (11 er, 39.1ip) but the Giants have only gone 3-4 in those games.

**CHAPSTICK: IF Matt Chapman**, who has missed the last two games nursing a sore right hamstring, enters tonight's game with a 25-game on-base streak...the streak is the fourth-longest active streak in MLB behind NYY's Aaron Judge (35), TEX's Corey Seager (28) and STL's Paul Goldschmidt (26).

- ▶ The 25-game streak is the longest by a Giant since IF Eduardo Núñez reached base in 33 straight games from May 12-July 16, 2017.
- ▶ He has a slash line of .295/.407/.526 with 22 runs, four home runs and 14 RBI over the streak.

**ON THE BRINK: IF Wilmer Flores** logged a pinch-hit single for his 999th career hit...when Flores reaches the 1,000-hit mark, he'll be 17th Venezuelan-born player to record at least 1,000 career hits and 150 career homers.

- ▶ Since May 12, Flores has slashed .266/.333/.438 for a .771 OPS with two doubles, three homers, eight RBI and nine runs scored (20 games).

**LET'S 'DANCE:** The Giants drew 32,820 fans to Oracle Park for last night's win over the Astros...it marked SF's 20th straight game dating to April 24 drawing at least 30,000 fans...*that is the longest streak since they did so in 30 consecutive games from June 12-August 14, 2019.*

- ▶ Overall, the Giants are averaging 33,440 fans per game at home this year...that is eighth-best in the Majors...last season, SF averaged 30,866 fans (17th of 30 MLB teams).

**This Date in Giants History**

**June 11, 1944** - The New York Giants took a doubleheader from the Phillies by identical scores of 6-5. In the first game, the Giants used 22 players including five pitchers, three catchers, three second basemen, three pinch hitters and two pinch runners.

**WELCOME TO SF:** Hicks signed with San Francisco as a free agent on January 18, 2024 on a four-year deal worth \$44 million...he was originally drafted by the Cardinals in the supplemental third round (105th overall) of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft and spent his whole career with St. Louis before being traded to Toronto in July last season for RHP Sem Robberse and RHP Adam Kloffenstein.

**PUSH TO START:** Has transitioned from a relief role into a traditional starting role this year...has made 21 career starts entering today, 13 of which have come this season...prior to this year, he had pitched 204 games out of the bullpen over parts of five Major League seasons...Hicks worked almost exclusively out of the rotation in the minor leagues, but the Cardinals ended up moving him to the bullpen to accelerate his path to the Majors.

**LAST OUTING:** Did not factor into the decision in his last start on June 5 at Chase Field...threw a season-low 3.2 innings and allowed two runs on six hits and four walks with seven strikeouts (92 pitches)...according to *SIS*, he recorded the highest average velocity on fastballs in a start (96.4mph) since April 16 vs. the Marlins (96.7mph).

**VS. HOUSTON:** Has made just one appearance against the Astros in his career and earned the save as he threw 1.0-scoreless inning of relief on June 27, 2023 while with St. Louis...Hicks was born and raised in Houston, TX, where he still currently resides in the off-season...he grew up an Astros fan and his favorite players were Lance Berkman and Craig Biggio.

**SEIZE THE DAY:** The right-hander is 3-0 with a 1.72 ERA (7er, 36.2ip) and .189 opposing average in seven day games this season...for comparison, Hicks has a 1-2 record and 4.15 ERA in six night starts.

**TOP OF THE CHARTS:** Has a 2.82 ERA through 12 outings, which currently ranks as the eighth-best ERA in the National League...his 54.2% groundball rate is fourth-highest in the NL.

**TRYING NOT TO SINK:** Opponents are hitting .338 against the sinker in May and June, 100 points higher than they hit against it in March and April (*SIS*).

**SPLIT SECOND:** Opponents are hitting just .150 (9-for-60) with 22 strikeouts off his splitter...however, in his last two starts, opponents have been 8-for-13 with a home run...he's been using the pitch 23.1% of the time this year.

**VIA THE LONGBALL:** Has allowed five home runs over his last five outings...prior to that, Hicks had allowed just one home run over his first eight starts.

**THIRD TIME'S A CHARM:** Has faired well when pitching longer into the game so far this season, with opponents going 10-for-42 (.238) the third time through the lineup.

**HIGH-FIVE:** Hicks has pitched 5.0+ innings in 11 of his 13 starts this season...the only times he hasn't reach the 5th inning was on May 3 at Philly when he tossed 4.0 innings and on June 5 at Arizona when he threw 3.1 innings.

**FEEL THE HEAT:** Since entering the Majors in 2018, Hicks has consistently been one of the hardest throwing pitchers in the league...he has thrown 5,246 pitches in his Major League career, with 1,680 clocked at over 100 mph (32.0%)...so far this year he hasn't thrown a pitch above 100 with his fastest pitch logging in at 99.5 mph on March 30 at San Diego.

**DIABETIC PHENOM:** Was diagnosed with Type 1 diabetes at age 17 while in high school...he calls himself the "diabetic phenom", which was the Xbox identity he chose for himself...Diabetic phenom evolved into his brand and he now sells merchandise...he wears cleats that say "Type 1" on them when he pitches.
