NATIONALS HISTORY
APRIL 7 (6-10)
 2012 – Washington scored five runs with two outs and the bases empty in the eighth inning to burst past the Chicago Cubs, 7-4. **Danny Espinosa** hit a solo homer to start the rally, but **Chad Tracy's** pinch-hit two-run single was the inning's big hit as it erased a 4-3 deficit. Eight straight Nationals reached base by the inning's end. **Adam LaRoche** finished with a game-high four hits, including a two-run shot in the fourth frame that hit the right-field foul pole.

NATIONALS NEWS

CRAZY EIGHTH
 Powered by a six-run eighth inning - that included three home runs - the Washington Nationals topped the visiting St. Louis Cardinals, 9-6, in the opening game of this three-game series.

- **James Wood** (2-for-3, HR, 3 RBI, 2 R) tied the game at six with a three-run shot, **Brady House** (3-for-5, 2 2B, HR, 2 RBI, R) gave Washington the lead with a two-run blast and **CJ Abrams** (1-for-4, HR, RBI, R) added a solo homer to make it 9-6.
- Making his first start as a member of the Nationals, **Zack Littell** allowed one earned run on four hits with six strikeouts and three walks in 5.0 innings of work.

PRETTY OFFENSIVE
 The Nationals have scored 64 runs, the most by any Nationals club in team history (2005-pres.), ahead of the 2019 Nationals who scored 59 runs through the first 10 contests...Looking ahead, the 2019 Nationals scored 74 runs through their first 11 games.

OUR HOUSE
Brady House leads the Nationals and is tied for fourth in the National League with five multi-hit games this season.

- House has hit safely in six of eight starts, going 12-for-35 (.343) with three doubles, two homers, five RBI, four walks, seven runs scored, a .410 on-base percentage and a .600 slugging percentage in those eight starts.
- He has four walks in 40 plate appearances (10% BB) through 10 games...He had eight walks in 274 plate appearances (2.9% BB) in 73 games in 2025.

STREAKIN'
CJ Abrams has reached base safely in all nine games to start the season and has hit safely in seven straight...He is 9-for-28 (.321) with four homers, 11 RBI, five walks, two stolen bases and eight runs scored during the hitting streak.

- Like House, Abrams has improved his walk rate this season...He has a 12.2% BB (5 BB in 41 PA) in 2026, compared to a 5.8% BB (37 BB in 635 PA) in 2025.

DAYLEN'S DAYS
Daylen Lile's 13 hits are tied for fifth-most in the National League...He has hit safely in eight of the first 10 games to start the 2026 season, going 13-for-45 (.289) with three doubles, four RBI, two walks and seven runs scored.

- Since June 21, 2025, he ranks fourth among all hitters with a .319 batting average.
- The reigning National League Player and Rookie of the Month, Lile paced the National League in OPS (1.212), slugging percentage (.772), batting average (.391) and triples (7) during September 2025.

PAUL TOBONI
Paul Toboni was named President of Baseball Operations on Oct. 1, 2025...Widely regarded as one of the best young executives in baseball, Toboni brings a fresh voice to the organization, providing valuable experience in scouting and player development to build around the Nationals' talented core of young star players.

- Toboni comes to the Nationals from the Boston Red Sox, where he most recently held the title of senior vice president, assistant general manager...In his time with Boston, Toboni oversaw player development at the Major and Minor League levels, as well as the MLB First-Year Player Draft and was one of the key voices in the organization's larger baseball operations strategy.

BLAKE BUTERA
Blake Butera was named Washington's eighth field manager on October 31, 2025 after spending the previous two seasons as the senior director of player development for the Tampa Bay Rays...He served as the Rays' Minor League field coordinator in 2023 following four seasons (2018-19, 2021-22) as a manager in their Minor League system.

- At Single-A Charleston, Butera was named Carolina League Manager of the Year in 2021 and 2022, won the Carolina League championship both seasons and the 2022 club was named Minor League Team of the Year by *Baseball America*.
- He began his coaching career with the Rays organization in 2017 as the bench coach for Single-A Hudson Valley and was promoted to manager in 2018, becoming the youngest manager in all of Minor League Baseball at the age of 25.

Tall, powerful right-hander was Washington's Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2021 and 2022...Made his Major League debut in 2022 and returned to the mound in 2025.

- 1,076 days passed between his debut on Aug. 26, 2022 vs. Cincinnati and his second career appearance on Aug. 6, 2025 vs. Athletics.
- Was ranked as high as the No. 53 prospect according to MLB Pipeline.com and the No. 61 prospect per *Baseball America* entering the 2023 season.
- Had the "Best Curveball" in Washington's system, per *Baseball America*, for two consecutive seasons (2024-25)...Had the "Best Slider" in the system in 2021 and 2022.
- Led all of Minor League Baseball with 175 strikeouts in 2021.

LAST START

Cavalli allowed just one earned run on five hits with three strikeouts and two walks in 6.0 innings of work at Philadelphia last Wednesday...He left the game with a score of 2-1 in favor of Washington.

vs. ST. LOUIS

Cavalli is set to face the Cardinals for the first time in his career.

2026 OPENING DAY

Cavalli made his first career Opening Day start March 26 against the Chicago Cubs at Wrigley Field...He allowed two earned runs on three hits with five strikeouts.

- Became the 10th different pitcher in Nationals history (2005-pres.) to start on Opening Day.

2025

Returned to the Major Leagues after missing all of 2023 and 2024 recovering from Tommy John surgery.

- Made his return on Aug. 6 against the Athletics...Worked 4.1 scoreless innings with six strikeouts.
- In his third start, Cavalli worked 7.0 scoreless innings with five strikeouts against the Philadelphia Phillies on Aug. 16 for his first Major League win.
- Allowed three earned runs or less in eight of his 10 starts.
- Collected all three of his wins against National League East opponents (Miami twice, Philadelphia).
- Went 3-0 with a 2.25 ERA (7 ER/28.0 IP) with 19 strikeouts in five starts against the NL East...The Nationals went 5-0 in those starts.
- 2025 Pitch Mix:** 4-Seam (31.2%) Knuckle-Curve (30.5%) Sinker (18.3%) Change-up (13.6%) Cutter (6.3%) Slider (0.1%)

2023-24

Spent the 2024 season rehabbing from 2023 Tommy John surgery...Underwent the surgery in Spring Training 2023.

- Appeared in three rehab outings with the FCL Nationals and Single-A Wilmington in 2024.
- Returned to throwing/playing catch by the end of the 2023 season.

2022

Was named Washington's Minor League Pitcher of the Year for the second consecutive season...Eventually made his Major League debut on Aug. 26 vs. Cincinnati.

- Allowed just three home runs, and his 0.28 home runs allowed per 9.0 innings ranked eighth among Minor League pitchers (min. 75.0 IP).
- Ranked eighth in Washington's system with 104 strikeouts.
- Was selected to represent the Nationals in the 2022 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game, but did not participate.
- Struck out Kyle Farmer for his first MLB strikeout...Was placed on the Injured List following that start (right shoulder inflammation).
- From May 22 to July 27, went 3-0 with a 1.89 ERA (10 ER/47.2 IP) and a .179 opponents average in nine starts.
- 2022 Pitch Mix:** Four-Seam (40.4%) Curveball (33.3%) Changeup (13.1%) Slider (11.1%) Sinker (2%).

2021

Led all of Minor League Baseball with 175 strikeouts, while his 3.36 ERA paced Washington's system...Selected to his first SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game.

- Allowed just five home runs, and his 0.36 home runs allowed per 9.0 innings led all of Minor League Baseball (full-season).
- Led full-season Nationals Minor Leaguers with a .213 opponents' batting average while his 1.26 walk and hits per innings pitched ranked third.
