I-70 STRIP SERIES: The I-70 Interleague series resumes today as the St. Louis Cardinals and cross-state rival Kansas City Royals continue with the second game of a three-game weekend series at Busch Stadium as part of Major League Baseball's "Rivalry Weekend" ... After Monday's scheduled off day, the Redbirds six-game/seven-day homestand continues Tuesday with a three-game series with the division rival Pittsburgh Pirates.

TARPS OFF: Winners of 12 of their last 17 since April 27, the Cardinals enter play today in 3rd place in the NL Central, 2.5 games behind first place Chicago and pct. points behind 2nd place Milwaukee (25-17) ... St. Louis is a season-high eight games above .500 for the second time (also: 23-15 entering May 9)

SKINNED: Since Interleague play began in 1997, the Cardinals .593 regular season win pct. (80-55) against the Royals is the best of any of tonight's 15 Rivalry Weekend Matchups.

BARE NECESSITIES: Prior to today's game, the Cardinals activated RHP **Matt Pushard** (pronounced *pu-SHARD*) from the 15-Day Injured List and designated LHP **Jared Shuster** for assignment ... Pushard, who has missed the past 41 games due to right knee patellar tendinitis, went 1-1 with a 3.55 ERA (12.2 IP), one save, and 10 strikeouts in 11 games during a 30-day injury rehab assignment with Memphis (AAA).

TAKE YOUR SHIRT OFF, TWIST IT 'ROUND YO' HAND, SPIN IT LIKE A HELICOPTER: Last night marked the team's 13th comeback win, 3rd-most in MLB behind the Diamondbacks (14) and Dodgers (14) ... St. Louis paces Major League Baseball in extra inning wins (6-1), one-run victories (10-3), and wins in games decided by two runs or fewer (18-7) ... The Redbirds also share the MLB lead in last at-bat wins (8) with the Rays, Padres, & Braves ... In "high leverage" situations per *FanGraphs*, the Cardinals share the MLB lead in both runs scored (67) and RBI (64).

THE NAKED GUN: **Jordan Walker**'s homer off **Michael Wacha** last night was the first hit by a Cardinals 1st round pick off of another fellow Cardinals 1st round pick since **Colby Rasmus** took Milwaukee's **Braden Looper** deep on May 18, 2009 at Busch Stadium.

NO SHOES, NO SHIRT, NO PROBLEM: **Yohel Pozo** collected his second career walk-off RBI with a two-out, pinch hit single (also: 6/21/25 vs. CIN - single) ... All five of Pozo's RBI this season have come with two outs, four of which came in the 9th inning or later ... Pozo became the first Cardinals pinch hitter since **Nolan Arenado** to record a walk-off RBI (June 7, 2025 vs. Dodgers) and the 2nd to do so against an American League squad, joining **Reggie Sanders** (June 17, 2004 vs. Oakland).

THE NAKED TRUTH: The Cardinals and Reds are the only two MLB teams with six pitchers all making 20 or more appearances this season (**Justin Bruihl-20**, **Riley O'Brien-22**, **JoJo Romero-22**, **George Soriano-20**, **Ryne Stanek-22**, **Matt Svanson-20**) ... The NL-leading 22 appearances by O'Brien, Romero, and Stanek are the most by any Cardinals relievers in the first 44 games of a season since LHP **Brett Cecil** (24) and RHP **Matt Bowman** (23) in 2017 (prior to the three-batter minimum rule).

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (May 16, 1997): With two outs in the 9th inning of a scoreless game, **Michael Tucker** doubles to breaks up **Alan Benes**'s no-hitter against the Braves at Turner Field ... Benes followed by intentionally walking **Chipper Jones** and striking out **Fred McGriff** to send the scoreless game to extra innings, which St. Louis lost, 1-0, in 13 innings ... Benes, **Michael Wacha** (Sept. 24, 2013 vs. Washington), and **Miles Mikolas** (June 14, 2022-2 vs. Pittsburgh) own the three longest no-hit bids in Cardinals history that fell short at 8.2 innings.

KANSAS CITY CONNECTIONS

The Cardinals and Royals faced off in the 1985 World Series, also known as the "Show-Me Series" or "I-70 Showdown Series."

Ryne Stanek graduated from Blue Valley High School in nearby Stilwell, KS, winning the 2010 Kansas High School 6A State Championship... named the 2010 *Kansas City Star* All-Metro Baseball Player of the Year.

Jon Jay played 59 games for the Royals in 2018 before being traded to Arizona for RHP **Elvis Luciano** and LHP **Gabe Speier** (June 6, 2018).

Gordon Graceffo and **Thomas Saggese** were teammates with **Jac Caglianone** and **Vinnie Pasquantino** on Team Italy during the 2026 WBC.

Jac Caglianone made his MLB debut on June 3, 2025 against the Cardinals at Busch Stadium.

Michael Wacha, the Cardinals 1st round draft selection in 2012, pitched seven seasons (2013-19) in St. Louis and was voted MVP of the 2013 NLCS against the LA Dodgers...became the 105th player to appear in at least one game for both the Royals and Cardinals...made his MLB debut on May 30, 2013 vs. the Royals while pitching for St. Louis.

Lane Thomas played in 84 games for the Cardinals from 2019-21 after St. Louis acquired him from Toronto on July 2, 2017 in exchange for international bonus slot money.

Royals Radio Producer/Engineer **Eric Guthrie** is a St. Louis native.

Bobby Witt Jr.'s father, **Bobby Witt**, pitched in 17 games (5 starts) for the Cardinals in the second half of the 1998 season.

Nick Mears's great-grandfather **Alyn Butler** was a catcher in the Cardinals farm system.

Cardinals 2026 Hall of Fame inductee **Albert Pujols** moved to Independence, Mo., in 1996 when he was 16 years old...graduated from Fort Osage High School in Independence...played college baseball at Maple Woods Community College in Kansas City (now named Metropolitan Community College).

Michael Massey played college baseball at the University of Illinois (2017-19).

Cardinals broadcaster **Brad Thompson** (16 games) appeared on the 2010 Royals squad.

Royals VP of Scouting **Danny Ontiveros** was a Cardinals scout from 1998-2004.

Royals broadcaster **Rex Hudler** played in 251 games over three seasons in St. Louis (1990-92).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Vince Coleman** played in 179 games across parts of two seasons with Kansas City (1994-95).

Royals Major League Scout **Willie Fraser** pitched in 35 games for the Cardinals in 1991.

Royals Sr. Advisor to the GM **Mike Arbuckle** was selected by the Cardinals in the 1969 MLB Draft.

Royals MLB.com reporter **Anne Rogers** covered the Cardinals for two seasons (2019-20).

Royals Special Assistant, International Scouting **Johnny DiPuglia** worked in scouting for the Cardinals from 1990-98.

Royals Special Assistant to Baseball Operations/Player & Staff Engagement **Blaine Boyer** pitched in 15 games for the Cardinals in 2009.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Al Hrabosky** pitched in 116 games over two seasons (1978-79) with Kansas City...traded to Kansas City for **Mark Littell** and **Buck Martinez** (Dec. 8, 1977).

Royals Assistant Director of Player Development **Kevin Howard** played in 97 games for St. Louis Triple-A affiliate Memphis in 2010.

Royals Major League Scout **Tim Conroy** worked as an Area Scout and East Coast Regional Supervisor with St. Louis (1994-2000)...pitched for St. Louis for two seasons (1986-87).

St. Louis Post-Dispatch reporter **Lynn Worthy** covered the Royals for four seasons for the *Kansas City Star* (2019-22).

Royals.TV reporter **Joel Goldberg** covered the Cardinals for FOX Sports Midwest for three seasons (2005-07)...worked parts of six years for KTVI FOX 2 in St. Louis.

Royals.TV reporter **Bridget Howard**'s father, **David Howard**, played in 98 games for St. Louis (1998-99).

Royals broadcaster **Steve Stewart** is a St. Louis native...called Cardinals games on KMOX in 2002.

TODAY'S GAME:

- Today marks his 9th start of the season (10th career) and 107th career appearance.
- It will be his 1st career start against the Royals and his 4th career appearance in the I-70 Series; Is 0-0 with a 1.93 ERA (1 ER/4.2 IP) and three strikeouts in three relief outings.
- A win today would give him a career single-season high 5 and would extend his win streak to three games.
- **Three of his team co-leading four wins this season have come on the road:** April 5 at Detroit, April 17 at Houston and April 28 at Pittsburgh.
- Limiting right-handed batters to .213/.280/.347 (16-75) slash with a .627 OPS this season.
- His first 97 career appearances were as a relief pitcher beginning with his Major League debut on July 7, 2023; First career start came at Chicago's Wrigley Field on Sept. 28, 2025.
- Previously started 72-of-89 games over his first four professional seasons (2018-19, 2021-22).
- Kyle's 97 career relief appearances before his 1st career Major League start (Sept. 28, 2025 at CHI) were the most by a Cardinal since **Jordan Hicks** (April 21, 2022 at Miami) who made his 1st career start after having made 114 career relief appearances.

LAST TIME OUT (Sunday, May 10 at San Diego): ND, L, 3-2: 5.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 4 BB, 5 SO, 0 HR - 95 pitches.

- Blanked the Padres on two hits and was in line for the win, before SD tied the game with 2-out HR in 9th and won it in the 10th.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

EN GARDE: Ranks T-2nd among all MLB pitchers with his 14 Opponent's Sword Swings (Max Meyer-MIA, 18) and his 87.2 competitive swing pct. is the lowest among Cardinals starters & ranks 15th among all NL starters. A "sword" swing is an expression of the art of forcing a batter to take an uncomfortable, awkward swing.

PARK PLACE: Each of his five road games have been at Parks (Petco Park, Comerica Park, Daikin Park, loanDepot park, & PNC Park).

DEEP DRIVE DIVE: Four of his six homers allowed have been solo shots, three of the six HR's have come in the 3rd inning.

DECISIVE STARTS: Has earned the decision in seven of his eight starts; co-leads the team in wins (4) and is T-2nd in losses (3).

STRETCHING OUT: Pitched a career-high 5.1 innings in back/back starts 4/28 at PIT & 5/4 vs. MIL, and has worked at least 5.0 innings in seven of his eight starts on the year.

OH MOTHER: Blanked the Padres over his 5.0 IP on just 2 hits on May 10 (Mother's Day), and was in line for the win before the Padres Nick Castellanos tied the game with a 2-out, 2-strike 2-run HR to tie the game at 2-2, and then SD won it in the 10th, 3-2.

CENTRAL FOCUS: Earned a win in both of his starts against NL Central opponents this season (4/28 at PIT & 5/4 vs. MIL) to improve to 4-1 in his career against divisional opponents.

BROOM RIDE: Gained the win in the middle game of the Cardinals three-game series sweep at HOU in a 9-4 win on 4/17; Struck out a season high 6, but allowed 3 solo HR's.

ALL EYES ON US: Drew back-to-back starting assignments in nationally televised games on Easter Sunday on NBC/Peacock Sunday Night Baseball in Detroit and April 11 vs. Boston on FOX.

EASTER DELIGHT: Gained his 1st win of the season on April 5, allowing 2 runs over 5.0 IP in the Cardinals 5-3 Easter win over the Tigers. He threw a career-high 97 pitches as he earned the winning decision as a starter for the 1st time - all while helping to prevent a series sweep by Detroit.

IT'S COLDER IN BOULDER: The Colorado native worked in game time temps of 42 degrees on Easter Sunday in Detroit, his third career MLB appearance in temperatures 45 degrees and below, two shy of matching Cardinals announcer **Brad Thompson** (5) for T-3rd among Cardinals in the frosty temps.

CAREER:

- Graduated from Erie (Colo.) High School. Named Boulder County Player of the Year and was selected to play at the High School Futures Game at Coors Field.
- Played college baseball at Colorado Mesa University in Grand Junction, Colo., going 22-2 with a 3.13 ERA (204.1 IP), 188 strikeouts and six complete games.
- Allowed nine home runs to 852 total batters faced while pitching in high altitude (Grand Junction is 4,583 ft above sea level).
- Posted a 13-0 record with a 1.41 ERA during his sophomore season, earning First Team All-American, First Team Academic All-American, and was the South Central Regional Tournament MVP.
- Pitched two summers for the Waterloo Bucks of the collegiate summer Northwoods League (2016-17).
- His father, Tim Leahy, played college basketball at Kansas State University and his uncle, Thomas Leahy, pitched in the Braves organization (1991-93) advancing to Durham (High-A).

LEAHY VS. KANSAS CITY:

- Is making his 1st career start (4th appearance) vs. the Royals in the annual I-70 rivalry series action.
- Has compiled a career mark of 0-0 with 1.93 ERA in his three relief appearances against Kansas City covering 4.2 IP.
- Worked 2.0 scoreless IP in relief of Miles Mikolas nearly one year ago today on May 17 at KC in a 1-0 Cardinals combined shutout win vs. **Noah Cameron**.
- Is 2-1 with a 4.50 ERA in his three Interleague starts this season (14.0 IP/7 ER) with road wins at DET & HOU and a home loss vs. BOS.
