METSCELLANEOUS: The Mets returned to action last night and fell to the Yankees, 6-2...New York is in a stretch where they play 18 of 21 games in the state of New York (4-3)...The Mets are in the midst of a six-game road trip (0-1)...They begin in The Bronx (0-1) before shipping up to Boston for a three-game set.

LET'S NOT GO STREAKING: The Mets have dropped back-to-back games...The team has yet to lose three games in a row...Below is a chart of the longest streaks to start a season by the Mets without losing three in a row, courtesy of Elias.

CH-CH-CHANGES: Major League Baseball announced a scoring change...In the top of the sixth inning of the May 13 game against the Pirates, Jared Triolo reached base on what was originally scored a double...This has been changed to an error by Mark Vientos...As a result, the run is unearned...Kodai Senga's ERA is now 1.02.

HIGH FIVE: Griffin Canning is set to take the bump today...The right-handed pitcher is on a five-game winning streak...That is the longest winning streak by a Mets pitcher since Zack Wheeler won six straight from July 14-August 15, 2018...For Canning, this is his longest winning streak of his career.

SUBWAY SERIES: The Mets are 0-1 in the Subway Series this year...They went 4-0 in the Subway Series in 2024...The Mets earned their second series sweep against the Yankees in franchise history, also accomplished in 2013 (4-0)...In 2023, the Mets went 2-2 against the Yankees, splitting the series in The Bronx and in Queens...The Amazin's are 66-81 vs. the Yankees all-time during the regular season...The Mets are 114-151-2 vs. the Yankees combined in the regular season, World Series, Spring Training, 2020 Summer Camp, Mayor's Trophy Games, Mayor's Challenge Games and the Big Apple Series.

ON THE MARK: On June 25, 2024 at Citi Field, Mark Vientos became the 12th player in franchise history to record a multi-homer game in the Subway Series, joining Pete Alonso, Francisco Lindor, José Reyes Jason Bay, Carlos Delgado, David Wright, Carlos Beltrán, Cliff Floyd, Ty Wigginton, Kaz Matsui and Richard Hildago... He hit safely in each of his first seven career games vs. the Yankees, which is a franchise record.

YOU LOOK FAMILIAR: There have been 167 players who have played for both the Mets and Yankees...Carlos Mendoza managed his first game against the Yankees on June 25, 2024...The Mets skipper spent 15 years in the Yankees system, serving most recently as the team's bench coach...There have been five managers who have guided both teams - Buck Showalter, Casey Stengel, Yogi Berra, Dallas Green and Joe Torre...Courtesy of Elias.

THEY'RE OUT OF OUR LEAGUE: The Mets will play American League teams in nine of their next 12 games (0-1)...This year marked the first time in franchise history that the Mets open their home and road schedule against an Interleague Opponent...The Mets are 7-6 in Interleague Play this season...The team went 24-22 in Interleague Play last year...Overall, New York owns a 285-282 record in Interleague play.

INTERGALACTIC: Pete Alonso has hit a franchise-record 59 home runs in Interleague Play...His 59 home runs are the eighth-most all-time...It is tied for third among active players with Manny Machado...Only Aaron Judge (69) and Kyle Shwarber (60) have hit more.

INVADER NIMS: Brandon Nimmo is on a season-high eight-game hitting streak... He is batting .333 (10-30) in that span with four doubles, one home run, one walk, one steal, four RBI with a .375 OBP and a .567 SLG...He is slashing .261/.324/.543 with seven home runs and 19 RBI in 23 road games...This compares to a .197/.247/.296 slashline with one homer and eight RBI in 20 games at Citi Field.

DON'T STEAL THIS ALBUM: New York Mets backstops have caught 14 of 34 potential runners this season...There 41.2% is the second-best in the majors.

23 AND ME: The Mets have won the last 23 games in which Francisco Lindor has homered...The streak that goes back to July 9, 2024 is the longest streak in team history...Prior to Lindor's streak, the longest was 21 straight wins when George Foster homered between July 3, 1985, and June 29, 1986...The next-longest active streak by any major leaguer is Boston's Ceddanne Rafaela at 17 straight wins... Courtesy of Stats Perform.

LINSANITY: Francisco Lindor has safely reached base in 18 of his last 19 games... In his last 28 games dating back to April 16, has a .328/.400/.569 slashline with 19 runs, four doubles, eight home runs, 21 RBI and nine walks...Lindor is batting .386 (17-44) in the first inning this year...As the first batter of the game, his 17 hits are tied for the most in the majors, while his eight extra-base hits are the second-most...Lindor has hit six lead-off homers as a member of the Mets...That is tied with Mookie Wilson for the seventh-most in team history...Michael Conforto is next with seven leadoff homers.

PITCHING IN: The Mets lead the majors with a 2.89 ERA and are tied for fifth with 406 strikeouts...They are tied for fourth with five shutouts...New York's starting staff has posted an MLB-best 2.83 ERA this year...The bullpen ranks fifth in the majors with a 2.99 ERA.

OUCH: The Mets have been plunked 25 times this year, which is tied for the most in the major leagues...New York was hit 107 times last season, the second-most in the majors and the most in the Senior Circuit...Pete Alonso owns the franchise record, having been hit by 90 pitches in his career...Brandon Nimmo is second with 81, followed by Jeff McNeil at 77 HBP.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his sixth consecutive win in as many starts on May 11 vs. Chicago-NL...He is the first Met to do so since Zack Wheeler had a six-game winning streak in 2018 (7/14-8/15/18)...Gave up one run and two hits over 6.0 innings while striking out five.

START ME UP: His 2.36 ERA (11 ER/42.0 IP) is the best of his career through his first eight games of a season, topping his 3.65 ERA through his first eight starts of 2019...His ERA is the tied for the 13th best in the majors among starters and tied for fifth in the NL (min. 40.0 IP)...His ERA is also the 12th-lowest through a starter’s first eight games with the club, and the lowest since Taijuan Walker’s 2.05 ERA from April 8 - May 17, 2021...He joins Walker as the only Mets starters to record as low of an ERA through their first eight starts with the team since 1998.

VS. YANKEES: Canning has made three career starts against the Yankees and has posted a 3.94 ERA (7 ER/16.0 IP) to go along with 21 strikeouts...He set a career-high with 12 strikeouts against the Yankees on July 17, 2023, while pitching with the Angels.

GRIFFIN FANNING: During Spring Training, he struck out 22 batters over his 14.1 innings of work, highlighted by his nine strikeouts in 4.2 innings vs. Tampa Bay on March 17...His 22 strikeouts ranked ninth in the Grapefruit League and tied for the 17th-most across the majors...Canning finished the spring with an impressive 1.88 ERA (3 ER/14.1 IP) and a K/9. rate of 13.8%...He struck out a season-high eight batters on April 17 vs. St. Louis and he has racked up 42 strikeouts through his first eight starts of this season...In his last two major league seasons, Canning has recorded 130 and 139 strikeouts respectively.

SLIDE TO THE LEFT: Canning has thrown his slider more this season than he ever has before...So far, he has thrown his slider 35.0% of the time compared to 24.1% of the time last season and 29.9% during the 2023 season...He has picked up 16 strikeouts on his slider so far this season and is generating a 32.4% whiff rate on the pitch...His 16 strikeouts with his slider are tied for the 19th-most in the majors this season...He has thrown his slider 249 times this season which is the 10th-most anyone has thrown their slider in majors this year.

WORKHORSE: Last season, he set a career-high with 31 starts and 171.2 innings pitched for the Angels and in 2023 he finished with 127.0 innings...He is just one of 51 pitchers to throw at least 125.0 innings in each of the past two seasons...In the last two seasons combined, Canning has thrown 298.2 innings which ranks 48th in the majors over that time.

KEEP THE CHANGE: Canning's changeup is one of his best pitches and last season it had a run value of four which ranked eighth in the majors...He threw his changeup 26.7% of the time and he held his opponents to a .259 batting average against that pitch...He also generated a 28.8% whiff% on his changeup which was the 11th-highest clip in the majors...So far this season he has thrown it 23.0% and it produced a 25.8% whiff rate while picking up seven strikeouts with the pitch.

STAY GOLDEN: Canning was awarded the American League Rawlings Gold Glove in 2020, and he owns a career .951 fielding percentage...Last season he had a perfect fielding percentage on his 32 chances, and he is perfect through his first seven chances so far this season.

WELCOME TO NEW YORK: He signed a one-year contract with the Mets on December 19, 2024, and he had spent his entire five-year major league career with the Angels prior to signing with the Mets this past offseason...Canning owns a career 30-35 record with a 4.60 ERA (281 ER/550.0 IP) and 525 career strikeouts.

- Didn't allow an earned run and earned his second win of the season on May 12 against the Pirates (W, 1.0 IP, 2 H, R)...His 1.08 ERA (3 ER/25.0 IP) is the best among all Major League pitchers (min. 25.0 IP).
- Entered in the seventh inning on May 7 at Arizona and stranded a runner while picking up the final two outs (0.2 IP, K)...It was his sixth hold of the season and he now has 13 scoreless relief appearances this season.
- In 10 road games this season he has posted a 0.69 ERA (ER/13.0 IP) with one save, four holds, and 12 strikeouts.
- He has made five relief appearance of at least 2.0 innings and all five of those outings have been scoreless (one of five relievers to record as many appearances).
- Has been used as an opener twice this season and he hasn't allowed a run over 3.0 innings total innings as an opener...Had a season-high three strikeouts on April 30 vs. Arizona as a opener.
- Has gone 2-0 with one save, six holds and a 1.08 ERA (3 ER/25.0 IP) through 19 appearances this season, holding batters to a .157 average (13-83)...With runners on base, has held batters to a .077 average (3-39).
- Has produced a run value of four with his sinker this season, tied for the seventh-best among qualified Major League pitchers.
- Got the final two outs and picked up the save in the Mets 6-5 win on April 2 at Miami...It was his first career save after not recording one in his first 118 career appearances.

- Threw 2.0 innings scoreless innings on May 17 against New York-AL (2.0 IP, BB, K)...It was the 12th time since the start of 2024 season that he pitched at least 2.0 innings without allowing an earned run in relief...Which is tied for the fifth most such games in the majors over that span.
- 10 of his 16 appearances this season have been scoreless...Including his last two outings.
- Has completed 1.1 or more innings in 11 of his 16 appearances this season, which is the most such outings among major league relievers...His eight wins since the start of the 2024 season are tied for the 13th-most among major league relievers (tied for sixth-most in the NL).
- Has allowed one or zero runs in 34 of his last 38 appearances, including scoreless outings in 26 of those contests, dating back to July 6, 2024...In that span, has gone 7-0 with three saves, five holds and a 2.44 ERA (16 ER/59.0 IP)...Has held batters to a .198 average (40-202) in that span...Over that range, the Mets are 29-9 in games he has pitched in.
- In 2024 he completed 36.0 innings in 23 relief outings and allowed eight runs (2.00 ERA), going 6-0 with three saves and 41 strikeouts...Was 1-3 with a 3.08 ERA (13 ER/38.0 IP) in seven starts.
