TODAY'S GAME: The Giants look to get back in the win column in tonight's series opener vs. their Northern California rivals.

- ▶ SF is coming off a 2-3 road trip in which the Giants took both games played vs. the Braves (the finale was rained out and re-scheduled for late August) before getting swept in a three-game series at the Marlins...SF has been swept six times this season, tied with Kansas City and Detroit for most in MLB.
- ▶ Despite the record, SF's pitching staff had a strong road trip, posting a 3.64 ERA (17er, 42.0ip) and a 1.31 WHIP.
- ▶ With a loss tonight, SF would fall to 16 games under .500 for the first time since finishing the 2018 season 73-89.

TODAY'S STARTER: LHP Robbie Ray is set to open the series tonight...the lefty technically came out of the bullpen in his last outing (June 17 at ATL), resuming a rain-delayed game in the 2nd inning that was started the day prior by RHP Adrian Houser.

- ▶ In that game, Ray became the third Giants pitcher since 1901 to throw 6.0+ shutout innings of relief with two or fewer hits allowed and at least eight strikeouts (also Mike McCormick in 1968 and Larry Jansen in 1953).
- ▶ After a run of rough outings in May (6.44 ERA), Ray has turned it around in June, going 2-0 with a 2.65 ERA (5er, 17.0ip), 15 strikeouts and a 1.06 WHIP in three games.
- ▶ Ray is 2-3 with a 3.23 ERA (17er, 47.1ip), 61 strikeouts and a 1.20 WHIP in eight career starts vs. the A's.

VS. THE A'S: The Giants can secure at least a split for the season series vs. the A's with a win tonight...SF took two of three in West Sacramento in May.

- ▶ SF is 8-2 over its last 10 games vs. the A's dating to August 18, 2024.
- ▶ The Giants are 9-3 (.750) vs. the A's here at Oracle Park since the start of the 2021 season...SF's .750 home winning percentage is its third best vs. any opponent over that time behind only its marks vs. Colorado (33-6, .846) and Philadelphia (14-4, .778).
- ▶ The Giants are 5-10 (.333) vs. interleague opponents this season, tied with the Angels (9-18, .333) for the worst interleague winning percentage in MLB.

SCHMITTY CONNECTS: IF/OF Casey Schmitt has at least two hits in each of his last six games...the last Giant with a multi-hit game streak of six or more games was Marco Scutaro with a seven-game streak in 2013.

- ▶ In this six-game stretch, Schmitt is batting .565 (13x23) with three runs, three doubles, a homer, four RBI and a 1.409 OPS.
- ▶ Schmitt currently leads the Giants in total bases (147), home runs (16), RBI (42), stolen bases (seven), slugging percentage (.531) and OPS (.855).
- ▶ Of the seven MLB players with at least 26 multi-hit games in 2026, three play for SF in IF Luis Arraez (29, 2nd), OF Jung Hoo Lee (26, T-4th) and Schmitt (26, T-4th) (Stats, LLC).

BRYCE, BRYCE, BABY: IF Bryce Eldridge has reached base in 24 of his last 25 games since May 23...the rookie is slashing .364/.457/.625 with 18 runs, eight doubles, five home runs, 14 RBI, 16 walks and a 1.082 OPS over that span.

- ▶ Overall, Eldridge is batting .298, which is second best in MLB among qualified rookies...the only rookie ahead of him is the A's Henry Bolte, who is a Palo Alto High School grad.
- ▶ In June, Eldridge ranks inside the NL's top-10 in batting average (.348, 6th), on-base percentage (.442, 4th) and OPS (1.017, 5th).
- ▶ Eldridge has a .998 OPS with three doubles, four homers and nine RBI in 16 games at Oracle Park this season...the last SF batter to have a .998 OPS or better in his first 16 home games was J.D. Davis in 2022 (1.069 OPS)...the last Giants rookie to have an OPS of .998 or better in their first 16 home games in a season was Jason Ellison in 2005 (1.231 OPS).

LET'S PLAY TWO: The Giants announced yesterday that they will now play a split doubleheader vs. the Diamondbacks on Saturday, August 29...Sunday, August 30, will now serve as an off-day for both clubs...Game 1 will begin at 1:05 p.m. PT. and Game 2 will remain at 7:05 p.m. PT.

- ▶ The schedule change comes as a result of SF's game vs. Atlanta on June 18 being postponed due to rain...that game has been rescheduled for Monday, August 31, in Atlanta.

WITH THE GIANTS: The 2021 Cy Young Award winner is in his third season with the Giants and his 13th season overall in the Majors... the 2026 season marks the fifth year of a five-year, \$115 million contract he signed with Seattle in late 2021...he opted into the final two years of the contract prior to the 2025 season with SF.

LAST START: Earned the win in his last outing on June 16 vs. Atlanta...Ray resumed the Giants' suspended game and threw 6.1-scoreless innings, allowing just two hits and two walks with a season-high eight strikeouts...it marked just his fifth career appearance out of the bullpen and his first since September 1, 2020 with Toronto at Miami.

GRAB SOME PINE: With his eight strikeouts in his last start, Ray has now struck out 303 batters in a Giants uniform (2024-2026)... it marked his 54th game with the franchise, which is the fewest games needed to reach 300 strikeouts with the Giants among left-handed pitchers all-time (STATS, LLC).

PAGING DR. ROBBY: Is 2-0 with a 2.57 ERA (6er, 21.0ip), 21 strikeouts and a .208 opponents average against in his last four outings with the Giants winning each of those four games...prior to that he had a rough three games stretch where he posted a 0-2 record with an 11.08 ERA (16er, 13.0ip) and a .370 opponents average against.

WALK IT OUT: Has issued 38 walks over his 79.2 innings pitched this year, the fifth-most walks in the Majors.

SLIP AND SLIDE: Ray's slider has been different this year with his average velo dropping from 87.9 mph last year to 85.8 mph this year...he's also allowed four HR with it compared to seven all of last year...opponents are hitting .254 off his slider this season, compared to a .206 average last year...in 2025 his slider had a run value of 4, compared to a run value of -2 this season.

AGAINST THE ATHLETICS: Is slated to make his ninth career start against the Athletics...is 2-3 with a 3.23 ERA (17er, 47.1ip) and 61 strikeouts...his last start against the Athletics came on July 30, 2024 when he allowed four runs in 4.1 innings of work in the Giants 5-2 loss to the A's.

LEFT ON READ: Left-handers were just 1-for-10 off Ray in his last outing, after going 11-for-27 (.407) off him with three doubles, triple and HR in his previous six starts...prior that that tough stretch, lefties were 6-for-36 (.167) with no extra-base hits through his first eight starts of the year.

RUNNERS ON: When leading off an inning, opponents are hitting .355 (27-for-76) off Ray...overall, opponents are hitting .345 (30-for-87) off him with no one on base and no one out, compared to a .169 (20-for-118) average with runners on base...opponents are just 9-for-55 (.164) off him with runners in scoring position and have just two hits in 27 at-bats (.074) with runners in scoring position and two outs.

- ▶ Will make his first start (11th overall this season) since May 26 versus Arizona (L, 5.0ip, 3h, 3r, 3er 3bb, 3k)...is returning from a left hamstring strain that landed him on the 15-day Injured List.
- ▶ Struggled with command in his lone rehab outing at Triple-A Sacramento last Tuesday, as he pitched 3.0 innings and allowed one earned run on one hit, three strikeouts, and five walks.
- ▶ Is set to make his fourth career appearance against the A's (all starts), against whom he's 0-3 with a 3.71 ERA (7er, 17.0ip)...faced the A's in Sacramento on May 15 this season, and he took the loss after allowing five earned runs on 10 hits over 5.0 innings pitched.
