THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
MAY 18

2015 - **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** makes his Major League debut in a start at home vs. OAK. He allows just 1 run in 4.2 IP with 5 strikeouts. He earns his 1st career punchout for the final out of the 1st inning (Billy Butler).

2002 - **Jose Vizcaino** walks off the Pirates with a solo HR in the 9th inning, lifting the Astros to a 2-1 win.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Astros visit Target Field in Minneapolis today to begin a 3-game series vs. the Twins...**RHP Tatsuya Imai (1-1)** will start vs. the Astros as he takes on Twins LHP Kendry Morales (1-0)...both starters are facing their respective opponents for the first time.

ROADIES: Tonight is the 1st game of a 10-game, 3-city road trip for the Astros...after this 3-game set at MIN, they will visit Chicago for a 3-game series at Wrigley Field (Fri.-Sun.) vs. the Cubs and then travel back to Texas for a 4-game series vs. the Rangers at Globe Life Field.

VS. THE TWINS: The Astros were 5-1 vs. MIN last season, going 3-0 at home and 2-1 here at Target Field...the Astros won 2 of 3 in their last visit to Target Field, April 3-6 of 2025 and then later swept MIN in a 3-game series at Daikin Park, June 13-15... since 2021, the Astros are 9-5 at Target Field and 18-13 vs. MIN overall.

ABOUT IMAI: **RHP Tatsuya Imai** will make his fifth start tonight and the first of his career vs. the Twins...on Tues. vs. SEA, he made his 1st start after being out for 26 games while on the Injured List due to arm fatigue (4 IP, 6 ER)...in January, the Astros signed Imai to a three-year deal...in 2025, he was an All-Star for the Seibu Lions in the NPB in Japan, where he went 10-5 with a 1.92 ERA (35ER/163.2IP) in 24 games.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP: The Astros dropped the finale of their 3-game series vs. the Rangers yesterday afternoon at Daikin Park, 8-0...**RHP Peter Lambert (2-4)** took the loss (6.0 IP, 3 H, 5 ER, 2 BB, 6 SO)...**The Lamma:** Despite the loss, Lambert allowed 3 hits or less yesterday for the 4th time in his 6 starts...the Astros offense was held to just 5 hits.

THE SILVER BOOT SERIES: The weekend was the 1st series of the Silver Boot Series, with the Astros taking 2 of 3 games vs. the Rangers...the Astros and Rangers have played each other 295 times all-time in the regular season, with the Astros edging out the Rangers 148-147...when including the postseason, the two clubs are 151-151 vs. each other in the overall series...recently, the Astros have had the upper hand, winning or splitting nine straight season series, going 95-52 against the Rangers since the start of the 2017 season.

RECENT STROS: The Astros have won 2 of 3 and 3 of their last 5 games.

deBOMBS OFF deGROM: The Astros hit 4 solo HR off RHP Jacob deGrom in Saturday's 4-1 win over the Rangers...that ties for the most HR off the ace righthander in a single game...the other time was July 7, 2017 at STL...on Saturday, **Jose Altuve** led off the game with a HR, followed by **Yordan Alvarez**, **Christian Walker** and **Zach Cole**, respectively.

ROAD WARRIOR: In his young career, **Brice Matthews** has had success hitting on the road, as he enters tonight with a .280 (21x75) career avg. in 24 road games with 6 HR and 20 RBI with a .587 SLG and a .947 OPS...in 2026, he is hitting .294 (15x51) on the road with 2 HR and an .883 OPS.

ROSTER MOVES: The Astros have placed **IF Jose Altuve** on the 10-day IL due to a left oblique strain (retro 5/17)...the Astros also reinstated **IF Jeremy Peña** from 10-day IL and recalled **RHP Jason Alexander** from Triple A Sugar Land...to make room on the active roster, the Astros designated **RHP Cody Bolton** for assignment.

BRYAN'S SONG: After a slow start to his season, **RHP Bryan Abreu** has not allowed a run in his last 5 outings, covering 5.2 IP (3 H, 0 R, 3 BB, 5 SO)... in his last 7 appearances, Abreu has posted a 1.23 ERA (1ER/7.2IP) with 9 K's.

AIR YORDAN: **Yordan Alvarez** is batting .316 with 11 doubles, 15 HR, 31 RBI and a 1.061 OPS (.423 OBP/.638 SLG)...in the AL, he ranks first in total bases (111), first in XBH (26), 2nd in OBP, and SLG, and 3rd in batting avg...Alvarez was named AL Player of the Month for March/April...**Twinn-Killing:** In 27 career games vs. MIN, Alvarez has 9 HR and 22 RBI while posting a .577 SLG/.913 OPS...in 14 career games at Target Field, he has 5 HR and 14 RBI.

THE SHEW FITS: **IF Braden Shewmake**, who has seen steady playing time recently, has hit safely in 11 of his last 12 games and is hitting .333 overall in 17 games this season with 3 HR while posting an .896 OPS...Shewmake had a career high 10-game hitting streak from May 5-15...he was acquired by the Astros in a trade with the Yankees on April 19.

TAPPING FOR SUCCESS: Astros batters lead the Majors in successful ABS challenges with 30 won in 52 total challenges (58% successful)... **Jose Altuve** is tied for the MLB lead in successful challenges among hitters, having won 9 of 13 challenges (69% successful).

LEADING MEN: On Saturday night vs. TEX, **Jose Altuve** connected for his 42nd career leadoff homer, which ranks second in franchise history, trailing only **2B Craig Biggio** (53)...the Astros have a long history of leadoff homers, between Biggio, Altuve, **OF George Springer** (40), and others, with the team combining for 228 leadoff homers in franchise history, which ranks second in the Majors since their inception in 1962, trailing only the Tigers (230).

CLIMBING THE CHARTS: **2B Jose Altuve** connected for his 239th career homer as a 2nd baseman Sat. night vs. TEX, which tied him with **Lou Whitaker** for 7th place all-time in MLB history for the position.

WALKER, TEXAS HAMMER: **1B Christian Walker** is batting .263 (45x171) with 27 runs, 10 doubles, 11 HR, 30 RBI and a .857 OPS...among all AL players in 2026, Walker ranks tied for sixth in extra-base hits (21), tied for seventh in RBI (30), eighth in total bases (88), eighth in SLG (.515) and tied for ninth in home runs (11).

LAST START, MAY 12 vs. SEA: Returned from the IL to start on Tuesday vs. the Mariners...tossed 4.0 innings, allowing 6 runs on 5 hits, 3 walks and 2 HBP...allowed 2 homers in the outing...tossed 80 pitches in the outing, including 46 strikes...threw only sinkers (63%, 50 pitches) and sliders (38%, 30 pitches).

ABOUT IMAI (pronounced ee-MY): Rookie starter joined the Astros this offseason as an international signing out of Japan...has made 4 Major League starts this season around a month-long IL stint (April 13-May 10) due to right arm fatigue...tonight is his second start since returning from the IL.

SAVANT SAYS: Is in the 88th percentile of Major League pitchers in groundball percentage (53.1%) and 87th percentile of whiff % (31.3%)...also ranks in the 67th percentile of strikeout percentage (24.6%).

IMAI'S ARSENAL: Has thrown 41% sliders in his MLB career, while throwing four-seamers (34%) and sinkers (18%) as his fastballs...among fastballs, threw only four-seamers in his first 3 starts, and only sinkers in his last time out...also worked in select changeups (2%), split fingers (2%) and curveballs (2%) in his first three starts...has raised eyebrows by featuring his unique wrong-way slider, which was well known during his time pitching in the NPB...Imai's slider is averaging 5.9 inches of arm-side run...for context, the average MLB slider breaks 4 inches to the glove side.

OUT ON REHAB: Made two rehab appearances during his time on the IL, one with Double A Corpus Christi and the other with Triple A Sugar Land...recorded a combined 10.80 ERA (6ER/5IP) with five strikeouts and eight walks.

FIRST MAJOR LEAGUE WIN: Flashed brilliance and earned his 1st career Major League win on April 4 at ATH in what was his second Major League start...in that outing, he allowed 3 hits and 3 walks with 9 strikeouts in 5.2 innings...threw a season-high 94 pitches in the outing.

MLB DEBUT: Made his MLB debut on March 29 vs. LAA, working 2.2 innings while allowing 4 runs on 3 hits...picked up his first MLB strikeout vs. **Mike Trout**, the second batter he faced in his debut...the Angels really worked Imai in the outing, swinging just 6 times on 37 fastballs thrown, taking 12 fastballs for strikes.

SCORELESS SPRING TRAINING: Made 3 official Spring Training starts and an exhibition game start, combining to toss 9.2 innings of scoreless baseball...in his 3 official starts, he allowed 2 hits and 1 walk with 7 strikeouts in 6.0 innings...his exhibition start came on March 23 vs. the Astros Triple A affiliate, the Sugar Land Space Cowboys, in which he tossed 3.2 scoreless innings.

2025 RECAP: Went 10-5 with a 1.92 ERA (35ER/163.2IP) in 24 games with Seibu in the NPB in 2025...recorded 178 strikeouts and a 0.89 WHIP...in the NPB, he ranked T-1st in WHIP, 2nd in strikeouts, 6th in ERA and 10th in starts (24)...was selected as an All-Star for the 2nd consecutive season...struck out a club record 17 hitters on June 17, 2025 vs. the Yokohama DeNa Baystars...also tossed 8.0 innings of a combined no-hitter on April 18, 2025 vs. the Fukuoka Softbank Hawks.

JAPANESE CAREER: Prior to signing with the Astros, Imai starred in the Nippon Professional Baseball Organization (NPB) for the last 8 seasons (2018-25)...he went 58-45 overall with a 3.15 ERA (337ER/963.2IP) and 907 strikeouts in 159 career games in the NPB...was a 3-time All-Star in the NPB (2021, 2024 and 2025).

JAPAN CONNECTION: Became the 33rd Japanese-born pitcher to make a start in the Majors...is the fourth Japanese-born player to play for the Astros, joining **IF Kazuo Matsui** (2008-10), **OF Norichika Aoki** (2017) and **LHP Yusei Kikuchi** (2024)...Imai knows Matsui well, having played for him from 2023-24, while he was managing in the NPB with the Seibu Lions.

LAST APPEARANCE (5/16 vs. TEX): Picked up his 2nd save of the season on Sat. night, tossed 1.1 scoreless innings while working around 1 hit and 1 walk...has recorded a win (Wed. vs. SEA) and a save in his 2 appearances during the last homestand.

TIDES TURNING: Has gone 2-0-1 through 5 consecutive scoreless appearances (5.2 IP), dating back to May 3 ...prior to this streak, posted a 12.54 ERA (13ER/9.1IP) in his first 11 games of the season.

AGAINST THE TWINS: In 13 career appearances vs. MIN, he's recorded a 2.77 ERA (4ER/13IP) with 24 strikeouts.

ALL-TIME ASTRO RANKINGS: With his outing on April 24 vs. NYY, he reached 338.0 career innings, passing **RHP Octavio Dotel** for the 10th-most innings by a reliever in Astros history...ranks 7th all-time in appearances (333) among relievers in Astros history, and is closing in on **RHP Ryan Pressly** (342) for 6th on that all-time list...also among Astros relievers, he ranks 4th all-time in strikeouts (469).

DAIKIN PARK RANKINGS: Reached 179.2 career innings pitched at Daikin Park with his outing on Sat. night .vs TEX, surpassing **RHP Ryan Pressly** (179.1) for 4th-most by a reliever in the venue's history...is also 3 strikeouts from matching **RHP Octavio Dotel** (247) for the 2nd-most strikeouts by a reliever in Daikin Park history.

CAREER: In 333 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.87 ERA (110ER/344.2P) with 469 strikeouts, a 1.22 WHIP, a 12.25 K/9 and a 0.76 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 2nd in appearances among active AL relievers.

TODAY'S ROSTER MOVE: Was recalled from Triple A Sugar Land today...marks his 3rd stint with the Astros this season.

LAST APPEARANCE (5/12 at TAC): Made his 7th start of the season with Triple A Sugar Land...in that outing, he allowed 3 runs on 5 hits with 2 walks and 3 strikeouts in 5.0 innings to earn his 1st win of the season.

LAST MLB APPEARANCE (5/6 vs. LAD): In his relief appearance, he allowed 5 runs on 9 hits with 2 walks and 5 strikeouts in 4.1 innings.

DOWN IN SUGAR LAND: In 7 starts with Triple A Sugar Land this season, he's gone 1-2 with a 5.03 ERA (19ER/34IP)...has been strong when pitching at home for the Space Cowboys this year in the hitter-friendly Pacific Coast League, posting a 3.92 ERA (9ER/20.2IP), 1.21 WHIP and .253 opponent batting average in his 4 home starts.
