THE TWINS: After completing their first home series of the season by going 1-2 against Houston over the weekend, the Twins began their second roadtrip of the season with a loss to the Royals in Kansas City last night...tonight, the Twins will play the second of four at Kauffman Stadium...after this series, the Twins will return home for a six-game homestand, playing three against Detroit over the weekend, followed by three against the Mets next Monday-Wednesday.

KANSAS CITY MISERY: The Twins lost to the Royals last night by a score of 4-2...Simeon Woods Richardson (0-1) was the starter and loser, allowing four runs on eight hits in 5.2 innings pitched, with four walks and six strikeouts...Scott Blewett made his 2025 debut, pitching 2.1 scoreless innings of relief with one hit allowed, no walks and two strikeouts...the offense recorded seven hits, two from both Matt Wallner and Harrison Bader...Minnesota scored on a Willi Castro second-inning double and a Bader ninth-inning single...Rocco Baldelli was ejected for the 15th time in his managerial career, after arguing a pitch clock violation called on Woods Richardson in the sixth inning.

LIFE OF PABLO: Since being acquired by the Twins in January of 2023, Pablo López has gone 27-19, 3.82 ERA (391.1 IP, 166 ER) with 90 walks, 440 strikeouts, a 1.17 WHIP and 39 quality stats in 66 starts...below are López's ranks among AL starters since the start of 2023 (minimum 300.0 innings pitched):

ROYALTY CHECK: The Twins went 7-6 against the Royals last season, going 5-2 at Target Field and 2-4 at Kauffman Stadium.

- Twins have gone 28-16 in their last 44 against the Royals, dating back to April 21, 2022.
- Twins have dropped five-straight to the Royals, marking their longest losing streak to KC since August 14-September 6, 2016, when they lost seven-straight.
- Rocco Baldelli has a career managerial record of 56-38 vs. Kansas City...56 wins are his second-most against any opponent (Chicago-AL - 57-39).
- Byron Buxton is hitting .319 (45-for-141) with 16 doubles, seven home runs, 21 RBI, 33 runs scored and a .991 OPS in his last 38 games against the Royals.
- Carlos Correa is hitting .297 (57-for-192) with 10 doubles, seven home runs, 23 RBI, 25 walks, a .378 on-base percentage and an .847 OPS in 50 games against the Royals since '19.
- Harrison Bader has reached safely in all 11 of his games played at Kauffman Stadium...in those 11 he is hitting .341 (14-for-41) with an .879 OPS.
- Jose Miranda has hit safely in 10-straight against KC and six-straight at Kauffman.

CI-TY OF FOUNTAINS: Ty France is hitting .406 (43-for-106) with nine doubles, five home runs, 20 RBI, a .496 on-base percentage, a .632 slugging percentage and a 1.128 OPS in 28 career games against the Royals; the OPS is his highest against any opponent...of those 28 games, he has four three-hit games, a four-hit game and a five-hit game...in 12 career games at Kauffman, he is slashing .477/.603/.727 (1.331 OPS).

Among players with a minimum of 50 plate appearances at Kauffman since 2021, France ranks first in batting average, on-base percentage and OPS, and second in slugging.

THE MOOSE IS ON THE LOOSE: After going 2-for-3 last night, Matt Wallner has now recorded six hits in his last eight at-bats over his last two games...below are Wallner's number comparisons over the first 10 games of the season:

LEFT OUT: The Twins have gone 5-for-70 (.071) with four doubles and no home runs (.273 OPS) against left-handed pitching this season, compared to 61-for-261 (.234) against right-handed pitching...in 2024, Minnesota hitters slashed .253/.310/.422 (.732 OPS) against lefties, compared to .244/.317/.407 (.724 OPS) against righties.

Minnesota's .422 slugging percentage vs. lefties last season ranked fourth in the AL and ninth in baseball...their .732 OPS ranked fourth in the AL and 10th in baseball.

Career notable numbers against Cole Ragans: Byron Buxton is 3-for-6 with a triple and two walks...Carlos Correa is 3-for-6 with two doubles, one triple and two walks.

WILL-MATIC: Willi Castro has reached base safely in all 10 of the Twins games...he is one of five players in the AL to reach safely in all of their games played (min. 10 games), joining Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (11), Jacob Wilson (11), Kristian Campbell (10) and Adley Rutschman (10).

It marks the longest on-base streak for a Twin to start a season since Trevor Larnach reached safely in his first 11 of 2023.

CONTACTUAL AGREEMENTS: The Twins struck out just five times last night, their fourth game striking out five times or fewer...they enter today tied for 11th in baseball in fewest strikeouts with 81...through 10 games in 2024, they had struck out 105 times.

'PENSION PLAN: Despite allowing five runs (4 earned) in Sunday's loss to the Astros, over the last eight games, the Twins bullpen has posted a 1.83 ERA (34.1 IP; 7 ER) with five walks, 37 strikeouts, a .209 opponent batting average and a .576 opponent OPS.

CHILDREN OF THE CORN: High-A Cedar Rapids right-handed pitcher Spencer Bengard and outfielder Gabriel Gonzalez were named Midwest League Pitcher and Player of the Week.

Bengard, 22, pitched 4.0 no-hit innings with six strikeouts and one walk leading theernels to a 4-1 victory over Wisconsin on Friday.

Gonzalez, 21, went 6-for-13 with three doubles, a home run and three RBI in three games for the kernels...on Sunday, he recorded two doubles and a home run, while driving in three.

- Making third start of the season and 161st career start...seventh vs. Kansas City.
Lopez is 5-1, posting a 2.50 ERA (39.2 IP, 11 ER), with four walks and 45 strikeouts in six starts against the Royals.
Allowed one run on four hits (1 ER, 1 HR), one walk and five strikeouts in 7.0 quality innings during his last start at Chicago-AL on April 2, earning his first win of the season.

KING PABLO: Last pitched on April 2 at Rate Field vs. the White Sox...earned his first win of the season, and his first win since September 10, 2024, in Minnesota's 6-1 victory...allowed one run on four hits (1 ER, 1 HR) in 7.0 quality innings...secured his first career win against the White Sox and the Twins' second win of the season.

- With his 7.0 innings pitched, Lopez surpassed 900 career innings...he is the 53rd among active starting pitchers in MLB to accomplish this.
His lone run allowed was a home run from Brooks Baldwin during the seventh inning.
This marked the first time he has allowed one run or less since his scoreless three game streak from August 18-30, 2024.

THE ROYAL TREATMENT: In six career starts vs. Kansas City, Lopez is 5-1, 2.50 ERA (39.2 IP, 11 ER), four walks, 45 strikeouts, allowing a .222 (32-for-144) opponent batting average...in 2024, Lopez made two quality starts against the Royals, posting a 2.08 ERA (13.0 IP, 3 ER), with no walks and 12 strikeouts, allowing four runs off 10 hits...his 45 strikeouts are his second most against American League teams, with him having 47 strikeouts in eight appearances against Tampa Bay.

- His five wins against the Royals are tied for his most wins against an opponent, the other team being the New York Mets, for which his record is 5-5...his .833 win percentage is the highest among teams he has started against at least six times.
Last pitched at Kauffman Stadium on Opening Day last season, March 28, 2024, where he earned the win in Minnesota's 4-1 victory, allowing one run on four hits — a leadoff homer from Maikel Garcia in the first inning — with no walks and seven strikeouts.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Since being traded to the Twins, Lopez has gone 13-8 with a 3.86 ERA (191.1 IP, 82 ER), 10.21 K/9, 1.93 BB/9 and 0.99 HR/9 in 32 starts at home, compared to 16-11 with a 3.60 ERA (212.2 IP, 85 ER), 9.86 K/9, 2.20 BB/9 and 1.31 HR/9 in 36 road starts.

- In 2024, allowed a .265 (90-for-340) batting average and .711 OPS at home, compared to a .240 (90-for-375) AVG and .700 OPS away.
In his last seven road starts, Lopez has gone 2-3, a 4.28 ERA (40.0 IP, 19 ER), with nine walks and 29 strikeouts...allowed 21 runs on 49 hits (5 HR).
In two starts at Kauffman, Pablo has posted a 0.73 ERA (12.0 IP, 1 ER), with three walks and 15 strikeouts...also has a .146 (6-for-41) opponent batting average.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Through two starts in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .360/.360/.600 in 25 at-bats vs. Lopez, while righties have slashed .136/.174/.136 in 22 at-bats...lefties posted an average exit velocity of 93.0 mph and a hard-hit percentage of 54.5 compared to righties' 84.4 mph and 17.6 percent.

- Has a whiff rate of 18.8 percent vs. lefties and 22.4 percent vs. righties.

THE ARSENAL: Lopez uses a five-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer nearly 45% of the time, the most he's used the pitch in his career...primarily uses his sweeper and sinker against right-handed batters, while favoring his changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

- In 2024, he ranked in the 95th percentile for extension, 92nd percentile for fastball run value, 90th percentile for BB % and 89th percentile for chase %.
Currently ranks 95th percentile for breaing fun value and 90th percentile for fastball fun value...ranks in the 89th percentile for BB % and 87th percentile for extension.
In his last start on April 2 against Chicago-AL, he racked up nine swing and misses...had a high velocity of 97.3...of his four hits allowed, two were 4-seamers, one was a fastball, and one was a changeup.

Ks FOR A GOOD KAUSE: This season, Pablo is donating \$1,000 for every one of his strikeouts to the Minnesota Twins Community Fund.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP JOE RYAN (2025: 0-1, 4.50 ERA // CAREER: 33-27, 3.93 ERA)

Right-hander Joe Ryan is scheduled to start tomorrow night at Kauffman Stadium vs. the Royals...last start came on April 3 at Target Field for the Twins' Home Opener, where he took the loss in Minnesota's 2-5 defeat, allowing four runs on five hits (2 HR), with no walks and six strikeouts in 5.0 innings...Ryan has eight career starts against Kansas City where he is 6-0, posting a 1.49 ERA (48.1 IP, 8 ER), with 11 walks and 55 strikeouts...the Twins are a perfect 8-0 against the Royals when Ryan starts.

CAREER NOTES

- In 2025, made his third career Opening Day start, became the fourth different Twins pitcher to start at least three-straight Opening Days, joining Bert Blyleven (1972-76), Brad Radke (1999-05) and Dave Goltz (1977-79).
In 2024, recorded his 800th career strikeout on June 6 at New York-AL, fanning Gleyber Torres in the second inning.
Tied career high and set 2024 season high with 14 strikeouts on June 23 at Oakland (6.0 IP)...also pitched 8.0 shutout innings with two hits allowed and one walk during the start, earning the win in a 3-0 Twins victory.
Earned 50th career win in 150th career start on August 12, 2024 vs. Kansas City, allowing three runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and five strikeouts.
2023 recipient of Mike Augustin "Media Good Guy" Award and Carl R. Pohlad Outstanding Community Service Award.
Won both 2023 Postseason starts, allowing one run in 12.2 total innings and helping Twins snap 18-game Postseason losing streak with a G1 win in the ALWCS vs. Toronto.
In 2023, earned first All-Star selection and finished seventh in AL Cy Young Award voting after posting career highs in innings (194.0) and strikeouts (234).
On April 21, 2023, signed a four-year contract extension through the 2027 season with Minnesota.
In 2022, set career highs in wins (10), games started (32), innings (180.0) and strikeouts (174) as No. 2 starter for Miami.
489 career strikeouts with Miami are 11th on their all-time list and is one of 16 pitchers in Marlins history to reach 500.0 innings pitched.
In 2021, spent fourth season with Miami, holding opponents to two-or-fewer runs in 15 of his 18 starts and posting a career-low 1.12 WHIP.
Made first career Postseason appearance October 7, 2020, going 5.0 innings in a loss to Atlanta in Game 2 of the National League Division Series.
Received 2020 Marlins Charlie Hough Good Guy Award, voted on by Miami chapter of BBWAA recognizing a Miami player who fostered a strong relationship with reporters.
In 2020, spent entire season on active roster and led Marlins in innings pitched (57.1), games started (11), wins (6), and strikeouts (59).
Made only 21 starts in 2019 after missing over two months on the Injured List with a right shoulder strain, posting a 5.09 ERA in 111.1 innings pitched with 95 strikeouts.
Made major league debut on June 30, 2018 vs. New York-NL and earned first career victory, tossing 6.0 innings with five strikeouts while limiting the Mets to two runs.
Acquired by Miami along with outfielder Braynan Hernandez, right-handed pitcher Brandon Miller and right-handed pitcher Lukas Schiraldi from Seattle in exchange for right-handed pitcher David Phelps on July 20, 2017.
