THE TWINS: Completed their seven-game, eight-day homestand with a record of 1-6, going 1-3 against the Tigers last weekend, followed by a three-game sweep from the A's this week... tonight, the Twins will begin a six-game roadtrip with the first of three against the White Sox at Rate Field...after the series finale on Sunday afternoon, Minnesota will fly to Toronto for a three-game series at Rogers Centre, from Monday-Wednesday.

◆ The Iwins last road trip was three games at Yankee Stadium, from August 11-13, as Minnesota lost the first two and won the finale...they are 4-3 in their last seven road games.

NOT SO ATHLETIC: The Twins lost to the A's yesterday afternoon by a score of 8-3 and were swept for the fifth time this season...marked the first time the Twins were swept by the A's in Minnesota since April of 2014...José Ureña (0-1) was the starter and issued the loss, allowing six runs (all in the 2nd inning) on seven hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and three strikeouts...the offense recorded five hits, highlighted by doubles from Royce Lewis (15) and Trevor Larnach (18).

DEEP DISH: The Twins are playing the White Sox tonight for the seventh of 13 scheduled games in 2025...after dropping their first game on March 31 at Rate Field, the Twins have gone 4-1 in their last five vs. the Sox, outscoring them 24-12 in those five.

♣ Twins return to Rate Field where they played their second series of the season, from March 31-April 2, taking two of three...they have gone 11-3 in their last 14 here.

♣ Minnesota has gone 23-4 in its last 27 against the White Sox, dating back to May 4, 2023.

♣ Since 2015, the Twins have gone 103-72 against the Sox, their most wins against any opponent in that span.

♣ Since 2019, no opponent has hit more home runs at Rate Field than the Twins, hitting 91 home runs (next: Cleveland with 62)...in that same span, no team has hit more homers against the Sox overall (home or away) than the Twins with 151 (next is KC with 117).

♣ In his last 14 games against the Sox, Trevor Larnach is hitting .304 (14-for-46) with two doubles, four home runs, 10 RBI, 10 walks, a .429 on-base percentage and a 1.037 OPS.

♣ Since the start of 2023, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .384 (28-for-73) with a 1.041 OPS in 22 games vs. the White Sox...he has reached safely in 18-straight starts against CWS.

♣ Matt Wallner is hitting .324 (22-for-68) with five doubles, one triple, three home runs, 13 RBI, a .471 on-base percentage and a 1.030 OPS in 24 career games against the White Sox...in 13 career games at Rate Field, he is slashing .395/.5007.632 (1.132 OPS).

♣ Royce Lewis is hitting .417 (10-for-24) with four home runs, 14 RBI, nine walks, a .576 on-base percentage, a .958 slugging percentage and a 1.534 OPS in seven career games vs. the White Sox...he is 6-for-14 (.429) lifetime at Rate Field, hitting safely in all four here.

BUCK WEARING OUT THE SOX: Byron Buxton is hitting .283 (89-for-315) with 28 doubles, one triple, 23 home runs, 53 RBI, 66 runs scored and a .944 OPS in 93 career games vs. the White Sox...below are his first 48 career games vs. the Sox (June 22, 2015-June 29, 2019), compared to his last 45 (June 30, 2019-present):

99 PROBLEMS: Byron Buxton enters today with 99 hits on the season, one short of reaching 100 for the second time in his career…he hit 117 in 2017, his single-season career-high.additionally, at 25 home runs. he is three short of his single-season career-high of 28, hit in 2022

♣ He enters today with 499 career runs scored, looking to become the 18th player in Twins history (since 1961) to reach 500 runs scored.

♣ One run scored and he will be the third player in Twins history to reach 500+ runs, 150+ home runs, 100+ stolen bases and 400+ RBI...the others: Kirby Puckett and Torii Hunter.

♣ Since June 17, he has homered nine times in 17 road games, tied for eighth-most in baseball during that span...since that date, he has homered in five of six road series': four homers at Cincinnati (June 17-19), two homers at Detroit (June 27-29), none at Miami (July 1-3), one homer at Colorado (July 18-21), one homer at Los Angeles-NL (July 21-23) and one homer at New York-AL (August 11-13). homer at New York-AL (August 11-13).

NEW 'PEN, WHO DIS?: Over their last eight games, since August 13, the Twins bullpen has posted a 2.19 ERA (37.0 IP, 9 ER) with two home runs allowed, 14 walks, 32 strikeouts and a .189 opponent batting average...since that date, they rank fifth in baseball in both ERA and opponent batting average.

♣ In 19 games since the trade deadline, the bullpen has posted a 3.40 ERA (84.2 IP, 32 ER)... in 19 games leading up to the deadline, the 'pen had posted a 5.04 ERA (80.1 IP, 45 ER).

TOP JEFF: Over his last 32 games. Ryan Jeffers is hitting .330 (38-for-115) with seven doubles, three home runs, 13 RBI, 10 walks, a .398 on-base percentage, a .470 slugging percentage and an .868 OPS...he has reached base safely in 19 of his last 20 games.

◆ At 91 hits, he needs two to tie his single-season career-high of 93, done last season...at 22 doubles, he needs one to set a new single-season career-high.

ALL SAINTS NIGHT: Right-handed pitcher Pablo López (right shoulder strain) and Simeon Woods Richardson (illness) both pitched for Triple-A St. Paul last night vs. Round Rock at CHS Field.
₱López, in his first rehab start since the injury, pitched 1.2 innings and allowed one run on four hits, with one walk and two strikeouts...Pablo touched 95.3 mph with his 4-seam fastball and averaged 94.3 mph on the pitch...he threw 45 pitches.

₱ SWR, in his second rehab appearance, pitched 3.1 innings and allowed four runs (3 earned) on five hits, with one walk and four strikeouts, throwing 64 pitches.

MOTOWN MATTHEWS: Last pitched on August 16 vs. Detroit, opposite Casey Mize...he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 5-8 defeat...allowed two runs on five hits (1 HR), with a career-high four walks and six strikeouts in 4.0 innings...permitted an RBI single to Spencer Torkelson in the first, scoring Colt Keith, and a solo home run to Kerry Carpenter in the third.

♣ Marked his shortest outing since July 19 when he threw 4.0 innings at Colorado.

♣ Has recorded 106 strikeouts through his first 19 career games, the most by a pitcher through their first 19 major league games in Twins history (1961-).

♣ Just 51 of Zebby's 92 pitches thrown were strikes, for a rate of 55.4, a career low.

IN THE BRONX: Pitched on August 11 at New York-AL, opposite Will Warren, where he was dealt his fourth loss of the season in Minnesota's 3-4 defeat...allowed three runs on six hits (career-high-tying three home runs), with one walk and a career-high-tying nine strikeouts in 5.2 innings...all three runs allowed were solo home runs...one from Cody Bellinger in the first, followed by back-to-back home runs from Giancarlo Stanton and Ben Rice in the third...the hit from Rice also marked Zebby's 100th career hit allowed...recorded a career-high 99 pitches

₱ Fanned Giancarlo Stanton in the sixth, marking his 100th career strikeout

MOW 'EM DOWN MATTHEWS: Matthews has totaled 100 strikeouts through his first 18 career major league games, the most in Twins history (1961-)...here are some of his numbers compared to other Twins pitchers through their first 17 games:

KNOCK THEIR SOX OFF: Matthews is facing Chicago-AL for the first time in his career, making them his 16th new opponent faced in 20 career games...in six career starts against division opponents, Zebby has gone 2-1, posting a 3.90 ERA (27.2 IP, 12 ER) with eight walks, 35 strikeouts and a .293 (34-for-116) opponent batting average.

◆ With two outs and runners in scoring position, opponents have gone 10-for-43 (.233) with two doubles, one home run, four walks, 15 RBI and 13 strikeouts.

HOME SWEET HOME: Zebby has gone 2-3 with an 7.12 ERA (36.2 IP, 29 ER), 10 walks, 53 strikeouts and a 319 (51-for-160) opponent batting average in nine career major league starts at home; compared to 2-5, 4.78 ERA (49.0 IP, 26 ER) with 16 walks, 53 strikeouts and a .273 (54-for-198) opponent batting average in 10 career major league starts on the road.

© In six major league starts on the road this season, Matthews has gone 2-3, posting a 5.46 ERA (29.2 IP, 18 ER) with 10 walks, 37 strikeouts and a .283 (34-for-120) opponent batting average.

PLATOON SPLITS: Through his first 10 major league starts this season, left-handed hitters have slashed .267/.324/.465 in 101 at-bats vs. Matthews, while righties have slashed .290/.333/.441 in 93 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 88.8 mph and a whiff rate of 31.9 compared to righties' 89.6 mph and 28.1 percent.

4 His hard-hit rate against lefties is 39.4 percent, compared to 44.9 percent in 2024; and his hard-hit rate against righties is 40.3 percent, compared to 38.5 percent in 2024.

THE ARSENAL: Matthews uses a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer over 40% of the time...primarily uses his sinker against right-handed batters, while favoring is changeup and cutter against left-handed batters...here is a look at his 2025 pitch breakdown:
