# ATLANTA BRAVES (7-5-1) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (5-7)

TODAY'S GAME: The Braves continue their exhibition schedule today against the Pittsburgh Pirates with their 14th of 32 games this spring.. The club will play 16 games at CoolToday Park in North Port, Fla. and 16 games on the road...This afternoon's contest is the second of four scheduled exhibition meetings between the clubs...Pittsburgh won the first exhibition, 13-4, on February 27...The teams will play again on March 12 and 16... The Pirates will field a split-squad for today's game and again on March 16.

A The Braves will host nine different major league teams at CoolToday Park, including three games each against the Baltimore Orioles and Minnesota Twins and two games each against the Boston Red Sox, Pittsburgh Pirates and Tampa Bay Rays...The Detroit Tigers, New York Yankees, Philadelphia Phillies and Toronto Blue Jays will make one visit each to North Port.

A On March 17, Atlanta will travel to Boston's JetBlue Park at Fenway South in Fort Myers, Fla. for the inaugural edition of MLB Spring Breakout...The event is aimed toward showcasing baseball's future: the current stars of Minor League Baseball...Games will be played between teams comprised of each MLB organization's top prospects.

CAMP BREAKDOWN: The Braves currently have 42 players in camp, 19 of whom are pitchers (seven left-handers and 12 right-handers)...Atlanta also has five catchers, 13 infielders and eight outfielders in camp...There are 12 non-roster invitees (one pitcher, three catchers, five infielders and three outfielders)...The club opened camp with 60 players.
A On Friday, the Braves optioned LHP Ray Kerr and OF J.P. Martínez to Triple-A Gwinnett, and reassigned RHP Ken Giles to minor league camp.
A On March 5, MLB Pipeline unveiled its prospect rankings for the 2024 season...Atlanta opened camp with seven players that currently rank among the team's top 30 prospects, including top overall prospect, RHP AJ Smith-Shawver...Also included are fellow top 10 prospects RHP Hurston Waldrep (No. 2) and INF Nacho Alvarez Jr. (No. 6).

23 IN '23: The Braves clinched the 23rd division title in franchise history last season, beating Philadelphia, 4-1 on September 13 at Citizens Bank Park to win the National League East...The 23 division titles are the most in major league history, two more than Los Angeles (NL) and three more than New York (AL)...Last season also marked the franchise's 29th postseason berth in the Modern Era (since 1900) and its sixth straight.
A The Braves won a major league-record 14 consecutive division titles from 1991-2005, with the first three coming as NL West champs before moving into the NL East in the strike-shortened 1994 season...They also won the West in 1969 and 1982, and the East in 2013 and every year since 2018

A The six straight division titles marks the longest streak in baseball...The Astros have won three straight AL West titles dating to 2021, while the Dodgers have won each of the last two NL West crowns.

## Probable Pitchers

Max Fried • LHP • 6-4 • 190 • 30 yrs • \#54

- Makes his second start of the spring (2.0 IP, 0 R Feb. 26 vs. Batimore).
- Went $8-1$ with a 2.55 ERA (22 ER/77.2 IP) in 14 starts last season.. Navigated three separate stints on the Injured List: April 4-17 (strained left hamstring), May 9-August 4 (strained left forearm) and September 22 through the end of the regular season (blister on left index finger).
- Served as Atlanta's Opening Day starter in each of the last two seasons...Since the start of 2019, his 60 wins rank second in all of baseball, trailing New York's (AL) Gerrit Cole (71).


## Raisel Iglesias • RHP • 6-2 • $190 \cdot 34$ yrs • \#26

- Makes his second appearance of the spring (1.0 IP, 0 R March 1 vs. Baltimore)...Notched 33 saves in 37 opportunities ( $89.2 \%$ ) last season.
- Entering the third year of a four-year, $\$ 58 \mathrm{M}$ contract he signed with the Los Angeles Angels on November 30, 2021...Acquired by Atlanta on August 2, 2022 in exchange for RHP Jesse Chavez and LHP Tucker Davidson.
