TODAY'S GAME: The Giants look to secure at least a series split with a win tonight in the second game of this four-game series vs. the visiting Rockies...SF won last night's series-opener 8-2.

- ▶ After taking consecutive series at home vs. the A's and Braves from June 23-28, the Giants have lost three straight series entering this one and are 4-6 in their last 10 games.
- ▶ This series vs. the Rockies is SF's final before the All-Star Break... SF's 54 losses prior to the break are its most since having 56 prior to the 2017 break...the Giants' have lost 54+ games prior to the break just four times since 1958 (2026, 2017, 2008 and 1985).

ROSTER MOVES: SF made the following moves today.

- ▶ **RHP Keaton Winn** (#67) returned from his rehab assignment and reinstated from the 15-day injured list.
- ▶ **OF Grant McCray** (#58) recalled from Triple-A Sacramento.
- ▶ **LHP Carson Whisenhunt** optioned to Triple-A Sacramento postgame yesterday.
- ▶ **OF Victor Bericoto** placed on the 10-day injured list with a left oblique strain.

VS. THE ROCKIES: SF is 3-4 against the Rockies in 2026 with the four losses being the most in a single-season vs. Colorado since SF went 9-4 against the Rockies back in 2023...from 2024-25, SF was 21-5 (.808) against Colorado.

- ▶ The Giants continued their strong showing vs. the Rockies at home with last night's win... since 2021, they are 34-6 (.850) and outscoring Colorado 230-108 (+122 run diff).
- ▶ SF has won seven straight home games vs. the Rockies dating to May 2, 2025...the Giants have also won 19 of their last 20 home games against Colorado dating to July 8, 2023.
- ▶ The last time in the SF-era (since 1958) the Giants have won 19-of-20 at home against a single opponent came from 1964-66 vs. Houston (*Stats, LLC*).
- ▶ The only other time since 1898 that the Giants beat a single team 20-of-21 times at home was when they took 20-of-21 games vs. the Cardinals from 1905-1907.

TODAY'S STARTER: **LHP Robbie Ray** will make his final start of the first half, and second straight start vs. the Rockies...in his last outing (a win on July 4 at COL), Ray struck out four while allowing three runs on five hits and three walks over 6.0 innings.

- ▶ In his lone start at Oracle Park vs. the Rockies (May 2, 2025), Ray struck out eight while allowing two walks and two hits over 7.0 shutout innings.
- ▶ Ray is 5-0 with a 1.88 ERA (9er, 43.0ip), 33 strikeouts and a 1.02 WHIP over his last seven games (six starts)...his 1.88 ERA since May 31 is seventh-best in the Majors, and fourth-best in the NL, over that span.

HOMER HAPPY: With his home run last night, **IF Willy Adames** joined **IF Casey Schmitt** (18 home runs) and **IF Rafael Devers** (18 home runs) as the first trio of Giants with 15+ home runs prior to the All-Star Break since 1970 when **Willie McCovey** (23), **Willie Mays** (19) and **Dick Dietz** (18) combined to do so (*Stats, LLC*).

- ▶ Adames, Devers and Schmitt are also the first trio of Giants to have 15+ homers through 93 team games since **Will Clark**, **Kevin Mitchell** and **Matt Williams** each had 17 homers through SF's 93rd game played in 1991.
- ▶ Schmitt and Devers combined for three homers on July 5 against tonight's starter for Colorado, Tanner Gordon...with three more games to hit two home runs, Devers or Schmitt could be the first Giants batter with 20+ home runs prior to the All-Star Break since **Barry Bonds** had 23 first-half homers in 2004.

SPLASH LANDING!: **IF Bryce Eldridge** hit his first career splash hit last night...the home run was the 109th splash hit by a Giant all-time (last: **IF Rafael Devers** on September 24, 2025 off STL's Sonny Gray), and Eldridge became the 33rd different Giant to hit a splash hit.

- ▶ At age 21 years and 263 days old, Eldridge's eight home runs this season are the most by a Giants batter age 21 or younger since **Matt Williams** (eight, 1987)...the last SF batter age 21 or younger to hit double-digit homers in a season was **Jack Clark** (13, 1977).

WITH THE GIANTS: The 2021 Cy Young Award winner is in his third season with the Giants and his 13th season overall in the Majors... the 2026 season marks the fifth year of a five-year, \$115 million contract he signed with Seattle in late 2021...he opted into the final two years of the contract prior to the 2025 season with SF.

LAST START: Earned his fourth straight win as he threw 6.0 innings and allowed three runs on five hits and three walks with four strikeouts in the Giants 6-4 victory over the Rockies at Coors Field on the Fourth of July...the Giants have now won each of Ray's last eight outings.

SOLID STRETCH: Over his last six outings, Ray has posted a 5-0 record with a 1.85 ERA (8er, 39.0ip), 27 strikeouts and a .163 op-ponents average against...he's been even better over his last five appearances, as he's held opponents to just three earned runs over 28.1 innings of work (0.95 ERA) and a 0.95 WHIP...this solid stretch came on the heels of a rough three games from May 13-24 where he posted a 0-2 record with an 11.08 ERA (16er, 13.0ip) and a .370 opponents average against.

LIMITING THE LONGBALL: Over his last seven games, Ray has al- lowed just two home runs over 43.0 innings (0.42 HR/9.0ip)...in his first 11 games, he allowed 13 homers over 58.2ip (1.99 HR/9.0ip).

WALK IT OUT: Has issued 46 walks over his 101.2 innings pitched this year, tied for fifth-most in the Majors.

SLIP AND SLIDE: Ray's slider has been different this year with his average velo dropping from 87.9 mph last year to 86.0 mph this year...he's also allowed four HR with it compared to seven all of last year...however, it's been better as of late with opponents going 1-for-16 in his last four games and 2-for-21 off him over his last six contests.

I'VE WATCHED A CHANGE IN YOU: On the flip side, Ray's changeup has a +5 run value this season (his best of any pitch in his arsenal) compared to a -1 run value a season ago...this year, hitters have an xBA of .205 on the offering while hitting .207 off it overall...it's been his second-best put away pitch (18.3%) behind his knuckle curve (23.1%)...in his last five starts, hitters are 6-for-41 in at-bats that end with Ray's changeup, however they were 3-for-4 with a home run in his last start.

AGAINST THE ROCKIES: Will make his second straight start against the Rockies and 25th career start, the second-most starts he's made against any team in his career behind the Dodgers (26 starts)...he's posted a 7-6 record with a 5.10 ERA over his 24 career outings against the Rockies...tonight will be the first time Ray faces Colorado at home since May 2, 2025 when he tossed 7.0-scoreless innings and allowed just two hits with eight strikeouts.

LEFT ON READ: Left-handers are just 5-for-33 (.152) off him over his last four games, after going 11-for-27 (.407) off him with three doubles, triple and HR in his previous six starts from May 13-June 10...prior that that tough stretch, lefties were 6-for-36 (.167) with no extra-base hits through his first eight starts of the year.
