PITTSBURGH PIRATES (52-50) vs. ARIZONA DIAMONDBACKS (53-50) JULY 26, 2024 AT CHASE FIELD, PHOENIX, AZ - 6:40 AZT - GAME #103/ROAD #51 RHP LUIS ORTIZ (5-2, 2.57 ERA) vs. RHP ZAC GALLEN (7-5, 3.64 ERA)

THE PIRATES: Fresh off a 5-0 victory over the Cardinals on Wednesday to secure a series win, the Pirates today begin a road trip with three games against the Arizona Diamondbacks before traveling to Houston for three more against the Astros from July 29-31...The Pirates have gone 5-1 on the road in the month of July after taking two of three games at Milwaukee and sweeping the White Sox in three games in the final trip leading up to the All-Star break.

- The Pirates took two of three games against the Cardinals this week, giving them a 4-1-1 series record this month...The only team with a better series record in July is the Diamondbacks (5-0-1).
- The Bucs are tied with Arizona for the second-best record (12-7) in the National League this month...The Mets have a National League-best 14-7 record in July.

THE SITUATION AT HAND: The Pirates are entering a stretch where they will play opponents with a .500 winning percentage or better for the next 21 consecutive games (six with Arizona, three with Houston, six with San Diego, three with Los Angeles-NL and three with Seattle).

- The Bucs currently sit 1.5 games out of the final Wild Card spot and a half game behind the Arizona Diamondbacks.

WEST COAST DREAMING: The Pirates are 8-7 this season against NL West opponents, including a 7-4 mark since May 4...The Bucs have won three of their last four series against NL West teams, including taking two of three at Colorado from June 14-16, two of three against Los Angeles-NL from June 4-6 and two of three against Colorado from May 3-5...Their only series loss was against the Giants at PNC Park from May 21-23 (lost two of three).

TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS: The Pirates recalled INF/OF **Ji Hwan Bae** from Triple-A Indianapolis in place of OF **Bryan Reynolds**, who was placed on the Major League Bereavement List yesterday...The Pirates also activated RHP **Hunter Stratton** from the 15-day Injured List (right triceps strain) and designated LHP **Josh Fleming** for assignment...The Pirates 40-man roster is now at 39.

PITCHING IN: Pirates starters have posted a 2.96 ERA in the month of July, second best in the majors (Seattle – 2.41). The Pittsburgh bullpen has posted a 2.75 ERA this month, sixth in Major League Baseball...The only other team to rank in the top six in starter and bullpen ERA is the Cubs (starters fourth, bullpen first).

- In total, the Pirates have the fourth-most quality starts (49) in Major League Baseball behind the Mariners (63), Phillies (56) and Royals (52)...The Bucs boast the third-best ERA (3.47) among all starting rotations in MLB behind the Phillies (3.18) and Mariners (3.25).

ABOUT TODAY'S STARTER: **Luis Ortiz** has pitched at least 5.0 innings, allowed five or fewer baserunners and one or zero runs in each of his four starts this season...This is tied with Cliff Lee (2008), Trevor Bauer (2020), Corbin Burnes (2021) and Carlos Rodon (2022) for the longest streak of such starts to begin a season in the modern era (since 1901).

- Dating back to his final start of the 2023 season, Ortiz has thrown 5.0+ innings and allowed four or fewer hits in five consecutive starts, matching the second-longest such streak in franchise history...The only longer streak was six by Francisco Liriano from July 17-Aug. 14, 2014.
- Through four starts this season, Ortiz has posted a 0.73 ERA (2 ER in 24.2 IP) with a .174 opponents batting average (15-for-86).

FACTS AND FIGURES: The Pirates have won 10 straight and 13 of their last 14 games when scoring at least four runs.

- Have drawn at least one walk in 67 straight games, which is the longest active streak in MLB (the longest streak for the season is 75 straight games by the Phillies from 4/15 to 7/9).
- Rank third in all of MLB in stolen base percentage (83.3 percent) behind the Brewers (84.1) and Reds (83.4).

KEEPING UP WITH CUTCH'S MILESTONES: **Andrew McCutchen** ranks 11th in Pirates history coming into today with 1,637 hits...He is one shy of tying Hall of Famer Fred Clarke for the 10th-most in team history.

CALL TO THE PEN: Since June 25, Pittsburgh's bullpen ranks third in MLB with a 2.41 ERA...The only two teams with a lower bullpen ERA during that time are the Cubs (1.53) and Braves (2.09).

- Since allowing six runs on June 15, **Dennis Santana** has an 0.75 ERA (12.0ip/1er)...**Colin Holderman** ranks seventh among all National League relievers this season with a 1.67 ERA...**David Bednar** has the National League's longest active saves streak (17)...In his last 17 appearances out of the bullpen, **Carmen Mlodzinski** has an 0.82 ERA (22.0ip/2er) and a .147 batting average against.

HOW ACQUIRED: Signed by Pittsburgh as a non-drafted free agent on Oct. 2, 2018

STARTING OFF: The 25-year-old right-hander is in his third Major League season, all with the Pirates...Entering today, he's made 48 career appearances (23 starts) for the Bucs, including 22 relief appearances in 2024 (four starts)...He made the first Opening Day roster of his career with the Pirates in 2024 after making just two appearances (both starts) with the club in 2022 and 18 appearances (15 starts) over two stints with the Bucs in 2023...Ortiz was signed by the Pirates as an International Free Agent on October 2, 2018 and is one of four players to come up through the Pirates' Dominican Academy and reach the Major Leagues with the club, joining RHP Yerry De Los Santos, RHP Osvaldo Bido and INF Rodolfo Castro.

STARTING OFF: Ortiz has posted a 2-0 record with a 0.73 ERA (2 ER in 24.2 IP) with 19 strikeouts against three walks and a .174 opponents batting average in his four starts this season.

- Dating back to his final start of the 2023 season, Ortiz has thrown 5.0+ innings and allowed four or fewer hits in five consecutive starts, matching the second-longest such streak in franchise history...The only longer streak was six by Francisco Liriano from July 17-Aug. 14, 2014.
- He has pitched at least 5.0 innings, allowed five or fewer baserunners and one or zero runs in each of his four starts this season...This is tied with Cliff Lee (2008), Trevor Bauer (2020), Corbin Burnes (2021) and Carlos Rodon (2022) for the longest streak of such starts to begin a season in the modern era (since 1901).

LIKE RIDING A BIKE: Today will be Ortiz's 24th career Major League start and his fifth of the season, having last made the start on July 20 vs. Philadelphia, earning the win after tossing 7.0 shutout frames, allowing just three hits with two strikeouts.

- Served in the bulk role following Carmen Mldozinski "opening" for the Bucs three times this season...Ortiz threw 4.1 shutout frames on June 8 vs. Minnesota, allowed one run in 5.0 IP on June 14 at Colorado and allowed 6 earned runs in 4.0 innings pitched on June 21 vs. Tampa Bay.
- Has posted a 4-1 record with a 1.97 ERA (10 ER in 45.2 IP) in his last eight starts since September 4, 2023, allowing two runs or fewer in seven of those games and one run or fewer in six of them.
- Ortiz was a starter in 19 of his first 22 career Major League games with the Bucs from 2022-23 before primarily pitching out of the bullpen this season.
- He started 67 of his 72 appearances in the Minor Leagues from 2019-2023.

EFFECTIVE WORK: In 20 games (four starts) since April 20, Ortiz has gone 4-1 with one save, a 2.24 ERA (16 ER in 64.1 IP) and 54 strikeouts against 15 walks.

VS. ARIZONA: Ortiz will be making his first career start and appearance against the D-backs today...The D-backs are one of three opponents (excluding the Pirates) that Ortiz has never pitched against, joining Cleveland and Houston.

SHUTTING IT DOWN: Ortiz earned the first save of his big league career on June 1 at Toronto, facing a total of 10 batters in 3.0 scoreless innings while throwing 36 pitches.

2023 RECAP: Ortiz had two different stints with the Pirates last season, going 4-5 with a 4.93 ERA (40 ER in 73.0 IP) in his 15 starts and 1-0 with a 3.95 ERA (6 ER in 13.2 IP) in three relief appearances.

- Pitched with the Dominican Republic team in the World Baseball Classic, making one appearances and striking out three batters in 2.0 scoreless innings.
