TODAY'S GAME: The Giants close the book on their 2024 campaign this afternoon and look to do so with a victory to win this series after taking yesterday's game 6-5...SF also seeks a win today to finish the year at .500.

- ▶ The Giants have exceeded their win total from last season when they finished 79-83...SF last finished at .500 or better in 2022 when they were 81-81.
- ▶ SF has won its final regular season game in two of the last three seasons (wins in 2021 and 2022 but a loss last year to the Dodgers).

HOLY HORSESHOES CHAPMAN!: IF Matt Chapman doubled twice yesterday in SF's 6-5 win, giving him 39 for the season, tied for the second-most doubles he's had in a season (also last year) in his career...Chapman had a career-high 42 doubles in 2018 with Oakland.

- ▶ The last Giant to hit more doubles in a season than Chapman was **Brandon Belt**, who logged 41 doubles back in 2016.
- ► His 39 doubles this year are tied for eighth-most in the Majors and fourth-most in the National League.
- ► Chapman has 68 extra-base hits this year, most by any Giant since **Pablo Sandoval** had 74 in 2009.
- ▶ The 31-year-old has been a mainstay for the Giants all season, appearing in 153 of the Giants 161 games this year...he leads the team in virtually every offensive category including hits (142), doubles (39), homers (27), RBI (78), runs scored (98) and walks (64).
- If Chapman can double today, he'd join a short list of Giants to have 40+ doubles, 25+ homers and 15+ steals in the San Francisco-era (1958-pres.).

WHO POISONED THE WATER HOLE?: SF has flipped its script in September, going 9-3 on the road while going just 3-9 here at home...in fact, the Giants have lost 10 of their last 13 games here dating to August 31.

- ▶ The Giants are trying to win consecutive home games with a victory today for the first time since August 15-20 when they won three straight at home (one vs. the Braves and two versus the White Sox).
- ▶ Dating to August 11, SF is 7-15 (.318) at Oracle Park, the lowest home win % in the NL in that time and 28th of 30 MLB teams ahead of only Los Angeles-AL (6-13, .316) and Chicago-AL (6-16, .273)...entering play on August 11, SF was 35-23 (.603) at home, the sixth-best home win% in MLB...SF is still 42-38 at home this season.

D-D-D, DE-FENSE: Entering play today the Giants have two of *Fangraphs'* DRS leaders at their respective positions in **C Patrick Bailey** (leads all catchers with 19 DRS) and **IF Matt Chapman** (leads all third basemen with 18 DRS)...the duo rank inside the top five for DRS at *any* position this year.

THE BALLAD OF SONGBIRDS & CARDINALS: 23-year-old **RHP Hayden Birdsong** will cap his rookie season this afternoon with his 16th start for the Giants.

- ▶ Birdsong is having a bounce-back month in September, posting a 3.38 ERA (7er, 18.2ip) in four starts...the Giants have won each of his last two outings...in five August starts he had an 8.68 ERA (18er, 18.2ip) and walked 15 batters.
- ► The youngster's home ERA of 3.67 in six starts is more than 1.5 runs lower than his ERA on the road this year (5.31 ERA in nine starts).
- ▶ Between SF and the minors this year, Birdsong has thrown a career-high 125.0 innings, surpassing his total of 100.2 innings from a season ago.

INVALUABLE EXPERIENCE: The Giants will add to their total number of innings pitched by rookies this year with **RHP Hayden Birdsong** on the bump today.

- ▶ Entering play today Giants rookies have thrown 528.0 innings this season, most in the National League (ahead of Miami's 494.2 rookie innings) and second-most in the Majors behind only the A's (566.0 innings).
- ▶ Looking at it a different way, Giants rookies have thrown slightly more than 37% of the team's total 1,424.2 innings this year…looking specifically at starters, Giants rookies have thrown 322.1 of the team's 774.1 starter innings this year (41.6%).
- ▶ The 528.0 innings from rookies will fall just short of passing the 1975 Giants that got 541.1 innings from rookies.

THE ATTEN-DANCE: Through 79 home dates the Giants have averaged 33,106 fans per game here at Oracle Park, 10th-best in the Majors and seventh-highest in the National League.

Last season the Giants averaged 30,866 fans per game, 17th of 30 MLB teams...this season's attendance bump for SF has been an increase of 2,240 fans/game.

IT'LL BE HERE BEFORE WE KNOW IT: After today's game the Giants will next take the field for game action on February 22, 2025 in Surprise, AZ when they open up Cactus League play against the Rangers....the club's first home date at Scottsdale Stadium will be February 23, 2025 against the Reds.

▶ SF opens its 2025 regular season slate March 27 in Cincinnati...the 2025 home opener here at Oracle Park will be Friday, April 4 vs. Seattle.

This Date in Giants History SEPTEMBER 29, 1976 - John "The Count" Montefusco pitched a no-

hitter, besting the Braves 9-0 in Atlanta. He needed just 97 pitches to dispatch Atlanta, while **Johnnie LeMaster** drove in three runs on strength of a double and a triple.

TODAY'S START: The 23-year-old is scheduled to make his 16th big league start today...he's gone 5-5 with a 4.66 ERA (35er, 67.2ip) in his 15 starts, with the Giants going 6-9 in his outings... had his contract selected from Triple-A Sacramento on June 26.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned back-to-back wins for the second time this season (also: July 21-27)...threw 95 pitches across 5.0 innings of work in SF's 6-3 win at Arizona on Monday...allowed two runs (both earned) on four hits with two walks and six strikeouts.

TAKING FLIGHT: Birdsong is ending the season on a high note after struggling last month...in his three most recent starts, Birdsong has allowed just five earned runs across 15.2ip (2.87 ERA) and held opponents to a .179 average and a .508 OPS...in his previous six starts (8/6-9/4), Birdsong posted an 8.31 ERA (20er, 21.2ip) and allowed batters a .253 average and a .926 OPS...the Giants lost each of the six games.

THROW THAT CURVE: He's thrown 252 curveballs this season at the MLB level and batters are 6-for-52 (.115) with 26 strikeouts off the pitch...the Cardinals have done well against the curveball this season...their .237 average against it ranks fifth-best in the NL, while their .423 slugging percentage is third-best in the NL.

VS. THE LEFTY: Lefties are batting just .203 (29x143) with a .315 slugging percentage off Birdsong this season, while righties are hitting .231 (24x104) with a .490 SLG...however, Birdsong issues far more walks to lefties (6.18 BB/9) vs. righties (4.13 BB/9).

NO PLACE LIKE HOME: Birdsong owns a 3.67 ERA (11er, 27.0ip) at home versus a 5.31 ERA (24er, 40.2ip) on the road...opponents own a .735 OPS against Birdsong on the road and a .697 OPS at home.

GETTING AHEAD: In his last three starts, Birdsong worked ahead with more first pitch strikes, logging a 58.1% first pitch strike rate...in the tough six start stretch that preceded, his first pitch strike % was 46.7%...after Birdsong falls behind 1-0, opposing batters have walked 27 times while posting an .849 OPS...when he's gotten ahead 0-1 they have a .608 OPS and have drawn just 13 walks.

HEAVY LIFTING: Birdsong has worked a combined 125.0 innings this year between Double-A Richmond (48.1ip), Triple-A Sacramento (9.0ip) and the Giants (67.2ip)...in fact he's already passed his innings total from last year (100.2 innings across three levels), which was his first full year in pro ball after being drafted in 2022.

THE FUTURE IS NOW: The Illinois native entered the 2024 campaign as the Giants #6 prospect according to *Baseball America* and #7 according to *MLB.com...*he has since graduated from the prospect rankings given his accrued MLB time this year but is still one of SF's younger pitching hopefuls having just turned 23 on Aug. 30.

EARLY ARRIVAL: Birdsong became the second Giant from the 2022 draft to reach the Majors, joining **OF Wade Meckler** (eighth round), who did so last year...there are just four players from the *first* round of that 2022 draft that have reached the Majors overall (IF Jackson Holliday with Baltimore, IF Zach Neto with the Angels, OF Jordan Beck with Colorado, IF Brooks Lee with Minnesota)...at the time of his debut, there were just 12 players selected ahead of Birdsong (6th round, 30th pick) in that 2022 draft that had made their debuts.
